THE OPENING TIP

Michigan State's men's basketball hits the road again this week for its first Big Ten Conference road game of the season, at Penn State on Wednesday, Dec. 7 (6:30 p.m., BTN) ... The Spartans have lost their last two games and are coming off a 70-63 loss at home to Northwestern in the Big Ten opener for both teams ... Since the start of the regular season, the Spartans have played seven of their 10 games away from home ... MSU played three ranked teams, including two in the top-5 (Gonzaga and Kentucky), and traveled to San Diego, Indianapolis, Oregon and South Bend, racking up more than 10,000 miles of travel during the team's first eight games ... Following the game on Wednesday night, the Spartans will three games (Brown, Oakland and Buffalo) in the next 22 days ... Per KenPom.com, Michigan State has faced the 4th-toughest slate of opposing offenses in the country, the 16th-toughest slate of opposing defenses and ranks No. 8 overall in strength of schedule.

Second season at MSU after transfer from Northeastern ... 12th in the Big Ten in scoring ... Leads the Big Ten in minutes played (37.0 mpg) ... 9th in league in assists and 5th in assist/turnover ratio (2.8; 4.0 apg, 1.4 tpg) ... Season-best 8 assists vs. Oregon.

Made his first career start against Alabama in the opening game of the Phil Knight Invitational ... Career-high 15 points against Oregon on Friday, matched with 15 vs. Portland ... Averaging 10.5 ppg last 4 ... Career-best 9 rebounds vs. Alabama.

Scored 23 points had had 8 rebounds in win over Kentucky ... 11th in the B1G in rebounding ... 3-point percentage (44.2%) leads the team and 13th in the B1G in 3-pointers made (2.1/game) ... 4th in B1G in minutes played.

Scored 16 points, including 7 points in the second overtime, and had 8 rebounds in win over Kentucky ... Also added two assists and 3 steals ... Career-high 9 rebounds against Gonzaga ... Four games with at least 10 points ... Averaging 9.0 ppg, 5.7 rpg last 4.

THE STARTING FIVE

1. The Nation's Toughest November

Like they did at the start of the 2016-17 season, Michigan State began the 2022-23 season with arguably one of the toughest opening months in college basketball ... In 2016-17, the Spartans faced No. 1 Duke, No. 2 Kentucky and No. 10 Arizona ... This year, the Spartans squared off against three ranked teams during the month of November, beating No. 4 Kentucky and dropping games to then-No. 2 Gonzaga and then-No. 18 Alabama ... Two other opponents were ranked in the Associated Press Preseason Top 25 (Villanova and Oregon) ... In addition, the Spartans closed out play in the Phil Knight Invitational by playing Portland in its home arena, though MSU was listed as the home team for the contest ... Since 2009-10, Michigan State was one of only six teams (including that 2016-17 team) scheduled to play at least four AP ranked opponents in the month of November ... Michigan State was the ONLY team to play two teams in the top 4, with No. 2 Gonzaga on Nov. 11 (64-63 loss) and No. 4 Kentucky on Nov. 15 in the Champions Classic in Indianapolis (an 86-77 win). 2. Series History

Michigan State leads the all-time series with Penn State, 42-10 ... The Spartans have won 25 of the last 31 games in the series, including 13 of the last 16. » Tom Izzo is 35-9 in his career against Penn State ... Michigan State is 16-5 in games played at Penn State, but the Nittany Lions won last year's meeting, 62-58.

3. Michigan State Falls to Northwestern in Big Ten Opener

Michigan State fell behind by nine points in the second half and cut the Northwestern lead to one in the final minute but could not get closer as the Spartans lost their Big Ten Conference opener, 70-63, at the Breslin Center on Sunday night ... Junior guard A.J. Hoggard came off the bench and led the way with 12 points, eight assists and six rebounds, while junior forward Mady Sissoko scored 12 points, had two rebounds three blocks and graduate forward Joey Hauser added 10 points and eight rebounds.

