### FIRST SERVE

» Penn State hosts Charleston (WV) and George Mason in this weekends EIVA Conference matches in Rec Hall. The Nittany Lions will face the Golden Eagles of Charleston (WV) on Friday at 7 p.m., followed by a Saturday February 27 matchup with the Patriots of George Mason with a first whistle slated for 7 p.m.

» Penn State men's volleyball notched its ninth and tenth wins of the season this past weekend moving to 5-0 in EIVA play in the process. Penn State downed Princeton in straight sets (25-20, 25-20, 25-20) and defeated NJIT in the second four-set match of the season for the Nittany Lions (21-25, 25-21, 25-20, 25-22).

» Penn State moved up one spot to No. 6 in the latest AVCA Top 15 Coaches Poll. PSU has been in the top 15 the last six consecutive weeks since debuting at No. 10 in the AVCA DI-II pre-season poll. The Nittany Lions have now seen or will see a total of nine teams from the top 15 at some point during the regular season.

» This weekend's matches against Charleston (WV) and George Mason are the third and fourth games of an 11-game homestand at Rec Hall for the Nittany Lions. Penn State will compete at home for over a month with their next road match coming on April 1 in Princeton, N.J.

» Penn State currently leads the EIVA with a 5-0 record in conference play. Harvard is second in the EIVA with a record of 3-1 in conference play and 6-5 overall. Sacred Heart is in third-place as the final team with a 3-1 record in conference play and 3-8 record overall.

» The Nittany Lions welcome Charleston (WV) to University Park to begin a new series with the Nittany Lions.

» Penn State looks to continue its success against George Mason Saturday February 27th as they enter the match holding a 88-14 series lead over the Patriots. The Nittany Lions defeated George Mason 3-0 during their last matchup in Rec Hall back on May 1, 2015 in the EIVA Championship match.

» Following a 2015 season that featured Penn State men's volleyball's 17th consecutive trip the NCAA national semifinals, the Nittany Lions return a core group of nine letterwinners and three starters this year, while welcoming four freshmen to the roster

» Penn State is ranked in the top-25 in four different team categories including top-10 rankings in Hitting Percentage - .305 (10th), Blocks Per Set - 2.61 (6th), and currently lead the nation in Kills Per Set - 13.76, and Assists Per Set - 13.00. Individually, Chris Nugent is ranked seventh in the nation in Points Per Set (4.90) and eighth in the nation in Kills Per Set (4.23), while Matt Callaway is currently sixth in the nation in Blocks Per Set averaging 1.26. Taylor Hammond leads the nation in Assists Per Set currently averaging 11.75.

» The 27-time defending EIVA champion Penn State men's volleyball team was selected as this year's EIVA preseason favorite. The Nittany Lions were voted to capture this year's championship crown by the league's seven head coaches, receiving six of a possible eight first-place votes in the preseason poll.

» The Nittany Lions will square off a total of nine teams featured in the this season's AVCA preseason poll including eight teams ranked within the top 15 and two receiving votes.

» University Park will be the site of the 2016 National Collegiate Men's Volleyball Championship, marking the sixth time in school history that Rec Hall has hosted the event. Penn State will serve as the host of the vaunted event on May 5-7, 2016. Penn State men's volleyball was selected as one of two Nittany Lion programs to host an NCAA national championship.

Penn State is ranked in the top-25 in four different team categories including top-10 rankings in Hitting Percentage - .305 (10th), Blocks Per Set - 2.61 (6th), and currently lead the nation in Kills Per Set - 13.76, and Assists Per Set - 13.00. Individually, Chris Nugent is ranked seventh in the nation in Points Per Set (4.90) and eighth in the nation in Kills Per Set (4.23), while Matt Callaway is currently sixth in the nation in Blocks Per Set averaging 1.26. Taylor Hammond leads the nation in Assists Per Set currently averaging 11.75.

### EIVA OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Redshirt-Junior Matt Callaway has been selected as the EIVA Defensive Player of the Week after helping No. 7 Penn State to a 2-0 week in EIVA action.

In a 3-1 victory at home against NJIT, Callaway recorded five total blocks and in a 3-0 sweep of Princeton added nine total blocks. Matt currently leads the EIVA in total blocks (49), blocks assist (44), and blocks per set (1.26). This is Callaway's first EIVA Defensive Player of the Week selection in 2016.

### PENN STATE VOTED EIVA PRE-SEASON FAVORITE

The 17-time defending EIVA champion Penn State men's volleyball team has been selected as the 2016 EIVA pre-season favorite. The Nittany Lions were voted to capture this year's championship crown by the league's eight head coaches. Penn State received six of a possible eight first-place votes in the preseason poll, while George Mason picked up two. The Patriots are slotted to finish second, while Princeton, NJIT and St. Francis (Pa.) round out the top five in spots three through five.

### NITTANY LIONS PICKED 10TH IN AVCA PRESEASON POLL

Penn State, along with No. 6 Ohio State and No. 14 George Mason were the only EIVA schools to earn a spot on this year's AVCA DI-II Men's Volleyball Preseason Poll. The Nittany Lions checked in at No.10. BYU earned this year's No. 1 overall spot, while UC-Irvine grabbed the No. 2 position. Defending NCAA national champion Loyola-Chicago checked in at No. 3, while Long Beach State and UCLA rounded out the top five at No. 4 and No. 5, respectively.

### PSU TO HOST 2016 NCAA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

University Park will be the site of the 2016 National Collegiate Men's Volleyball Championship, marking the sixth time in school history that Rec Hall has hosted the event. The announcement came during the 2014 NCAA announcement of its host sites through the 2017-18 season.

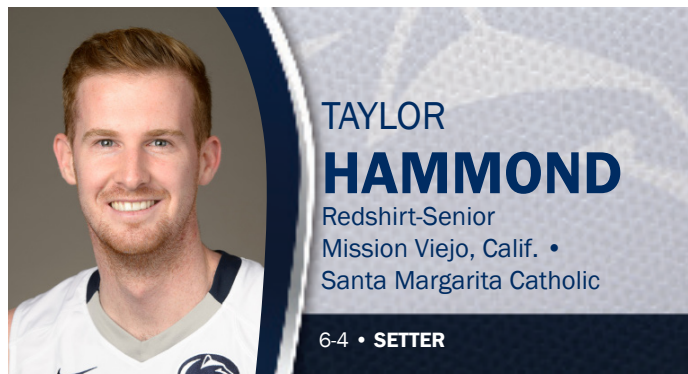

Led the team with five blocks at Saint Francis (4/25) ... Had six kills on seven perfect swings in the EIVA semis against Princeton (4/29) ... Posted four kills in the EIVA finals vs. GMU (5/1) ... Posted three kills, two digs and a team-high four blocks in the NCAA play-in against No. 4 Hawaii (5/5) ... Had three kills and a team-high four blocks in the NCAA national semifinals against No. 1 Lewis (5/7).

Had 24 assists, two digs and a block at No. 10 Hawaii (1/9) ... Dished out a career-high 60 assists to go along with five digs at Ball State (1/16) ... Recorded a double-double with 47 assists and a career-high 14 digs vs. No. 1 Loyola (1/23) ... Paced the team to a season-high .425 hitting clip vs. Mount Olive (1/30), adding a team-high nine digs ... Directed the team to a .500 hitting percentage against Erskine (2/6), matching a career-high mark with three blocks ... Recorded a career-high five blocks at No. 12 Ohio State (2/10) ...
