Series Record: Penn State leads 40-31

Last Meeting: Rutgers 70, Penn State 68 (Feb. 4, 2017)

OPENING TIP: Rutgers plays its second of three road games over four contests, when it travels to Penn State for a 4 p.m. tip-off on Saturday. The Scarlet Knights will be working to win their second straight over the Nittany Lions, after a 70-68 victory at the Bryce Jordan Center last season. It marked RU's first conference road win since joining the Big Ten in 2014-15.

The Scarlet Knights are 6-0 this season when limiting foes to 59 points or less and 8-1 when shooting a better percentage than their opponent. PSU is 7-0 when holding foes under 60 points and 12-3 when out-shooting its opponent.

The game will mark the 72nd meeting between RU and PSU dating back to 1922, with the Nittany Lions holding a 40-31 advantage. RU is 9-25 all-time at PSU, but has won four of the last five meetings in State College. Corey Sanders shot 4-of-5 from behind the arc to score a game-high 25 points in the 70-68 win on Saturday, Feb. 4. RU out-rebounded PSU 39-27 and had a 17-4 advantage in second chance points. Rutgers and Penn State were both members of the Atlantic 10 from 1976-79 and from 1982-1991.

THE OPPONENT: Under seventh-year head coach Pat Chambers, Penn State is coming off a dramatic, 82-79, win at No. 13 Ohio State Thursday night. Tony Carr hit a three-pointer from 35 feet out at the buzzer, immediately after OSU tied the game on a long-range triple with five seconds left. One of four players, including three starters, from Philadelphia's Roman Catholic High School, Carr posts 19.4 points-per-game to lead five players averaging double figures. All of the team's losses have been in either single digits, to a nationally-ranked team or in overtime.

- Rutgers and Steve Pikiell came to terms on a contract that will keep the head coach courtside at the RAC through the 2023-24 season. He was introduced as the 19th coach in program history on March 22, 2016, with an initial contract through 2020-21.

- Rutgers is 6th nationally in scoring defense (62.0), 9th in both rebounding (40.91) and offensive rebounding (13.95), 12th in FG% defense (39.0) and 17th in turnover margin (4.0). The Scarlet Knights are among the top three in 12 Big Ten stat categories.

- Rutgers concluded the fall semester with a 2.9 team GPA. Mike Williams, Jake Dadika and Myles Johnson made the Dean's List with GPAs of 3.50 or above, with seven players (Geo Baker, Joey Downes, Luke Nathan, Aaren Smith) posting GPAs of 3.0 or higher.

- Senior tri-captain Mike Williams sustained a lower leg injury in practice on Jan. 13 and is sidelined indefinitely.

- In the RU career record books, Corey Sanders ranks tied for 12th in steals (123), 14th in assists (295) and 24th in scoring (1,166). His crossover step back jumper at Michigan State and acrobatic slam dunk against Iowa were recognized as No. 3 and 4, respectively, on the Sportscenter Top 10 this season.

- Geo Baker leads all Big Ten freshmen in assists (3.1) and minutes (32.3) and is second in scoring (11.4).

- Deshawn Freeman is 5th in the Big Ten in double-doubles (7), 6th in rebounding (7.5) and 8th in steals (1.41).

- Mike Williams and Corey Sanders both exceeded 1,000 career points this season. The last duo to achieve 1,000 points in the same season was Anthony Farmer and JR Inman in 2008-09.

- After defeating No. 15 Seton Hall, Rutgers was honored as the NABC D-I National Team of the Week, Steve Pikiell was HoopDirt.com National Coach of the Week, Geo Baker was Big Ten Freshman of the Week, Corey Sanders was Met Player of the Week and Deshawn Freeman was the Hero Sports D-I Hero of the Week. That 2-0 week was capped before a capacity crowd of 8,318 at the RAC, the biggest in 15 years, and marked RU's first ranked victory since a 67-62 win over No. 4 Wisconsin on Jan. 11, 2015.

