Home-and-Home With Penn State This Week

Ohio State faces the Nittany Lions twice in the same week

Ohio State Women's Volleyball gets not one, but two, chances to knock off the defending national champion Nittany Lions of Penn State this week. A home-and-home awaits as the Buckeyes travel to Happy Valley for Tuesday night's 8 p.m. match broadcast nationally on the Big Ten Network before returning to St. John Arena to host Penn State Friday night in a 7 p.m. showdown.

MOVING ON UP

The Buckeyes have ascended to a season-high No. 17 ranking in this week's Top-25 Coaches Poll. The climb has been powerd by a 7-1 mark in the last eight games which includes 3-1 vs. fellow Top-25 squads and three of four victories coming on the road. The computers have risen the Buckeye position as well, slotting OSU 20th in the national RPI rankings.

WINNER ON CUSP OF CENTURY MARK

The next time senior defensive specialist Alyssa Winner steps between the lines it will mark the 100th match of her collegiate career. She donned the libero jersey for the first weekend of Big Ten season and responded a big way, picking up 18 digs in a three-set contest at Wisconsin (Sept. 28). She has since started five matches at defensive specialist.

SETTING UP THE BUCKEYES FOR SUCCESS

Senior setter Taylor Sherwin became just the seventh player in school history to record 3,000 career assists, surpassing the milestone on Oct. 18 at Purdue. The Orlando, Fla., native has accumulated 3,078 assists entering Tuesday night's contest at Penn State.

WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE

Ohio State improved to 7-0 this season inside St. John Arena following wins over Michigan State and Michigan last weekend. The Buckeyes also picked up a pair of top-25 wins over #15 Illinois and #24 Northwestern threee weeks ago. The Buckeyes defended their home turf admirably Sept. 5-7 as well, laying claim to the 9th Annual Sports Imports D.C. Koehl Classic trophy. The Buckeyes defeated Auburn, Florida Gulf Coast and Southern Illinois to take ownership of the hardware. Luisa Schirmer was voted the tournament's Most Outstanding Player while Elizabeth Campbell and Taylor Sandbothe joined her on the all-tournament team.

Amidst the 29th season calling St. Johna Arena 'home,' the Buckeyes are 294-127 (.698) all-time in the facility.

BALANCED ATTACK IN THE BIG TEN

Hafway through the conference schedule, three different Buckeyes can be found in the Big Ten's top-15 for kills per set. Erin Sekinger, Elizabeth Campbell and Katie Mitchell are each putting away an average of three or more kills per set. Taylor Sherwin was distributed the ball to the OSU three-headed monster to the tune of 10.66 assists/set, good for fourth in the conference.

THE BIG TEN GAUNTLET

Six Big Ten progams are ranked in this week's AVCA Division I Coaches Poll, including No. 4 Wisconsin, No. 6 Penn State, No. 10 Illinois, No. 13 Purdue, No.14 Nebraska, and No. 17 Ohio State. In addition, Minnesota is receiving votes.

SCHOOL HISTORY WITH BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK TOP-25 VICTORIES

For the first time in school history, the Buckeyes recorded back-to-back-to-back wins with all three opponents ranked in the Top-25. It all started Oct. 4 when the Buckeyes marched into Lincoln and earned a five-set road victory over #8 Nebraska, followed by home triumphs over #15 Illinois and #24 Northwestern the following week.

NEVER-SAY-DIE BUCKEYES

The dramatic fashion in which Ohio State came back to emerge victorious over #8 Nebraska and #15 Illinois in consecutive matches was monumental and potentially unparalleled. In total, the Buckeyes successfully fended off seven match points to erase 14-11 and 14-10 fifth-set deficits at Nebrasaka and vs. Illinois, respectively.

