THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- Penn State welcomes Arizona State back to Pegula Ice Arena for the second time in the past three seasons for a pair of games over the weekend.
- This marks the third-straight season that the two newest NCAA Division I programs have met as Penn State leads the all-time series 4-0-0 outscoring the Sun Devils 26-6
- Senior Chris Funkey has two career shutouts to his name and they have both come against ASU with one in each of the past two seasons.
- Last year a two-game sweep in Glendale, Arizona sparked an 11-game unbeaten streak for the Nittany Lions vaulting them back in to the national scene after a slow start to begin the season.
- Junior Brandon Biro registered a pair of one goal, one assist games against ASU last season while classmate Nate Sucese leads all current Nittany Lions with three goals and four assists for seven points against the Sun Devils
- Junior Denis Smirnov missed both games last season in Arizona, but registered a hat-trick in 2016-17 with four total goals and one assist for five points during a weekend sweep. Junior Liam Folkes has also had good success against Arizona State with one goal and four assists for five points.
- Sophomore classmates Evan Barratt and Sam Sternschein along with senior Derian Hamilton each collected their first career goals against ASU last season in Glendale.

STRETCH LIMO

- Sophomore Alex Limoges is currently riding a fourgame point-streak (3-3-6) which is just one game shy of his career long streak of five games from the end of last season.
- Limoges has seven goals and seven assists for 14 points in his last 11 games dating back to last season while recording at least one point in nine of those contests.

POSSESSION IS NINE-TENTHS OF THE LAW

- Penn State has improved on its face-off percentage drastically after ranking 44th in the nation in 2017-18. During the first six games this season the Nittany Lions are winning 63.9 percent of their draws up from just 48.2 percent last season.
- The Nittany Lions won 46-of-67 face-offs last week against Princeton led by Ludvig Larsson and Chase Berger who went 20-3 and 11-4 at the dot, respectively.
- Larsson currently leads the entire nation winning 73-of-92 faceoffs (79.3 percent) over the first six games. Berger has also elevated his success this season winning the draw 61.5 percent of the time, up from 49.1 percent last season.

IT WILL KILL

• Penn State's penalty kill is currently ninth in the nation at 89.5 percent allowing just two man-advantage goals. Prior to allowing a power-play goal in the third period last Friday the Nittany Lions had killed 17-straight penalties after allowing a goal on the first power-play of the season against Clarkson back on October 10.

200 FOOT GAME

• Early in the season Penn State has excelled on both ends of the ice averaging 5.00 goals per game while only allowing 1.80 goals on the defensive end ranking them second and ninth in the nation among teams with at least four games played.

 Penn State is also leading the nation averaging 21.00 blocked shots per game led by junior Kris Myllari who has 24 blocks in five games with his 4.80 blocks per game pacing the nation.

BONES JONES

- Junior goaltender Peyton Jones became the all-time leader at Penn State for starts by a goaltender after making the 74th start in net for his career last Friday passing Matt Skoff '16.
- Jones is also now just 144 saves behind Skoff's Penn State record of 2,114 recorded from 2012-16.
- Jones earned Big Ten Third Star of the Week accolades this past Tuesday securing his fifth career weekly award and the first this season. Jones currently leads the Big Ten with a .963 save percentage and a 1.33 goals against averaging ranking fifth and ninth in the nation, but second and fourth based on minutes and games played.

CHASE-ING RECORDS

- Senior captain Chase Berger continues to make his way up the all-time games played list at Penn State where he now sits tied for eighth with 120 games under his belt.
- Berger is currently second on the team with six points this season on three goals and three assists.
- Berger became just the fourth player in program history to hit the 40 career goals mark a few weeks ago and he is also now just five points shy of becoming the third Nittany Lion to reach 100 points.
- The senior's 95 career points rank third in the Big Ten and ninth in the nation among active players.

