- The teams will meet for the fourth time.
- The Lady Lions opened the 2021-22 campaign with an 85-66 victory over LIU on Tuesday.
 - Penn State led by double-digits for the entire second half.
- Sophomore forward Ali Brigham had an impressive Penn State debut with 20 points, on 8-of-13 from the field and four-of-four from the free-throw line, nine rebounds and three blocks. Junior guard Makenna Marisa filled up the box score with 19 points, including three triples, six
- Junior guard Makenna Marisa filled up the box score with 19 points, including three triples, six rebounds and six assists.
- Graduate student guard Kelly Jekot contributed 11 points, including three three-pointers.
- Penn State assisted on 20 of its 30 made field goals, led by Marisa's six dimes and Maddie Burke's four.
 - The Lady Lions shot 45.5 percent from the field, including 50 percent in the second half.
 - Penn State forced 21 turnovers by LIU and collected 13 steals with five players recording at least two steals.
 - Penn State will look for its 33rd 2-0 start in program history.

Impressive Debut

- Sophomore forward Ali Brigham made a big impact in her first game as a Lady Lion, vs. LIU, after transferring from George Washington.
- Brigham finished the game with 20 points, shooting 8-of-13 from the field and hit all four free-throw attempts.
- She also pulled down nine rebounds and blocked three shots.
- Brigham posted 14 points in the first half.

Marisa Doing It All

- Junior guard Makenna Marisa filled up the box score in the season opener vs. LIU.
- Marisa scored 19 points, including three three-pointers.
- She also contributed six rebounds, tying for second on the team, and led PSU with six assists.

Stingy Defense

- The Lady Lions had a solid night on the defensive end against the Sharks.
- Penn State held LIU to 25-of-65 shooting (38.5 percent) from the floor and 7-of-18 (38.9 percent) from three. LIU shot just 26.7 percent in the first quarter and 25 percent in the fourth quarter.
- The Lady Lions also forced 21 turnovers and collected 13 steals.
- Anna Camden had three steals as one of five Lady Lions with at least two steals.

 Penn State saw significant improvement in a number of statistical categories from the 2019-20 season to the 2020-21 season.

All-Big Ten Returners

- Sophomore Maddie Burke returns after earning Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year and Big Ten All-Freshman team honors in 2020-21.
- Burke reached 20 points in four games, including a career-best 24 points vs. Maryland.
- Burke drilled at least three three-pointers in 11 games and hit five or more treys in six games.
- Burke ranked fifth among Division I freshmen with 58 three-pointers.
- Junior Makenna Marisa also returns after being named honorable mention All-Big Ten.
- Marisa averaged 13.4 points per game, including 15 double-figure scoring efforts and six 20-point games.
- Marisa finished fifth in the Big Ten and 37th nationally with 5.0 assists per game.

Returning Scorers

- Penn State returns eight of its top nine scorers from the 2020-21 season.
- Senior Kelly Jekot paced the Lady Lions, averaging 15.9 points per game through nine games, before suffering a season-ending injury. Jekot reached double-figures in all nine games and had 20+ points in three contests.
- Marisa averaged 13.4 points per game, tallying 15 games with double-digit points and six with 20 points.
- Senior Niya Beverley averaged 9.2 points per contest in 2020-21 with nine double-figure efforts and two 20-point games.
- Sophomore Maddie Burke tallied 8.9 points per game and led the Nittany Lions with 58 three-pointers. She had four 20-point games and eight double-figure efforts.
- Junior Anna Camden averaged 7.8 points with 13 double-digit games and fellow junior Shay Hagans averaged 7.0 points with 11 double-figure efforts.

Non-Conference Slate

- Penn State opened its 11-game non-conference slate against LIU.
- The Lady Lions' first three contests will be played at the Bryce Jordan Center against LIU (11/9), Rider (11/11) and Delaware State (11/16).
- Penn State's non-con continues at Clemson on Sunday, November 21. The Tigers reached the 2021 WNIT Second Round.
- The Lady Lions then travel to the Gulf Coast Showcase in Florida. Penn State will open the tournament against St. John's on November 26.
- On November 27, Penn State will face either Iowa State or Charlotte in the Gulf Coast Showcase. Iowa State was a 2021 NCAA Tournament team, while Charlotte was a 2021 WNIT participant.
- Penn State takes on Boston College in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge on Thursday, December 2.
- The non-conference schedule closes out with home games against Youngstown State (12/12) and Towson (12/22) and a road matchup at Duquesne (12/18).