The Buckeyes silenced a crowd of more than 8,000 in Lincoln. The drama came to a crescendo when OSU stared a 14-11 fifth-set deficit and three match points in the face. Ohio State ripped off the next five points on the strength of Katie Mitchell's superb service to lock in the program's second straight win at Nebraska (3-3 all-time in Lincoln). Ohio State's 77 kills that night are the most by any Big Ten team this season (OSU's 74 vs. Syracuse are the second most).

The Buckeyes then faced an even more daunting deficit vs. Illinois. Buried in a 14-10 hole, Ohio State rattled off six points in a row to send the Buckeye faithful into a frenzy with a 16-14 Houdini act escaping with another wild come-from-behind triumph.

DIGGING THE DEFENSE

Valeria León picked up Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week honors on Oct. 13. She averaged 3.44 digs, .56 aces and 1.11 assists per set as the Buckeyes tallied two more wins over top-25 teams in the past week. León served as the libero, picking up a dozen digs versus #15 Illinois and 19 more against #24 Northwestern. She played a major role in the service game as well. On the offensive, León fired a total of five aces, at least two in each. She also successfully handled 53 service receptions with no errors.

CAMPBELL, BUCKEYES GARNER NATIONAL RECOGNITION

Two days after earning Player of the Week honors from the Big Ten Conference (details below), Elizabeth Campbell garnered the same recognition on a national level as ESPNW's National Player of the Week. Ohio State then cracked the AVCA Top-25 for the first time in 2014, coming in at #22.

BIG TEN'S BEST FOR WEEK OF OCT. 6

The Big Ten Conference recognized a pair of Ohio State women's volleyball players on Monday (Oct. 6) for their efforts over the weekend in guiding OSU to road wins at Iowa and No. 8 Nebraska. Elizabeth Campbell was tabbed the Big Ten Player of the Week while Taylor Sherwin collected her third career Big Ten Setter of the Week honor.

Campbell performed on both sides of the net, averaging 4.38 kills and 3.62 digs per set while swinging at a .308 clip; all team highs. Her 23 kills are the most by any opponent against the Huskers this season. Sherwin tallied 95 assists (11.88/set) over the weekend, evenly distributing the ball to four different OSU attackers with 17 or more kills. She did more than just assist, however, providing 2.75 digs per set, including 19 in Lincoln.

DOUBLING UP

Taylor Sherwin has racked up a half dozen double-doubles (10 or more assists and digs in a match) this season. Luisa Schirmer and Elizabeth Campball have contributed heavily on both sides of the net as well, each posting kill-dig double-doubles four times. Erin Sekinger and Valeria León have both posted one.

HAVE YOURSELF A DAY

Saturday, Sept. 20 was one to remember for Katie Mitchell and Erin Sekinger. Not only did the Buckeyes clinch the Miami Invitational title with a pair of wins, but both Buckeyes racked up statistical totals that rank tops in the Big Ten thus far this season. Sekinger pounded 22 kills vs. IUPUI, the most in a three set match by a B1G player, and Mitchell came back in the night cap with 27 points versus the RedHawks (tied for the most in a four-setter by at B1G player this season). Setter Taylor Sherwin guided the offensive attack, earning Most Outstanding Player honors for the tournament as both Mitchell and Sekinger joined her on the all-tournament team.

THREE WEEKENDS, THREE ALL-TOURNEY VOTES FOR SANDBOTHE

Sophomore middle blocker Taylor Sandbothe got off to a hot start for the Buckeyes, earning all-tournament honors in each of the first three weekends before taking a five-match leave due to illness. Her final recognition came at the Millennium Hotel Invitational in Cincinnati after racking up 65 points in three matches with an attacking efficiency of .396, 3.71 kills/set and 1.80 blocks/set.



SANDBOTHE GETS DEFENSIVE

Taylor Sandbothe was named the Big Ten Co-Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 8 after averaging 2.00 blocks per set as Ohio State laid claim to the Sports Imports D.C. Koehl Classic trophy. The sophomore middle blocker was a force throughout the entire weekend, recording no less than six blocks and averaging at least 1.5 per set in all three Buckeye victories.

