- This will be the 68th meeting all-time between Ohio State and Penn State.
- The Lady Lions are one of two Big Ten teams to have a winning record against Ohio State, leading the all-time series 36-31.
- Penn State won the first two regular season meetings of the McGuff era in 2014 but the 8th-seeded Buckeyes then blitzed top-seeded Penn State 99-82 in the quarterfinals of the 2014 Big Ten Tournament. That win sparked what is now a 10-game Buckeye win streak in the series.
- Ohio State had to pause due to COVID-19 protocols on Dec. 14 and has not played a game since its win over Miami (Ohio) on Dec. 10. That will be a span of 24 days when the Buckeyes take the court Monday night.
- Ohio State averaged 96.3 points per game and outscored their non-conference opponents by an average of almost 41 points per game.
- Penn State comes in at 3-3 overall following a 96-82 loss at home vs. Maryland on New Year's Eve. The Lady Lions went 3-1 in the non-conference and are now 0-2 in Big Ten play with losses to Purdue and Maryland.
- The Buckeyes have only played four games but their 96.3 ppg is third in country and their 55.6 field goal percentage is tops in the country.
- Sophomore Jacy Sheldon has scored in double figures in her last 10 games dating back to last season. She is second on the team in scoring at 17.3 ppg and leads the team with eight steals.
- Madison Greene has 22 assists and just three turnovers for a ratio of 7.3-to-1 which is seventh-best in the country.
- Junior Aaliyah Patty is one of 11 players in the Big Ten shooting better than 60 percent on the season. She is also averaging over 10 ppg at 10.8.
- Fellow junior Dorka Juhasz has three double-doubles this year and 25 for her career. She is also just 202 points shy of 1,000 for her career.

GAME 5 -- OHIO STATE VS. PENN STATE

HITTING 100

- Ohio State has topped the 100-point mark twice this season, scoring 103 vs. Kent State and 104 vs. Miami (Ohio).
- This marks just the fifth time in the "non-Kelsey Mitchell Era" that the team has had two 100-point games in the same season.
- The team hit 100 four times during Mitchell's senior year (2017-18) and three times in both her freshman (2014-15) and sophomore (2015-16) seasons.

RECORD TURNOVERS...IN A GOOD WAY

- The Buckeyes obviously did a lot right in their runaway 103-47 victory over Kent State on Dec. 2.
- Scoring over 100 points is a little easier when you don't turn the ball over and the Buckeyes did that in record fashion.
- The three turnovers were the fewest in a game in school history.
- The three turnovers also tied Northwestern from Feb. 10, 2020 for the fewest turnovers in a game by a Big Ten team since 2011.

BEST ASSIST-TO-TURNOVER RATIO

- Ohio State dished-out 23 assists to go along with the school-record low three turnovers in their win over Kent State on Dec. 2.
- That 7.7-to-1 ratio is the highest ratio in any game in school history.
- It was also the best ratio by a Power Five team since the start of the 2016-17 season.
- Eight of the 11 Buckeyes had at least one assist while Braxtin Miller and Madison Greene led the team with six apiece.

RECAPPING THE MIAMI (OHIO) GAME

- Ohio State shot 60 pct. from the field in the first half, stormed out to a 49-26 halftime lead and went on to defeat the Miami Red-Hawks, 104-65 on Dec. 10.
- Dorka Juhasz and Jacy Sheldon scored 15 and 13 points, respectively, in the first half to spark the Buckeyes while Juhasz also grabbed nine of her season-high 15 rebounds in the half. Her 27 points for the game tied a career high while her double-double represented the 25th of her career and third this season.
- Madison Greene dished five first-half assists on her way to her career-high tying seven assists ... for the second consecutive game! She also scored 12 points.
- Braxtin Miller finished with 13 points while freshman Kateri Poole had 11.
- Ohio State had a 58-20 advantage in points in the paint and a 22-0 margin in fast break points. The team had 20 assists against just nine turnovers while forcing 23 RedHawk turnovers.

HITTING PAUSE

- The Buckeyes opened the year with four dominating victories but then had to hit the pause button on Dec. 14 due to COVID-19 protocols.
- The pause was extended to a seven-day shutdown on Dec. 18 and the team had to postpone three games.
- Ohio State returned to the court vs. Penn State on Jan. 4, marking a 24-day break games.

JUHASZ NEARING 1,000

- Dorka Juhasz has scored 798 points in her Buckeye career and this season, she will likely become the 35th player in school history to record 1,000 career points
- Juhasz is just 202 points away
- She also has pulled down 576 career rebounds. If she remains on the same pace as her first two seasons, she would likely become the ninth player in school history with more than 1,000 career points and 750 career rebounds

JUHASZ NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG 10

- Buckeye junior Dorka Juhasz enters the season as one of the best post players in the conference and was recognized as such as she was named to the 10-member Preseason All-Big Ten Team.
- Juhasz led the team in scoring and rebounding each of the last two seasons, including averaging 13.2 points and 9.4 rebounds a season ago.
- She earned first team All-Big Ten honors last year after being named to the second team as a freshman in 2018-19

JUHASZ ON NAISMITH WOMEN'S WATCH LIST

- Juhasz finds herself in good company as she was named to the Naismith Women's Watch List at the start of the season.
- There are 50 players on the preseason list and Juhasz is one of six players from the Big Ten, joining Arella Guirantes (Rutgers), Naz Hillmon (Michigan), Ashley Owusu (Maryland), Ali Patberg (Indiana) and Lindsey Pulliam (Northwestern)