THE BEST IS YET TO COME

Throughout Steve Pikiell's career as both a player and coach he has arrived at struggling programs and been instrumental in turnarounds that have resulted in conference championships and NCAA berths.

THE WAY YOU LOOK TONIGHT

- RU's 18 assists against Iowa on Jan. 17 matched a season high and are its most in a regulation Big Ten game since joining the league in 2014-15.
- Rutgers' five turnovers against OSU marked its fewest ever in a Big Ten game and its least since committing just three at Clemson on Dec. 1, 2014.
- Rutgers limited Michigan State to 41.2 percent shooting on Jan. 10, well below its national-best 52.5 percentage.
- Rutgers' six turnovers versus Wisconsin on Jan. 5 marked its fewest in a Big Ten game since joining the conference in 2014-15.
- Rutgers shot 62.5 percent from behind the arc versus Wisconsin on Jan. 5, its best percentage under Steve Pikiell and its highest 3-point percentage since shooting 71.4 percent versus Minnesota on Feb. 23, 2016.
- With the 71-65 win over No. 15 Seton Hall on Dec. 16, Rutgers defeated a nationally-ranked team for the first time since topping No. 4 Wisconsin, 67-62, on Jan. 11, 2015. In each of Rutgers' last two wins over ranked opponents, they have erased double-digit point deficits – 14 against Wisconsin and 13 against Seton Hall.
- Rutgers defeated a nationally-ranked Seton Hall squad for the second time, with the first coming in a 70-64 win at No. 22 SHU on Feb. 4, 2001.
- The Seton Hall attendance was 8,318, signaling the largest crowd at the RAC since February 23, 2002 for a 66-60 Rutgers win over the Pirates. It was the first capacity crowd at the RAC since Ohio State on Feb. 8, 2015.
- Rutgers was honored as the NABC D-I National Team of the Week and Steve Pikiell was recognized as the HoopDirt.com National Coach of the Week on Dec. 18 after a 2-0 week consisting of wins over Fordham and No. 15 Seton Hall.
- Geo Baker was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week on Dec. 18. He averaged 14.5 points and four assists in wins over Fordham and No. 15 Seton Hall.
- Corey Sanders was named Met Player of the Week on Dec. 18. He averaged 17 points, 4.5 rebounds, 3.5 steals and 2.5 assists in a 2-0 week consisting of wins over Fordham and No. 15 Seton Hall.
- Deshawn Freeman was recognized as the Hero Sports D-I Hero of the Week on Dec. 18 after a pair of double-doubles in wins over Fordham (14 points/10 rebounds) and No. 15 Seton Hall (12 points/16 rebounds).
- Rutgers has held three teams under 40 points. The last time RU limited three or more teams to under 40 points in a season was 1945-46 (Haverford, Franklin & Marshall, Panzer, Camp Kilmer).
- Geo Baker shot 7-of-11 versus FDU en route to his first career double-double (19 points, 11 assists), which was comprised of the most helpers by an RU player in a regulation game since Marquis Webb also had 11 versus Syracuse on Jan. 24, 2005.
- Rutgers limited No. 3 MSU to a season-low 62 points and 38.6 percent shooting, well below its season average of 50.2 percent.
- At No. 12 Minnesota, Rutgers had five players score in double-figures for the first time since six players at Miami on Nov. 13, 2016.
- Rutgers won by 14 vs. East Carolina with one player in double-figures. The last time RU won by double-digits with one player scoring in double-figures was a 69-55 win over Robert Morris on Nov. 11, 2008.
- Geo Baker's 29 points vs. Bryant marked the most for an RU freshman in a regulation game since Todd Billet had 31 vs. Notre Dame on Jan. 18, 2000. Baker's seven 3-pointers were the most for an RU rookie since Billet made eight triples that same game.

