# PENN STATE TRAVELS TO TEXAS **FOR QUAD MEET**

The Penn State women's gymnastics team (5-3, 2-3 Big Ten) heads to Denton, Texas, for a non-conference quad meet against Sacramento State, Texas Woman's University and Western Michigan. The meet is slated for a 1 p.m. (CST) start inside the Kitty Magee Arena on Sunday, Feb. 19.

The Nittany Lions are coming off a 195.950-195.850 loss to then-No. 18 Ohio State last weekend. Against OSU, the Blue & White recorded its second-straight meet with a team score of a 195.850 or better.

As a team against Ohio State, Penn State posted season-best scores on the uneven bars, balance beam and the floor exercise for the second-straight week.

Individually, three Nittany Lions brought home titles, as Briannah Tsang tied for the all-around title and Sabrina Garcia and Nicole Medvitz shared the balance beam title. Garcia's balance beam title was the first of her career, while Medvitz captured her third-straight balance beam title.

Following the meet at TWU, Penn State returns to Rec Hall for its final home meet of the 2017 season on Feb. 25 against Pittsburgh. The meet is slated for a 4 p.m. start and Penn State will honor its 2017 senior class.

### **HEAD COACH JEFF THOMPSON**



Entering his seventh season at the helm of the Penn State women's gymnastics program, Jeff Thompson has led the Nittany Lions program back on to the national scene. Named the ninth head coach in program history on July 15, 2010, Thompson helped the Nittany Lions end a four-year drought and return to the NCAA Championships in 2014.

Under Coach Thompson, the Nittany Lions have had 28 Academic All-Big Ten honorees, eight First Team All-Big Ten selections, five Big Ten individual event champions, one Big Ten Gymnast of the Year, one Big Ten Freshman of the Year and one NCAA Regional champion.

The 2016 campaign featured a very young squad with eight newcomers, which included seven freshmen, and featured no seniors.

Making an impact in her very first meet at PSU was transfer Kiera Brown. In her Nittany Lion debut, Brown tied the No. 3 performance in school history on the uneven bars with a 9.950, a mark she hit again at the Big Ten Championships to tie for the Big Ten title.

Brown was a mainstay on the uneven bars throughout her junior year and for her success she received All-America honors. All-Big Ten First Team honors and was named to the Big Ten Championships team.

Nicole Medvitz also etched her name into Nittany Lion history as she captured a 9.975 on the balance beam at the Big Five Qualifier to tie the No. 5 performance in school history

In the Penn State record books, the 2016 Nittany Lions set three individual top-10 performances and tied the No. 4 performance as a team on the balance beam (49,375) and the No. 4 overall team score (197.125) against lowa, Michigan, Minnesota and Rutgers.

In the classroom, Nicole Medvitz, Tina Postiglione, Chanen Raygoza and Briannah Tsang were named to the Academic All-Big Ten team, while Medvitz and Tsang were named Big Ten Distinguished Scholars. Penn State women's gymnastics has received 28 Academic All-Big Ten honorees under Coach Thompson

Tsang capped off an outstanding sophomore season as she tied for the floor exercise title at the NCAA Regional Championships with a 9.900 to advance to her first NCAA Championships. She finished off her sophomore year with a 38th-place finish on the floor exercise at the NCAA Championships with a 9.8125.

The 2016 season was a highlighted with a second-place finish at the Big Five Qualifier with wins over No. 6 Michigan and No. 18 lowa. The Nittany Lions then finished fourth the following week at the Big Ten Championships.

Behind a 196.350-195.350 victory against Big Ten opponent Maryland on Feb. 22, 2016, Coach Thompson captured his 150th career win as a head coach.

In 2015, Thompson and his staff helped Tsang become the fourth Nittany Lion in program history to receive the honor of Big Ten Freshman of the Year. Tsang shared the honor with Brianna Brown of Michigan.

As a team, Penn State finished the regular season with a record of 14-3. The Nittany Lions ended the 2015 season ranked No. 22 in the NCAA to mark the 13th-straight season the program has finished among the top-25 nationally.