It marks the third B1G weekly recognition for Sandbothe, twice being named the conference's Freshman of the Week last season (Nov. 11; Nov. 25). She also becomes the first Buckeye to earn Defensive Player of the Week laurels since Mariah Booth on Nov. 7, 2011.

COACH CARLSTON JOINS IN ALS AWARENESS EFFORTS

Ohio State women's volleyball coach Geoff Carlston was called upon to participate in the ALS #lce-BucketChallenge from the Buckeye women's soccer staff, and he gladly accepted. Video can be found at OhioStateBuckeyes.com.

CHALLENGING DOCKET FOR THE BUCKEYES

Ohio State's 32-match regular season schedule includes 17 matches against schools which qualified for the 2013 NCAA Tournament and a dozen versus teams ranked in the preseason AVCA Top-25. In addition, two more opponents in Oregon and Michigan are receiving votes in the AVCA poll. St. John Arena will serve as the venue for 13 home matches, starting with the 9th Annual Sports Imports D.C. Koehl Classic Sept. 5-7.

NEW FACES FROM DIFFERENT PLACES

A pair of transfers bolster the Ohio State roster this season as Elizabeth Campbell and Tyler Richardson both begin their junior campaigns as Buckeyes. Campbell is a six-rotation player who earned Co-ACC Player of the Week honors last season while playing for Duke University. She was tabbed to the ACC All-Freshman squad in 2012. Richardson comes from Middle Tennessee State University where she seized 2013 AVCA All-American honorable mention after performing as one of the most efficient offensive weapons in the country. She attacked at a .414 clip, ranking 13th nationally.

B1G TIME COVERAGE FROM THE BIG TEN NETWORK

Ohio State women's volleyball will be showcased at least 15 times by BTN during the 2014 season with a pair of matches airing live on the Big Ten Network linear channel and an additional 13 contests streamed live online by BTN Plus.

The Big Ten Network rolls into town on Oct. 11 for a home match inside St. John Arena versus Northwestern. Ohio State takes the national stage on Oct. 28 as well when a road match at Penn State is broadcast nationally on BTN. Seven of the Buckeyes' 10 home conference matches will be streamed live on BTN Plus while the additional three contests can be seen on Buckeye Vision. The three-match Sports Imports D.C. Koehl Classic can be seen on Buckeye Vision as well.

HEAD COACH GEOFF CARLSTON



The 2014 season marks Geoff Carlston's seventh as Ohio State's head coach. He took the reins of the women's volleyball team on Feb. 5, 2008 and is the fifth head coach of the Buckeyes in the 43-year history of the program.

Carlston enters '14 with a career winning percentage of .684 in 14 years as a Division-l head coach, racking up 316 victories compared to just 146 defeats. His squads have averaged

over 22.5 wins per season and own 10 years of 20 or more victories.

The native Minnesotan has made his mark in the state of Ohio, guiding the Bobcats of Ohio University and the Buckeyes to a combined nine NCAA Tournament appearances. Carlton directed Ohio State to four consecutive postseason berths highlighted by back-to-back Sweet 16 advancements in 2010-11.

Before arriving in Columbus, Carlston started his NCAA Tournament success with five straight Mid-American Conference championships to propel Ohio into the big dance, including his first Sweet 16 showing in 2005. Carlston's squads are a combined 6-3 all-time in the NCAA First Round and 4-0 at Ohio State. He led the Bobcats to a conference crown in each of his five campaigns in Athens.

Carlston's pupils have often been recognized amongst the nation's elite, totaling nine All-American accolades. Ohio State's Katie Dull (2009) and Emily Danks (2011) earned All-America honorable mention from the AVCA while Mari Hole was chosen in back-to-back seasons as an '11 honorable mention and Third Team member in 2012. Five Bobcats picked up All-American status under the tutelage of Carlston. On the conference level, Carlston has molded 10 All-Big Ten, 25 All-MAC and eight All-NSIC performers since 2000.

