### **OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**Chris Nugent – Penn State – 6-4 – OH – Junior – Fair Lawn, N.J.**

Junior Chris Nugent has been selected as the EIVA Offensive Player of the Week for the second consecutive week. Nugent led #9 Penn State to a 3-0 sweep of #14 Saint Francis (Pa.) on the road in EIVA play last week with 15 kills (5 kills/set) on a .370 attacking percentage. Chris also added one service ace while adding five digs and a block on the defensive end. This is the second EIVA Offensive Player of the Week selection for Nugent in 2016.
