**Nittany Lions Take On Temple and SJU:** The Penn State baseball team will head back out on the road this weekend, taking on Temple in a doubleheader on Saturday, March 16 and facing Saint Joseph's on Sunday, March 17. The Nittany Lions' (5-9, 0-0 Big



Ten) doubleheader against the Owls (4-9, 0-0 A-10) will begin at noon, while the single contest against the Hawks (6-10, 0-0 A-10) will begin at noon on Sunday, as well.

**Last Time Out:** The Lions are coming off of a momentum building series against Houston Baptist, earning two wins over the Huskies and scoring 27 runs in the process. Penn State hit .373 as a team, with sophomore **J.C. Coban** leading the pack with an average of .533 over the three-game span. In the 9-3 win over HBU on March 8, the sophomore went five-for-five, becoming the first Penn Stater to do so since 2010. Coban came away with eight hits and two RBIs, while senior **Luis Montesinos** batted .462, posting six hits, six RBIs, a triple and his first collegiate homerun.

Montesinos and Coban are two of seven Lions that are currently on an at least three-game hitting streak, with sophomore **Taylor Skerpon** recording six hits against the Huskies, as well. Skerpon also hit his first collegiate homerun in the three-game series, ending the weekend with a .429 batting average, five runs and two RBIs. Redshirt junior **Steve Snyder** had a stellar day in the extra-inning loss on March 9, earning four RBIs, two of which came on a game-tying play, two hits and a run scored. Snyder ended the series with five runs and five hits.

Leading Penn State on the mound, redshirt sophomore **T.J. Jann** earned his first collegiate win on March 9 in game one of the doubleheader. Jann fired 4.1 innings after relieving senior **Dave Walking**, allowing just one earned run and striking out one batter to earn a 2.08 ERA. Senior **Steven Hill** shined on Friday's contest, pitching the seventh complete game of his career after throwing 143 pitches. The Texas native tied his career-high of eight strikeouts, while allowing four earned runs and nine hits.

**Scouting the Owls:** Temple recently snapped a two-game losing streak, topping Lafayette 10-3. Henry Knabe leads the Owls with a .409 batting average, racking up 18 hits and 10 RBIs. Derek Peterson leads with 15 RBIs, collecting 16 hits and 13 runs to lead the squad. Also batting over .300, Nick Lustrino holds a .391 average, recording 12 runs, 18 hits and nine RBIs. Temple will put sophomore twin brothers Patrick and Eric Peterson on the mound in the doubleheader, with Eric Peterson holding a 2.53 ERA and a 2-0 record. He has made four appearances this year, allowing eight hits and three earned runs with nine strikeouts in 10.2 innings. His brother, Patrick, currently sits with a 4.80 ERA and a 0-2 record, and leads the team with 15 strikeouts. He has appeared and started in three games, allowing 14 hits and eight earned runs.

**Scouting the Hawks:** The Hawks are currently on a four-game win streak after taking down Central Connecticut, Iona and Villanova, and will play against Marist and

Wagner before taking on the Lions. Anthony Cirillo, Mike Huha and Brian O'Keefe are currently all batting above .300, holding .341, .327 and .317 averages, respectively. The trio has combined for 28 runs, 51 hits and 19 RBIs. SJU will put Daniel Thorpe on the mound, who currently holds a 2.86 ERA and a 1-2 record. The junior has fired 22. Innings this season, allowing 24 hits and seven earned runs, while retiring 22 batters.

