### Nittany Lions Travel to Kent State, Host Binghamton in Midweek Contests

Coming off a 16-run and 19-hit outburst at Purdue on Sunday, Penn State baseball (8-18, 2-4) opens up midweek action at Kent State on Tuesday. First pitch is slated for 3 p.m. at Schoonover Stadium. The Nittany Lions then return home on Wednesday as it hosts Binghamton at 6:05 p.m.

**Penn State Probables:** Senior southpaw **Mike Franklin** will get the start on the mound in Tuesday's contest with Kent State. In his most recent outing against Coppin State last week, Franklin went six innings, giving up three hits and striking out a career-high eight batters in the win. Two weeks ago against Pittsburgh, Franklin had a very quality outing, going 5.2 innings and giving up three earned runs in a 5-3 victory over the Panthers. Junior right-hander **Cody Lewis** will get the ball on Wednesday evening against Binghamton. Lewis will be making his first start since March 11 when he faced UAB. Lewis hurled a nice quality start against Samford to earn his first ever win in a Penn State uniform on March 3. The junior went six innings, giving up seven hits and just one earned run.

**Scouting Kent State:** Kent State enters Tuesday's contest with a 14-12 overall mark and a 6-0 record in MAC action. The Golden Flashes have won six of their last eight games and are coming off a series sweep over Ball State this past weekend. Penn State has one common opponent in Pittsburgh with Kent State. The Panthers downed the Golden Flashes by a score of 6-5 back on March 28. Leading the way offensively is Nick Hamilton, who is hitting .490 on the season. Hamilton has played in just 16 games but has driven in 11 runs. Jimmy Rider has hit three homeruns this year and has driven in 22 runs, to go along with a .336 batting average. Michael Clark will get the start on the mound for Kent State, as he is winless on the year with an ERA north of seven.

**All-Time vs. the Golden Flashes:** This will be the ninth all-time matchup between the Golden Flashes and the Nittany Lions. Kent State has won three of the last four matchups, including a 7-6 win last year.

**Scouting Binghamton:** Penn State will be taking on Binghamton for the first time on Wednesday night. Zach Blanden is the Bearcats' leading hitter, sporting an average of .408. They sport an 8-10 overall record and have yet to begin conference action.

**Opening the Gates:** After dropping the first two of the series and facing a potential sweep, Penn State closed out the weekend with a season-high 16 runs and 19 hits in a 16-6 victory over the No. 19 Purdue Boilermakers on Sunday afternoon. for some players. Most notably, **Alex Farkes** homered in his second consecutive game and set or tied career highs five offensive categories. Farkes set career highs in at bats (5) and hits (3) and also tied his career best in runs (2) and RBI (2). **Aaron Novak's** three RBI that came on his homerun in the third inning are a single-game best for him. In addition, **Joey DeBernardis** scored a personal best four runs in Sunday's victory. The 16 runs were the most the Nittany Lions have scored since May 1, 2010 when Penn State defeated Michigan State by a score of 22-5.

**Solid Pitching Against Nation's No. 1 Offense:** Purdue's offense came into the weekend first in the country in hitting, but strong starts from all three Nittany Lion starters dropped Purdue from first to ninth nationally. The Boilermakers scored 18 runs (6.0 per game), which were 2.1 below their season average. Most notably, 10 of those 18 Boilermaker runs were unearned.

**The Sheep is on the Loose!:** Junior **Elliot Searer**, who got off to a rough start in non-conference play, has significantly come back to his own self as of late. Searer has really stepped up since Big Ten action began, as he's reached base at a .467 clip. Searer leads the team in hitting for conference play by a large margin, as he sports a .389 average. Searer hit an extra inning, walk-off RBI single in the 10th inning to give Penn State its first conference win back on March 24 in a 4-3 victory over Indiana.

**“Sterankings”:** With his four RBI performance against Pittsburgh two weeks, Jordan Steranka moved into third place all-time on the Penn State RBI list with 153 (currently has 158). Steranka trails Chris Wright by 18 RBI for second place in the school record books. Steranka is approaching a handful of records including at bats (ranks third, 44 behind first), runs (sixth), hits (third, five behind second), doubles (sixth) and triples (fourth). With his homer against Pitt, Steranka moved into the school’s top 10 list for homers with 24.

