Ohio State is seventh in the NCAA on the power play, converting 28-of-109 chances this season. Carson Meyer has a team-best six power play tallies, tying for first in the B1G. The team has a power play goal in seven of the last eight games.

BUCKEYES VS. NITTANY LIONS

The No. 13 Ohio State men's hockey team returns home for two games against No. 9 Penn State this weekend. The teams will meet at 7 p.m. Friday and 5 p.m. Saturday in Value City Arena. The games will be streamed through BTN+ and on Ohio State radio. The teams enter the weekend tied for first place in the Big Ten, one point ahead of three teams tied for third.

BUCKEYE NOTES TO KNOW

- ▶ Ohio State leads the all-time series with Penn State, 16-11-2, with a 7-5-1 mark in Columbus. The teams met in State College Nov. 22-23, 2019, splitting a series. The Nittany Lions won the opener, 5-4, before a 4-3 Ohio State victory. The teams last faced off in Columbus in a Big Ten Tournament semifinal game March 17, 2019, a 5-1 PSU win.
- ▶ The Buckeyes are home for just the second time in six weeks after back-to-back road series. The squad is 9-1-2 in Columbus this season.
- ▶ A Big Ten best three Buckeyes have double-digit goals. Gustaf Westlund is tied for third among league skaters with 12 tallies, Quinn Preston is tied for fifth with 11 and Carson Meyer is tied for seventh with 10.

Senior and leading scorer Tanner Laczynski is second among current NCAA skaters in career points (135) and assists (91). His 1.04 points per game average is sixth among non-freshmen and second among seniors.

Sophomore Gustaf Westlund leads the Buckeyes with 12 goals, including a Big Ten best four gamewinners. He is tied for third among league skaters in goals this year.

The Buckeyes have six regular season (and Big Ten) games remaining, with four at home and two on the road. The squad has a bye next weekend before hitting the road for a series at Michigan State.

BUCKEYE SNAPSHOT

- ▶ The Buckeyes are 16-9-3 this season and ended a three-game losing streak with a win over Michigan Saturday.
- ▶ The squad is scoring 2.71 goals a game this season, while allowing 2.29 a night. The power play is seventh in the nation, converting 25.7 percent (28-for-109) and Ohio State has stopped 74-of-88 (.841) opponent power play chances.
- ▶ Senior Tanner Laczynski is first on the team with 19 assists and 26 points. Sophomore Gustaf Westlund has a team-best 12 goals and is second with 24 points. Sophomore Quinn Preston is second with 11 goals, followed by senior Carson Meyer with 10. Meyer is third with 20 points. Westlund is second with 12 helpers, followed by Meyer with 10.
- ▶ Senior Gordi Myer leads the squad with 55 blocked shots.
- ▶ In goal, junior Tommy Nappier has a 2.06 goals-against average and .929 save percentage, posting a 13-8-2 record in 24 games. Freshman Ryan Snowden has a 2.52 goals-against average and .905 save percentage, notching a 3-1-1 record, in five appearances.

IN THE POLLS

- ▶ This week, the Buckeyes moved to No. 13 in the USCHO.com and USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine rankings.
- ▶ Big Ten teams joining the Buckeyes in the USCHO poll include No. 9 Penn State and No. 19 Michigan State, with Minnesota, Notre Dame and Michigan receiving votes.
- ▶ No. 10 (tied) Penn State joins Ohio State in the USA Today Top 15, with Michigan State receiving votes.