4. About the Spartans

Michigan State enter the game on Sunday with a 5-4 overall record after facing one of the nation's toughest schedules during the opening month of the season ... MSU has faced the 4th-toughest slate of opposing offenses in the country, the 16th-toughest slate of opposing defenses and ranks No. 8 overall in strength of schedule, per KenPom.com. ... Through nine games, senior guard Tyson Walker leads the team in scoring with 14.4 ppg, while adding 3.0 rpg and 4.0 apg ... He is one of four players scoring in double figures ... Graduate forward Joey Hauser is second on the team in scoring with 13.2 points per game, shooting 44.1 percent from the floor and 44.2 percent from 3-point land ... Senior forward Malik Hall is third on the team with 12.0 ppg and third with 5.3 rpg ... Junior guard A.J. Hoggard is fourth on the team with 11.6 ppg, fourth with 4.1 rpg and leads the team (and is third in the Big Ten) with 6.3 assists per game ... Three other players are averaging at least 6.0 points ... Sophomore Pierre Brooks, who has started the last five games, is averaging 7.9 points and 2.8 rebounds ... Junior forward Mady Sissoko, who scored 16 points and had eight rebounds in the win over Kentucky in the Champions Classic on Nov. 15, is averaging 8.0 points and is second on the team with 5.8 rebounds, while sophomore guard Jaden Akins is adding 6.0 points and 3.2 rebounds.

5. Hall and Akins Sidelined

Michigan State played without senior forward Malik Hall, a preseason All-Big Ten selection, and sophomore guard Jaden Akins for four games ... The duo missed all three games in the Phil Knight Invitational and the ACC/Big Ten Challenge at Notre Dame, with the Spartans splitting the four games ... Akins returned to the lineup against Northwestern and played 23 minutes ... The hope is for Hall to return to play around Christmastime.

**STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE**

» Any one, any time, any place and any where has always been a mantra of MSU Coach Tom Izzo.

» The Spartans annually play one of the nation's toughest schedules and this year, Izzo and the Spartans will face a gauntlet in the opening month of the season.

» In November, Michigan State faced one of its toughest schedules under Izzo, playing teams ranked No. 2 (Gonzaga) and No. 4 (Kentucky) in the country in the first three games and then squared off against three other teams (Villanova, No. 16; Alabama - No. 20; and Oregon - No. 21) that appeared in the Associated Press Preseason Top 25.

» Michigan State's opening slate included a win at Portland in the home arena of the Pilots and among its first eight games, the Spartans played six against teams from high-power conferences.

» MSU has faced the 4th-toughest slate of opposing offenses in the country, the 16th-toughest slate of opposing defenses and ranks No. 8 overall in strength of schedule per KenPom.com.

LOGGING MILES

In the first eight games of the season, not only did Michigan State play some of the best teams in the country, the Spartans put in a lot of mileage, with a trip to San Diego to start the season, a trip to Oregon for the Phil Knight Invitational and a pair of trips to Indiana for the Champions Classic and the ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... All told, MSU logged more than 10,000 miles (10,179) of travel in November.

ABOUT THE NITTANY LIONS

» Penn State enters the game on Wednesday with a 6-2 overall record.

» This will be the Big Ten opener for the Nittany Lions, who will be playing their first game in eight days

» Penn State is 4-0 at home, with wins over Winthrop, Loyola Maryland, Butler and Lafayette.

» The team's only two losses are a 2-point neutral-site defeat to Virginia Tech and a double-overtime loss at Clemson.

» Penn State has four players scoring in double figures, with three of those top four in their fifth year in college basketball.

» Senior guard Jalen Pickett leads the team in scoring (16.1 ppg) and assists (7.6 apg) and is second on the team with 6.6 rebounds.

» Penn State leads the nation with 12.1 3-pointers made per game ... The Nittany Lions are shooting 40.4 percent (97-240) from 3-point land, which ranks No. 14 nationally.

AGAINST PENN STATE

» Michigan State leads the all-time series with Penn State, 42-10.

» The Spartans have won 25 of the last 31 games in the series, including 13 of the last 16.

» Tom Izzo is 35-9 in his career against Penn State

» Michigan State is 16-5 in games played at Penn State, but the Nittany Lions won last year's meeting, 62-58.