During the 2014-15 academic year, the Penn State women's gymnastics team won its fifth-straight Champs Cup [Penn State Team Community Service Award] for work in the community.

It was memorable 2014 campaign, as the Blue and White posted one of its most consistent seasons in the gym and in the classroom. The Lions set a school record for the highest score in a road meet - ranking third all-time - and recorded the highest postseason score in school history to place second at the NCAA Regional and earn their 17th trip to the NCAA Championships in school history.

A trip to the NCAA Championships, hosting the NCAA Regional and Big Ten Championships in Rec Hall, eight Penn State all-time top-10 performances, five Academic All-Big Ten, five Big Ten weekly award winners, four NACGC/W Scholastic All-Americans, three All-Big Ten honorees and one All-American highlighted the successful campaign.

Kassidy Stauder capped one of the most remarkable seasons in Penn State history with regular-season All-America honors on the balance beam. It was the first honor of her career and came on the heels of being named first

team All-Big Ten and Big Ten All-Championship. Stauder won 16 individual titles, including three all-around, six balance beam and seven uneven bar crowns in 2014.

Sidney Sanabria-Robles and Krystal Welsh were named second team All-Big Ten, while freshman Emma Sibson posted two of the top-10 vaults in school history during her rookie campaign and was a two-time Big Ten Freshman of the Week award winner.

As a team, Penn State finished the season ranked No. 12 nationally and owned a 20-3 regular season record, including a third place finish in the Big Ten regular season standings. For the fourth straight year, the women's gymnastics program was awarded the Penn State Team Community Service Award for their work in the community during the 2013-14 academic year.

On the coaching front, Thompson guided the Lions to the first 20-win regular season in school history and became just the third head coach in NCAA history to lead two different programs to the NCAA Championships. He joined K.J. Kindler (Iowa State & Oklahoma) and Judi Avener-Markell (Penn State & Florida).

The 2013 season concluded with senior Sharaya Musser earning regular-season All-America honors on balance beam and in the all-around and also All-America honors on balance beam and in the all-around at the NCAA Championships to push her career total to eight All-America certificates. The Lions were ranked as high as No. 14 in the national rankings and ended the season at No. 15 with a National Qualifying Score of 392.375.

Musser was also a first team All-Big Ten selection, Big Ten All-Championship Team pick and joined Lindsay Musgrove on the Big Ten Distinguished Scholars ledger. Madison Merriam was a first team All-Big Ten selection, as well.

Five gymnasts earned Academic All-Big Ten accolades for their work in the classroom, including Alex Witt, along with Merriam, Musgrove, Musser and Stauder. In 2013, the team was awarded the Penn State Team Community Service Award for the third straight year.

In 2012, Thompson and his staff helped Musser earn the distinction of Big Ten Gymnast of the Year, marking the seventh time in program history a Nittany Lion was bestowed the award. Musser's award marked the third time in a four year span that a Penn State gymnast won the Big Ten Gymnast of the Year award. Additionally, Musser advanced to the NCAA Championships where she was named an All-American on floor exercise and balance beam. Thompson also produced six Academic All-Big Ten selections and two NACGC/W scholar athletes. Also in 2012, the team was awarded the Penn State Team Community Service Award for the second straight year.

A two-time SEC Coach of the Year, Thompson joined the Penn State family in 2010 after 11 successful years at Auburn University. In his first season at the helm of the Nittany Lion program, Thompson guided the Nittany Lions to a second place finish at the 2011 Big Ten Championships, with Natalie Ettl and Musser earning individual event titles on uneven bars and in the all-around, respectively. Penn State earned a berth to the NCAA Regional Championships as the No. 2 seed and narrowly missed advancing to the NCAA Championships

Three Nittany Lions were selected to the 2011 All-Big Ten team, and Musser, a Honda Award nominee, advanced to the NCAA National Championships to represent Penn State. Outside the gym, the Nittany Lions excelled in the classroom and community. Five gymnasts earned Academic All-Big Ten laurels and the team was awarded the Penn State Team Community Service Award.

In 11 years as the head of the Auburn University women's gymnastics program, Thompson was named both the SEC Coach of the Year and NCAA Regional Head Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2008.