BUCKEYES VS. NITTANY LIONS

- ▶ Ohio State leads the all-time series with Penn State, 16-11-2, with a 7-5-1 mark in Columbus.
- ▶ The teams met in State College Nov. 22-23, 2019, splitting a series. The Nittany Lions won the opener, 5-4, before a 4-3 Ohio State victory.
- ▶ The squads faced off in Columbus three times in 2018-19. They split a series in Columbus Nov. 23-24, 2018, with a 4-3 PSU win and 5-2 Buckeye victory. The Nittany Lions won a Big Ten Tournament semifinal matchup, posting a 5-1 win March 17, 2019 in Columbus.
- ▶ Gordi Myer leads the current Buckeyes with 15 career games played vs. Penn State. Junior Tanner Laczynski has a team-best 12 assists and 17 points vs. the Nittany Lions (in 11 games). Laczynski and sophomore Gustaf Westlund (in seven games) each have five goals vs. PSU to lead the Buckeyes. Westlund is second on the team with six assists, followed by Myer

and Matt Miller (10 games played) with five each. Miguel Fidler is second on the team with 13 games played, while Ronnie Hein and Sam McCormick have skated in 12 games.

OHIO STATE VS. PENN STATE - THE LAST SERIES

- ▶ The Buckeyes and Nittany Lions split a series on PSU home ice Nov. 22-23, 2019.
- ▶ **Game One (PSU 5, OSU 4):** The teams traded power play goals in the first period, with Carson Meyer tallying for the Buckeyes. Penn State notched the only two goals of the second for a 3-1 advantage. Ohio State made it a one-goal game at 3:08 of the third on a Gustaf Westlund power play goal, but the Nittany Lions answered less than a minute later. The 4-2 score stood until the final 2:15, when the teams scored three times. Penn State tallied an empty net goal at 17:45. At 18:34 Matthew Jennings scored for the Buckeyes and Tanner Laczynski followed with an extra attacker goal at 19:07, but the Buckeyes could get no closer. Each team was 2-for-4 on the power play and the Buckeyes were outshot, 41-32.
- ▶ **Game Two (OSU 4, PSU 3):** The teams traded goals in the first period, with Tanner Laczynski scoring for Ohio State in the final minute. Penn State went ahead 2-1 at 2:53 of the second, but Ohio State scored back-to-back, with a Quinn Preston power play goal and Gordi Myer tally, for a 3-2 advantage. The Nittany Lions got a PPG of their own for a tie score after 40 minutes. Gustaf Westlund notched the gamewinner for the Buckeyes with just under seven minutes remaining in regulation, assisted by Laczynski and Preston. Freshman goalie Ryan Snowden played the third period in relief of injured starter Tommy Nappier, stopping all 15 shots he faced in his first collegiate action to pick up the win. Penn State had the edge in shots, 36-34. The Buckeyes were 1-for-3 on the power play, with Penn State 1-for-2.

THE PENN STATE NITTANY LIONS

- ▶ Penn State is 17-9-2 overall this year after going 0-1-1 vs. Notre Dame at home last weekend (T OT 3-3/0-1 SOL, L 2-4). The squad is 7-4-0 in road games this season.
- ▶ The Nittany Lions rank sixth nationally in scoring offense, with 3.61 goals a game, and are allowing 2.57 a night.
- ▶ The power play ranks sixth in the NCAA (26-for-99, .263) and the penalty kill is seventh, stopping 84-of-97 (.866) opponent chances.
- ▶ Nate Sucece leads the team with 30 points, sharing the assist lead with Evan Barratt with 20 each. Sam Sternschein is first with 12 goals, followed by Sucece with 10. In goal, Peyton Jones is 15-8-1,

with a 2.59 goals-against average and .922 save percentage. Oskar Autio has a 2-1-1 mark, 1.87 goals-against and .930 save percentage.

