

No. 11 Rutgers (8-4, 1-3) at No. 5 Penn State (8-3, 3-1)

Friday, April 21, 6 p.m., Panzer Stadium, State College, Pa.

No. 11 Rutgers men's lacrosse finishes the regular season this Friday night at No. 5 Penn State. The contest will be a 6 p.m game on Big Ten Network, with Joe Beninati and Mark Dixon will be on the call.

ABOUT THE SCARLET KNIGHTS

Rutgers stands at 8-4 overall and are at 1-3 in Big Ten Conference play, with the lone win in league play coming over Michigan in overtime. Last Sunday, RU made a late comeback against No. 4 Maryland, but were unable to overcome an early deficit in an 11-8 loss on Senior Day. In addition to recognizing 21 seniors pregame, Rutgers also honored its alumni, including last season's final four team.

Rutgers is the lone team in the Big Ten to have four players reach the 20-goal plateau. Ross Scott, Brian Cameron and Dante Kulas have 25 goals and Jack Aimone has 20. Shane Knobloch has 17 goals, plus added a team-high 16 assists. Those five players have combined for 112 of the team's 157 goals (71.3%) and 163 of the team's 238 points (68.4%). Scott and Knobloch are on the Top 25 of the Tewaaraton Award Watch List.

Rutgers remains first nationally in turnovers (12.0/game). The team is also 12th in scoring defense, leading the Big Ten at 10.25, and leads the league in caused turnovers at 8.33.

RU has excelled in the middle two quarters this spring, outscoring opponents, 87-53. RU outscored their foes 49-30 in the second and 44-29 in the third. They've been outscored 40-34 in the first and have outscored foes 31-29 in the fourth quarter.

RU is at No. 11 in the RPI following their last game. They are 5-4 against the top-25 in the RPI, with wins over No. 17 Utah, No. 18 Princeton, No. 20 Michigan, No. 22 UMass and No. 24 Loyola.

WITH A VICTORY

A win over No. 5 Penn State would represent:

- Fourth ranked win of the season.
- Second top-five win of the season (also defeated No. 5 Loyola).
- First time since 2003 defeating two top-five opponents in the same season.
- Fourth top-five win since 2019.
- First ranked road win over a top-five team since March 31, 2019 (14-6 win at No. 4 Ohio State)
- Would improve to 47-24 in the all-time series vs. Penn State

ABOUT THE SERIES

Rutgers holds a 46-24 advantage in the series against Penn State, a .657 winning percentage in a series that dates back to its first meeting in 1946. Rutgers has won three straight meetings. Last season, Ross Scott had five goals, including the game-tying tally and game-winning goal in overtime in a 14-13 win.

The annual rivalry game is contested for the Friendship Cup. The trophy debuted in 1998 as a symbol of the friendship of a group of four friends from Sewanhaka High School on Long Island who went off to college splitting two ways; one pair attending Penn State, and the other heading off to Rutgers, including the recently passed Tom Hayes, who was a Penn State alum and then the longtime head coach at Rutgers.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

Penn State is 5th in the polls and No. 8 in the RPI, and on a three-game winning streak in league play. PSU leads the Big Ten in scoring offense, points per game, saves per game, and both man-up and man-down percentages.

Jack Traynor, off a six-goal game that earned him Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week, sits first on the team in goals and second in the Big Ten with 26. TJ Malone leads the team with 24 assists and 49 points. Jack Fracyon has a .567 save percentage and 10.43 goals-against-average. Chase Mullin is at 51.6% at the faceoff 'X'.

Rutgers is wearing burgundy shoelaces and special warmups in support of their equipment manager, Uly Molina, who was recently diagnosed with throat cancer and is undergoing radiation treatments. Molina graduated from Rutgers in 1989 and has been a member of the equipment staff ever since.

MILESTONE WATCH

Ethan Rall enters the game with 80 caused turnovers. He is 4 shy of RU's record of 84 for a career, set by Nick Contino, who graduated in 2014.

Brian Cameron is three goals away from reaching 100 for his career. He scored 38 with UNC and 59 with Rutgers. Ross Scott is 11 goals away from reaching 100 for his career.