INDOOR - OUTDOOR

» After Michigan State's win over Kentucky in the Champions Classic, a reporter joked with graduate forward Joey Hauser that he must be glad to be back indoors after a difficult game against Gonzaga outdoors on an aircraft carrier ... Taking away the outdoor game, Hauser is shooting 46.6 percent from the floor (41-of-88) and 47.5 percent from 3-point land (19-of-40).

WALKER PASSES 1K MARK

» When senior guard Tyson Walker hit a 3-pointer in the first overtime period against Kentucky on Nov. 15 in the Champions Classic, it moved him past the 1,000-point mark for his career.

» Walker scored 680 points in two years at Northeastern (13.6 ppg in 50 career games) and now has 1,106 career points in 95 games (an 11.6 ppg career average).

WHAT'S BACK

- » Michigan State lost its top three scorers from last season, but still returned more than 50 percent (50.2% to be exact) of its scoring from last season.
- » Despite the losses of All-Big Ten selection Gabe Brown (11.6 ppg), Marcus Bingham Jr. (9.3 ppg) and second round NBA Draft pick Max Christie (9.3 ppg), the Spartans return four players – Malik Hall (8.9 ppg), Tyson Walker (8.2 ppg), Joey Hauser (7.3 ppg) and A.J. Hoggard (7.0 ppg) – who each averaged between 7 and 9 points per game.
- » The Spartans also returned more than 50 percent of their rebounds (55.1%), with second-leading rebounder Hauser (5.3 rpg) and Hall (4.6 rpg, third on the team) among the returnees.
- » The Green & White also had 80.5 percent of the team's assists back, with Hoggard (4.8 apg, #1 in the country in assist rate per KenPom.com last year) and Walker (4.3 apg) leading the way.
- » **Experience Matters** – Three Spartans – Hall, Hauser and Walker – have combined to play 296 games in their careers and started 195 games, with Hauser and Walker lead the way with 83 starts apiece.

HALL OF FAME CONNECTIONS

- » Michigan State's roster includes several players with Hall of Fame connections.
- » The Spartans have the sons of a Pro Basketball Hall of Famer (Steven Izzo) and the son of an NFL Hall of Famer (Nick Sanders, the son of long-time Detroit Lions standout Barry Sanders) on the roster.
- » Michigan State is the only school in the country with the sons of a basketball and football Hall of Famer on the roster.
- » Add in Davis Smith, whose father Steve is a Michigan State Hall of Famer, and the Spartans have three sons of Hall of Famers on the roster.

MALIK HALL SELECTED TO PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN TEAM

- » Senior forward Malik Hall was one of 11 players selected to the Preseason All-Big Ten men's basketball team on October 6.
- » It was the second career All-Big Ten honor for Hall, who was an honorable mention selection for his performance during the 2021-22 season.
- » A fourth-year senior, Hall appeared in all 36 games and started seven times, finishing fourth on the team in scoring with 8.9 points and third on the team with 4.6 rebounds with 1.1 assists per game.
- » An Academic All-Big Ten selection, Hall earned his bachelor's degree in communication and is pursuing a master's degree in sport coaching & leadership.

COACHING STAFF CHANGES

- » Head Coach Tom Izzo had positions to fill on his staff after long-time assistant Dwayne Stephens was named head coach at Western Michigan and Mike Garland announced his retirement at the end of the school year.
- » Former Michigan State men's basketball standout and graduate assistant Thomas Kelley rejoined the program as an assistant in June after spending four seasons as an assistant coach at Western Michigan.
- » Kelley started his coaching career at Michigan State in 2015-16 and the Spartans won two Big Ten Championships and reached three NCAA Tournaments during that time.
- » Kelley played at Michigan State from 1994-99 and as a fifth-year senior in 1998-99, he was part of Izzo's first Final Four team, helping to lead the Spartans to a 33-5 overall record, the No. 2 national ranking by the Associated Press and a Big Ten Championship.
- » Jon Borovich was named director of recruiting operations for the Michigan State men's basketball program in August.
- » Borovich started his coaching career at Michigan State as a graduate assistant from 2001-03 under Izzo ... Borovich comes to East Lansing after spending three seasons as an assistant coach at Northwestern. He helped lead the Wildcats to seven Big Ten wins in each of the last two seasons, the program's most in a year since the 2016-17 season.