IN THE B1G

- ▶ One point separates the Top 5 teams in the Big Ten standings with four weeks remaining in the regular season.
- ▶ Ohio State and Penn State are tied for first with 29 points (9-7-2-0 records), while Michigan State (9-6-1-0), Minnesota (7-5-4-3) and Notre Dame (7-7-4-3) are tied for third with 28 points. The Gophers and Spartans have played 16 games, while the other three have played 18.
- ▶ Michigan is in sixth with 21 points in 16 games and Wisconsin is seventh with 17 points in 18 games.
- ▶ This weekend, Ohio State hosts Penn State, Wisconsin travels to Michigan and Minnesota hosts Michigan State.
- ▶ When the Buckeyes have their bye the weekend of Feb. 14-15, the series include Michigan/Michigan State, Minnesota/Notre Dame and Penn State/Wisconsin.
- ▶ A Big Ten best four Ohio State defensemen rank in the Top 15 in points among league blueliners. For the Buckeyes, Matt Miller (4g, 9a, 13p) is tied for sixth, Gordi Myer (4g, 8a, 12p) and Grant Gabriele (4g, 8a, 12p) are tied for ninth and Wyatt Ege (3g, 8a, 11p) is tied for 12th. No other school has more than two in the Top 12 (encompassing 15 players).
- ▶ In B1G games only, Tanner Laczynski (4g, 10a, 14p) leads the Buckeyes and is tied for eighth in the Big Ten in points. Carson Meyer (7g, 6a, 13p) and Gustaf Westlund (8g, 5a, 13p) are tied for 11th and Quinn Preston (7g, 5a, 12p) is tied for 13th.
- ▶ Westlund is fourth with eight goals in B1G play and Quinn Preston and Meyer are tied for fifth with seven tallies each. Laczynski is tied for second with 10 helpers.
- ▶ In conference action, Ohio State is tied for third among league teams in scoring offense (2.61 goals per game) and ranks third in scoring defense (2.56 goals allowed per game). The power play is 15-for-59 (.254) to rank second and the penalty kill is 41-for-50 (.820) to rank third.

IN COLUMBUS

- ▶ The Buckeyes are 9-1-2 at home this season, with an 8-0-2 record in their last 10 games in Value City Arena.
- ▶ In Columbus, the Buckeyes have scored 2.50 goals a game and allowed 1.50 a night. Tanner Laczynski has a team-best 11 assists and 14 points at home, while Quinn Preston is first with eight goals.
- ▶ The squad is 5-7-0 in road games this season, with a 2-1-1 mark in neutral sites.

LAST TIME OUT - OSU SPLITS WITH UM

- ▶ Ohio State was 1-1 at Michigan last weekend.
- ▶ **Game One (UM 3, OSU 2):** Ohio State came from a goal down twice, but the Wolverines scored the gamewinner at 16:17 of the third. Michigan opened the scoring at 5:24 and held the lead until a Carson Meyer power play tally at 4:33 of the second for the Buckeyes. At 18:03 the Wolverines took a 2-1 advantage, but Ohio State again answered with a power play goal, scored by Grant Gabriele at 11:02. Will Lockwood notched the final go-ahead goal at 16:17. Ohio State was outshot, 42-27, in the game, with Tommy Nappier making 39 saves. The Buckeyes were 2-for-5 on the power play and 3-for-3 on the penalty kill.
- ▶ **Game Two (OSU 4, UM 1):** Ohio State scored twice in the first 10 minutes of the game for a lead it would not relinquish en route to a 4-1 win. Matt Miller tallied just 43 seconds into the game, followed by Jaedon Leslie's first career goal at 9:43. Michigan made it a one-goal game at 9:33 of the second. In the third, Austin Pooley notched an insurance goal at 11:35, set up by Quinn Preston, and Preston ended the scoring with an empty net goal at 19:10. Shots were 36-21 in favor of the Wolverines. The Buckeyes were unable to score on three power play chances (including two five-minute majors) and the penalty kill was 4-for-4.