The Tigers qualified for NCAA Regionals under Thompson for the first time in 2003 and advanced to the NCAA Championship that same year. Auburn's women's gymnastics team continued to improve each year and qualified for the NCAA Regionals for eight consecutive years. In 2005, Auburn hosted the NCAA Women's Gymnastics

With the exception of the University of Alabama, Thompson's teams posted victories over every SEC team during his tenure. In his final season in 2010, Thompson led Auburn to upset victories over No. 8 Arkansas, No. 12 Kentucky and finally defeated 10-time National Champion and five-time defending SEC Champion Georgia for the first time in program history.

Thompson and his wife, Rachelle, helped produced four NCAA All-Americans, four All-SEC selections, three SEC Gymnast of the Year winners and one SEC Freshman of the Year during their time at Auburn. They coached nine NCAA Championship individual qualifiers and four NCAA Regional Event Champions.

Their gymnasts also excelled in the classroom and in the community in their 11 years with the program. There were three SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year winners, three CoSIDA Academic All-District members, 41 NACGC/W Academic All-Americans and 53 SEC Academic Honor Roll selections.

Prior to arriving at Auburn, Thompson was the assistant coach at Louisiana State University from 1994-99 and was the Junior Olympic Program Director at the Cincinnati Gymnastics Academy in Fairfield, Ohio from 1993-94. Thompson also held assistant coaching positions at two Big Ten institutions, Illinois and Wisconsin, as well as serving as a graduate assistant coach at Kentucky.

Thompson earned a bachelor of arts in education with an emphasis in Physical Education from Kentucky in 1985. He went on to receive a Master of Science in Biomechanics in 1995

A native of Highland Heights, Kentucky, Jeff is married to the former Rachelle Fruge, and they have two sons, Parker and Griffin.

#### ABOUT SACRAMENTO STATE

Sacramento State is 6-3 on the year and competes in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) conference.

Sacramento State is 45th in team scoring (193.896), 31st on the vault (48.717), 41st on the uneven bars (48.550), 44th on the balance beam (48.279) and is tied for 55th on the floor exercise (48.350).

Lauren Rice leads the team in the all-around (39.000) and the floor exercise (9.700). Caitlin Soliwoda leads the team on the vault (9.762), the uneven bars (9.704), and the balance beam (9.750).

Sunday marks the first meeting between the two programs.

#### ABOUT TEXAS WOMAN'S UNIVERSITY

Texas Woman's University enters the weekend with an overall record of 3-10. Last weekend, TWU tallied a victory over BYU and Centenary.

TWU competes in the Midwest Independent Conference (MIC) as a NCAA Division II member.

The 2017 TWU schedule features No. 18 Arizona (Jan. 6), No. 7 Denver (Jan. 14), No. 2 LSU (Jan. 20), No. 1 Oklahoma, No. 8 Denver and No. 20 Nebraska (Feb. 3).

Texas Woman's University ranks 55th in team scoring (192.918), 50th on the vault (48.407), 48th on the uneven bars (48.300), 59th on the balance beam (47.786), and ranks 52nd on the floor exercise (48.425).

Schyler Jones leads the team in the all-around (38.600) and the vault (9.779). Jenna Cashmore leads the team on the uneven bars (9.732), Bria Northrop leads the team on the balance beam (9.654), and Erin Alderman leads the team on the floor exercise (9.800).

In their lone regular season meeting back in 2007 against TWU, the Nittany Lions prevailed, 196.825-190.525.

#### ABOUT WESTERN MICHIGAN

The Western Michigan Broncos enter the weekend with a record of 1-4 on the year as a member of the Mid-American Conference (MAC).

Western Michigan is 44th in team score (194.029), tied for 45th on the vault (48.500), 27th on the uneven bars (48,758), 47th on the balance beam (48.250), and 47th on the floor exercise (48.521).

Anna Corbett leads the team in the all-around (38.779) and the vault (9.779). Jessie Peszek leads the team on the uneven bars (9.792), Kelsey Hood leads the team on the balance beam (9.725), and Jessica Juncaj leads the team on the floor exercise (9.713).