HEAD COACH TOM IZZO

- » Now in his 28th season at Michigan State, Hall of Fame coach Tom Izzo has built the Spartans into one of the elite programs in the nation.
- » The Spartans' 24 straight NCAA Tournaments are a Big Ten record, the second-longest active streak in Division I and tied for the third-longest in NCAA history ... He's been able to accomplish this while playing more ranked teams than anyone else since 1998.
- » Michigan State has appeared in eight Final Fours since 1999, the most in the nation.

COACHING STABILITY

- » Michigan State has had just two basketball coaches in the last 46 seasons and three in the last 53 ... Tom Izzo is in his 28th season, having taking over from his mentor Jud Heathcote, who spent 19 years as head coach (1976-95).
- » Before Heathcote, Gus Ganakas spent seven seasons as head coach ... The late Ganakas provided commentary on Spartan radio broadcasts for 31 seasons before his passing in 2019.

IZZO PASSES KNIGHT FOR ALL-TIME OVERALL BIG TEN WIN RECORD

- » When Michigan State beat Maryland in the regular season finale last season, the win was the 663rd for Head Coach Tom Izzo.
- » The win moved Izzo past former Indiana coach Bob Knight for the Big Ten record for overall wins by a league coach with at least 10 years in the conference ... He tied Knight when the Spartans beat Purdue on Feb. 26.
- » Knight won 662 games in 29 years in Bloomington (662-240, .734) ... Izzo has a career record of 666-267 (.714) ... Knight is the all-time leader for Big Ten Conference wins (353), with Izzo second at 322.

SPARTANS SHARE THE BALL

» Unselfishness has always been a trademark of all Tom Izzo teams.
 » That has been especially true for nearly the last decade as MSU established the top-five school record for assists during that span.
 » In 2018-19, the Spartans led the country in total assists and handed out the second-most in a single season in MSU history (715), recording an assist on 66.8 percent of their field goals that season.
 » In 2017-18, MSU led the country in assists per game (19.1) and handed out 670, then the second-best mark in program history.
 » In 2015-16, MSU tallied a school record 719 assists, good for the 22nd-best total in NCAA history ... MSU's nation's-best assist average of 20.5 was the 23rd-best average in NCAA history.
 » ***This year, the Spartans have handed out at least 20 two times and at least 15 on six occasions, and averaged 15.4 per game (6th in the Big Ten) ... MSU ranked No. 33 nationally per KenPom in Assist Rate at 59.9% (139 assists on 232 made field goals).***

POINT OF ATTACK

» Junior Tyson Walker and sophomore A.J. Hoggard split the point guard duties last season, with Walker starting 28 games and averaging 22.6 mpg while Hoggard averaging 20.3 and started the final eight games of the season.
 » In 36 games last year, the duo combined to average 15.2 points, 9.1 assists, 3.6 rebounds and 1.9 steals per game.
 » Through nine games this year, the duo has combined to average 26.0 points, 10.3 assists and 7.1 rebounds per game.
 » ***Hoggard ranked No. 1 in the country in Assist Rate (46.1%) per KenPom last year, while Walker was No. 14 nationally (36.0%).***

DEFENSIVE MINDED

» One of the mantras for Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo has always been to Defend, Rebound and Run ... The Spartans rank No. 67 nationally in the KenPom Adjusted Defensive Efficiency ratings.
 » MSU has held two opponents to fewer than 65 points and had held Kentucky to 63 through regulation.