UP NEXT: BIG TEN TOURNAMENT

All six teams will make the Big Ten Tournament. The top two seeds get byes. On Saturday, April 29, the 3 seed hosts the 6 seed and the 4 seed hosts the 5 seed. The top four remaining teams head to Homewood Field for the Big Ten Semifinals (Thursday, May 4) and Championship Game (Saturday, May 6).

Rutgers has three potential scenarios for the Quarterfinals next weekend, pending the results of Rutgers-Penn State and primarily the Michigan-Ohio State game (as RU is tied with both Michigan and Ohio State currently for fourth place).

- Rutgers Win, Michigan Win: Rutgers Hosts Michigan
- Ohio State Win over Michigan: Ohio State Hosts Rutgers
- Michigan Win but Rutgers Loss: Rutgers plays at Loser of Johns Hopkins vs. Maryland game.

Rutgers-Penn State is at 6 pm Friday, Michigan-Ohio State in at 8 pm Friday and Maryland-Johns Hopkins is at 6 p.m. on Saturday.

RALL CAUSING TURNOVERS

Since Rutgers started tracking caused turnovers in 2006, Ethan Rall is among the program's best in the category. With 31 caused turnovers last season, Rall had the most caused turnovers in any one season for a RU player since 2006. He is second among RU's career leaders.

A HISTORIC TWO-YEAR STRETCH

In 2022, RU smashed the previous program record for wins, grabbing 15 victories. The team won back-to-back NCAA Tournament games for the first time, downing No. 14 Harvard and No. 3 Penn to advance to the Final Four for the first time.

RU set a record with six ranked wins this season, included matching the highest ranked win in program history with the win over No. 3 Penn and three top-10 wins for the second consecutive season. RU is 12-7 over the past two seasons against ranked teams and the became the first RU men's program to make the Final Four since 1994.

The 2021 season marked a breakthrough campaign for the Rutgers men's lacrosse program. The Scarlet Knights navigated a challenging double round robin conference-only schedule in the grueling Big Ten with ease, finishing the regular season with an 8-2 mark. RU earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament, qualifying for the NCAAs for the first time since 2004 and subsequently winning a NCAA Tournament game for the first time since 1990.

TRANSFER PORTAL SUCCESS

RU has become a prominent place for transfers to thrive. Rutgers added eight transfers to the roster this year, with 12 student-athletes overall as transfers.

Last season, Rutgers' roster was highlighted by performances from transfers who have since departed: Mitch Bartolo (Penn), Ronan Jacoby (Wesleyan), Brennan Kamish (Detroit Mercy), Colin Kirst (Lehigh) and Bryant Boswell (Bucknell).

Brian Cameron (UNC), Jonathan Dugenio (St. John's), Brad Apgar (Salisbury), Andrew Kim (Syracuse) and Justin Kim (Syracuse) return to the roster.

This season, RU again added to the transfer portal to supplement the roster.

Ryan Decker (SSDM from Colgate): Played in 36 games over four years at Colgate ... team captain as a senior in 2021-22... scored seven goals and had five assists ... collected 50 ground balls and caused nine turnovers

Kyle Mullin (GK from Harvard): Played in four seasons at Harvard, starting 30 of 31 career games played at goalkeeper, boasted save percentage of 51.7% (404 career saves) and 12.99 goals-against-average named All-Ivy League in 2022

Jon Miller (M from Bryant): Played in two seasons at Bryant, playing in 26 games with two starts ... scored three goals and had five assists ... collected 45 ground balls and had 16 caused turnovers

Joe Neuman (FO from Yale): Played in three seasons at Yale, winning 61.5% of his faceoffs ... had 42 ground balls

Noah Daniels (M from Mount St. Mary's): Played in 45 games over four seasons at Mount St. Mary's, starting four ... compiled a total of 104 ground balls and 28 caused turnovers ... scored 17 goals and had eight assists

Anthony Palma (GK from Stony Brook): Started 26 games over three seasons at Stony Brook ... posted 11.06 goals-against-average and 51.1% save percentage

Zak Conley (D from Binghamton): Played in 13 games at Binghamton over 2021 and 2022 seasons

LaJhon Jones Jr. (D from Bryant): Played in 28 games at Bryant, making 15 starts at close defense ... caused 31 turnovers and collected 51 ground balls ... also scored five goals ... led team in caused turnovers in 2022

Additionally, Joe Nardella (Albany Firewolves), Connor Kirst (Georgia Swarm) and Adam Charalambides (Vancouver Warriors) all had successful seasons in the NLL.