Strength of the Big Ten

- The Preseason AP Poll features five Big Ten teams: No. 4 Maryland, No. 8 Indiana, No. 9 Iowa, No. 11 Michigan and No. 17 Ohio State.
- Penn State opens Big Ten play at Indiana on December 6.
- The Lady Lions played 10 ranked opponents in 2020-21, the most among Big Ten schools, and earned a 69-67 win over No. 15 Ohio State on February 24, 2021.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Rider

- Rider is led by head coach Lynn Milligan, in her 15th year at the helm.
- Milligan is 178-247 in her time at Rider and led the Broncs to their first ever MAAC Regular Season Championship in 2019-20.
- Rider had an 8-15 record last season.
- Rider returns five players who averaged at least 6.7 points per game last season.
- Sophomore guard Makayla Firebaugh led the Broncs with 11.0 points per game in 2020-21.
- Sophomore forward Raphaela Toussaint (7.5 ppg) and junior guard Maya Hyacienth (7.3) also return.
- Rider led the MAAC last season in three-point field goals made (145) and free-throw percentage (72.2).
- The Broncs allowed 59.3 points per game last season and led their conference in blocked shots per game (4.8).
- In their exhibition win over The College of New Jersey, the Broncs were paced by Toussaint's 20 points and 12 rebounds. Firebaugh contributed 13 points, while Lenaejha Evans had 15 off the bench.

Against The Broncs

- Penn State will meet Rider for the fourth time between the programs. The Lady Lions lead the all-time series, 2-1.
- The Lady Lions fell 78-70 in 2019. Makenna Marisa tallied 13 points in that contest.

Run It Back

- Penn State got a boost in its veteran leadership when senior guard Niya Beverley and graduate student guard Kelly Jekot decided to return for another season.
- Beverley, who transferred from Wisconsin before the 2020-21 campaign, led the Big Ten and ranked second in the nation with a 3.88 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- She tallied nine double-figure games and two 20-point efforts last season.
- Jekot played in nine games as a Nittany Lion before suffering a season-ending injury.
- She was the team's leading scorer, averaging 15.9 points per game, and led the team in minutes per game, 34.6, while holding second on the squad with 6.8 rebounds per game.
- Jekot scored double figures in all nine games she played and tallied double-doubles in three contests.

Experienced Backcourt

- Penn State welcomes back seven guards from the 2020-21 squad.
- Graduate student Kelly Jekot led the Lady Lions in scoring through nine games before suffering an injury.
- Maddie Burke (Sixth Player of the Year) and Makenna Marisa (All-Big Ten honorable mention) earned conference recognition for their efforts in 2020-21.
- Junior Shay Hagans has made 32 starts in a Penn State uniform and tallied eight doublefigure scoring games last season.
- Sophomore Tova Sabel played in 24 games last season and went for 10+ points in four games.
- Fellow sophomore Nyam Thornton saw action in 10 games (two starts), averaging 2.7 points and 2.3 rebounds per game.
- The Lady Lion backcourt adds sophomore transfer Alli Campbell and benefits from the return of Leilani Kapinus, who missed the 2020-21 campaign with an injury.

New Faces

- Penn State added four newcomers for the 2021-22 campaign, including two transfers and two freshmen.
- The Lady Lions welcomed sophomore forward Ali Brigham, who transferred from George Washington.
- As a freshman, Brigham was named Atlantic-10 All-Rookie after leading the Colonials with 11.9 points per game and a team-high 50.4 field-goal percentage. She averaged 4.3 rebounds and blocked 26 shots. Brigham reached double-figures in 10 games against A-10 opponents.
- Penn State also welcomes sophomore guard and Altoona native Alli Campbell, who transferred from Notre Dame. She saw action in six games with the Irish, averaging 12.2 minutes per game and shooting 55.6 percent from the field.
- Campbell was a 2020 Naismith National High School All-American and 2019 USA Today Pennsylvania Player of the Year at Bellwood-Antis.
- The Lady Lions added freshman forward Ymke Brouwer and freshman forward Kayla Thomas.
- Brouwer played for GC Zürich, a member of the Swiss Basketball League and was a threeyear participant in the U-16 and U-18 European Championships with the Swiss National Team.
- Thomas played three seasons at Emerge Christian Academy, where she ranked as the No. 9 post player and No. 72 overall prospect in the 2021 class by Girls Basketball Report.
- Penn State also will see the debut of Leilani Kapinus, who missed the 2020-21 season with an injury. She was a two-time All-State honoree at James Madison Memorial High School in Wisconsin.
- Kapinus was ranked the No. 8 guard and No. 30 overall player in the 2020 class by ESPN.