DEFEND, REBOUND, RUN

» Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo has always said that if his teams can defend and rebound, it will lead to positives.
 » The Spartans have led the Big Ten in rebounding 10 times in the last 19 years and led the nation in rebounding four times (in 2009, 2010, 2016 and 2019) since 2009.
 » In 2019-20, MSU led the Big Ten in rebounding offense (40.6 rpg) and tied for the league lead in rebounding margin (+7.5 rebounds) ... That same year, the Spartans led the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense, limiting opponents to 37.9 percent shooting.
 » ***In 2021-22, the Spartans were 4th in rebounding offense (36.9 rpg) and 4th in rebounding margin (+4.2 rpg) overall ... In B1G games, Michigan State was 6th in rebounding offense (35.1) and 5th in rebounding margin (+2.8).***

GRADUATE MATTERS

Four players on the MSU roster are already pursuing graduate degrees ... Seniors Malik Hall and Steven Izzo graduated in three years, joining Joey Hauser and Jason Whitens in pursuing master's degrees.

MICHIGAN STATE TO HONOR TWO FORMER PLAYERS

» Michigan State will wear patches this season to honor two former players who passed away in the past year, Adreian Payne and Stanley Washington.
 » Washington, who passed away on July 12 at 78-years-old, played at Michigan State from 1963-66 ... He finished his career at Michigan State ranked second all-time in scoring at the school and is currently 31st all-time with 1,242 points in 69 games over three seasons, averaging 18.0 points per game
 » He still ranks sixth all-time in scoring average (18.0 ppg), his 10.5 rebounds per game during his career ranks fifth all-time and he is ninth all-time in free throw percentage, connecting on 81.5 percent of his shots (278-of-341).
 » Payne, a 2014 NBA First Round pick of the Atlanta Hawks, left Michigan State in 2014 as one of nine players in program history with 1,200 career points (1,232) and 700 career rebounds (735), while also ranking as the school's all-time leader in blocked shots (141) at the time.
 » As a senior in 2014, he averaged 16.4 points and 7.3 rebounds as an All-Big Ten Second Team selection, while also earning USBWA and NABC All-District accolades as well as honorable mention Associated Press All-America honors.
 » He was selected to the Big Ten All-Tournament and the NCAA East Regional All-Tournament teams as the Spartans captured the 2014 Big Ten Tournament title and advanced to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament.
 » His postseason included a 41-point performance against Delaware in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, establishing many school records, including the most points ever by an Izzo-coached Spartan and the most points ever by a Spartan in the NCAA Tournament.



MEN'S BASKETBALL ADDS FOUR ON SIGNING DAY IN CLASS THAT RANKS AMONG NATION'S BEST

Michigan State's men's basketball team has received signed National Letters of Intent from Xavier Booker, Coen Carr, Jeremy Fears and Gehrig Normand. The Spartans recruiting class has been recognized nationally as one of the best in the country, ranked No. 3 by Rivals, No. 3 by 247 Sports and No. 5 by ON3 Sports. All four players are ranked among the top-55 nationally by ON3 Sports.

"As we get ready to go on our trip to San Diego, nothing is more exciting than having the four players that my staff did such a job recruiting and my players did a good job," Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo said. "We got four guys that are "OKG" – Our Kinda Guys. They were guys that get along, they kind of united together, all four of them spent a lot of time talking to each other. Coen Carr was the last one, Gehrig (Normand) from down in Texas, he was one of the early ones. Of course Book (Xavier Booker) down in Indianapolis is the, I guess, marquee in the class, but Jeremy Fears is probably the ringmaster. He's the Mateen Cleaves, the Magic Johnson of the bunch. He just brings a unity and a confidence. He's an extroverted personality who I think will fit in here very well."

Listed as the No. 1 recruit in the country by Rivals ... Also carries three top-20 selections, No. 3 by ESPN, No. 6 by 247 Sports and No. 9 by On3 Sports ... The No. 1 rated (Rivals, ESPN) or No. 2 (247 Sports, On3 Sports) at his position ... The highest-ranked recruit to commit to Michigan State under Head Coach Tom Izzo, per 247 Sports ... Coached by Jason Delaney at Cathedral High School ... As a junior, averaged 12.5 points and 6.7 rebounds while shooting 36.0 percent from 3-point land ... Had 19 points, 14 rebounds and nine blocked shots against Ben Davis in the Indiana state tournament ... Plays for the George Hill All-Indy AAU team, coached by Mike Saunders ... Coached by Barney Jackson at Legacy Early College ... Played his first two seasons at Dutchtown High School in Hampton, Ga. ... Named to the GBCBA First Team All-County squad in 2022 ... Plays for the Georgia Stars AAU ... A member of the USA Basketball 3x3 U18 World Cup Team.