NO. 9 LEADING THE WAY

- ▶ Senior Tanner Laczynski has a team-best 19 assists and 26 points, ranking fourth with seven goals. He is fifth in the Big Ten in points and tied for third in assists. Last weekend was the first time this season he was held off the scoresheet in back-to-back games.
- ▶ Laczynski is a member of the Century Club with 135 collegiate points, ranking second among active NCAA skaters. He is averaging 1.04 points per game, ranking sixth among all non-freshmen in the NCAA. He is the third Buckeye to average better than a point per game since 1999-2000, joining RJ Umberger (1.15 from 2000-03) and Mason Jobst (1.09 from 2015-19).
- ▶ He has notched 91 assists in the Scarlet and Gray, six back of tying for 10th in program history.
- ▶ In Big Ten games only, Laczynski has a 23-48-71 line in his career, tying for seventh in league history among all B1G skaters. His 48 assists are sixth among all Big Ten players.
- ▶ He is one of 20 candidates for the Senior CLASS Award and is on the Hobey Baker Award fan ballot.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- ▶ Ohio State is 28-for-109 (.257) on the power play this season, with at least one power play goal in 18 of 28 games. The squad is seventh in the NCAA in power play

percentage. The team is sixth nationally in total power play goals.

- ▶ The Buckeyes were 2-for-5 in game one at Michigan and 0-for-3 in game two, ending a streak of seven straight games with a power play goal. Two of the three chances were majors.
- ▶ Carson Meyer has a team-best six power play goals, tying for 12th nationally and sharing the Big Ten lead.
- ▶ Quinn Preston is second with five PPG, Ronnie Hein follows with four and Matt Miller and Gustaf Westlund each have three. In all, 10 Buckeyes have at least one goal with the man advantage.
- ▶ Tanner Laczynski has a team-best 11 power play assists and 12 power play points, leading the Big Ten.
- ▶ On the penalty kill, the Buckeyes are 74-for-88 (.841).
- ▶ The squad was 7-for-7 on the penalty kill at Michigan, with a 4-for-4 night in game two. The team is 11-for-12 (.917) in the last five games combined.
- ▶ Tanner Laczynski scored the team's first shorthanded goal of the season (and the first of his career) vs. Army Jan. 4. It was the first shorthy for the Buckeyes since Feb. 9, 2019.
- ▶ Ohio State averages 3.14 penalty kills a game, tying for the sixth-lowest average in the NCAA. The squad has averaged 3.80 power plays per night.
- ▶ Last season, Ohio State was 33-for-158 (.209) on the power play and 108-for-132 (.818) on the PK.

SCORING NEWS AND NOTES

- ▶ The Buckeyes are averaging 2.71 goals per game, with three or more goals in 14 outings (including in 10 of the last 18 games).
- ▶ Gustaf Westlund has a team-high and career-best 12 goals this season, tying for third in the Big Ten. Westlund is tied for fifth nationally with a Big Ten-best four gamewinners. Westlund, who had a 5-14-19 line in 25 games last season, is second on the squad with 24 points this year and a

helper in each game at Michigan.

- ▶ Along with Tanner Laczynski (135 career points), Carson Meyer (78), Matt Miller (60), Ronnie Hein (57) and Wyatt Ege (53) all have reached the 50-point mark. Miller and Ege are the 12th and 13th Buckeye blueliners with 50+ points since the start of 2003-04.
- ▶ Carson Meyer had a power play goal in three straight games, scoring in each contest vs. Minnesota and game one at Michigan. He now has an Ohio State career-high 10 goals, matching the 10 he had as a freshman at Miami. Meyer is third for the Buckeyes with 20 points this year.
- ▶ Quinn Preston has a goal in four of his last five games and now has 10 on the year to rank third on the squad. He had a goal and an assist in game two at Michigan, his fourth multi-point outing of the season. He has a 4-3-7 line in his last five games combined. As a freshman last year Preston had five goals and 14 points.
- ▶ Freshman Jaedon Leslie scored his first career goal Saturday at Michigan. The tally stood as the gamewinner.
- ▶ Ronnie Hein is fourth in faceoff winning percentage (.567) among Big Ten forwards, while Tanner Laczynski is seventh (.546). Laczynski is third among B1G players with 267 faceoff wins, followed by Hein with 254. As a team, Ohio State is third in the Big Ten in faceoff winning percentage (.518).
- ▶ In all, 17 Buckeyes have at least one goal this season. Rookies Tate Singleton, Michael Gildon and Kamil Sadlocha, along with sophomore Matthew Jennings and Leslie, have all notched their first career goals this year.

