POSTGAME NOTES

Stanford Notes:

Stanford went on a 25-7 run to end the first half, taking a 23-19 deficit and turning it into a 38-25 halftime lead.

Tara VanDerveer improved to 16-4 in Regional Semifinal play while head coach at Stanford.

Stanford improved to 9-1 against top-25 opponents this season. In those 10 games, Chiney Ogwumike averaged 25.4 points and 12.8 rebounds per game.

Chiney Ogwumike now has 25 double-doubles in 35 games this season. Her career total for double-doubles is now 83. Ogwumike has eight double-doubles in 16 career NCAA Tournament games.

Chiney Ogwumike's 29 points tied her NCAA Tournament career high (vs. Tulsa, 2013 First Round, March 24, 2013). Her 15 rebounds tied for second most in her NCAA Tournament career (three total times).

25 points is Stanford's largest margin of victory since a 74-48 win against Arizona on Feb. 16 at Maples Pavilion. It is Stanford's largest margin of victory in the NCAA Tournament since a 73-40 win against Michigan in the 2013 Second Round.

Home teams are now 24-4 in the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Host teams were 3-0 in Regional Semifinal action this weekend.

Stanford is 29-4 at Maples Pavilion in NCAA Tournament play and 4-1 in NCAA Regional action on its home court. Stanford has won nine consecutive home NCAA Tournament games.

Bonnie Samuelson made two 3 pointers to bring her 2014 NCAA Tournament total to 11. Her 11 3 pointers made rank second in the tournament behind Megan Rogowski of Depaul (13).

Penn State Notes:

Ariel Edwards' 21 points was Edwards' highest point total in 10 career NCAA Tournament games. Edwards reached double-digit points in five of her 10 NCAA Tournament games.

Coquese Washington falls to 6-4 in the NCAA Tournament as head coach of Penn State and 0-2 in Regional Semifinal action. Penn State drops to 4-9 all time in Regional Semifinal play.

Maggie Lucas finishes her career in 11th place all time in the NCAA with 365 career 3 pointers, four 3 pointers shy of Aaryn Ellenberg of Oklahoma for 10th place.

Maggie Lucas's season free throw percentage finishes at .949, good for the sixth best season total in NCAA history. Lucas did not attempt a free throw against Stanford.

Maggie Lucas's six points set her new season low. It was one of only two games this season in which Lucas was held under 10 points (7, 12/4/13 vs. Notre Dame).

Penn State's record against ranked opponents dropped to 4-4 this season. The Lady Lions finished 0-3 against top-10 teams on the season and 24-5 in all other games.

Penn State started the same starting five of Dara Taylor, Maggie Lucas, Ariel Edwards, Tori Waldner and Talia East for the 29th consecutive game. Taylor, Lucas, Edwards and Waldner started all 32 games for the Lady Lions.