- RU's 16 blocks vs. Bryant were the most since issuing 18 vs. St. Peters Dec. 22, 2009.
- The 94-38 win over CCNY tied the largest margin of victory in program history, matching the 56-point (91-35) win over Trenton State on Dec. 9, 1936. The 60 rebounds were RU's most since 74 against Keene State on Dec. 7, 1992.

- A 2003 Wooden All-American, 2002 Associated Press All-American and two-time All-Big East honoree, Knight's No. 20 jersey was retired by the Panthers on March 4, 2009.
- An East Orange native, Knight's brother Brevin was a 12-year NBA veteran and a consensus All-America point guard at Stanford. The Knights represent one of only eight brother combinations in Division I history to earn All-America honors. His father Melvin, a former Seton Hall assistant coach and player, serves as the athletic director at Essex County College (N.J.).

COME RAIN OR COME SHINE

Rutgers announced that the game versus No. 3 Purdue on Saturday, Feb. 3, at 4 p.m. is sold out to the general public. It marks the second home sellout this season for the Scarlet Knights, after drawing 8,318 fans to the RAC on Dec. 16 to witness the 71-65 defeat of No. 15 Seton Hall in the annual Garden State Hardwood Classic. It signals the first time Rutgers men's basketball has enjoyed multiple home sell-outs in the same campaign since 2011, when the Scarlet Knights hosted No. 2 Pittsburgh (Jan. 29; 8,024) and Seton Hall (Feb. 12; 8,057). This season's crowd versus the Pirates was the largest at the RAC in 15 years.

I CAN READ BETWEEN THE LINES

"Give them credit, I heard Steve Pikiell got an extension today. Much deserved. His teams play hard, they play tough, they play physical. They played with a chip on their shoulder."

MY KIND OF TOWN

Rutgers and Steve Pikiell came to terms on a contract that will keep the head men's basketball coach courtside at the RAC through the 2023-24 season. Introduced as the 19th coach in program history on March 22, 2016 with an initial contract that ran through 2020-21, Pikiell has orchestrated an impressive turnaround while competing in the Big Ten, the nation's premier athletic and academic conference.

"Steve is doing a fantastic job and it's our intent to do everything we can to keep him at Rutgers for a very long time," said Director of Athletics Pat Hobbs. "There is incredible excitement around our program. We are going to compete with the very best because of Steve's leadership. Our program could not be in better hands."

"It's an honor to be the head men's basketball coach at Rutgers University," said Pikiell. "I am humbled by the support of President Barchi and Pat Hobbs, as we work together to build our program and write a great chapter in Rutgers history. It is a very exciting time at The State University of New Jersey. My family and I are thrilled to be part of the Scarlet Knight community."

Rutgers men's basketball issued another strong classroom performance under head coach Steve Pikiell, posting a 2.9 cumulative team grade point average for the fall 2017 semester. Three student-athletes earned recogni-

tion on the Dean's List, with semester GPA's of 3.5 and above, while seven achieved GPA's of 3.0 or greater.

Rutgers' Dean's List representatives included a pair of tri-captains, in senior guards Mike Williams and Jake Dadika. A criminal justice and finance major respectively, both had 3.5 GPAs. Freshman center Myles Johnson also made an early impact "On the Banks," achieving a 3.7 during his first semester in the School of Engineering. Freshmen Geo Baker and Luke Nathan, as well as sophomores Joey Downes and Aaren Smith, earned GPAs of 3.0 or greater in the fall.

In the most recent NCAA Graduate Success Rate (GSR) report, Rutgers men's basketball achieved a score of 80. The score ranked seventh among Big Ten Conference men's hoops programs and was 60 points ahead of the national average. In addition, the team's latest Academic Progress Rate (APR) score was 984, which ranked fifth among Big Ten Conference men's basketball programs.