POSTSEASON BAN

<u>On Dec. 22, Ohio State released a statement:</u> "The Ohio State University Department of Athletics is currently working cooperatively with the NCAA Enforcement Staff on an infractions case involving three sports programs: fencing, women's golf and women's basketball. Ohio State has self-imposed post-season competition bans for each of the sprots for the 2020-21 year. As always, we are focused on supporting our student-athletes. SERIES HISTORY VS. PENN STATE

- Monday's matchup will be the 68th meeting all-time between Ohio State and Penn State.
- Penn State is one of just two Big Ten teams that Ohio State has a losing record against as the Lady Lions lead the all-time series 36-31.
- After losing five in a row from 2012-14, the Buckeyes have won 10 consecutive in the series.
- The Buckeyes will be trying to match their longest win streak in the series which was 11 games from 2005 to 2010.
- The OSU win last season gave the Buckeyes a 14-13 edge in meetings in Columbus.

MCGUFF VS. PENN STATE

- Head coach Kevin McGuff is 11-3 all-time against Penn State.
- He is 10-2 against the Lady Lions as head coach at Ohio State. He also split a home-andhome series with Penn State while coaching at Xavier.
- The McGuff led Musketeers dropped a 73-66 decision in overtime at Penn State in 2006 and then topped PSU 72-68 in Cincinnati in 2007.
- McGuff and the Buckeyes are currently riding a 10-game win streak against Penn State.

LAST YEAR VS. PENN STATE

- Forward Dorka Juhasz scored a game-high 23 points and grabbed 12 rebounds as the Buckeyes broke open a tight game in the third quarter and claimed an 80-70 victory on Jan.
 12 at Value City Arena.
- Juhasz' was 3-of-5 from beyond the arc and tied a career-high with four steals.
- Freshman Kierstan Bell and sophomore Janai Crooms each added a spark off the bench. Bell scored 14 of her 17 points in the second

half and hit three three-pointers. Crooms also had a solid second half as she scored eight of her 10 points after the break. The Cranston, R.I. native added nine assists, six rebounds and three steals.

- Sophomore Aaliyah Patty battled foul trouble but was still effective as she had 13 points, six rebounds and two steals.
- The Buckeyes forced Penn State into 22 turnovers and scored 26 points off those miscues. The other key in the game was the Buckeye ball movement. Defensively, Penn State was in a zone for most of the game, forcing the Buckeyes to move the ball and find the gaps. After a slow start, OSU found its footing and ended up assisting on 22 of 30 made field goals.
- After trailing by two at the end of the first quarter, the Buckeyes went on a 17-2 run in the second quarter to turn a four-point deficit into a 30-19 lead and OSU would eventually lead by seven at the break. In the third quarter the teams combined to score 57 points as the Buckeyes shot 66.7 percent and were 5-of-9 from long range. OSU's 33 points in the quarter were the second-most in any quarter this season and its third quarter of 30+ points. That helped shove the lead out to 66-50 with a quarter to play.
- The fourth quarter wasn't the smoothest of quarters for the Buckeyes as PSU cut the lead to eight on three different occasions but Ohio State was never really threatened in the final 10 minutes.

OSU PICKED 5TH IN B1G PRESEASON POLL

- Both the league's 14 head coaches and the media have pegged the Buckeyes to finish fifth in Big Ten preseason poll
- Ohio State was 11-7 last year in conference play and earned the No. 6 seed in the Big Ten Tournament. The Buckeyes strung together three wins in the tournament to advance to the championship game
- That finish, coupled with the fact that the team returns all five starters, has people thinking the Buckeyes could be in the mix for the title this season

JUHASZ LEADING THE WAY IN HER FIRST TWO YEARS

- Dorka Juhasz led the team in scoring and rebounding in each of her first two season, becoming just the second player in program history to do so.
- Jantel Lavender led the Buckeyes in both categories in all four of her seasons from 2007-11
- Juhasz will try to join Lavender and Jessica Davenport (2004-07) as the only players in school history to lead the team in scoring and rebounding in three consecutive seasons
- Juhasz averaged 11.7 points and 9.0 rebounds as a freshman and 13.2 points and 9.4 rebounds last year as a sophomore

CREATING THE EXTRA POSSESSION

- When the Buckeyes commit fewer turnovers and have more rebounds in the same game, thus creating more possessions, good things usually happen.
- Under McGuff, Ohio State is 54-1 when creating those extra possessions.

SHARING THE LOVE

- Under head coach Kevin McGuff, the Buckeyes have dished-out 20 or more assists in a game 38 times and are 37-1 in those games.
- Dating back to the 2009-10 season, the Buckeyes have won 66 of the last 69 games when sharing on 20 or more of their field goals.

HITTING THE GLASS

- When the Buckeyes win the battle on the boards, they usually end up winning the game.
- Ohio State is 91-12 under McGuff when out-rebounding the opponent.

247-STRAIGHT WITH A THREE

- Ohio State has made at least one three-point field goal in 247-straight games.
- The last time the Buckeyes failed to make a

three-pointer in a game was on Feb. 10, 2013 at Northwestern. OSU was 0-of-6 from long range that game.


