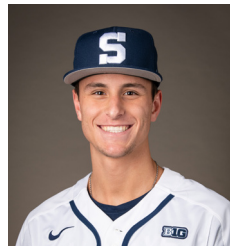

- The Nittany Lions took the middle game of the series against the Terrapins last season.
- Penn State looks for a strong finish to the season after falling 11-3 against Pitt on Tuesday night at PNC Park.
- Entering the series against Maryland, Penn State has played five games against opponents ranked in the D1Baseball Top 25, including a win at No. 22 Miami.
- On Saturday, Penn State will honor 10 seniors: Thomas Bramley, Carson Ertter, Brenden Franks, Ben Kailher, Steven Miller, Jordan Morales, Ryan Partridge, Johnny Piacentino, Blaise Scalfani and Kellan Tulio.
- Bramley and Partridge earned Academic All-District honors on Tuesday.
- Tayven Kelley has five triples this season, one shy of the Penn State record held by Kevin Billotte (6).
- Kyle Hannon has collected 26 steals, sitting one behind the program season record held by Michael Campo (27, 2000).

Harry Named To Brooks Wallace Award Watch List

- Junior shortstop Jay Harry was named to the Brooks Wallace Award watch list on Tuesday, April 18.
- The award honors the nation's top shortstop.
- Harry has started all 47 games this season and is batting .289. He leads the team with 55 hits and 13 doubles, while collecting a triple, six homers, 33 RBI and 43 runs. He has also drawn 19 walks and stolen five bases.
- The New Jersey native owns 16 multi-hit games this season, including five three-hit games, while recording 12 multi-run games and eight multi-RBI games.
- He started the 2023 campaign with two hits, including a double, and three RBI in a win over No. 22 Miami. He also had three hits, including a double, at No. 14 North Carolina.
- He launched two homers, including a walk-off two-run shot, against Brown on March 11 and added two hits and three RBI against Georgetown.
- Harry tallied three hits, including a double, three runs and an RBI in a win over Pitt and launched a clutch solo homer against West Virginia before tallying three hits, three runs and a solo homer against Ohio State.
- In his Penn State career, Harry has started 142 games, all as the primary shortstop.
- He owns 164 career hits, including 33 doubles and 12 homers, 77 RBI and 105 runs.

Nittany Lions Chasing Records

- Entering the final series of the season, several Nittany Lions are pursuing Penn State season records or a spot among a season Top 10.
- As a team, Penn State is challenging the program's season triples record. Penn State has posted 16 triples, three away from the program record (19, 2022).
- Kyle Hannon has 26 steals this season, good for second at PSU, and sits just one steal away from the PSU record held by Michael Campo (27, 2000). Hannon's 33 career steals are two shy of eighth all-time at Penn State.
- Tayven Kelley has five triples this season, tied for second at PSU, just one shy of the PSU record set by Kevin Billotte (6, 1995). Kelley also has 11 career triples, tied fifth all-time at Penn State.
- Thomas Bramley owns 39 walks this season, tied for third in a season at Penn State. He is seven walks shy of second place and eight walks away from the PSU season record.

