No. 5 Penn State travels to East Lansing, Mich. for semifinal action at the Big Ten Tournament as the Nittany Lions face No. 7 Maryland for a chance to play for a Big Ten title. The Terripins and Nittany Lions take the pitch at 1:30 p.m. ET at Ralph Young Field and can be watched LIVE on BTN.

**MARYLAND SERIES HISTORY** Penn State leads 21-16-1 all-time in their series with the Terrapins dating back to 1975. Penn State is currently on a one-game slide vs. Maryland, falling to the Terps 2-1 in 2OT this season on the road in College Park, MD.

#### SCOUTING MARYLAND

The Terrapins sit at 13-5 on the year currently riding a seven-game win streak that includes wins over Michigan State (twice), Liberty, Ohio State, Penn State, Virginia and Rutgers.

Lein Holsboer is the team leader in goals (11) as well as contributinga team-high 10 assists, as well as two game-winning goals during the 2017 season.