HOME IS WHERE YOU MAKE IT

- With five consecutive victories to open the 2018-19 season, Penn State has now won nine consecutive games inside Pegula Ice Arena dating back to last season's four-straight victories over Minnesota to close out the season.
- The nine-straight home wins are the second best stretch in program history behind the 12-straight victories achieved from October 28, 2016 through January 14, 2017
- During this current stretch, The Nittany Lions have scored at least five goals in seven of the nine games while outscoring opponents 46-20 averaging 5.11 goals per contest while allowing just 2.22 goals per game.
- Penn State's early 2018-19 goal differential of +16 ranks fourth in the nation behind Bowling Green's +24 mark. Arizona State currently sits in third at +17. Through the first five games of their season, the Nittany Lions 5.00 goals per game ranks second in the nation among teams with at least five games played. ASU currently sits in 12th scoring 3.75 goals per game in its first eight contests.

SCOUTING ARIZONA STATE

- The Sun Devils finished 2017-18 just 8-21-5, but are already off to their best start in program history at 6-2-0 as they enter their fourth year as an NCAA Division I program.
- Arizona State returns nine of its top-10 scorers from last season including all three players who registered 20-plus points led by Brinson Pasichnuk who slotted home eight goals while adding 18 assists for 26 points. Brett Gruber led the team with 20 assists while collecting 25 points and Johnny Walker had a team-best 17 goals as a freshman while adding seven assists for 24 points.
- The Sun Devils are coming off a sweep over Nebraska-Omaha where they outscored the Mavericks 13-5 while going 7-for-17 on the power-play including four man-advantage goals by Johnny Walker alone on Saturday night.
- Walker leads the nation with eight goals and 13 points already this season while the Sun Devil power-play ranks 23rd in the nation at 21.7 percent (10-for-46). ASU's 10 power-play tallies are currently tied for the third most in the nation through the opening month of play.
- The Sun Devils also rank sixth in the nation on the penalty kill at 92.9 percent allowing just three goals in 42 chances. Those 42 power-plays against are the most in the nation as ASU is averaging 8.4 penalties per game.
- Arizona State also returns starting goaltender Joey Daccord who has started all eight games posting a .949 save percentage and a 1.51 goals against average to rank tenth and 15th in the nation, respectively.

FOUR MORE

- · Joining Limoges on four-game point streaks are junior Nikita Pavlychev, sophomore Evan Barratt and freshman Aarne Talvitie. For Pavlychev it ties his career-high while marking new career-highs for Barratt and Talvitie.
- · Dating back to the end of last year, Barratt has registered at least one point in six of his last eight games scoring four goals while adding seven assists for 11 points in his last eight games.

SMIRNOV AND SUCESE NAMED B1G PLAYERS TO WATCH

- Junior classmates Denis Smirnov and Nate Sucese were both named to the Preseason Big Ten Players to Watch list
- This marks the second-consecutive season that Smirnov has made the list as he enters the 2018-19 season second on the team in career points with 74 in just 69 games while Sucese ranks not far behind with 65 points in 74 career games played. The duo has combined for 65 goals over the past two seasons.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

• Senior Chase Berger was named the sixth captain in program history for the 2018-19 campaign after serving as an alternate last season. Fellow senior Kevin Kerr and junior Brandon Biro will serve as his alternates.

RECAPPING 2017-18

 Penn State is coming off its second-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance after finishing the 2017-18 season at 18-5-5 with a 9-10-5-2 mark in Big Ten, good for a fourth place finish with 34 points in league action.

- The Nittany Lions led all Big Ten teams with 138 goals and 374 points last season ranking third and fourth in the nation, respectively, in each category. Penn State returns 109 of those goals and 274 points each topping the Big Ten while ranking first and fourth in the NCAA to open the 2018-19 season.
- The Nittany Lions have 20 players returning from last season's roster as they welcome six newcomers to the 2018-19 squad.
- Andrew Sturtz became just the third player in program history to reach the 40-point mark in a season as the junior scored 14 goals while adding 26 assists. Sturtz then became the fourth Nittany Lion to ink a professional contract signing a two-way NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators forgoing his final season in Hockey Valley.
- · Penn State had six players register double-digit goals while two others fell one goal shy of that mark. The Nittany Lions ranked first in the Big Ten and third in the nation averaging 3.63 goals per game during the 2017-18
- Brandon Biro had a career-year for the Blue and White ranking second on the team with 31 points on nine goals and 22 assists. Fellow classmates Nate Sucese and Denis Smirnov were also top-5 in points for the Nittany Lions with 29 and 27, respectively while Smirnov led the team with 15 goals and Sucese one behind with 14. Liam Folkes also had a career-year with 13 goals and 10 assists for 23 points.
- Senior Trevor Hamilton became the first Penn State player to earn a major conference honor as he was recognized as the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year after scoring six goals while adding 23 assists for 29 points and leading the nation in blocked shots for the second-consecutive season with 109.