Transfers Provide Spark

- The Nittany Lions welcomed four transfers to the program ahead of the 2023 season and all four have had strong starts to the year.
- Joining Daniel Ouderkirk, a West Virginia transfer, are grad students Thomas Bramley (Mount St. Mary's) and Grant Norris (Duke) and freshman Bobby Marsh (Florida Atlantic).
- Ouderkirk has tallied 57 strikeouts in 39.2 innings and has multiple strikeouts in 18 different innings this season.
- Ouderkirk recorded at least 10 strikeouts in three straight starts: 11 vs. Northern Illinois, 11 vs. Dartmouth and 10 vs. Brown. He became the first Nittany Lion with three straight starts of 10+ strikeouts since at least 2004.
- Fellow grad student Thomas Bramley has started all 47 games, splitting time between catcher, outfield and designated hitter. Bramley is batting .318 with 55 hits, including 10 doubles, a triple and four homers, including a grand slam at Purdue, and has drawn a team-high 39 walks. In the third game against Purdue, snapped a 36-game reached base streak.
- Bramley has 18 multi-hit games and six multi-RBI games.
- He ranks fifth in the Big Ten in walks (39) and leads PSU in on-base percentage (.447).
- Norris has started 38 games at third base after transferring from Duke and is batting .288 with seven homers and leads the team with 40 RBI.
- Freshman Bobby Marsh, a Bellefonte native and transfer from Florida Atlantic, has played in 41 games (35 starts). He owns 11 doubles, six homers and 31 RBI.
- Marsh launched a solo homer in game two at Purdue and drove in the go-ahead run with a two-run double against Youngstown State. He hit a solo homer at West Virginia.
- In four games against Youngstown State and Ohio State, recorded 11 RBI.
- On the season, Marsh is batting .303 overall and .274 in Big Ten play.
- Travis Luensmann, a 2022 transfer, is tied fourth in the Big Ten with six wins and sits fourth in the league with a 3.94 ERA.

Hannon Emerges As Power, Speed Threat

- Kyle Hannon leads the team in runs (48) and steals (26), while tying the team lead with seven homers.
- Hannon is challenging to become Penn State’s first player with 10+ homers and 10+ steals in a season since Sean Deegan (12 HR, 15 SB). His 26 steals are already second in a season at PSU. Hannon needs just two steals to tie the season record held by Michael Campo (27, 1999). Hannon has six games this season with multiple steals.
- Hannon sits second in the Big Ten in steals per game (0.57), good for 35th in the nation, and total steals (26), sitting 29th in the country.
- Hannon is one of 14 Division I players with 7+ homers and 26+ steals this season.

Balanced Bats

- The Nittany Lions currently rank 26th in triples per game (0.34) and 31st in total triples (16).
- Johnny Piacentino leads the Nittany Lions with a .324 average to go with 46 hits, 22 RBI and 29 runs.
- Piacentino is hitting .328 in conference play with six extra-base hits and 10 RBI.
- Thomas Bramley is batting .318 with 55 hits, 39 walks, good for fifth in the Big Ten in walks, and a .447 on-base percentage, leading PSU, while Jay Harry is tied with Bramley for the team-lead with 55 hits to go with 43 runs and a .289 average. Grant Norris holds the team RBI lead (40) and owns 19 extra-base hits. Bobby Marsh (.303) is hitting above .300. Marsh has 17 extra-base hits and 31 RBI.
- Tayven Kelley leads PSU with five triples this season and has 11 for his career, tied for fifth all-time at Penn State.
- Kelley’s five triples rank 22nd in the country and second in the Big Ten.
- Against Binghamton, Anthony Steele went two-for-four with a homer, four RBI and a stolen base before taking the mound and striking out two. He also had three strikeouts and an RBI single against Delaware State.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Maryland

- Maryland is led by head coach Rob Vaughn in his sixth season. Vaughn has led the Terrapins to 176 wins and a .607 winning percentage.
- The Terrapins are 35-18 overall and 15-6 in Big Ten play after taking two of three in a series against Minnesota.
- Maryland is ranked 20th in the D1Baseball poll.
- As a team, Maryland leads the country in walks (345), while ranking second in home runs (117), on-base percentage (.437) and total runs (515), third in runs per game (9.7) and slugging percentage (.577), seventh in hits (587) and doubles (123), and 15th in batting average (.313).
- Luke Shliger leads the country in runs (83) and ranks second in walks (57) and 14th in on-base percentage (.518).
- Nick Lorusso paces the nation in RBI (90) and ranks 12th in the nation in hits (83) and homers (21).
- Matt Shaw ranks fifth in the country in homers (23), third in runs (72) and 25th in RBI (64).
- On the mound, Maryland has a 6.06 ERA as a staff, ranking 12th in the Big Ten.
- Jason Savacool leads the rotation with a 4.44 ERA in 13 starts and has 74 strikeouts in 77 innings.

