Following back-to-back shutouts, the No. 4 Penn State field hockey team travels to No. 2 Maryland for a Big Ten matchup on Friday, Oct. 10 at 3:30 p.m. The game will be nationally televised by the Big Ten Network, the first of three BTN matches this season for the Nittany Lions. Penn State then returns home to host Bucknell on Tuesday, Oct. 14 at 7 p.m.

### With a Win at Maryland

Penn State would pick up its first victory over a team ranked No. 2 or higher since defeating No. 2 Wake Forest, 2-0, in the semifinals of the NCAA Tournament on Nov. 16, 2007. That season, the squad beat No. 2 Maryland in the quarterfinals on Nov. 11, 1-0, marking the last time the Nittany Lions beat the Terrapins.

### **Maryland Notes**

- The Terrapins have compiled a 9-2 record this season, including a 3-1 mark in the Big Ten.  $\,$
- Maryland has downed five ranked opponents this season. It's only losses came to then-No. 2 North Carolina (3-1, Sept. 5) and then-No. 15 Northwestern (3-2, Sept. 20).
- Offensively, Maryland ranks ninth in the country with a 1.91 scoring margin this season. Moira Putsch leads the squad with seven goals and 18 points this season. Katie Gerzabek leads the squad with 11 assists and is sixth nationally with 1.00 per game.
- Defensively, the Terrapins are eighth nationally with a 1.18 goals against

### **Series History**

Penn State holds a 20-11-1 lead in a series that dates back to 1975.

### **Bucknell Notes**

- The Bison are 6-3 this season and 2-0 in the Patriot League.
- Bucknell has a ranked win against then-No. 14 Princeton (Sept. 14).
- Offensively, Liz Willis leads the squad with five goals and 12 points on the season.
- Defensively, the squad is 17th nationally with a 1.54 goals against average.
- Jeremy Cook is in his eighth season at the helm.

### **Series History**

Penn State is 36-2-2 all-time against Bucknell in a series dating back to 1964, the first year in program history. The Nittany Lions have not lost to the Bison

since 1970, picking up a 2-0 win on the road last season.

### **Last Time Out**

Penn State is coming off a two-shutout weekend. First, senior Taylor Herold (Fredericksburg, Va.) notched two goals as No. 9 Penn State field hockey put together a dominating 5-0 win at Drexel on Oct. 3. Four different Nittany Lions scored in the contest. Then, the squad defeated No. 14 Temple, 2-0, on Oct. 5. Seniors Herold and Laura Gebhart (Mount Joy, Pa.) each found the back of the cage in the victory.

### **Herold Hits a Hundred**

Herold posted a goal and two assists at Ohio State (Sept. 28), giving her 100 career points. She has 46 goals and 15 assists for her career. Her 46 goals are two shy of tying her for 10th on Penn State's all-time list. She is four goals away from tying head coach Charlene Morett-Curtiss for ninth with 50.

#### **Herold's Heroics**

Herold posted three goals, all in the second half, against No. 14 Princeton on Sept. 12. It marked her first career hat trick. Against Ohio State (Sept. 28), she had a career-high two assists. She is first posts, making nine saves against Old on the team with 30 points and 12 goals and tied for first with six assists. Herold has four multi-goal games this season. The senior ranks fifth nationally in goals per game (1.00).

### **Gebhart on the Assist**

Gebhart has started all 75 games since arriving on campus as a freshman. Currently, she has 44 assists, which is two away from tying her for seventh on Penn State's all-time list and three from tying her for sixth. She is tied for first on the team with six assists.

### **Coming up with Corners**

The Nittany Lions rank fifth nationally with 8.25 penalty corners per game. The squad has had 12 or more on three separate occasions, including a seasonhigh 16 against Lock Haven. Penn State has only had less than seven corner attempts four times.

### **Big Ten Honors**

Redshirt senior goalkeeper Kylie Licata (Mountain Top, Pa.) was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week twice this

season. Most recently, she made a careerhigh 14 saves at No. 3 UConn and shut out Quinnipiac to earn the honor on Sept. 9. Licata earned Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week (Sept. 2), while back Cori Conley (Oak Park, III.) was named Freshman of the Week following the seasonopening wins. Licata made a career-high nine saves against the Lady Monarchs and shut out the Cavaliers. Conley played a key role defensively, helping a unit that held Virginia scoreless in a game for the first time since 2011.

### Chrismer Capitalizing

Senior Jenna Chrismer (Mountain Top. Pa.) has been impressive offensively. Most recently, Chrismer tallied two goals at Ohio State. Prior to that, she posted a career-high two assists against No. 14 Princeton (Sept. 12) before tying her personal best with two goals vs. Lafayette (Sept. 14). She scored each of the team's goals in the 2-1 win over Old Dominion (Aug. 29), before tallying an assist against Virginia (Aug. 31) and at Quinnipiac (Sept. 7). She is second on the team with 18 points and seven goals.

### Solid in the Cage

Licata has been a force between the Dominion and holding Virginia scoreless, the first time the Cavaliers were blanked since 2011. Then, at No. 3 Connecticut, she stopped a career-high 14 shots. Most recently, she made 10 saves against No. 18 Michigan. She ranks third nationally with a .835 save percentage.

### **Ehret Making Noise**

Sophomore Emilee Ehret (Philadelphia, Pa.) has scored a point in six of the last eight games, and posted a goal and an assist in two of those games. She has played a key role in penalty corner chances, being the primary player to insert for the Nittany Lions.

### **Dazzling Dinunzio**

Senior Amanda Dinunzio (State College, Pa.) posted the first multi-goal game of her career against Lock Haven, scoring two in the contest. It was a career-high four points for the senior.

