Penn State Preview

The 10th-ranked Nittany Lions closed out their regular season slate with with matches at Ball State and IPFW on April 15-16. The Lions improved to 22-6 overall after a 3-0 setback to Ball State and a 3-2 triumph against IPFW. Penn State had a bye in the EIVA Quarterfinals on April 23 after winning its 27th EIVA/ECVL Championship Title on April 2. In the final weekend of regular season action for Penn State, redshirt junior Joe Sunder pounded a team-best 4.62 kills per set. Redshirt junior Edgardo Goas averaged 11.12 assists per set, while senior Dennis Del Valle registered 2.50 digs per set. Sunder and Goas were a strong presence at the net with 0.62 blocks per set each.

Penn State vs. Rutgers-Newark

Penn State owns an 81-24-1 record against the Scarlet Raiders. This will be the third meeting between the Nittany Lions and Rutgers-Newark this season. Penn State is 2-0 against the Scarlet Raiders in 2011 having defeated RN on Feb. 11, 3-1, and sweeping the Scarlet Raiders on March 26.

Scouting the Scarlet Raiders

Rutgers-Newark earned the No. 4 seed in the EIVA Tournament. Prior to taking on the Nittany Lions, the Scarlet Raiders faced Saint Francis in the EIVA Quarterfinals and came away with a 3-0 victory. Rutgers-Newark is 17-11 overall this season. The Scarlet Raiders finished EIVA play with a 4-6 record.

Penn State vs. Potential EIVA Championship Opponents

George Mason

Penn State has taken on George Mason twice this season, defeating the Patriots 3-0 both times. The Patriots are the No. 2 seed in the EIVA Tournament and defeated NYU, 3-1, to advance to the semifinals. George Mason owns a 17-10 overall record and finished with an 8-2 record in the EIVA.

Springfield

The Nittany Lions have taken on the Pride two times in 2011, defeating Springfield 3-0 on Jan. 22 and 3-1 on March 5. The Pride is 17-14 overall this season and closed out the regular season conference schedule with a 4-6 record. To reach the EIVA Semifinals, the No. 3 Pride defeated Juniata, 3-2.

Recap

Lions Grab 27th EIVA/ECVL Title

The Nittany Lions claimed their 27th EIVA/ECVL title since 1976 with a 3-0 sweep of George Mason on April 2. The Nittany Lions secured a bye for the EIVA Quarterfinals and host the EIVA Semifinals and Championship on April 28 and 30. Penn State remained undefeated in EIVA play with the win and improved its all-time EIVA record to 231-66. This was the 11th time in program history the Lions went undefeated in league play and the 12th with head coach Mark Pavlik at the helm.

Turko Picked as EIVA Player of the Week

Sophomore Nick Turko picked up EIVA Player of the Week laurels on April 4. Turko helped Penn State to a 3-0 sweep of George Mason on April 2 to close out the EIVA regular season. Turko was second on the team with eight kills on 14 errorless swings for a .571 attack percentage. He totaled 12.0 points for the match after also contributing two aces and four blocks.

Sunder Tabbed EIVA Player of the Week

Redshirt junior Joe Sunder was named the EIVA Player of the Week on March 21. Sunder led the Nittany Lions to victories against Ball State and IPFW, both of the MIVA. Against Ball State on March 18, Sunder totaled 19.5 points after pounding 17 kills on .542 hitting and tallying two aces and one block. He also notched a team-high eight digs. The following night against IPFW, Sunder hit .381 and posted 12 kills and one block. For the weekend, Sunder averaged 4.73 kills, .33 aces, 1.50 digs, .33 blocks and 5.33 points per set.

Goas Picks Up EIVA Weekly Honors

Redshirt junior Edgardo Goas was named the EIVA Player of the Week on March 14. It was his second award of the season. Goas led the Nittany Lion offense against three nationally-ranked opponents, including then No. 8 UCLA, as well as UCSB and Long Beach State, both tied at No. 5. Against the Bruins, Goas scored eight points off of six kills and three blocks. He had 49 assists, while guiding Penn State to a .234 attack percentage. Versus the Gauchos, Goas tallied another 49 assists and guided Penn State's offense to an impressive .449 attack percentage. He also contributed one kill, one ace and one block with two digs. To close out the week at Long Beach, Goas dished out 41 assists and had six kills and three blocks.

Sunder Honored as EIVA Player of the Week

Redshirt junior Joe Sunder was honored as the EIVA Player of the Week on March 7. It was Sunder's second award of the season. Sunder guided Penn State to a 3-1 victory on the road at Springfield to extend the team's winning streak to seven consecutive matches. Sunder put down a match-high 16 kills on .464 hitting. He also put up two blocks and had an ace, while contributing one assist and two digs. Sunder totaled 18 points in the match.

