THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

• Penn State and Robert Morris will meet for the 9th and 10th time this weekend as the two in-state foes play a home-and-home series.

 The all-time series is tied as each side has won four times, however, Penn State is 2-0-0 all-time in the two venues that will be used this weekend as the series opener on Friday will be played at Pegula Ice Arena where PSU secured a 7-4 victory last season and Saturday's contest will take place at Colonials Arena, formerly 84 Lumber Arena, where the Nittany Lions picked up a 5-4 victory back in 2013. Five of the meetings have been played at PPG Paints Arena, formerly CONSOL Energy Center, the home of the Pittsburgh Penguins while the first-ever matchup took place at Greenberg Ice Pavilion in 2012.

 Penn State swept the season series last year with a 5-2 victory at PPG Paints and a 7-4 win at Pegula Ice Arena as the two teams once again played a home-and-home series.

• Last season both Denis Smirnov and Nate Sucese scored twice in the series finale at Pegula and three times during the two games while Smirnov added a pair of assists for five total points and Sucese registered one helper for four points.

• Peyton Jones started both games between the pipes for the Nittany Lions stopping 61-of-67 shots for a .910 save percentage in the two victories.

WALK THE LINE

 Penn State's most productive forward line so far this season has been the one of sophomore's Alex Limoges and Evan Barratt paired with junior Liam Folkes. In seven games this season the line has combined to score 11 goals while adding 17 assists for 28 points.

• Dating back to the end of the 2017-18 campaign the line has registered 22 goals while adding 26 assists for 48 points in their last 14 games.

• During that time the trio has distributed the scoring evenly with Limoges scoring nine goals while adding nine assists for 18 points, Barratt has lit the lamp seven times with eight assists for 15 points and Folkes has scored six goals while adding nine assists for 15 points. Penn State has gone 11-3-0 over its last 14 games dating back to the end of last season.

• Overall in 35 career games together the Limoges - Barratt - Folkes combination has registered 38 goals and 41 assists for 79 points while the Nittany Lions have a 19-11-5 record when the trio is paired together.

PEYTON'S PAINT

• Junior Peyton Jones already holds every Penn State single-season goaltending record and after becoming the all-time leader in games started by a goaltender following the Princeton game, he added another all-time record last weekend against ASU.

• Jones became the all-time leader in minutes played by a goaltender at Penn State as he has now served 4448:07 between the pipes for the Blue and White.

 His 43 victories are already a Nittany Lion career record while the junior is just three appearances and 123 saves away from two more Penn State career standards. One more shutout would also give Jones solo possession of that Nittany Lion career milestone.

FUNKEY COLD MEDINA

• Senior Chris Funkey made his third start of the season last Friday securing his third-straight victory improving to 3-0-0 on the year. Funkey entered the season with just three career wins as he has now doubled his total and stands at 6-4-1 overall in 17 career appearances with nine starts.

TWO-WAY HOCKEY

• Early in the season Penn State has excelled on both ends of the ice averaging 4.86 goals per game while only allowing 2.57 goals on the defensive end ranking them first and second in the Big Ten, respectively. The Nittany Lion offense leads the entire nation in goals per game as well as points per game, averaging 13.57.

• Penn State is also leading the nation in shots per game (42.57) and blocked shots per game (21.71) while its .626 faceoff percentage is also tops in the country.

• Junior Kris Myllari's 33 blocked shots and 4.71 blocks per game are both tops in the nation while senior Ludvig Larsson's .736 faceoff percentage is the best mark in the country.

BALANCED ATTACK

• Penn State ranks third in the nation with 34 goals through the first seven games while nine of 14 players who have scored already have multiple goals.

• Of those nine, eight have at least three goals, which is the most players on a single team in the country with at least three goals.

CHASE-ING RECORDS

• Senior captain Chase Berger continues to make his way up the all-time games played list at Penn State where he now sits tied for sixth with 122 games under his belt.

• Berger became just the fourth player in program history to hit the 40 career goals mark a few weeks ago and he is also now just four points shy of becoming the third Nittany Lion to reach 100 points.

• The senior's 96 career points rank third in the Big Ten and ninth in the nation among active players.

BLUE STREAK

• Penn State currently has three players riding career-long point streaks as Barratt, Limoges and junior Nikita Pavlychev have each registered at least one point in six-straight games. No surprise the three rank first, second and third on the team in scoring.