### **Buttinger Breaks Out**

Redshirt senior Natalie Buttinger (Kitchener, Ontario) scored the first two goals of her career in the 3-0 win over No. 6

Virginia.

### **Postseason Fixture**

The Nittany Lions return after making the NCAA Tournament field each of the last four seasons. Penn State has been at the top of the Big Ten in those seasons as well, being named co-conference regular season champions in 2013 and the outright winner in 2012. The squad won the Big Ten Tournament in 2011 and 2012.

### **Excelling with Experience**

Penn State brings back six starters and three of its top six scorers from a season ago. The squad returns two 2013 Big Ten first team members in Laura Gebhart (Mount Joy, Pa.) and Kylie Licata (Mountain Top, Pa.), while Taylor Herold (Fredericksburg, Va.), who garnered second team

honors, also returns. Herold led Penn State with 30 points (13 goals, four assists) last year. Gebhart was a 2013 Longstreth/NFHCA Division I second team All-American.

#### **Preseason Accolades**

Seniors **Katie Breneman (Washington Boro, Pa.)**, Gebhart and Herold were each named to the 2014 Big Ten Field Hockey Players to Watch List.

#### Remaining Elite in the Rankings

The Nittany Lions were selected No. 8 in the 2014 Penn Metro/NFHCA Division I Preseason Poll. The squad holds the second-highest ranking of any Big Ten team in the top 20. Maryland (No. 1) is the only conference foe ranked higher. Penn State plays nine teams ranked that are ranked in the preseason poll.

### On the Turf and in the Classroom

The Penn State field hockey program was recognized by Gladiator and the National Field Hockey Coaches Association with the National Academic Team Award for sporting a team GPA above 3.0 in the 2013-14 academic year. In addition, the Nittany Lions placed 12 players on the Gladiator by SGI/NFHCA Division I National Academic Squad.

Katie Andrews, Katie Breneman, Carly Celkos, Amanda Dinunzio, Emilee Ehret, Abby Fuhrman, Laura Gebhart, Kirsten Gochnauer, Jacqueline Kenney, Haley Kerstetter, Lauren Purvis and Whitney Reddig all earned the accolade.

### **Challenging Schedule**

Penn State has again put together a top-tier schedule, facing nine teams that were ranked in the 2014 NFHCA Preseason Poll, including conference-foes Maryland (1), Northwestern (14), Michigan State (16), Michigan (17) and Iowa (20). Along with the conference opponents, the squad also has matchups against Connecticut (3), Virginia (6), Princeton (7) and Old Dominion (9). Seven teams (ODU, Virginia, Connecticut, Quinnipiac, Princeton, Michigan State and Maryland) each made the 2013 NCAA Tournament.

### In the Spotlight on BTN

The field hockey squad will receive coverage at Maryland on Oct. 10 at 3:30 p.m., vs. Rutgers on Oct. 17 at 3:30 p.m. and vs. Northwestern on Oct. 31 at 3:30 p.m. Additionally, both Big Ten Tournament semifinal matches and the championship game will be aired live on the BTN.

The longest tenured coach in the Big Ten and the sixth-longest tenured at a single school in Division I field hockey history, Charlene Morett-Curtiss enters her 28th season as head coach of the Penn State field hockey program in 2014. Morett-Curtiss boasts a remarkable resume covering her time as the leader of the Nittany Lions. Over the last six years, Morett-Curtiss has led the Nittany Lions to three Big Ten regular season titles, two Big Ten Tournament championships and five NCAA Tournament appearances.

Morett-Curtiss currently ranks fifth all-time in Division I history in wins with 458 and is one of just six DI coaches to accumulate 400 career wins. She has led the Nittany Lions to the NCAA Tournament in 24 of her 27 years as head coach of Penn State and has helped maintain Penn State's distinction as the No. 3 ranked school in all-time NCAA Tournament appearances with 29.

A seven-time NFHCA Mideast Region Coach of the Year, Morett-Curtiss is an excellent teacher of field hockey. Her players earn national recognition on a yearly basis, 11 of whom have been named two-time first team All-Americans with Kelsey Amy being the most recent. Her teams dominate the national scene, consistently ranking among the Top 10 in the national polls. Penn State was ranked in the Top 10 of the STX/NFHCA poll for 32 consecutive weeks from the first poll of the 2005 season ending with the second poll of 2008. The squad achieved a No. 1 ranking in the STX/NFHCA poll for the first time in program history. From 2005-08, Penn State finished eighth, sixth, ninth and 11th respectively, in the final poll of the season.

Under Morett-Curtiss' tutelage, five of her players have been named Big Ten Athlete of the Year -- Traci Anselmo, Jen Coletta, Heather Gorlaski, Tracey Larson and Kiley Kulina. Six players have been voted the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year -- Natalie Berrena, Dawn Lammey, Larson, Tara Maguire, Allison Scola and Kelsey Amy. In 2012 and 2013, Brittany Grzywacz was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, earning the ninth and 10th Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honors from Penn State, joining Anselmo, Gorlaski, Becca Main, Jill Martz, Jill Pearsall and Jen Long. Long, Anselmo and Grzywacz are the only Lions to be named Defensive Player of the Year twice.

Since Penn State's entry into the Big Ten in 1992, Morett's program has produced more First Team All-Big Ten selections, Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year, Big Ten Athletes of the Year and Big Ten Freshmen of the Year than any other program. Penn State's 10 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honorees are five more than any other school.

With Laura Gebhart, Brittany Grzywacz, Taylor Herold, Ashtin Klingler and Kylie Licata earning All-Big Ten laurels last season, Penn State has now totaled 94 All-Big Ten selections since 1992, including 65 first team All-Conference choices, the most of any Big Ten school since Penn State moved to the Big Ten in 1992.
