The No. 15 Gopher Hockey program closes out the 2014-15 regular-season this weekend with a two-game homestand against Penn State at Mariucci Arena. Both games for the weekend are set for 7:05 p.m. CT. Friday's opener will be televised on GETTV with Saturday's finale on FOX Sports North PLUS. Both games will also be streamed on BTN2Go while radio broadcasts will be determined later in the week (1500 ESPN or MyTalk 107.1).

In the Hunt

The Gophers have gone 8-3-1 in their last 12 games to climb back into the hunt for a fourth-straight regular-season conference championship and a second-straight Big Ten regular-season conference championship. Minnesota's 33 league points are tied with Michigan for second in the Big Ten -- one point behind Michigan State with 34. Penn State (28), Ohio State (18) and Wisconsin (10) round out the Big Ten standings. The 2015 Big Ten Men's Ice Hockey Tournament is slated for March 19-21 at Joe Louis Arena in Detroit. The top two seeds for the tournament get a first-round bye. The Wolverines and Spartans play each other in a home-and-home series while the Gophers host Penn State.

Salute the Seniors

This weekend's series will be the final two games at Mariucci Arena for the six members of the senior class. Seth Ambroz, Travis Boyd, Christian Isackson, Ben Marshall, Kyle Rau and Sam Warning make up one of the most successful classes in program history with three-straight regular-season conference titles (a program record) and two trips to the NCAA Frozen Four. The Gophers are 101-42-15 (687) during their tenure and 60-13-7 (.812) at Mariucci Arena. A second-straight Big Ten title this weekend would make the senior class the only group to win regular-season titles in all four years of competition at Minnesota.

Lucia Sets School Wins Record

Last Friday's 4-2 win over Ohio State gave Minnesota head coach Don Lucia his 391st win at Minnesota -- making him the winningest coach in school history. Lucia is 670-356-97 all-time as a head coach including 391-201-68 at Minnesota. Lucia's 670 career wins rank him ninth all-time in college hockey and third among active Division I coaches while he will enter his 28th overall season as a head coach and 16th season with the Gophers in 2014-15. Lucia was the inaugural Big Ten Coach of the Year last season.

Reilly Leads NCAA Defensemen in Scoring

As a sophomore last season, Mike Reilly earned First Team All-Big Ten honors, Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honors and became Minnesota's first First Team All-American since 2009. The defenseman is once again among the elite defensemen in the nation -- his 32 assists and 38 points are both first nationally among defensemen. Reilly is the first Gopher defenseman to lead the team in scoring since Mike Crowley tallied 56 points (nine goals, 47 assists) in route to All-America honors in 1996-97. His 32 assists are tied for second among all NCAA skaters this season.

The Minnesota Rau-ser

With the game winner on Friday, captain Kyle Rau ranks tied for 25th all-time at Minnesota (Mike Crowley) with 157 career points in 155 games while his next point will move him into a tie for 23rd all-time with Reggie Berg and Todd Richards. Rau's 157 points are the fourth most in the Don Lucia era behind Erik Westrum's 168 (1997-2001), Troy Riddle's 178 (2000-04) and John Pohl's 200 (1998-2002). Minnesota is 80-15-8 all-time when Rau tallies a point and 39-4-0 when the All-American records multiple points in a game. His 21 career game-winning goals are the most among active NCAA skaters.

There's No Place Like Home

Minnesota's 6-2 victory over Michigan on Feb. 13 gave the Maroon & Gold its 300th all-time win at Mariucci Arena. The 2014-15 season marks the 21st campaign in which the Gophers have called Mariucci Arena home. Since opening Mariucci Arena, Minnesota is 302-116-46 (.700) on home ice. Since the start of the 2011-12 season, the Gophers are 60-13-7 (.812) on home ice including a 15-1-3 (.853) mark last year and a 12-3-1 mark this season. Minnesota's 4-2 loss to Michigan State on Feb. 27 marked the first Big Ten Minnesota has ever lost at Mariucci Arena (14-1-2).

Wilcox Climbs Record Book

Defending Big Ten Player of the Year and Goaltender of the Year Adam Wilcox has appeared in 109 games since arriving on campus as a freshman while the All-American continues to make a name for himself in the Gopher Hockey history books. Wilcox's 11 career shutouts rank second all-time at Minnesota behind Kellen Briggs' 13 while the junior's 69 career wins are fourth all-time at Minnesota. Next up on the list for Wilcox is Hobey Baker Award winner Robb Stauber with 73 wins while Briggs also holds the school wins record at 84.

Power Play on Point

Minnesota continues to boast the nation's best power play at .291 (37-for-127). The Gophers have now tallied a power-play goal in 10 of the last 13 games are now 16-for-44 (.364) over that stretch. Minnesota is one of only two Division I schools (Yale) to have not allowed a short-handed goal this year. Travis Boyd's nine power-play goals are most

in the Big Ten this season and tied for second most in the NCAA behind St. Cloud State's Jonny Brodzinski with 10 this season.

Seniors Leading the Pack

Over the last 12 games, no class in college hockey has more goals than Minnesota's seniors with 28. The senior class has tallied 60 percent of Minnesota's 47 goals over that stretch and 43 percent of the team's 132 points.

Rau Up for Senior CLASS Award

Already a nominee for the Hobey Baker Award, Kyle Rau has now been listed as one of 10 finalists for the annual Senior CLASS Award -- given to one Division I hockey player based on achievement in the "Four C's" -- classroom, character, community and competition. Rau was honored as Gopher Hockey's John Mayasich Outstanding Student-Athlete Award winner last year and was recognized as the Henry L. Williams Legacy Award winner, which annually recognizes the top male student-athlete at the University of Minnesota who excels in competition and in the classroom while representing the values of the athletics department, earlier this year. Rau was an Academic All-Big Ten honoree as a junior last season and was a member of the All-WCHA Academic Team in 2011-12 in his first year of eligibility.

Live and In Color

Thirty-one regular-season Gopher Hockey games will be available on television during the 2014-15 across several networks. FOX Sports will lead the way in Gophers television coverage this season with 15 games while the Big Ten Network will broadcast 11 regular-season games featuring the Maroon & Gold over the course of the season. The ESPN network follows up with another four Gopher games while the American Sports Network will televise Friday's game. The entirety of the 2015 Big Ten Hockey Tournament will be broadcast live on the Big Ten Network.

And on the Radio with Wally and Frank

Gopher Hockey will continue to call 1500 ESPN home for its radio broadcast after Minnesota and Learfield Sports' Gopher Sports Properties announced a three-year agreement with the radio station this summer. Every regular-season game as well as the entire post-season will be broadcast on the 1500 ESPN radio waves through 2016-17.

Seniors to Lead in 2014-15

All-American Kyle Rau will lead the Gophers as team captain in 2014-15, making the senior the first player at the University of Minnesota to serve as captain for two-straight seasons since Grant Potulny in 2002-03 and 2003-04. Seniors Seth Ambroz and Ben Marshall will serve as alternate captains -- the 159th and 160th players to serve as either captain or alternate captain for the Gophers in a tradition that dates back to the program's first year of play in 1921-22 when Chet Bros led the Maroon & Gold.

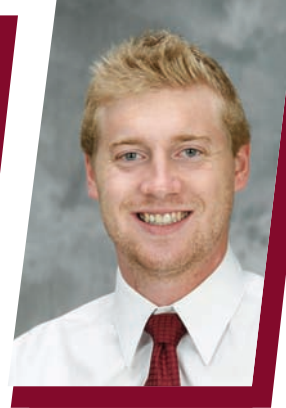