Current student-athletes Brian Cameron (Toronto Rock) and Brad Apgar (Georgia Swarm) have their rights owned by NLL teams that drafted them, in addition to alumn Ronan Jacoby (Panther City). Mazzone (Atlas) and Kamish (Whipsnakes) played in the February PLL Championship Series.

NATIONAL TV EXPOSURE

Rutgers has gotten unprecedented visibility in recent years, spurred by the Big Ten's television partner, Big Ten Network, along with the team's increased postseason success. Since joining the Big Ten, RU has played on national television 45 times (entering the 2023 season), with all five Big Ten games on national TV this year.

BIG TEN PLAYERS TO WATCH

Three RU players were selected as preseason players to watch by the Big Ten Conference: Ethan Rall, Shane Knobloch and Ross Scott. RU was ranked third in the Preseason Coaches Poll.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Per USA Lacrosse Magazine:

Ethan Rall: First Team

Shane Knobloch: Second Team

Ross Scott: Third Team

All three were also named Midseason All-Americans by Inside Lacrosse.

WINNING MEDALS

Over the summer, Shane Knobloch (USA) and Ross Scott (Canada) participated in the U-21 World Championships, held in Limerick, Ireland. Knobloch was a key contributor for the tournament champions, posting seven goals and three assists for 10 points from the midfield. He was fifth in goals for the champion American team. Scott excelled for Team Canada, earning a place on the All-World Team and being named the event's Most Outstanding Attacker. Scott produced 28 points on 17 goals and 11 assists, most on any of the three medalist teams. Overall, he was third in assists and eighth in points and goals.

ALL ABOUT THE RANKINGS

Rutgers entered the season in the top-10 of all three national polls. The Scarlet Knights have been no lower than No. 13 in the Coaches Poll this season, and have only spent three weeks outside of the top-10.

RODKIN CENTER

The Gary and Barbara Rodkin Center for Academic Success opened in 2021 as the team's new home. The state-of-the-art building features a brand-new locker room for the team as well as offices, film room and academic support.

COACHING STAFF



Brian Brecht recently completed his 11th season as the head coach at Rutgers where he has led the program to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances, including a Final Four appearance in 2022 and an NCAA Tournament Quarterfinals berth in 2021. Prior to his 11 seasons at the helm at Rutgers, he spent seven as the head coach at Siena and nine years as an assistant coach prior to that.

Brecht has been named conference head coach of the year five times (Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2021 and 2016, MAAC Coach of the Year in 2009, 2007 and 2006). Brecht, who was named head coach of the Scarlet Knights on June 16, 2011, has made four NCAA Tournament appearances in his career as a head coach (two at Rutgers and two at Siena).

Eric Seremet enters his fifth season as a member of the Rutgers coaching staff as the team's offensive coordinator. In 2022, Seremet was named the Division I Assistant Coach of the Year by the IMLCA. Previously, he spent nine seasons as the head coach of Air Force. He was 73-62 as the head coach and was named the USILA Division I Coach of the Year in 2014 and the 2016 Southern Conference Coach of the Year. Under his leadership, the Falcons won three conference championships and made three trips to the NCAA Tournament.



Jimmy Ryan enters his third season as the Rutgers defensive coordinator and his sixth season on the staff. Previously, he served as RU's volunteer assistant coach and Director of Lacrosse Operations. Ryan joined the program after spending the previous season as an assistant coach at Western New England University men's lacrosse program.



Peter Dolan enters his third season as the Rutgers volunteer assistant coach. Dolan works with Rutgers' specialists (face-off and goalkeepers). Dolan joined the Scarlet Knights after previously serving as an assistant coach with Western New England University. Prior to that, he worked as an assistant coach at Lasell University for three years, after his graduation from there, where he was a faceoff specialist.