Against The Terrapins

- Penn State has met Maryland in 39 previous games.
- The Terrapins lead the series, 21-18.
- Last season in College Park, Penn State took the middle game of the series, 6-4 in 10 innings.
- Tayven Kelley had a go-ahead pinch-hit, two-run double in the 10th.
- Travis Luensmann got the win in relief, allowing one run in the final three innings.

Head Coach

The 2023 baseball season is Rob Cooper's 10th as head coach of the Nittany Lion baseball program. Cooper was selected as the 14th head baseball coach in Penn State history on August 9, 2013. Not shy about stating his ultimate goal of returning Penn State to Omaha in June, the Lions have made significant strides under his leadership.

Under his tutelage, 12 players have been drafted and 13 total have signed with MLB teams in the last five seasons with a full draft. However, his strong belief in the first part of the term "student-athlete" is perhaps the top reason he has proven to be an excellent fit at Penn State. Even with state-of-the-art facilities, the chance to take on elite competition and a program history that includes five trips to the College World Series, Cooper cites the value of a Penn State degree as one of the top reasons to play baseball at Penn State.

In 2022, Cooper led the Nittany Lions to their first Big Ten Tournament appearance since 2012. Penn State finished the season with a 26-29 record, including an 11-13 mark in the Big Ten. The Nittany Lions earned the No. 6 seed in the Big Ten Tournament, picking up a 5-2 win over No. 3 seed Iowa to open the tournament.

The Nittany Lions won Big Ten series against Purdue, Minnesota and Michigan State, sweeping the Spartans. Penn State also earned a win in each series against Rutgers, No. 23 Maryland, Northwestern and Ohio State.

In non-conference action, the Nittany Lions' wins included an 8-4 win at West Virginia and a 19-6 win over Pitt in PNC Park, highlighted by a 14-run top of the ninth.

Penn State had two All-Big Ten selections, led by first team selection Matt Wood. The junior catcher won the Big Ten batting average title in the regular season (.395) and led the Nittany Lions in average (.379), hits (75), runs (55), homers (12), RBI (53), total bases (132), slugging percentage (.667), on-base percentage (.480) and walks (36). Wood's incredible season included a 26-game hit streak and a 36-game reached-base streak. Wood was PSU's first All-Big Ten first-team selection since Jordan Steranka in 2012) and Penn State's 16th first team selection in program history and the third catcher to earn first team honors.

Wood finished the season ranking fourth at PSU in runs (55), sixth in total bases (132), tied seventh in walks (36), tied eighth in hits (75) and RBI (53) and ninth in homers (12) and slugging percentage (.667).

Wood was selected in the fourth round (132nd overall) by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 2022 MLB Draft. Wood is the highest-selected position player in program history. The previous highest was catcher Ben Heath (fifth round, 153rd overall) by the Houston Astros.

In 24 Big Ten regular season games, Penn State collected 83 extra-base hits, including 43 doubles, 11 triples and 29 homers. Penn State set a program record with 19 triples in 2022, bettering the previous record of 18 in 1986, 2007 and 2010.

On the mound, the Nittany Lions' pitching staff set a program record with 503 strikeouts. Penn State tallied 21 games with 10+ strikeouts and 16 games allowing three or less earned runs. Six pitchers recorded at least 40 strikeouts. In 49 of 55 games, Penn State's starting pitcher was a Pennsylvania native.

In the classroom, Wood was a third-team CoSIDA Academic All-American.

The Nittany Lions finished the 2021 season with an 18-24 record, playing against exclusively Big Ten opponents. The wins included a 3-2 victory over No. 18 Michigan on March 26 and a series sweep over Michigan State in which Penn State out-scored the Spartans, 39-13. The Nittany Lions also won two series against Rutgers. Penn State scored 10 or more runs in six games, Penn State's most against Big Ten opponents since 2008 (8) and the most in a

season since 2016.