Academic success has followed Carlston throughout his career as well. Student-athletes receiving academic all-conference laurels has been a common occurrence under Carlston, racking up a total of 70 such awards: 35 Academic All-Big Ten, 25 Academic All-MAC, 10 Academic All-NSIC). His program was honored by the NCAA in May 2014 with the Public Recognition Award, given to teams scoring in the top-10 percent nationally in each sport based on their most recent multi-year Academic Progress Rates (APR).

The 2013 Buckeyes swept through a 12-0 nonconference and finished the season with 18 wins overall. Senior Kaitlyn Leary was tabbed an AVCA All-America honorable mention while Taylor Sandbothe was placed on the Big Ten's All-Freshman squad.

Ohio State went on a four-year run of 20-or-more wins starting in 2009. In 2012, the Buckeyes registered a 23-11 overall ledger, including a 13-7 conference mark to earn place fourth in the daunted Big Ten Conference. Carlston and the Buckeyes notched the program's first ever win at Nebraska (3-1, Oct. 26) that season. Senior Mari Hole was named AVCA Third Team All-American and unanimously voted All-Big Ten while fellow senior Emily Danks and junior Kaitlyn Leary were All-B1G honorable mentions.

Carlston conducted a pair of treks to the Sweet 16 in 2010 and 2011. Juniors Mari Hole and Emily Danks picked up All-America nods during a 21-15 campaign in 2011 after the '10 Buckeyes notched a 24-12 overall win-loss tally en route to the first Sweet 16 jaunt.

In just his second season at Ohio State, Carlston pushed the Buckeyes to a 25-10 season record and 12-8 Big Ten tally in 2009. OSU returned to the NCAA Tournament via an at-large bid and hosted the first and second rounds in Columbus.

During the summer of 2011, Carlston served as head coach of one of the USA A-2 squads that played at the USA Volleyball Open National Championships Women's Open, finishing second.

Carlston came to Ohio State after spending five years as head coach at Ohio University, building a powerhouse in the Mid-American Conference. His squads reached the NCAA Tournament every season and won five straight conference crowns with an overall record of 144-22 during Carlston's time in Athens. The Bobcats won 78 of 80 MAC matches and went 14-1 in the conference tournament with four tourney titles. Four Bobcats were named MAC Player of the Year and a pair were tabbed MAC Freshman of the Year. He was named the MAC Coach of the Year four times and was twice named the Mideast Region Coach of the Year.

Prior to Ohio, Carlston posted a 49-42 record in three seasons at the helm of the Concordia University-St. Paul (Minn.) program. He took the Golden Bears from an 0-18 mark in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference the season before his arrival to a serious run at the league title in 2002.

CUSP finished the 2002 campaign with a 24-9 record - its best in Division II competition - and earned its first national ranking during the season. Carlson recruited three consecutive NSIC Freshman of the Year selections to play for the Golden Bears.

In the summer of 2002, Carlston served as coach of a Division II all-star team that played in a tournament in Holland. Competing against the top Dutch college and professional league teams, the group won gold and bronze medals. Before Concordia, Carlston served two seasons as a student assistant coach at Minnesota while completing a master's degree in social work.

Carlston began his coaching career in 1994 as head coach at Hopkins High School. In his two-year tenure, his teams went 41-17 and captured the Classic Lake Conference title both seasons.

He left the high school ranks for two years of service in Belize as a Peace Corps volunteer but stayed close to the sport, serving as head coach of the Belize women's national team and as an assistant for the men's national team. He helped develop a year-round training program and the team finished fourth at the 1997 Central America championship, earning the country's first international victories.

Upon his return to the United States, Carlston became head coach of the 17's team of the Minnesota One Junior Olympics club, which competed in the 17 Open Division at USA Nationals three consecutive years under his direction.

