

PENN STATE HEADS TO NU FOR REGULAR SEASON FINALE

The Penn State men's soccer team caps off its 2016 regular season Sunday, Oct. 30 when it travels to Evanston, Ill. for only its sixth road contest of the season. The Nittany Lions and the Wildcats will square off a 1 p.m. ET at Lanny and Sharon Martin Stadium. The Blue and White will be looking for its first road win of the season as it brings a 0-4-1 away record into the contest.

HOW TO WATCH

For fans who cannot make it out to Lanny and Sharon Martin Stadium on Sunday afternoon, the match will be streamed on BTN Plus starting at 1 p.m. ET. Live stats are also available on NUSports.com.

SERIES HISTORY WITH THE WILDCATS

Penn State holds the 24-7-3 all-time series lead over Northwestern, but in the past five seasons the Wildcats have been closing the gap with three wins over the Nittany Lions. NU has picked up the victory in each of the last two seasons over PSU with a 2-1 victory in both 2014 and 2015. The Blue and White will be looking for its first win over the Wildcats since the 2013 season when it earned a 2-1 double overtime victory. Penn State is 1-1-1 in Evanston, Ill. with head coach **Bob Warming** at the helm and will hope to earn its first victory at Lanny and Sharan Martin Stadium since 2012.

SCOUTING NORTHWESTERN

The Wildcats have earned four wins in the 2016 season, two of which have come in Big Ten Conference play, while suffering 10 losses. NU came back from a seven-game skid in which it was unable to pick up a win and secured just one tie when it defeated Michigan 2-1 in double overtime in Evanston.

Northwestern is averaging only 8.9 shots per match and scoring less than a goal per match as it has been shut out in six matches this season. Elo Ozumba and Brandon Medina are the leading goal scorers for the Wildcats with three goals each for seven total points as each has notched one assist as well. Also scoring multiple goals for NU are Mike Roberge and Jeffrey Hopson, who have each netted two goals. The goal production has been spread out for Northwestern as seven players have scored at least one for the Wildcats in 2016, while 26 players have seen action on the pitch.

In net, Francisco Tomasino has seen the majority of the time with 13 starts but Robby White and Braden Thuraisingham have also played over 100 minutes in goal this season. Tomasino has given up 23 goals and made 55 saves to lead the NU keepers, while White made six saves and didnt give up a goal in his 113 minutes of action.

WHERE CAN PENN STATE FINISH IN THE B1G?

Heading into the final regular season match, it is time to look and see what seed Penn State can finish as going into the Big Ten Tournament.

If the Nittany Lions defeat Northwestern there are 18 different scenarios that would allow Penn State to finish second in the conference standings and nine that would have it finish third. However, if both the Blue and White and Michigan State win, Penn State would finish third overall.

If PSU falls to the Wildcats there are nine different scenarios that would see the Nittany Lions finish third, 12 that would have them finish fourth and six that would have them in a tie for fourth.

Finally, if Penn State and Northwestern end in a draw, there are 24 different scenarios that would have the Blue and White tie for third and three that would result in a fourth-place finish.

PENN STATE CONTINUES FIVE-MATCH UNBEATEN STREAK

The Nittany Lions used its final home stretch to leg out a five-match unbeaten streak in which it earned four wins and one tie. The five matches featured three double overtime games, including two against ranked opponents as Penn State came away with a win over then-No. 19 Michigan State and tied then-No. 22 Akron in that stretch. The Blue and White capped off the home season with a 1-0 win over Wright State to bring its home record to 8-2-1 in the 2016 campaign.

Entering his seventh season as Penn State's 11th coach in its storied history, Bob Warming has made his impact known in his first five years. Twice named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2012 and 2013 by leading the Nittany Lions to back-to-back Big Ten titles, Warming has added a pair of trips to the NCAA Sweet 16 [2010, 2013], and led the Lions to three straight postseason appearances.

Warming led the Nittany Lions to a 7-8-3 overall record and a 2-4-2 Big Ten Conference record in the 2015 campaign. The Blue and White earned an overtime victory over Michigan State in the Big Ten Tournament play in match before falling to eventual Big Ten Champion Ohio State in the quarterfinals in overtime. Junior Connor Maloney paced Penn State, starting 17 matches with a team leading 17 points that included seven goals and two assists en route to his second First Team All-Big Ten honor. Freshman Austin Maloney also made his mark on the program, earning All-Freshman team honors after starting 14 games with two assists and a .800 shots on goal percentage. Of its seven wins in 2016, six of them came by way of the shutout with senior goalkeeper Matt Bersano tallying five and junior Evan Finney earning one.

2014 was a banner year for Warming and his Nittany Lions as they won 13 matches for the second straight year, going 13-6-1 overall and 5-3 in the Big Ten. They also recorded their 800th win in program history over Penn (Sept. 24), with a 6-2 win at Jeffrey Field. The team got out to a sizzling 10-0-1 start, it's best ever and won seven straight matches for the first time since 2005.

