#### **LEADING OFF**

- Penn State welcomes West Virginia for a non-conference matchup on Tuesday.
- The Nittany Lions lead the all-time series, 71-42, against the Mountaineers.
- West Virginia is one of five teams that Penn State has played 100 or more times, joining Bucknell (131-30-1), Michigan (49-51), Ohio State (39-71) and Pitt (88-46-1).
- The teams will meet for the first time since 2018, when WVU won 3-2 in 10 innings.
- Penn State took one game in a tight three-game series at Northwestern.
- The Nittany Lions fell 5-4 on Friday and 5-2 on Sunday, both on walk-off hits, but won 4-1 on Saturday behind strong pitching.
- Kellan Tulio struck out a career-high seven in five innings while not allowing an
  earned run. Travis Luensmann threw four innings and struck out six to earn a
  save
- In game one vs. Northwestern, Johnny Piacentino, Josh Spiegel and Matt Wood each hit a solo homer.

#### **Wood Off To Strong Start**

- Through 28 games played, junior Matt Wood is batting .396 with six doubles, two triples, five homers, 24 RBI and 23 runs.
- Wood leads the Nittany Lions in batting average, hits, runs, triples, homers, RBI, walks (14), slugging percentage (.644) and on-base percentage (.467).
- He sits third in the Big Ten in batting average and seventh in slugging percentage.
- Wood is one of two Big Ten players with 10+ extra-base hits (13) and less than 10 strikeouts (9).
- The lefty batter has been impressive facing righty (.415) and lefty (.361) pitchers.
- Wood is batting .450 with runners in scoring position.
- Wood paces PSU with 14 multi-hit games and six multi-RBI games this season and is riding a current 11-game hit streak.
- The Gibsonia, Pa. native is batting .475 over the last 10 games with two doubles, a triple, a homer and nine RBI, including a solo homer in game one vs. Northwestern (4/9).
- He batted .500 in the Maryland series (4/1-3) with six hits and two RBI. He had three hits in each game, including the game-tying RBI single in Penn State's win on Saturday.
- Earlier this season, on opening weekend, Wood went 3-for-4 with four RBI and four runs while crushing two homers and a double in game one against LIU.
- In D1baseball's preseason rankings, Wood was tabbed as the top catcher in the Big Ten.

#### **Pennsylvania Influence In Starting Rotation**

- In 28 of 29 games this season, Penn State's starting pitcher has been a Pennsylvania native.
- Sophomore Travis Luensmann (Altoona) has made six starts, and eight appearances, with 45 strikeouts in 34.2 innings. Luensmann struck out eight in six innings against Maine (2/25).
- Luensmann earned his first save as a NIttany Lion, going four innings and striking out six vs. Northwestern (4/9).
- Freshman Tommy Molsky has made seven starts, and nine appearances, tallying 31 strikeouts. Molsky tied a career high with six strikeouts against UMass (3/12).
- Graduate student Mason Mellott has made four starts and 11 appearances.
- Mellott, graduating in August 2021 with a bachelor's degree in Kinesiology, ranks fourth all-time at Penn State with 13 saves and tied third with 78 appearances. Mellott is on the NCWBA Stopper of the Year Watch List.
- Junior Kellan Tulio has made seven starts and eight appearances. with 24 strikeouts and a .179 opponent batting average. He threw five innings, allowing no earned runs, and struck out a career-high seven at Northwestern (4/9).
- Jaden Henline made the start in game one at Maryland, going five innings, and the game-one start at Northwestern (4/9), striking out six.
- Henline has struck out 35 batters in 29 innings and sits third in the Big Ten with three saves. In 10 appearances (two starts), Henline has thrown two or more innings in seven outings.
- Senior Steven Miller made his first career start at Northwestern (4/9), throwing three shutout innings and striking out three. Miller has a 2.53 ERA in eight appearances.
- Penn State is challenged with replacing a 2021 rotation that featured three MLB draft selections in Conor Larkin (9th round, Toronto Blue Jays), Kyle Virbitsky (17th round, Oakland A's) and Bailey Dees (18th round, New York Yankees).
- The Nittany Lions were one of only four Division I schools to have all three members of their starting rotation selected. Penn State has eight pitchers who have been drafted since 2016.

#### Morales, Shingledecker Lead Bullpen

- Senior Tyler Shingledecker has made 12 appearances with a team-high three wins. The lefty has held opponents without an earned run in eight of his 12 outings.
- The versatile Shingledecker has gone more than an inning in eight appearances and has 28 strikeouts with only four walks. He recorded all four outs via strikeout in his appearance at Maryland and struck out six in 3.2 innings vs. Northwestern (4/9).
- Junior Jordan Morales has also established himself as a key member of the bullpen
- Morales is 2-0 with 28 strikeouts in 19.2 innings over 14 appearances.