Jeremy Fears Jr. (6-2, 185, F – Joliet, Ill. / Joliet West)

The first player of the class to commit to MSU ... Tabbed No. 33 in his class by 247 Sports ... Also ranked No. 34 by ESPN, No. 37 from Rivals and No. 54 from On3 Sports ... Among point guards, he is ranked No. 8 by 247 Sports and On3 Sports, No. 9 by ESPN and No. 11 by Rivals ... Plays at Joliet West High School ... Spent his sophomore and junior years playing at LaLumiere in LaPorte, Ind. ... Helped lead LaLumiere to a 21-5 record in 2021-22, averaging 8.5 points and 4.1 assists ... Plays for Bradley Beal Elite and the Indy Heat AAU ... Has USA Basketball experience, playing on the U17 team that won the gold medal at the 2022 FIBA U17 Basketball World Cup ... Scored 17 points in the semifinals vs. Lithuania ... Had 18 points and six assists in the final versus host Spain ... Averaged 9.9 points, 2.9 rebounds and 4.4 assists ... Among shooting guards, Normand is ranked No. 8 at Rivals, No. 9 by On3 Sports, No. 20 by 247 Sports and No. 24 by ESPN ... Played for Anthony Holman at Birdville High School ... Averaged 11.8 points, 6.3 rebounds, 4.3 assists as a junior ... Helped lead Birdville to a 23-11 record, including a 12-game win streak, as the team won the District 6-5A Championship ... Also plays for the 3D Empire AAU, coached by Shawn Ward.

Coach Izzo

In his 28th year, Tom Izzo (Northern Michigan, '77) is 671-271 (.712), and 322-153 (.678) in the Big Ten, as the head coach of the Michigan State basketball program. He ranks as the winningest coach in Michigan State history, having passed his mentor Jud Heathcote with his 341st career victory on Nov. 28, 2009. In his 27-plus seasons as a head coach, Izzo has captured eight National Coach of the Year awards, including the Clair Bee Award in 2005 and NABC honors in 2001 and 2012. In 1999, Izzo was named National Coach of the Year by Basketball Times, while earning similar honors from The Associated Press, Basketball News and the USBWA in '98. He also earned National Coach of the Year accolades from CBSSports.com in 2012. He earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in 1998, 2009 and 2012. Izzo was enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on September 9, 2016, cementing his status as one of the game's all-time greats.

Among The Big Ten's Best

Tom Izzo's .678 winning percentage in Big Ten games ranks fourth all-time among league coaches with at least 10 years of service, behind former Wisconsin coach Bo Ryan (.717), former Indiana coach Bob Knight (.700), and former Purdue coach Ward Lambert (.685). In all games, Ohio State's Thad Matta ranks first at .748, followed by Ryan (.737), Knight (.734), Izzo (.712) and Wisconsin's Walter Meanwell (.712), and Lambert (.709). With 322 conference victories, Izzo ranks second all time. When MSU beat Maryland on March 6, 2022, Izzo reached 663 wins, passing Knight (662) for most overall wins as a head coach at a Big Ten school.

Izzo Among Best Ever

Through his first 27 seasons, Tom Izzo won 666 games, ranking fifth in college basketball history for most wins by a college coach in his first 27 years.

Final Fours

Tom Izzo led MSU to eight Final Four appearances between 1999 and 2019, becoming just the fourth school in college basketball history to do it in any 21-year span, including just the third since the tournament field expanded to 64 teams in 1985. Izzo's eight Final Fours are the most by any coach since his first season in 1996 and he ranks fifth all-time, including third among active coaches. The eight Final Fours are also the most by any Big Ten coach.