The Nittany Lions lead the all-time regular season series against Western Michigan, 2-0. The two programs last met in 2014 with Penn State recording a 196.600-193.625 victory.

### **BIG TEN HONORS**

Following the season-opening quad meet, Briannah Tsang was named the Big Ten Gymnast of the Week for the first time in her career.

Individually, Tsang won titles outright on the vault (9.850), floor exercise (9.850) and allaround (39.350). She also tied for the balance beam title with a 9.825.

#### STELLAR SOPHOMORE SEASON

So far in her second year with the Blue & White, sophomore Sabrina Garcia has set a pair of top-10 performances in the Penn State record books, won six event titles and has three team-leading performances.

On the year, Garcia has posted team-leading scores on the uneven bars (9.950) and is tied for the team-lead on the floor exercise (9.900) and in the all-around lead (39.400).

Garcia has recorded a 9.950 on the uneven bars twice and she has won the uneven bars twice, the floor exercise twice, brought home her first career all-around title against Michigan State and captured her first balance beam title against Ohio State.

#### **HOMECOMING**

Penn State's trip to Texas will be a homecoming for three Nittany Lions. Sophomore Mason calls Pearland, Texas, home, Tess McCracken hails from Plano, Texas, and Emma Sibson is from Allen, Texas.

#### WELCOME BACK

The Nittany Lions return 12 members from the 2016 team that finished fourth at the Big Ten Championships and fifth at the NCAA Regional Championships.

Last year, a pair of Nittany Lion freshmen competed in all 12 meets (Mason Hosek & Jessica Jones), while freshman Sabrina Garcia competed in 11 of 12 meets on the year.

#### RECORD-SETTING PERFORMANCE

Sophomore Sabrina Garcia swung into the Nittany Lion record books with her performance on the uneven bars in the 2017 season-opener.

Garcia recorded a career-best 9.950 on the uneven bars, which tied the No. 3 performance in school history.

Two weeks later, Garcia posted another 9.950 on the uneven bars against Maryland on Jan. 21.

#### **TSANG'S 33 TITLES**

Junior Briannah Tsang has captured 25 individual titles and eight all-around titles in her Nittany Lion career.

Tsang opened up her junior year with three individual titles and the all-around title in a quad meet victory against Bowling Green, BYU and Temple on Jan. 7.

On the year, she has six individual event titles and three all-around titles.

#### **FIRST CAREER TITLES**

Freshman Kristen Politz and sophomore Peyton Schuller both captured their first career title as Nittany Lions against Maryland on Jan. 21.

Politz and Schuller tied for the floor exercise title along with Sabrina Garcia against Maryland, as they all tallied a 9.825.

#### **NEW NITTANY LIONS**

Tess McCracken, Kristen Politz and Mikayla Waddell joined the Penn State women's gymnastics team in the fall of 2016 as freshmen.

McCracken is from Plano, Texas, while Politz (Morganville) and Waddell (Ridgewood) both call New Jersey home.











#### **NITTANY LION DEBUTS**

All three Nittany Lion freshmen have competed in at least one meet during the 2017 season.

Tess McCracken made her Nittany Lion lineup debut at Nebraska, Kristen Politz competed in the season-opener and Mikayla Waddell made her lineup debut in Blue & White at Illinois.

#### ALL-AROUND DEBUT

In her first career all-around, freshman Kristen Politz tallied a 39.050 to finish third at the Penn State-Nebraska meet.

On the day, Politz recorded a 9.875 on the uneven bars, a 9.625 on the vault, a 9.750 on the floor exercise and a 9.800 on the balance heam

#### SIBSON RETURNS

After an injury plagued 2016, senior Emma Sibson made her return for the Nittany Lions in the season-opening quad meet. In her lone event of the day, Sibson tied for seventh on the vault with a 9.725.

A 2015 Second Team All-Big Ten honoree, Sibson owns eight career event titles. During her first two seasons at Penn State she competed in all 26 meets, which included tying for fifth-place on the vault at the 2015 Big Ten Championships (9.900).