## Saturday's Starter (Game 1): RHP #19 Steven Hill (1-3, 4.44)

Sr. • RHP • Colleyville, Texas • Colleyville Heritage

**AS A JUNIOR IN 2012:** Appeared in 15 games, starting each with nine Big Ten appearances... Led the team in innings pitched with 100.2... Fourth best ERA on the team with a 3.84... Tied eighth in the Big Ten for allowing just one triple all season... Made season debut against Cincinnati on Feb. 19 where he threw six innings with five strikeouts and three earned runs... Recorded first win at Purdue (April 1) with three strikeouts and three earned runs in 6.2 innings... Pitched first complete game on April 8 against Canisius, striking out eight with just seven hits and three earned runs for the win... Second consecutive and third overall win came against Michigan (April 15) with four strikeouts and three earned runs, while walking one... Had the game of his career against Iowa where he threw a no-hitter, walking one and striking out three... Hill's no-hitter was the first Penn State no-hitter since 1995, earning Big Ten Pitcher of the Week and NCBWA National Co-Pitcher of the Week honors on April 23... Final win of the season came against Minnesota on May 5... Struck out seven while only walking one and held the Gophers without an earned run... Struck out three in the final game of the season against Nebraska (May 24)... Had ten starts this season of pitching at least six innings while giving up no more than three earned runs.

**AS A SOPHOMORE IN 2011:** Pieced together a breakout sophomore campaign, earning second-team All-Big Ten honors while receiving the Charles Medlar Award as Penn State's top pitcher ... Anchored the starting rotation throughout the year, starting 15 games while leading all conference pitchers with a 2.57 ERA ... Fired 101.2 innings, which led the squad and ranked second in the Big Ten ... Tossed at least six innings in 12 starts, including a league-high four complete games ... Opened the year with a season-high eight strikeouts while scattering five hits over 7.2 innings of work against West Virginia during the BIG EAST / Big Ten Challenge on February 19 ... Limited NC State to six hits in 6.2 innings of work while posting five strikeouts on March 5 ... Tossed his first complete game of the season and earned the victory after striking out five while allowing just one unearned run during the second game of a doubleheader against Norfolk State on March 19 ... Continued his hot streak with 7.1 innings of work against No. 26 Wichita State, which earned him his second straight victory ... Picked up another win after surrendering just five hits and two runs while striking out seven during a complete game effort against Le Moyne on March 26 ... Tossed his first shutout of the season after blanking Northwestern during a 12-0 victory in Evanston ... Limited the Wildcats to seven hits while striking out two without allowing a walk ... Fired at least six innings in each of his next three starts, highlighted by an eight-inning effort against Michigan State on April 29 ... Named the Big Ten Co-Pitcher of the Week for his performance against Minnesota on May 13 ... Scattered just four hits and struck out six without surrendering a walk while firing his second shutout of the season against the Golden Gophers ... Wrapped up the regular season with seven shutout innings against Michigan on May 19 to earn his sixth victory of the year ... Surrendered just 12 walks during the season and ranked 17th in the nation with a 1.06 walks-per-nine-innings rate ... Finished the year with a 2.08 ERA in conference action, which was the lowest in the league.

**AS A FRESHMAN IN 2010:** Appeared in 21 games with eight starts while throwing 68 innings (second on the squad) ... 43 strikeouts were third-best ... Finished the season with sensational start vs. Michigan (5/21), tying a career-high seven innings, allowing only three runs. The Lions went on to a thrilling 6-5 walk-off win in the ninth ... Was the tough-luck loser at Minnesota (5/15), bouncing back from a tough first inning to go 5.2, allowing only four runs with five strikeouts in the Metrodome ... Earned first-career save as part of win over No. 24 Pitt (4/13), throwing 1.1 scoreless innings with two strikeouts ... Picked up second win of the season, coming into a jam against Columbia (3/20) while tossing 1.2 sparkling innings ... Second strong start in as many outings, tossing six innings while only allowing two runs with three strikeouts at Texas State (3/14) ... Impressed in first career outings, tossing 5.2 innings of one-run ball in the Big Ten/BIG EAST Challenge ... Pitched three innings against Notre Dame (2/28), allowing one run while striking out six. Got out of a bases loaded one-out jam in the ninth by striking out consecutive hitters to force extra innings ... Retired all eight batters he faced in the season-opener against Cincinnati (2/26) to earn the win. Came in with runners on the corners and only one out, proceeding to strike out the first batter on three hits while retiring the next hitter as well.