In June 1993, Carlston earned his undergraduate degree in speech communication from the University of Minnesota, where he played on the club team for the Gophers. The Plymouth, Minn., native is married to the former Sara Tibesar of St. Paul. The couple has a son, Teddy.

ASSISTANT COACHES LAURA BENZING JAY VAN VARK

Second Season, Bradley 2002



Laura Benzing joined the Ohio State coaching staff in March 2013 as an assistant coach and is set to begin her second season donning the Scarlet and Gray in 2014. She spent the previous five years as an assistant coach for Oregon State.

The Buckeyes swept through a 12-0 nonconference slate during Benzing's first campaign

in Columbus and finished with 18 victories overall. She made an immediate impact on the court, mentoring freshman middle blocker Taylor Sandbothe to a spot on the Big Ten All-Freshman team. Sandbothe's 1.02 blocks per set career average ranks fifth overall in school history entering the 2014 season. Benzing was a middle blocker as well, earning a pair of First Team All-Missouri Valley Conference accolades during her days as a Bradley University Brave (1998-2001).

At Oregon State, one of Benzing's primary responsibilities was to coordinate the program's recruiting. In this role, she helped produce a nationally-recognized 2009 recruiting class and brought in the program's first Fab 50 recruit. Benzing also served as the liaison between the student-athletes and academics and has helped the team earn three-straight AVCA Team Academic Award honors.

Her recruiting prowess continues as a Buckeye, evidenced by Ohio State hauling in a Top-25 class in 2014 according to Volleyball Magazine's national rankings.

On the court, Benzing focuses on both team and individual blocking. Both the 2010 and 2011 Beaver teams finished second in the Pac-10 in blocks per set. She also worked on defense and trained middle hitters.

Prior to Oregon State, Benzing played professionally in the German Bundesliga for four years before retiring and accepting a position with the Beavers in 2006.

Benzing graduated magna cum laude from Bradley in 2002 with a Bachelor's of Science in pre-law.

A native of Sparta, Wis., Benzing also completed a six-month stint with Club West Volleyball in Temecula, Calif., directing coaches and coaching U14 and U16 groups. She is fluent in German and also earned a Certificate in English Language Teaching to Adults from the University of Cambridge while overseas. She obtained her USA Weightlifting Level I Sports Performance Certification in January 2011 as well.

Van Vark carries a wealth of collegiate, club and USA Volleyball coaching experience with him entering his first season in Columbus.

Van Vark had a busy summer working with

Team USA, coaching various teams and programs including rising junior Katie Mitchell and the USA Collegiate National Team in Minneapolis.

Most recently on the collegiate level, Van Vark served as associate head coach for CSU-San Marcos in 2013 and as an assistant coach at San Diego State in 2012. He aided both programs to conference championships and postseason play. The CSUSM Cougars went 26-12 while the SDSU Aztecs won the Mountain West Conference championship for the first time in school history. Van Vark tutored two AVCA All-Americans and four All-MWC honorees while pushing San Diego State to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2001.

He began his coaching career as head coach for the Iowa State men's club team and assistant coach for the women's team. In his playing days, Van Vark was a Cyclone as well, named the club national MVP in 1985. During his last years in college, he played semi-pro indoor with the ACCO Sportswear team for two seasons, followed by three campaigns of outdoor for East Beach as an AAA-rated beach and grass player. He has also played in five indoor USVBA Open National Championships. In the late 80s, he was a college referee and at one point was the youngest head official for the Big 8 (now the Big 12).

After moving to San Diego, he headed the Rancho Bernardo High School boys' and girls' volleyball programs for 10 seasons. He led the Bronco girls to their only CIF volleyball title in 1994.

Van Vark took a leave from competitive volleyball to establish a career in the software business and raise a family. He returned to the sideline as his daughter took up the sport, coaching the Epic Volleyball Club from 2006-14 and resuming his role as head coach at RBHS from 2009-11.