EUROPEAN CONNECTION

- Penn State has five players on its 2018-19 roster from european countries with two from Russia and Finland and one from Sweden.
- A pair of Nittany Lion juniors hail from Russia by the way of Pennsylvania as both **Nikita Pavlychev** (Yaroslavl) and **Denis Smirnov** (Moscow) become the first Lions to wear the Blue and White from the Motherland.
- Both forwards migrated to the U.S. and to Pennsylvania in their early teen years, playing youth hockey in the Keystone State.
- The Nittany Lions also have a pair of freshman from Finland as goaltender Oskar Autio is following in his brothers footsteps joined by longtime friend and New Jersey Devils draft pick Aarne Talvitie. Both players are from Espoo and grew up playing for the Esspoo Blues.
- Graduate transfer **Ludvig Larsson** becomes the program's first-ever swedish born player as he hails from Malmo, Sweden by the way of Merrimack College (Hockey East).

PACKING THE PEG

- Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 93-of-97 home games, including all 17 regular season contests during the 2017-18 season.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 62 occasions including 12 games last season.
- In 2017-18, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,906) and led the nation in building capacity percentage (102.2 percent).
- Last season, Penn State had a season-total of 112,221 fans that have been to Pegula Ice Arena.

WELCOME HOME

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula lce Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its sixth season entering 2018-19. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests
- The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.
- The 2018-19 season will be the first season the Big Ten has instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockev.
- The Big Ten tournament will take place at on campus sites once again during the 2018-19 season.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky, will guide the Nittany Lions in his 20th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program in 2018-19 and his seventh at Penn State.

AT PENN STATE

Following the most successful season in Penn State history, Gadowsky once again led his Nittany Lions to the NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as they served as host for the Midwest Regional. However, once again the Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier during the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, which in turn, was the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 victory over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers by the Nittany Lions, which secured home-ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament Quarterfinals the following weekend, the first year the conference tournament was held at campus sites Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

In 2017-18, Gadowsky also saw junior Andrew Sturtz become just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State as well as becoming the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz then graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. Hamilton also joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only First-Team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA

Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Along the way Penn State opened the season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

In 2015-16 Gadowsky led Penn State to its first 20-win season, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose to as high as 14th in the uscho. com National Poll during the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6 the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten Quarterfinals before bowing out to eventual champion Michigan 7-2 in the semifinals.

Of his 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, garnering a winning season in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title up until the final weekend of the season

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with

the Toronto Maple Leafs, eventually scoring his first NHL goal in the season finale. Bailey was an All-Big Ten First Team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable mention by the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play. Additionally, his Lions earned wins over every Big Ten team during the season including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions during the Big Ten Conference's first season. Penn State, which faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

In 2012-13, Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to a 13-14-0 record during their inaugural NCAA Division I season. He guided the squad to several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells Fargo Arena in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL barn (19,529).

In 2011-12, Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

AT PRINCETON

Before coming to Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA tournament appearance.

During the 2007-08 campaign, Gadowsky, who inherited a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival, guided Princeton to both the ECAC Hockey tournament and Ivy League crowns. The team earned its first NCAA tournament berth since 1998, Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the

Gadowsky had more than 20 Tiger players go on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and lvy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

Prior to Princeton, Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he inherited a team that had not won more than 14 games in each of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.

BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fres-no Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign as he garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. The three-time WCHA All-Academic Team member collected 46 points in 134 career

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, The Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.