Comfort Earns EIVA Player of the Week Accolades

Sophomore Tom Comfort was named the EIVA Tait Player of the Week on Feb. 28. Comfort guided the Nittany Lions to two EIVA wins against Saint Francis and George Mason. Against the Red Flash, Comfort pounded 14 kills while hitting .355, and also tallied five digs and three blocks. Versus George Mason, Comfort put down 15 kills on .56 hitting. He also put up five blocks. He averaged 4.41 kills, 1.29 digs, 1.14 blocks and 4.71 points per set for the week.

Goas Impenetrable at the Net

Redshirt junior setter Edgardo Goas led the Nittany Lions to a convincing 3-0 sweep of Mount Olive on Feb. 18. During the match he guided the Nittany Lions to a .420 attack percentage, while also posting three kills and two digs. He also accounted for 5.5 of the team's 9.0 blocks, putting up four solo stuffs and three block assists. The following night, Goas finished third on the team with four total blocks helping the Nittany Lions to 13.0 team blocks.

Pavlik Reaches 400th Win

Head coach Mark Pavlik entered the 2011 season with a career-record of 390-113, winning more than 77 percent of all matches he's coached. With a 3-0 victory against Mount Olive on Feb. 18, Pavlik reached his 400th career win. He currently owns a career record of 401-116.

Comfort Named EIVA Player of the Week

Sophomore Tom Comfort was named EIVA Player of the Week on Feb. 13 after guiding the Nittany Lions to two wins against EIVA foes. Against Rutgers-Newark in a 3-1 victory on Feb. 11, Comfort scored seven points. He posted six kills and one block. The next night against Princeton, Comfort led the team with 12 kills on .500 hitting. He also tallied three aces and two digs. For the weekend, Comfort averaged 3.00 kills per set, .40 aces per set, .33 digs per set, .17 blocks per set and 3.67 points per set.

Kegerreis Posts Career-High Against Cal State Northridge

Redshirt freshman Scott Kegerreis led the Nittany Lions with a career-best 14 kills in a 3-0 sweep of Cal State Northridge on Feb. 5 at Rec Hall. In addition, Kegerreis was second on the team with three blocks. For the weekend, Kegerreis finished second on the team with 23 kills.

Goas Earns EIVA Player of the Week Laurels

Redshirt junior Edgardo Goas was named the EIVA Tait Player of the Week on Jan. 24. Against Saint Francis in a 3-1 win, Goas dished out 43 assists and guided the Nittany Lions to a .361 hitting percentage. He contributed six kills in seven attempts, two aces, six digs and one block. Goas guided his team to a .316 attack percentage against Springfield the following night. In the 3-0 victory, he posted three kills, one ace, four digs and two blocks against the Pride. For the week, Goas averaged 1.29 kills per set, 10.71 assists per set, 0.43 aces per set, 1.43 digs per set and 0.43 blocks per set.

Sunder Garners AVCA Player of the Week Laurels

Redshirt junior Joe Sunder was named the Sports Imports/AVCA Men's Division I-II National Player of the Week on Jan. 18. Sunder led the Nittany Lions to a 2-1 record in the team's opening weekend of play at the Outrigger Invitational. Sunder pounded 70 kills through three matches, including a career-best 33 against Hawaii. He was named the Outrigger Invitational Most Outstanding Player. This award marks the 14th time a Penn State men's volleyball player has been named an AVCA Player of the Week, and it's the first time for Sunder.

Sunder Named EIVA Player of the Week

Redshirt junior Joe Sunder was named the EIVA Tait Player of the Week on Jan. 17, marking the second honor of his career. Against then No. 8 UCLA, Sunder hit .341 tallying 25.5 points with a career-high 24 kills and three total blocks. He improved upon his career-high against Hawaii with 33 kills in 48 attempts for a .583 attack percentage. Sunder also put up four blocks against the Warriors. He closed out the invitational with 13 kills on .417 hitting with three blocks against Ball State. For the week, Sunder averaged 5.83 kills per set, .833 blocks per set and 6.33 points per set. He was named the Outrigger Invitational Most Outstanding Player for his efforts.

The Nittany Lions earned a second place finish at the Hawaii Outrigger Invitational. Despite suffering a 3-1 setback to UCLA to open the tournament, the Nittany Lions defeated Hawaii, 3-2, and Ball State, 3-0.

Nittany Lion Newcomers