Penn State had four players drafted from the 2021 squad. Conor Larkin was selected in the ninth round (272nd overall) by the Toronto Blue Jays. Justin Williams was a 17th round selection (508th overall) by the Houston Astros and Kyle Virbitsky followed, being selected 518th overall by the Oakland A's. Bailey Dees was drafted in the 18th round (543rd overall) by the New York Yankees. All three members of the starting rotation were drafted, making Penn State one of only four schools to accomplish that in 2021.

Penn State baseball's trip to Cuba prior to the 2016 season is perhaps the best example of Cooper's commitment to the first part of the "student-athlete" term. The Nittany Lions attended academic lectures and toured Havana, becoming the first NCAA Division I team to compete against a Cuban National Series team, the first U.S. team at any level to defeat a Cuban National Series team, the first U.S. baseball team to play in Cuba since restoration of diplomatic ties with Cuba, the second NCAA team to play in Cuba since restoration of diplomatic ties (Coastal Carolina men's basketball, August 2015) and the fifth NCAA Division I baseball team to compete in post-revolutionary Cuba. The harmony between academics and athletics was on full display, as multiple Penn State professors and a group of journalism students also joined the travel party.

The rare, once-in-a-lifetime experience helped bring a young Penn State team together, and the Lions went on to earn their first winning record (overall and in conference) since 2012. The starting lineup included at least three freshmen in all but six games and five to six freshmen in 19 games, and took on nine eventual NCAA tournament teams, including a three-game series at home against College World Series participant TCU. The Lions' 28 wins were a 10-win improvement over the previous season, and its 12 Big Ten wins doubled the 2015 total. Haley and Anderson were the first drafted out of Penn State since 2012, and Anderson and senior outfielder Greg Guers became the program's first All-Big Ten picks also since 2012. Pitcher Justin Hagenman became Penn State's first Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American since 1997.

Shortly after Cooper accepted the PSU head coaching position in 2014, the California native traveled to Taichung, Taiwan to serve as the head coach of USA Baseball's 18U National Team at the IBAF U18 World Cup. Cooper steered Team USA to an 8-1 record in World Cup play, including seven consecutive victories to win the gold medal.

Not long after the triumph in Taiwan, Cooper received one of the highest honors bestowed in the profession, as he was announced as the Rod Dedeaux USA Baseball Coach of the Year. With the honor, Cooper became just the 16th individual in the award's history to receive the accolade, joining the likes of Scott Brosius, Davey Johnson and Tommy Lasorda.

Cooper was also a member of the coaching staff for the 2007 and 2009 USA College National teams. The 2007 team earned a silver medal at the Pan Am Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Fourteen of the 20 players on the 2007 team reached the Major Leagues, including 2013 All-Star Pedro Alvarez. Fourteen of the 22 members of the 2009 team also reached the Major Leagues, including three-time All-Star Gerrit Cole.

Cooper brought an accomplished resume to Penn State that included three NCAA Tournament appearances as a head coach at Wright State and five more at various stops as an assistant coach, including two trips to the College World Series with Miami (Florida). Cooper was twice named the Horizon League Coach of the Year and guided Wright State to three league tournament championships and two regular-season championships after the team suffered six losing seasons in the seven years before his arrival.

Cooper began his coaching career at national power Miami, spending two seasons (1994-95) as a student/graduate assistant on the Hurricanes' staff. While at Miami, Cooper helped the Hurricanes to College World Series berths in 1994 and 1995. Cooper spent the 1996 season as an assistant and team academic coordinator at Wake Forest, then moved on to Tulane for the next two seasons, serving as the Green Wave's hitting coach. In 1997, the Green Wave won the Conference USA regular-season crown, and in 1998, they advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Cooper left Tulane following the 1998 season and returned to Sacramento City College, where he starred in the early 1990's before lettering at Miami in 1993.

Along with his college coaching experience, Cooper also was an associate scout for the Los Angeles Dodgers from 1990-92 and has been selected to four coaching stints with USA Baseball in 2000, 2007, 2009 and 2013.

Cooper earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Miami in 1994 and a master's in sports sciences/administration from Miami in 1996. He is married to his wife, Maureen, and has two sons, Jake and Tyson, who are both current members of the Penn State baseball team.