#### **Nittany Lions Finding Power**

- · Over the last 10 games, Penn State has tallied 23 extra-base hits, including 12 doubles, four triples and seven homers.
- Jay Harry leads the team with five extra base hits over that span, with three doubles and two homers.
- Johnny Piacentino (two triples, two homers), Josh Spiegel (two doubles, one triple, one homer) and Matt Wood (two doubles, one triple, one homer) each have four extra-base hits in the last 10 games.
- Cole Bartels hit a solo homer at Maryland (4/3).
- On the season, Matt Wood leads PSU with 13 extra-base hits, pacing PSU with two triples (tied with Piacentino) and five homers to go with six doubles.
- · Josh Spiegel leads PSU with seven doubles, while Billy Gerlott and Wood have six and Kyle Hannon has five.
- Harry and Spiegel have three homers this season, while Piacentino has two.

#### **B1G Road Win**

- Penn State earned a 6-4 win in 10 innings over Maryland on Saturday (4/2).
- The Terrapins were ranked No. 23 in the USA Today Coaches Poll and 25th in the Baseball America Poll.
- Penn State earned its first win in a true road game against a ranked opponent since a 15-5 win over No. 16 Michigan (5/13/07).
- The Nittany Lions recorded their first win against a ranked opponent away from home since March 2, 2019 against No. 21 Duke (8-7).
- Johnny Piacentino launched his first homer of the year, a two-run shot, in the sixth, while Matt Wood tied the game, 3-3, with an RBI single in the eighth.
- Penn State broke the tie in the 10th with a two-run double by Tayven Kelley and an RBI double by Jay Harry.

#### THE OPPOSITION

#### **Scouting West Virginia**

- West Virginia is led by head coach Randy Mazey in his 10th season.
- Under Mazey, the Mountaineers are 283-218.
- · The Mountaineers have won five straight games, including a sweep over Baylor this past weekend.
- · West Virginia ranks third in the country with 102 total steals and second in the nation, averaging 3.4 per game.
- Victor Scott III leads WVU with 25 steals, while Austin Davis has 19.
- Five members of the Mountaineers' lineup own a .300 or better average, led by McGwire Holbrook's .349 average.
- J.J. Wetherholt paces WVU with 13 extra-base hits and 22 RBI.
- The WVU pitching staff has a 4.31 team ERA and allow a .239 opposing batting average.
- Trey Braithwaite is 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA in 13 appearances, covering 20 innings.

#### **Against The Mountaineers**

- The Nittany Lions hold a 71-42 record all-time against West Virginia.
- West Virginia is one of five opponents Penn State has played more than 100 times: Bucknell (131-30-1), Michigan (49-51), Ohio State (39-71) and Pitt (88-46-1).
- The teams will meet for the first time since April 10, 2018 when the Mountaineers won 3-2 in 10 innings.
- Jordan Bowersox had two hits, including a homer.

# **HEAD COACH ROB COOPER**





ROB COOPER MIAMI (FLA.), 1994 OVERALL: 445-463 (17TH YR) PSU: 159-233 (9TH YR)

**Head Coach** 

The 2022 baseball season is Rob Cooper's ninth as head coach of the Nittany Lion baseball program. Cooper was selected as the 14th head baseball coach in Penn State history on August 9, 2013. Not shy about stating his ultimate goal of returning Penn State to Omaha in June, the Lions have made significant strides under his leadership.

Under his tutelage, 11 players have been drafted and 12 total have signed with MLB teams in the last four seasons with a full draft. However, his strong belief in the first part of the term "student-athlete" is perhaps the top reason he has proven to be an excellent fit at Penn State. Even with state-of-the-art facilities, the chance to take on elite competition and a program history that includes five trips to the College World Series, Cooper cites the value of a Penn State degree as one of the top reasons to play baseball at Penn State.

The Nittany Lions finished the 2021 season with an 18-24 record, playing against exclusively Big Ten opponents. The wins included a 3-2 victory over No. 18 Michigan on March 26 and a series sweep over Michigan State in which Penn State out-scored the Spartans, 39-13. The Nittany Lions also won two series against Rutgers. Penn State scored 10 or more runs in six games, Penn State's most against Big Ten opponents since 2008 (8) and the most in a season since 2016.

Penn State led the Big Ten in doubles (93) and doubles per game (2.21), ranking 10th in the country in doubles per game. The Nittany Lions sat third in the conference in batting average (.269). Penn State hit 34 home runs, its most since 2012, and had five players with four or more homers.

Sophomore Matt Wood collected Second Team All-Big Ten honors, batting .295 with four homers and 21 RBI. Wood became the fifth All-Big Ten selection under Cooper. Senior Gavin Homer led the Nittany Lions with a .310 batting average, a .429 on-base percentage and tied with Johnny Piacentino for the team-lead in runs (30). Junior Justin Williams hit .302 and paced Penn State with 48 hits. Piacentino led the squad with eight homers and 32 RBI to go with a team-best .525 slugging percentage.

Senior Kyle Virbitsky paced the Penn State rotation with a 4.17 ERA, five wins, 77.2 innings pitched and 88 strikeouts. Virbitsky ranked seventh in the Big Ten in strikeouts and third in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.40). His 88 strikeouts are tied for the 10th-most in a season at Penn State. Senior Conor Larkin earned three wins and 69 strikeouts in 63.2 innings and fellow senior Bailey Dees was responsible for four wins and 53 strikeouts in 66 innings.