HEAD COACH Carolyn Kieger

Second Season • Marquette '06 Overall Career Record: 116-102 Penn State Record: 17-38

Penn State and Vice President of Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the selection of Carolyn Kieger as the sixth head coach of the women's basketball program on April 3, 2019. Kieger (pronounced KEY-grr), a 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, enters her third season at the helm for the 2021-22 season.

In Kieger's second season in Happy Valley, she mentored three Nittany Lions to All-Big Ten honors. Freshman Maddie Burke was the consensus pick for the Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year and the All-Freshman team by the coaches and media. Burke was a unanimous selection All-Freshman team by the coaches and was Penn State's first selection to the All-Freshman Team since 2016.

Burke became the second Penn State player to earn Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year honors in program history. Along with Burke, Johnasia Cash earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors by the media and Honorable Mention All-Big Ten honors by the conference coaches. Makenna Marisa earned Honorable Mention All-Big Ten honors by the coaches and media.

Under Kieger's direction, the Lady Lions improved in nearly every offensive category from year one to year two. The youngest team in the Big Ten and ninth-youngest in the country in 2020-21, the Lady Lions increased their offensive output in points per game, assists per game, three-point field goal percentage, three-point field goals made per game and field goal percentage.

The Lady Lions battled 10 ranked teams, the most among Big Ten teams, during the 2020-21 season. Kieger led the Lady Lions to its first win over an AP ranked Top-15 team since 2016 with a 69-67 victory over No. 15 Ohio State on February 24.

In her first season leading the Lady Lions, Kieger coached Kamaria McDaniel to a First Team All-Big Ten selection as the conference's second-leading scorer with an average of 19.8 points per game, also a top-15 mark in the nation (13). She also developed an aggressive up-tempo offense thats speed got the Lady Lions to the charity stripe 555 times during the 2019-20 season.

Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, came to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Widely regarded as one of the nation's brightest and rising coaching stars, Kieger's first Marquette team in 2014-15 won nine games. She proceeded to lead the Golden Eagles to 14, 25, 24 and a program-record 27 victories over the next four seasons.

Kieger was named a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award after leading the Golden Eagles to one of the best seasons in program history this past season. Marquette captured its second consecutive, but first-ever outright Big East regular-season title and a posted a school-best 27-8 record. The Golden Eagles were ranked in every Associated Press poll of the season for the first time in school history.

Marquette earned its third-straight NCAA Tournament berth in 2018-19, advancing to the second round for the second consecutive year. The Golden Eagles garnered a No. 5 seed and defeated Rice before dropping a two-point decision at No. 4 seed Texas A&M in the second round. The three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances were Marquette's first since a three-year run from 1997-99.

Kieger mentored Allazia Blockton and Natisha Hiedeman to become Marquette's first Big East Players of the Year in 2017-18 and 2018-19, respectively. Kieger coached nine All-Big East selections in the last three seasons.

The 2017-18 campaign was another banner year as Kieger was named Big East Co-Coach of the Year after guiding the Golden Eagles to a program-record 15-3 conference mark and their first Big East regular season title. Kieger earned her first NCAA Tournament coaching victory with a first-round win over Dayton before falling at No. 1 seed Louisville.

Kieger coached Marquette to new heights in 2016-17 as the Golden Eagles won the Big East Tournament title for the first time in program history, while also earning a program-best No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament. She directed MU to the Big Dance for the first time since 2011. Kieger led Marquette to a 25-8 record in 2016-17, finishing with a 6-0 mark against teams ranked in the Top 25.

In her second year at the helm of the Golden Eagles, Kieger had the youngest program in NCAA Division I with eight freshmen on the roster in 2015-16, as MU improved its win total by five games. She made her collegiate head coaching debut on Nov. 15, 2014 against Green Bay and earned her first career victory on Nov. 17, 2014 when Marquette defeated Loyola-Chicago.