THE LAST DANCE

Rutgers drew to within two points on multiple occasions in the final minutes, but was unable to complete the comeback in a 60-54 loss to Nebraska Wednesday evening at the RAC. The Scarlet Knights grabbed 20 offensive rebounds in a game that featured five ties and 11 lead changes. Deshawn Freeman had 10 points and 10 rebounds for his second consecutive double-double. He was joined in double figures by Sanders (14 points) and Geo Baker (10 points). Despite besting the visitors in virtually every specialty scoring category, including 14-1 in bench points, Rutgers was unable to overcome its 33.8 percent (22-of-65) shooting.

IF I HAD YOU

Construction has begun on the RWJBarnabas Health Athletic Performance Center at Rutgers University. Slated for completion in 2019, it will be built on the site of the existing parking lot southwest of the RAC and northwest of the Business School. The Center signals a partnership between Rutgers and RWJBarnabas Health to create a comprehensive sports medicine program to serve Rutgers athletes, students and communities throughout New Jersey. Through this partnership, RWJBarnabas Health will become the exclusive health care provider for Rutgers Athletics, while creating a

best-in-class sports medicine program that can be expanded across the state. The building will provide a state-of-the-art practice facility for men's and women's basketball, wrestling and gymnastics.

Rutgers, RWJBarnabas Health, state and community officials broke ground on the 295,000-square-foot, four-story sports facility and parking deck in a ceremony on Nov. 1, 2016.

The 2018 Big Ten Men's Basketball Tournament will take place at Madison Square Garden, Feb. 28-March 4. The league held its annual media day from the World's Most Famous Arena on Oct. 19. Rutgers is 45-55 at the current (since Feb. 1968) Madison Square Garden. Overall at MSG since 1949, Rutgers is 51-57.

NIGHT AND DAY

- Last season, Rutgers more than doubled its overall win total and tripled its conference victory total from 2015-16.
- Achieved a plus-117 rank improvement in RPI, as well as major NCAA ranking improvements in rebound margin (+299), scoring defense (+272), three point FG defense (+247), offensive rebounds (+244), rebounds (+232), field goal percentage defense (+226) and blocks (+114).
- Ranked among the top 100 in 10 NCAA statistical categories, including

- among the top 50 in seven, after ranking among the top 150 in just two statistical categories in 2015-16.
- Earned the program's first Big Ten Conference road and tournament wins.
 - 9-1 start marked the best head-coaching debut in Rutgers men's basketball history.
 - 6-0 signaled the sixth-best undefeated start in the 110-year history of the program.
 - Posted an undefeated home record in non-conference play.
 - Out-rebounded opponents in 11 of 18 conference games, after winning the boards in just three league contests in 2015-16.
 - Ten Big Ten games were decided in single digits after suffering 15 league losses by double digits in 2015-16.
 - Played the second-toughest conference schedule in the Big Ten according to Ken Pom analysis.
 - Played 17 games, 52 percent of its schedule, against programs that earned NCAA (13) or NIT (4) bids.

SOMETHING WONDERFUL

Quincy Douby was officially inducted into the Rutgers Athletics Hall of Fame on Oct. 20, 2017. He scored 1,690 points, the sixth-highest total in RU men's basketball history, in three seasons. The Brooklyn native averaged 25.4 points per-game as a junior in 2005-06, setting the school record for points in a season (839), to lead the league in scoring en route to becoming RU's only First Team All-Big East selection. The Haggerty Award winner as the Metropolitan Player of the Year and an All-American in 2005-06, Douby is among the career leaders in every offensive category.

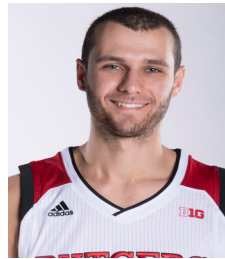

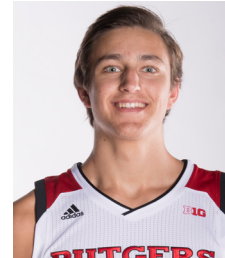