• During this streak Limoges has four multi-point games in his last five while Barratt has three multi-point efforts in his last five games.

• After missing a few games with an injury to open the season, junior Denis Smirnov is back to his scoring ways and is currently on a four-game point streak.

• Freshman Aarne Talvitie saw his career-best five-game point streak snapped last Saturday.

SCOUTING ROBERT MORRIS



at 3-4-1 on the year after splitting an Atlantic Hockey series last weekend against Niagara. Like Penn State the Colonials have played seven of their eight games at home to begin the season and dropped their lone road game to Bowling Green, 6-0. At home Bobby Mo is 3-3-1.

 RMU returns four of its top six scorers from last season, but are without the services of leading point getter Brady Ferguson who paced the team with 18 goals and 31 assists for 49 points. Ferguson finished his career with 66 goals and 101 assists for 167 points, which led all active players at the end of last season.

• The Colonials do return second leading scorer Alex Tonge who produced 44 points in 2017-18 on 17 goals and 27 assists. Tonge's 105 career points are good for eighth among active players. RMU also returns double-digit goal scorers Luke Lynch and Michael Louria who recorded 17 and 14, respectively, last season.

• So far this season the Colonials are averaging just 2.00 goals per game and are led by Tonge with just six points on two goals and four assists. Freshman Nick Lalonde leads the team with three goals.

• Back between the pipes for his junior season is Francis Marotte after compiling at 17-15-3 record with a .917 save percentage and a 2.56 goals against average last season. Marotte has started all eight games so far this season and boasts a .908 save percentage and a 2.67 goals against average.

Robert Morris hasn't started games particularly fast this season as they are being doubled up in the opening period 8-4 through the first eight games. RMU has also only converted on 6-of-45 power-play chances (13.3 percent) to rank 49th in the nation while its PK ranks 20th at 83.3 percent (35-for-42).

THE FINAL COUNTDOWN

· We're leaving together, win or lose, but heading into last weekend the Nittany Lions hadn't trailed entering the third period all season. In both games against Arizona State, however, Penn State found itself behind to begin the final 20 minutes.

• The Nittany Lions roared back both nights scoring three third period goals to earn the 6-5 victory on Friday before lighting the lamp twice in the third to force overtime on Saturday.

· So far this season Penn State is outscoring its opponents, 16-4, over the final period with only two of those tallies being of the empty net variety.

60 PERCENT OF THE TIME IT WORKS EVERY TIME

· Last Saturday marked the 100th game at Pegula Ice Arena with the Nittany Lions holding a 60-30-10 all-time record in the venue with an even more impressive 56-18-8 mark on home ice since the start of the 2014-15 season.

 During that span starting in the fall of 2014. Penn State has a +121 goal differential at home outscoring opponents 362-241

· Pegula Ice Arena has been sold-out for 91-straight games and 96 overall with the Nittany Lions outscoring opponents





• Penn State opens Big Ten play at home against No. 14 Michigan next Friday and Saturday. This marks the second time in the past three seasons that the Nittany Lions and Wolverines have opened conference play against each other and this is the third-straight season Michigan has been the first Big Ten opponent for Penn State on home ice

SMIRNOV AND SUCESE NAMED **B1G PLAYERS TO WATCH**

• Junior classmates Denis Smirnov and Nate Sucese were both named to the Preseason Big Ten Players to Watch list.

 This marks the second-consecutive season that Smirnov has made the list as he enters the 2018-19 season second on the team in career points with 74 in just 69 games while Sucese ranks not far behind with 65 points in 74 career games played. The duo has combined for 65 goals over the past two seasons.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

· Senior Chase Berger was named the sixth captain in program history for the 2018-19 campaign after serving as an alternate last season. Fellow senior Kevin Kerr and junior Brandon Biro will serve as his alternates.

RECAPPING 2017-18

· Penn State is coming off its second-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance after finishing the 2017-18 season at 18-5-5 with a 9-10-5-2 mark in Big Ten, good for a fourth place finish with 34 points in league action.

• The Nittany Lions led all Big Ten teams with 138 goals and 374 points last season ranking third and fourth in the nation, respectively, in each category. Penn State returns 109 of those goals and 274 points each topping the Big Ten while ranking first and fourth in the NCAA to open the 2018-19 season.