DEFENSIVELY

- ▶ Ohio State has held opponents to 2.29 goals per game this season, allowing more than two goals nine times in 28 games. The squad is 14th nationally in scoring defense.
- ▶ Freshman blueliner Layton Ahac is tied for second on the team with a +7 rating, ranking second among Big Ten freshman defensemen.
- ▶ The Buckeyes are ninth in the NCAA and third in the Big Ten in blocked shots per game (14.18). Last weekend at Michigan, the squad had 22 blocks in game one and 20 in game two.
- ▶ Gordi Myer leads the team with 55 shot blocks, tying for ninth nationally in blocks and ranking eighth in the Big Ten with 1.96 per game. Quinn Preston leads all Big Ten forwards with 29 blocked shots and is second among conference forward with 1.07 per game.
- ▶ Matt Miller leads all Buckeyes with an active three-game point-scoring streak.

BETWEEN THE PIPES

- ▶ Junior Tommy Nappier started 24 of the

first 28 games for the Buckeyes, making 644 saves on 693 shots for a 2.06 goals-against average and .929 save percentage, with two shutouts. He is in the Top 15 in the NCAA in goals-against average and save percentage.

- ▶ Nappier had 39 saves in game one at Michigan, his second-highest total this season and most since stopping 44 in an overtime game vs. Western Michigan to open the year. He had 35 stops in game two vs. the Wolverines.
- ▶ Freshman Ryan Snowden has played in five games, including four starts with Nappier out with injury. Snowden's first game action was the third period at Penn State Nov. 23 after an injury to Nappier. The rookie, who entered with the game tied at three, did not allow a goal, making 15 saves, in a 4-3 victory. The game marked Snowden's first collegiate minutes. Snowden made his first start Nov. 30 vs. Michigan State and had 26 saves on 27 shots for the win. He had a career-best 28 stops in the 2-1 win over Notre Dame Jan. 18.
- ▶ Nappier was named the HCA National Goaltender of the Month for December. He was 4-0-1 in the month, with two shutouts, a .97 goals against average and .970 save percentage.
- ▶ His overtime save vs. Minnesota Dec. 6 was save 1,000 of his Buckeye career.
- ▶ Prior to this season, Nappier had not started both games on a weekend for the Buckeyes. Last season he and Sean Romeo split starts each series until Nappier got the nod in the Big Ten semifinal and NCAA first round game.
- ▶ Nappier is 29-12-5 overall, with a .933 save percentage and 1.91 goals-against average in the Scarlet and Gray. His career totals are first and sixth, respectively, among active NCAA goalies.
- ▶ Nappier was the 2019 Big Ten Goalie of the Year and a Mike Richter Award semifinalist.

- ▶ Thirteen of the Buckeyes' games have been decided by one goal this season, along with three ties and two games where the final margin was two because of an empty net goal.
- ▶ Ohio State is 8-5 so far in one-goal games this season. Among the one-goal wins are overtime victories vs. Minnesota Dec. 6 and Army West Point Jan. 4, third-period gamewinners at Penn State Nov. 23 and vs. Colgate Dec. 27 and a GWG with less than two minutes left vs. Michigan Nov. 2.
- ▶ The Buckeyes are second in the NCAA with nine gamewinning goals scored in the third period and overtime combined and are tied for second in the nation with seven third-period gamewinners.

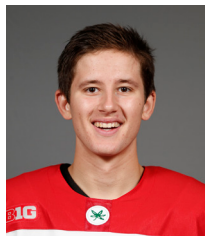

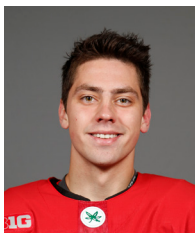

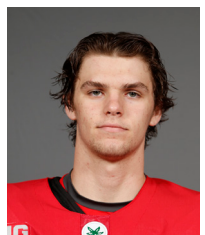