**Firsts for Skerper:** In last Wednesday’s 7-1 game two victory over Coppin State, freshman Taylor Skerpon went 1-for-2 and earned his first career hit and RBIs. With two outs in the second inning and the score tied at zero in game two, Skerpon hit a single the other way to right centerfield to give the Nittany Lions a 2-0 edge on the Eagles. Skerpon has started at shortstop in two games this season.

**Patton the Stats:** Also in the 7-1 victory over Coppin State last Wednesday, freshman Patton Taylor picked up his first career victory on the mound. Taylor pitched 2.2 innings in his first career start and struck out three batters to earn the win. Also noteworthy in that game was Alex Farkes, who hit his first career homerun. Mike Franklin additionally struck out a career-high eight batters in game one, as he picked up his second win of the season.

**Coban’s Career Day:** In a loss to East Carolina on March 17, Penn State got a great performance out of freshman catcher JC Coban. Coban was a single short of the cycle in a four RBI performance. Coban connected on an RBI double in the third, a two-run homer in the seventh, and an RBI triple in the ninth. The freshman also scored two runs on the day. The four runs he drove in are tied for the most of any Penn State player this season.

### Penn State to Have

**at Least Four Games Televised this Season:** The Nittany Lion baseball team will play in four games televised by the BTN starting with the Friday, Apr. 13 matchup against Michigan at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park. PSU’s visit to Target Field to play Minnesota will air Saturday, May 5 at 3:00 p.m. as well Illinois’ trip to Happy Valley on Sunday, May 13. Penn State’s regular season BTN finale at Michigan State is scheduled for Saturday, May 19 at Noon. Should the Nittany Lions return to the Big Ten Tournament for a second consecutive season, their games will once again be shown live on Big Ten Network throughout the week of May 23-27.

**Hill Earns Preseason Honors from College Sports Madness:** Penn State junior pitcher Steven Hill has been named to the College Sports Madness Big Ten Preseason All-Conference Second Team. Hill is coming off a stellar 2011 season, as he was named Second Team All-Big Ten and Academic All-Big Ten. During 2011, Hill fired four complete games, which equals the total posted by every other Penn State pitcher since the beginning of the 2009 season. His year was highlighted by a pair of shutouts after he blanked Northwestern, 12-0, on April 9 before firing another gem against Minnesota during a 7-0 victory on May 13. In his 15 starts last year, he posted a 6-5 record, including three wins during conference action. Hill held his opposition to three or fewer runs during 10 starts. Incredibly accurate, he averaged just 1.01 walks-per-nine innings, which stood as the 15th best rate in the nation. Overall, he issued just 12 free passes during the year.

**THIS SEASON:** Has made four appearances this season with three starts ... Appeared in relief at UNCG (2/25), going two innings and giving up one run ... Earned the start against Mississippi State (3/6), pitching 3.2 innings ... Picked up the victory against Pittsburgh (3/21) as he went 5.2 innings, giving up just five hits and three earned runs ... Had his best outing of the season against Coppin State (3/28), striking out a career-high 8 batters in six innings of work to pick up the victory.

**AS A JUNIOR IN 2011:** Appeared in 10 games and started nine on the mound for the Nittany Lions ... Posted a stellar 4-1 record during the year while ranking third on the squad with 50.2 innings of work ... Finished the season with a 4.09 ERA and 26 strikeouts ... Earned a victory in his first appearance of the season after scattering four runs on six hits over seven innings of work at Old Dominion on March 9 ... Also struck out six and did not surrender a walk against the Monarchs ... Fired an inning of scoreless relief against No. 26 Wichita State on March 18 ... Started three midweek games in March and April, including a victory against Pittsburgh on April 13 ... Did not allow an earned run while striking out three over six innings of work against the Panthers ... Took over a spot in the weekend rotation on April 24 with a four-inning start against Ohio State ... Tossed a season-high eight innings against Iowa on May 8, holding the Hawkeyes to just four hits and one run while striking out four ... Earned his third win of the season after limiting Minnesota to one run over five innings of work on May 15 ... Wrapped up his campaign with six innings of work against Michigan on May 21 ... Allowed just five hits and a pair of unearned runs while picking up the victory against the Wolverines, which clinched a playoff spot for Penn State.