. The Nittany Lions have 20 players returning from last season's roster as they welcome six newcomers to the 2018-19 squad.

• Andrew Sturtz became just the third player in program history to reach the 40-point mark in a season as the junior scored 14 goals while adding 26 assists. Sturtz then became the fourth Nittany Lion to ink a professional contract signing a two-way NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators forgoing his final season in Hockey Valley.

· Penn State had six players register double-digit goals while two others fell one goal shy of that mark. The Nittany Lions ranked first in the Big Ten and third in the nation averaging 3.63 goals per game during the 2017-18 season.

· Brandon Biro had a career-year for the Blue and White ranking second on the team with 31 points on nine goals and 22 assists. Fellow classmates Nate Sucese and Denis Smirnov were also top-5 in points for the Nittany Lions with 29 and 27, respectively while Smirnov led the team with 15 goals and Sucese one behind with 14. Liam Folkes also had a career-year with 13 goals and 10 assists for 23 points.

• Senior Trevor Hamilton became the first Penn State player to earn a major conference honor as he was recognized as the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year after scoring six goals while adding 23 assists for 29 points and leading the nation in blocked shots for the second-consecutive season with 109.

 The seventh-year program boasts a program-high five NHL draft picks on the 2017-18 roster.

• The Nittany Lions also have a pair of freshman from Finland as goaltender **Oskar Autio** is following in his brothers footsteps joined by longtime friend and New Jersey Devils draft pick **Aarne Talvitie**. Both players are from Espoo and grew up playing for the Esspoo Blues.

• Graduate transfer **Ludvig Larsson** becomes the program's first-ever swedish born player as he hails from Malmo, Sweden by the way of Merrimack College (Hockey East).

PACKING THE PEG

• Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 96-of-100 home games, including all 17 regular season contests during the 2017-18 season.

• More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 65 occasions including 12 games last season.

• In 2017-18, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,906) and led the nation in building capacity percentage (102.2 percent).

• Last season, Penn State had a season-total of 112,221 fans that have been to Pegula Ice Arena.

WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula lce Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its sixth season entering 2018-19. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.

• The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.

• The 2018-19 season will be the first season the Big Ten has instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

• The Big Ten tournament will take place at on campus sites once again during the 2018-19 season.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky, will guide the Nittany Lions in his 20th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program in 2018-19 and his seventh at Penn State.

AT PENN STATE

Following the most successful season in Penn State history, Gadowsky once again led his Nittany Lions to the NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as they served as host for the Midwest Regional. However, once again the Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier during the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, which in turn, was the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 victory over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers by the Nittany Lions, which secured home-ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament Quarterfinals the following weekend, the first year the conference tournament was held at campus sites. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

In 2017-18, Gadowsky also saw junior Andrew Sturtz become just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State as well as becoming the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz then graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. Hamilton also joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only First-Team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA

Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Along the way Penn State opened the season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

In 2015-16 Gadowsky led Penn State to its first 20-win season, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose to as high as 14th in the uscho. com National Poll during the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6 the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten Quarterfinals before bowing out to eventual champion Michigan 7-2 in the semifinals.

Of his 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, garnering a winning season in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title up until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs, eventually scoring his first NHL goal in the season finale. Bailey was an All-Big Ten First Team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable mention by the league coaches.

HC

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play. Additionally, his Lions earned wins over every Big Ten team during the season including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions during the Big Ten Conference's first season. Penn State, which faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

In 2012-13, Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to a 13-14-0 record during their inaugural NCAA Division I season. He guided the squad to several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells Fargo Arena in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL barn (19,529).

In 2011-12, Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

AT PRINCETON

WELCOME TO HOCKEY VALLEY

Before coming to Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA tournament appearance.

During the 2007-08 campaign, Gadowsky, who inherited a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his ar-rival, guided Princeton to both the ECAC Hockey tournament and Ivy League crowns. The team earned its first NCAA tournament berth since 1998, Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

Gadowsky had more than 20 Tiger players go on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup cham-pion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadows-ky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

AT ALASKA

Prior to Princeton, Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he inherited a team that had not won more than 14 games in each of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Colle-giate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.

BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fres-no Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign as he garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

PLAYING CAREER

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. The three-time WCHA All-Academic Team member collected 46 points in 134 career dames.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, The Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.

PERSONAL LIFE

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.