#### PRESEASON POLL

The Penn State women's gymnastics team was selected 23rd in the 2017 National Association of Collegiate Gymnastics Coaches/Women (NACGC/W) Preseason Coaches' Poll.

The Nittany Lions closed out the 2016 season ranked No. 26.

Penn State will compete against eight programs that are ranked in the NACGC/W Preseason Coaches' Poll during the 2017 season.

#### HOME SWEET HOME

The 2017 slate features five home meets for the Nittany Lions inside Rec Hall. Penn State opens the 2017 campaign at home in a quad meet against Bowling Green, BYU and Temple on Jan. 7. The Nittany Lions return home two weeks later to host Maryland in a double dual with the Penn State men's program on Jan. 21.

The month of February features three home meets for the Blue & White with Michigan State (Feb. 4), Ohio State (Feb. 11) and Pittsburgh (Feb. 25) coming to town. All Nittany Lion home meets start are scheduled for Saturdays at 4 p.m.

#### **THOMPSON CAPTURES WIN NO. 150**

Head coach Jeff Thompson is in his 18th season as a collegiate head coach in 2017 and during the 2016 season he captured win No. 150. In his career, Thompson has a record of 162-110.

On Feb. 22, 2016, Penn State defeated Maryland, 196.350-195.350, for Coach Thompson's 150th career win.

In his seventh season at the helm of Penn State, Thompson has a record of 90-28. Prior to Penn State, the Highland Heights, Kentucky, native tallied a record of 72-82 at Auburn.

In 2014, the Nittany Lions owned a 20-3 regular season record and set a school record for regular season victories on March 15 in the Big Ten Quad in Ann Arbor.

The previous school record was held by the 2007 squad, which finished 19-4 and placed third at the NCAA Regional Championships.

#### STARTING OFF STRONG

Since the 1999 season, the Nittany Lions have started the season with a top-10 seasonopening meet score. The Nittany Lions have tallied a season-opening top-10 score in each of the past three seasons.

Three of the current top-10 scores have come under the watch of head coach Jeff Thompson.

Five of those scores have been recorded at home, with four others accomplished at the Super Six Challenge; 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2007.

#### THOMPSON IN ELITE COMPANY

Head coach Jeff Thompson headed back to the NCAA Championships for the second time as a head coach and his first as the leader of the Nittany Lions in 2014.

Thompson's first appearance at the national meet came with Auburn in 2003 and he led the Nittany Lions back to the national summit for the first time since the program went in 2009.

He is just the third head coach in NCAA history to navigate two different programs to the NCAA Championships, joining K.J. Kindler (Iowa State & Oklahoma) and Judi Markell (Penn State and Florida).

Thompson took Auburn to the championships during his fourth season at the helm of the program. The Tigers finished 12th at the 2003 NCAA Championships, posting a team score of 193,525.

The Highland Heights, Kentucky, native guided the Nittany Lions to their 18th appearance at the NCAA Championships in his fourth year, as well. The Blue and White finished 12th with a team score of 194.825.

### MOLINARO, NILSON NAMED ASSISTANT COACHES

Following the conclusion of the 2016 season, head coach Jeff Thompson tabbed Kera Molinaro and Josh Nilson as assistant coaches with the Penn State women's gymnastics program.

The 2017 season marks the third season with Molinaro on staff with the Nittany Lions. Molinaro spent the 2016 season as an interim assistant coach after she spent the 2015 season as a volunteer assistant coach.

Nilson joined the PSU program after spending nine years at Utah State.

#### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Penn State enjoys one of the most historic collegiate gymnastics venues in the country and they take pride in giving the home crowd something to cheer for, including a lot of wins.

Since 1975, Penn State owns a 232-59 overall record in home meets. The Nittany Lions are 229-59 at Rec Hall and are 3-0 in meets contested inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The loss to North Carolina State on Jan. 9, 2016, snapped a seven-meet winning streak inside Rec Hall. The seven-meet winning streak was the fourth-best in program history.

Penn State swept its last two home meets in 2014 and was unblemished in its five home dates in 2015.