2016 NOTES AND HEADLINES

JEFFREY FIELD DOMINANCE

Penn State has enjoyed success at Jeffrey Field with over 300 victories at the famed field. Impressively, the Nittany Lions have never posted a losing season at Jeffrey Field in 43 years, going 328-85-36 all-time for a winning percentage of .771. This season, PSU finished 8-2-1 at the Jeff and over the past four seasons the Nittany Lions are 34-10-5 en route to a pair of Big Ten titles in 2012 and 2013. In the 43-year history of the stadium, Jeffrey Field has welcomed over 540,000 fans through its gates.

REEDY NETS GAME-WINNER WITH FIRST COLLEGIATE GOAL

Freshman **Pierre Reedy** has found ways to add points to his stat line at the right time. The freshman midfielder had his first two collegiate points against Rutgers having the assists on two goals before scoring his first collegiate goal against Wright State. Reedy gathered a pass from **Connor Maloney** 19-yards out and ripped a shot into the bottom left half of the net in the eighth minute of the match. The goal would prove to be the game-winner as **Evan Finney** and the Penn State backline pitched its fifth shutout of the season.

FINNEY RANKED AMONGST NATIONS BEST

Redshirt-junior **Evan Finney** finds himself amongst the elite in the nation as he ranks 21st with a .826 save percentage and 33rd with a 0.70 goals against average. Furthermore, Finney leads the Big Ten Conference in save percentage, ranks third in shutouts per game (0.38), fourth in saves per game (3.30) and goals against average and ties for sixth with three shutouts on the season.

NITTANY LIONS IN OVERTIME PERIODS

Penn State played its third-straight double overtime match against Rutgers, marking the first time since the 2013 season that they have played three-straight double overtime matches. Furthermore, the Blue and White played its eighth overtime match of 2016, which ties the most since the 2005 campaign and is the third-highest in program history. Penn State holds a 4-2-2 overall record in overtime periods, tying with then-No. 1 Stanford and No. 22 Akron, while falling to then-No. 4 Maryland and UC Berkeley.

PENN STATE EARNS B1G WIN OVER RUTGERS

The Blue and White continues its dominance at Jeffrey Field, earning its seventh victory of the season with a 3-2 double overtime win over Rutgers. Junior **Aymar Sigue** notched his second game-winner of the season for the Nittany Lions on his third goal of the season with two minutes remaining in the second overtime period. Freshman **Frankie De La Camara** netted his first collegiate goal donning the Blue and White, while freshman **Pierre Reedy** notched his first collegiate points with two assists in the match. Finally, senior **Connor Maloney** scored his team-leading seventh goal of the season in the second half of the match.

MALONEY NETS TWO AGAINST NO. 22 AKRON

Senior **Connor Maloney** became the third Penn State men's soccer player to tally a multi-goal match when he found the back of the net on two occasions against No. 22 Akron. Maloney knotted the score at 1-1 in the 66th-minute before giving Penn State the go-ahead goal in the 74th-minute. However, Akron came back to tie the score late in the match as Penn State would play to a 2-2 double overtime draw with the Zips.

Maloney joins the company of senior **Mason Klerks**, who scored two goals against Ohio State, and sophomore **Dayonn Harris**, who netted two against then-No. 4 Maryland.

PENN STATE TALLIES FIFTH MULTI-SCORING MATCH

In a game that typically ends with a 1-0 result, Penn State men's soccer has had five multi-goal matches in the 2016 campaign after Tuesday night's 2-2 tie with No. 22 Akron. The Nittany Lions had three-straight multi-goal games with a 4-2 win over Ohio State, a 3-2 overtime loss to then-No. 4 Maryland and a 2-1 double overtime win over Wisconsin. Following the three big scoring matches, the Blue and White suffered a scoring drought before finding two-straight one-goal wins and a 2-2 tie with Akron.

SAGEL HEADER LIFTS PENN STATE TO VICTORY

With less than two minutes left before the double overtime match with the No. 19 Spartans ended in a draw, senior **Robby Sagel** headed in the golden goal off a free kick from **Riley Grant**. The senior defender, who was in on the free kick, found an opening in the box and buried the ball into the lower right corner of the net to secure Penn State's first victory over a ranked opponent this year and third Big Ten Conference win of the season.

SAGEL KEY IN BEATING NATIONALLY-RANKED OPPONENTS

The win over No. 19 Michigan State marked the first time the Nittany Lions have defeated a top 20 opponent since Sept.13, 2015 when they beat then-No. 10 Indiana. Senior **Robby Sagel** netted the lone goal of the night in the double overtime win over the Spartans. Furthermore, Sagel found the game-winner against Indiana off a corner kick. The two goals are Sagel's only goals donning the Blue and White, having both come against nationally-ranked contenders.

NITTANY LION DEFENSE KEEPS PITT TO ONE SHOT

The Penn State defense gave up just one shot to the Panthers in its 1-0 victory Tuesday, Oct. 11. The one shot marked the least amount of shots a **Bob Warming** led team has given up in his six and a half seasons at the helm of the Nittany Lion program. Prior to Tuesday's match with Pittsburgh, Penn State's match low under Warming was two shots which it gave up against Stetson, Sept. 25, 2012 and Buffalo, Sept. 3, 2010.