The Nittany Lions continued their success in the classroom with a program-record 19 players earning Academic All-Big Ten accolades.

Penn State had four players drafted from the 2021 squad. Larkin was selected in the ninth round (272nd overall) by the Toronto Blue Jays. Williams was a 17th round selection (508th overall) by the Houston Astros and Kyle Virbitsky followed, being selected 518th overall by the Oakland A's. Bailey Dees was drafted in the 18th round (543rd overall) by the New York Yankees. All three members of the starting rotation were drafted, making Penn State one of only four schools to accomplish that in 2021.

It marked the third time in program history that Penn State had four or more players selected in a single year and the second time that Penn State had three pitchers selected in a draft. The Nittany Lions have had eight pitchers drafted since 2016. The four selections were double of any other Pennsylvania school and three of the draftees are Pennsylvania natives.

Penn State was off to a 10-5 start in 2020 before the COVID-19 pandemic canceled the remainder of the season. Penn State was among the conference leaders offensively, ranking second in on-base percentage (.394), slugging (.422), triples (7), doubles (30), third in batting average (.289) and walks (77), and fourth in scoring (6.7 runs/game) and runs (100). On the mound, Penn State ranked sixth in the NCAA with a 1.01 WHIP and also eighth with a 2.16 team ERA. The Nittany Lions also ranked 15th with 6.33 hits allowed per nine innings and 18th with a 3.63 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

Penn State baseball's trip to Cuba prior to the 2016 season is perhaps the best example of Cooper's commitment to the first part of the "student-athlete" term. The Nittany Lions attended academic lectures and toured Havana, becoming the first NCAA Division I team to compete against a Cuban National Series team, the first U.S. team at any level to defeat a Cuban National Series team, the first U.S. baseball team to play in Cuba since restoration of diplomatic ties with Cuba, the second NCAA team to play in Cuba since restoration of diplomatic ties (Coastal Carolina men's basketball, August 2015) and the fifth NCAA Division I baseball team to compete in post-revolutionary Cuba. The harmony between academics and athletics was on full display, as multiple Penn State professors and a group of journalism students also joined the travel party.

The rare, once-in-a-lifetime experience helped bring a young Penn State team together, and the Lions went on to earn their first winning record (overall and in conference) since 2012. The starting lineup included at least three freshmen in all but six games and five to six freshmen in 19 games, and took on nine eventual NCAA tournament teams, including a three-game series at home against College World Series participant TCU. The Lions' 28 wins were a 10-win improvement over the previous season, and its 12 Big Ten wins doubled the 2015 total. Haley and Anderson were the first drafted out of Penn State since 2012, and Anderson and senior outfielder Greg Guers became the program's first All-Big Ten picks also since 2012. Pitcher Justin Hagenman became Penn State's first Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American since 1997.

Shortly after Cooper accepted the PSU head coaching position in 2014, the California native traveled to Taichung, Taiwan to serve as the head coach of USA Baseball's 18U National Team at the IBAF U18 World Cup. Cooper steered Team USA to an 8-1 record in World Cup play, including seven consecutive victories to win the gold medal.

Not long after the triumph in Taiwan, Cooper received one of the highest honors bestowed in the profession, as he was announced as the Rod Dedeaux USA Baseball Coach of the Year. With the honor, Cooper became just the 16th individual in the award's history to receive the accolade, joining the likes of Scott Brosius, Davey Johnson and Tommy Lasorda.

Cooper was also a member of the coaching staff for the 2007 and 2009 USA College National teams. The 2007 team earned a silver medal at the Pan Am Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Fourteen of the 20 players on the 2007 team reached the Major Leagues, including 2013 All-Star Pedro Alvarez. Fourteen of the 22 members of the 2009 team also reached the Major Leagues, including three-time All-Star Gerrit Cole.

Cooper brought an accomplished resume to Penn State that included three NCAA Tournament appearances as a head coach at Wright State and five more at various stops as an assistant coach, including two trips to the College World Series with Miami (Florida). Cooper was twice named the Horizon League Coach of the Year and guided Wright State to three league tournament championships and two regular-season championships after the team suffered six losing seasons in the seven years before his arrival.

Cooper began his coaching career at national power Miami, spending two seasons (1994-95) as a student/graduate assistant on the Hurricanes' staff. While at Miami, Cooper helped the Hurricanes to College World Series berths in 1994 and 1995. Cooper spent the 1996 season as an assistant and team academic coordinator at Wake Forest, then moved on to Tulane for the next two seasons, serving as the Green Wave's hitting coach. In 1997, the Green Wave won the Conference USA regular-season crown, and in 1998, they advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Cooper left Tulane following the 1998 season and returned to Sacramento City College, where he starred in the early 1990's before lettering at Miami in 1993.

Along with his college coaching experience, Cooper also was an associate scout for the Los Angeles Dodgers from 1990-92 and has been selected to four coaching stints with USA Baseball in 2000, 2007, 2009 and 2013.

Cooper earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Miami in 1994 and a master's in sports sciences/administration from Miami in 1996. He is married to his wife, Maureen, and has two sons, Jake and Tyson, who are both current members of the Penn State baseball team.


