Setting the Scene: The No. 6 Penn State field hockey opens up the 2013 campaign with two tough road tests against top-10 opponents. The season gets underway on Friday with a match against No. 8 Old Dominion at 5 p.m. The Nittany Lions then travel to Charlottesville, Va. to face No. 7 Virginia in a match that begins at 1 p.m.

All-Time vs. Old Dominon: Friday's matchup will mark the 28th meeting between the Monarchs and the Nittany Lions. Old Dominion holds a slight series edge in the series, as Penn State is 12-15 against ODU. The Lions won last season's match by a final of 5-2. The last time PSU traveled to Old Dominion was in 2011 and the Monarchs claimed a 5-2 win in the contest.

Scouting the Monarchs: For the first time in 30 seasons, Old Dominion will have a new coach roaming the sidelines in Andrew Griffiths, who looks to fill the shoes of coaching legend Beth Anders. The Monarchs are coming off a 15-6 2012 campaign that led to a trip to the NCAA Tournament quarterfinals. ODU boasted a strong defense last season, holding opponents to an average of fewer than two goals per game. The Monarchs return their top-two point and goal producers from a year ago in Rosario Villagra and Sarah Breen.

All-Time vs. Virginia: The University of Virginia hosts Penn State for the 21st meeting between the two programs on Sunday afternoon. The Nittany Lions have enjoyed much success against the Cavaliers over the years, as PSU owns a 15-5 advantage in the series history. The Lions edged UVA in a 3-2 win last season. Scoring for the Nittany Lions in the match were returning starters Brittany Grzywacz, Lauren Purvis and Whitney Reddig.

Scouting the Cavaliers: Virginia comes into the 2013 season coming off an impressive 16-6 season that resulted in a trip to the NCAA Tournament guarterfinals. The No. 7 ranked team graduated only five players from last year's squad but lost a few crucial pieces. The 2012 US Field Hockey National Player of the Year Michelle Vittese and All-American Paige Selenski have graduated but Virginia still returns part of its potent attack. Threetime All-American Elly Buckley is returning for her senior season. Buckley enters 2013 with 133 career points, 53 career goals and 27 career assists, ranking in the top-10 in program history for each

category. Another key returning player for the Cavaliers is goalkeeper Jenny Johnstone, who was named All-ACC for her efforts in the cage in 2012.

Last Time Out: Penn State opened up the 2013 season with an exhibition against No. 2 Maryland on Friday, August 23. The Terrapins managed to come away with a 4-1 victory. Maryland senior Jill Witmer scored the visitor's first goal on their only shot of the first half. Penn State recorded eight first half shots but had nothing to show for and trailed 1-0 at the halftime break. The Terrapins added two more goals in the second to grab a 3-0 lead. Penn State got a goal back off Jenna Chrismer's strike from a great pass from defender Abby

Fuhrman to cut the deficit to 3-1. Maryland scored the exhibition's final goal from a

penalty stroke in the final minute. In defeat, the Nittany Lions attempted 10 penalty corners to Maryland's two, but were unable to find the back of the cage.

Gebhart, Grzywacz and Reddig Named Players to Watch: The Big Ten released its 2013 Field Hockey Players to Watch List last week and three Penn State student-athletes received the honor. Seniors Brittany Grzywacz and Whitney Reddig along with junior Laura Gebhart garnered the recognition. Grzywacz is the reigning Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, while Reddig placed second in the conference in assists in 2012. Gebhart is coming off an impressive summer, serving as the captain of the U.S. National Team at the Junior World Cup in Germany.

Lions Ranked No. 6 in NFHCA Preseason Coaches Poll: The first NFHCA Coaches Poll was released on Tuesday, August 27. Penn State was placed sixth in the preseason rankings, the best opening mark in the last five seasons. PSU is the highest ranked of the four Big Ten teams in the Top 20, joining Michigan (9), Northwestern (11), and Iowa (13). The Blue and White will play seven teams in the preseason Top 20. Along with facing the Wolverines, Wildcats and Hawkeyes, the team will additionally face Princeton (3), UConn (4), Virginia (7) and Old Dominion (8).

CHARLENE MORETT PROFILE



The longest tenured coach in the Big Ten and sixth-longest tenured at a single school in Division I field hockey history, Charlene Morett enters her 27th season as head coach of the Penn State field hockey program. Morett boasts a remarkable resume covering her time as the leader of the Nittany Lions. Over the last five years, Morett has led the Nittany Lions to two Big Ten regular season titles, two Big Ten Tournament championships and four NCAA Tournament appearances.

Morett currently ranks fourth all-time in Division I history in wins with 445 and is one of just five DI coaches to accumulate 400 career wins. She has led the Nittany Lions to the NCAA Tournament in 23 of her 26 years as head coach of Penn State and has helped maintain Penn State's distinction as the No. 3 ranked school in alltime NCAA Tournament appearances with 28.

A seven-time NFHCA Mideast Region Coach of the Year, Morett is an excellent teacher of field hockey. Her players earn national recognition on a yearly basis, 11 of whom have been named twotime first team All-Americans with Kelsey Amy being the most recent. Her teams dominate the national scene, consistently ranking among the Top 10 in the national polls. Penn State was ranked in the Top 10 of the STX/NFHCA poll for 32 consecutive weeks from the first poll of the 2005 season ending with the second poll of 2008. The squad achieved a No. 1 ranking in the STX/NFHCA poll for the first time in program history. From 2005-08, Penn State finished eighth, sixth, ninth and 11th respectively, in the final poll of the season.

Under Morett's tutelage, five of her players have been named Big Ten Athlete of the Year -- Traci Anselmo, Jen Coletta, Heather Gorlaski, Tracey Larson and Kiley Kulina. Seven players have been voted the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year -- Natalie Berrena, Coletta, Dawn Lammey, Larson, Tara Maguire, Allison Scola and Kelsey Amy. In 2012, Brittany Grzywacz was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, becoming the ninth Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year from Penn State, joining Anselmo, Gorlaski, Becca Main, Jill Martz, Jill Pearsall and Jen Long. Long and Anselmo are the only Lions to be named Defensive Player of the Year twice.

Since Penn State's entry into the Big Ten in 1992, Morett's program has produced more first team All-Big Ten selections, Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year, Big Ten Athletes of the Year and Big Ten Freshmen of the Year than any other program. Penn State's nine Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honorees are four more than any other school.

With Amy, Laura Gebhart, Lauren Purvis, Grzywacz and Ashtin Klinger earning All-Big Ten laurels last season, Penn State has now totaled 89 All-Big Ten selections since 1992, including 62 first team All-Conference choices, the most of any Big Ten school since Penn State moved to the Big Ten in 1992.

During Morett's tenure, Penn State has produced 37 first team All-America choices with at least one player earning the honor in 24 of the coach's 26 seasons. Overall, Penn State has had at least one first team All-American in 26 of the last 29 years, including every year from 1975-08. In 2007, for the first time since 2002, Penn State had two first team All-Americans in Long and Kiersten Wood.


