NOTABLES

>> For the seventh-straight week, the Penn State women's volleyball team has earned the No. 1 ranking in the American Volleyball Coaches Association and the Nittany Lions have earned all 64 votes for a unanimous selection. They are the first team this season that has received all 64 votes.

>> The marks the 73rd week the Nittany Lions have been at No. 1 in the poll since the end of the 2006 season, and the 97th time in the history of the poll. The Nittany Lions' first No. 1 Ranking came on Sept. 2, 1997, and the poll was started in 1982.

>> Penn State has racked up 12 Big Ten weekly awards as Simone Lee has a Player and Defensive honor to her name, while Haleigh Washington has picked up five Player of the Week honors, Kendall White has earned three Defensive Player of the Week awards, Ali Frantti snagged a Player of the Week honor, and Tori Gorrell closed out the season with a Defensive Player of the Week mark.

>> Against Rutgers (11/18), Simone Lee set a Penn State record for hitting percentage. The Penn State record required a minimum of 20 attempts, and the outside put down 17 kills with one error on 20 swings for an .800 clip to set the record.

>> Haleigh Washington is hitting the nation's best .515, which is on pace to be the 2nd best hitting percentage from 2008-Present in a season.

>> Washington is also on pace to have one of the top-three career hitting percentages in NCAA history (.461).

>> Simone Lee and Haleigh Washington are two of the 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award

>> Haleigh Washington was named CoSIDA Academic All-District for 2017. She has two CoSIDA Academic All-American honors to her name, and is now looking for a third.

>> Penn State has three active 1,000 kill club members as Ali Frantti was the first on Aug. 26 at West Virginia, and Simone Lee followed on Oct. 6 at Ohio State, and Haleigh Washington eclipsed the mark on Oct. 21 at Indiana. The last time Penn State had three active 1,000 kill club members was in 2008. Entering the season, Megan Hodge and Nicole Fawcett were already past the mark, but on Sept. 5, 2008, Christa Harmotto joined the club as well

>> Haleigh Washington became the 7th athlete in Penn State volleyball lore to reach 1,000 kills and 500 blocks on Oct. 25. She was the first in seven seasons to reach 500 blocks, as the last to achieve this feat was Arielle Wilson (2007-10).

>> Twice this season, the Nittany Lions have had four players with double-digit kills. Against Stanford (9/1): Abby Detering (11k), Ali Frantti (10k), Haleigh Washington (10k), and Simone Lee (11k), and against Purdue (10/20): Ali Frantti (15k), Heidi Thelen (14k), Simone Lee (13k), and Haleigh Washington (10k).

>>Senior Abby Detering recorded the program's first triple double against then-No. 1 Stanford on Sept. 1, Detering posted a career-high 11 while also dishing out 23 assists and scooping up 10 digs. She added four blocks in the affair as well.

>> White is just the third Nittany Lions to be honored as the Defensive Player of the Week three times in a single season by the Big Ten league office. She joins Katie Slay and Kaleena Walters, who each recorded seasons with three or more honors. Slay, who finished with eight career honors, earned three in the 2012 season, and Walters earned all four of her career honors during the 2005 season.

>> Washington will finish her career with a program-high ten Player of the Week honors, which is good for second in Big Ten history, as she is just the second player to reach double-figure honors, trailing Stacey Gordon (OSU, 2001-04) who finished with 16.

>> Haleigh Washington enters the NCAA Tournament as the active career leader in hitting percentage with 0.462 ... She is currently fourth in career total blocks (551) and eighth in blocks per set (1.31).

>> The Nittany Lions are one of only two NCAA Division I women's volleyball programs to compete in all 36 NCAA Tournaments since 1981. In tournament play, the Nittany Lions own a 94-29 all-time record, having made 12 appearances in the final four.

>> Since 2007, Penn State has made more appearances in the national semifinals than any other program. PSU has participated in eight of the last 10 final fours.

>> Having never lost a first round matchup, the Nittany Lions are regular contenders in the later rounds of the event. Russ Rose has guided his tournament teams to a total of 10 appearances in the national final. In the 2014 national final, Penn State captured a straight-set victory against BYU for its sixth National Championship in a span of eight years. PSU has not lost an NCAA title match since 1998. The BYU victory also marked the third time in history Penn State swept its national final opponent.

PACKING REC HALL ONCE AGAIN

Penn State closed out the regular season as one of the nation's leaders in attendance, ranking top five in the country with an average of 3,696 fans per match as of Nov. 29, 2017, almost 300 more people than the 2016 season (Figures provided by the NCAA). Penn State highlighted the year so far with a sold out crowd of 6,305 against Maryland on Nov. 11, 2017. Rec Hall was packed to the brim, with standing room only.

The Big Ten has nine schools in the top-25, and holds four of the top five slots, proving to be one of the biggest environments in the nation.

LAST TIME VS. HOWARD

Sept. 17, 2016 - PSU, 3-0; 25-16, 25-12, 25-16

The Nittany Lions had a balanced attack, with four players posting seven or more kills in the match. Outside hitter Simone Lee led the way for Penn State, this time with 12 kills. Haleigh Washington posted eight kills on .467 hitting while tacking on a team-best four blocks.

The duo of Ali Frantti and Heidi Thelen each posted seven kills. Frantti tacked on six digs and two blocks, while Thelen put up a pair of blocks as well.

Penn State holds a 3-0 advantage in the all-time series against Howard and has the same record for matches played at home in Rec Hall.

LAST TIME VS. PITT

Dec. 3, 2016 - PSU, 3-1; 20-25, 25-16, 25-13, 25-18

Penn State rallied after dropping the first set behind a strong blocking performance at the net. Penn State posted 13.0 blocks to Pitt's 5.5, with five players tallying multiple rejections to help account for the steep margin. The block also helped to force 28 errors from the Panthers.

Middle blocker Haleigh Washington had a standout performance, logging team bests in both kills (14) and blocks (six). She added a dig and an assist.

Penn State holds a 3-0 advantage in the all-time series against Howard and has the same record for matches played at home in Rec Hall.

Classmate Simone Lee tied Washington's team-best kills output and came a dig shy of her fourth career double-double with nine. She tacked on a pair of blocks as well.

Fellow outside Ali Frantti posted 11 kills to round out the players finishing with double-figure kills.

Penn State moved to a 31-17 advantage in the all-time series against Pittsburgh and 17-3 in matches played at home in Rec Hall.

LAST TIME VS. VCU

Sept. 4, 2010 - PSU, 3-0; 25-13, 25-12, 25-12

Setter Kristin Carpenter (Mechanicsville, Va.) led a balanced offense attack with 39 assists. Three Nittany Lions tallied double-digit kills, including McClendon and junior Katie Kabbes (Raleigh, N.C.) who had 13 kills apiece, and Brown who had 12. Senior libero Alyssa D'Errico (Byron, N.Y.) had a match-high 17 digs, while freshman Katie Slay (Raleigh, N.C.) posted a team-best four blocks.

Penn State attacked at a .422 clip totaling 49 kills, 46 assists, five aces, 50 digs and 7.0 total team blocks. The Nittany Lions held the Rams to just .053 hitting, 21 kills, 21 assists, one ace, 25 digs and 4.0 team blocks.

The Nittany Lions hold a 4-1 all-time record over the Rams and are currently on a four-match winning streak against them.