In addition to coaching, Van Vark is the co-founder of a successful software firm called Kick Your Apps which develops iPad and iPhone applications. He is also the author of one of the most successful volleyball statistics packages, iVolleyStats.

He and his wife, Linda, have been married for 23 years and have a daughter, Audrey (20) and a son, Jared (17).

ANTHONY GLASS DIRECTOR OF STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING



Anthony Glass is marking his 14th season as the Director of Strength and Conditioning for Olympic at The Ohio State University following four years as the director at Georgia where he developed and oversaw all related programs for 20 Olympic sports teams.

Prior to his tenure at Georgia, Glass spent one year in a similar position at Boston College. Prior

to that, he enjoyed four years as an instructor in the Department of Physical Education and assistant strength and conditioning coach at Northern Illinois, where he also earned a M.Ed. degree. (MS.ED)

Glass oversees a staff that manages the strength and conditioning progress of Ohio State's entire varsity sports program, with the exception of football and basketball.

Glass is certified by the National Strength & Conditioning Association, Collegiate Strength and Conditioning Coaches Association, The American College of Sports Medicine and the United States of American Weightlifting Association. A native of North Carolina, he graduated from Appalachian State in 1990 with a degree in physical education.

While at Northern Illinois, he authored the book entitled "Weight Training: A Step by Step Guide to the Development of a Safe and Sound Program" in addition to a number of articles for major sports science journals. Glass is nationally recognized speaker and serves as a state director for both the NSCA and NASE.

Since 1984, Glass has competed successfully in power-lifting, winning several North Carolina and Illinois state championships. He has trained athletes of all levels from high school to the professional ranks.

He and his wife, Guerdie, have one son, Lee Anthony, Jr., and daughters Leila and Leena.

KYLE HOMEYER DIRECTOR OF VOLLEYBALL OPERNATIONS



Kyle Homeyer joined Ohio State in the spring of 2013 and is in his second season as the Director of Volleyball Operations.

Homeyer came to Columbus following a twoyear stint as a volunteer assistant at St. Louis University. He assisted in on-court skill instruction and with gameday management, while also helping with Data Project software and oppo-

nent scouting for the Billikens.

Homeyer also worked with the St. Louis High Performance club as an administrative liaison for both the boys and girls divisions. He coached four teams while with St. Louis High Performance as well.

CHELSEA NOBLE VOLUNTEER COACH



Chelsea Noble enters her first season on the coaching staff in 2014, and fourth year overall as a Buckeye after finishing her playing career in Columbus (2007-09). In addition to her role as the Ohio State volunteer assistant coach, she also serves as the Development Coordinator for the Elite Volleyball Training Center.

As a student-athlete, Noble guided Ohio State as the team captain and libero during the 2008 and 2009 campaigns. The Vandalia, Ohio native set a then-school record with 486 digs as a senior. While that season dig total now ranks third all-time, Noble's 3.45 digs per set career average remains the top mark in Buckeye history. She began her career at Tennessee (2005-06), spending time as both a setter and defensive specialist during the Lady Vols' run to the NCAA Semifinals. For her collegiate career, Noble racked up 1,606 assists, 1,385 digs, 147 kills, 86 blocks and 79 service aces.

Noble excelled in the classroom as well, evidenced by her selection to the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District team twice and Ohio State Scholar-Athlete thrice.

After graduating in 2010 with a degree in K-12 Physical Education, she moved to Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Noble worked as the Coe College (D-III) graduate assistant while completing her master's degree in teaching and a health endorsement. As the women's volleyball GA, she aided Coe College in an undefeated conference record and 30-4 overall mark in 2011. Noble was the program's defensive coordinator and assisted with film breakdown, practice and team management.

The past three years saw Noble teaching middle school health in Pella, Iowa while coaching club volleyball for Pella Thunder 13U and 15U.
