No. 14 Penn State Nittany Lions



Nittany Lion Preview

The 14th-ranked Penn State men's volleyball team returns home to conclude the regular season on April 19-20. The Nittany Lions host Rutgers-Newark and NJIT. Both matches are set February for 5:30 p.m. starts in the South Gym of Rec Hall.

Penn State visited Concordia and No. 4 UC Irvine on April 12-13 and went 1-1 with a 3-1 win against the Eagles, but a 3-0 setback to the Anteaters. Redshirt sophomore Nick Goodell (Ambridge, Pa.) led Penn State with 4.00 kills per set, while sophomore Aaron Russell (Ellicott City, Md.) averaged 3.00 per set. Redshirt freshman Taylor Hammond (Mission Viejo, Calif.) posted 8.29 assists per set, while Goodell led the team at the service line with 0.86 aces per set. Goodell and Russell were the team's top defenders with 1.57 and 1.43 digs per set, respectively. Senior lan Hendries (Cardiff, Calif.) had a team-best 1.33 blocks per set and redshirt freshman Matt Seifert (Reading, Pa.) was second on the team with 1.00 blocks per set.

Against Concordia and UC Irvine Penn State hit .204 and averaged 10.57 kills, 9.29 assists, 1.57 aces, 6.71 digs per set and 2.64 blocks per set.

Penn State vs. Rutgers-Newark

Penn State has an 85-24-1 all-time record against the Scarlet Raiders. Earlier this season on March 1, the Nittany Lions visited Rutgers-Newark. Penn State came away with a 3-0 (25-13, 25-20, 25-19).

Scouting the Scarlet Raiders

Rutgers-Newark owns a 4-19 record this season and has not won any EIVA matches at 0-12. The Scarlet Raiders most recently defeated Lesley and Southern Vermont on March 29-30, but have since lost four consecutive matches.

Manuel Felipez leads the Scarlet Raiders with a 3.37 kills per set average. Kevin McCandless averages 6.69 assists per set, while Adrian Lopez has 5.10 assists per set. Felipez is also Rutgers-Newark's top defensive player with 1.57 digs per set. At the net, Travis Mintzer has a team-high 0.65 blocks per set.

Penn State vs. NJIT

Penn State owns a 31-1 record against NJIT. Penn State traveled to Newark, N.J. to take on the Highlanders on March 2. The Nittany Lions secured a 3-0 (25-22, 25-17, 25-13) win against NJIT.

Scouting the Highlanders

NJIT is 7-19 this season and 4-8 in the EIVA. The Highlanders have won three of their last four matches, including EIVA wins against Rutgers-Newark and Sacred Heart. NJIT visits Saint Francis on April 19 before taking on the Nittany Lions.

Sophomore opposite Kajetan Borecki and sophomore outside Chris Kaepernick lead the Highlanders offensively with 2.36 and 2.30 kills per set, respectively. Senior Matthew Lui and sophomore Zak Robben share setting duties and have averaging 7.78 and 6.74 assists per set, respectively. Senior libero Brady Smith is NJIT's top back row player with 2.54 digs per set, while senior opposite Doug Battersby is the leader at the net with 0.78 blocks per set.

Weekend Recap

Penn State went 1-1 on April 12-13 with a 3-1 win at Concordia and a 3-0 loss to No. 4 UC Irvine. Redshirt sophomore Nick Goodell led the team with 28 kills, while sophomore Aaron Russell tallied 21. Redshirt freshman Taylor Hammond dished out 58 assists. Goodell was Penn State's top server with six aces and also led the team in digs with 11. Russell added 10 digs, while senior Ian Hendries had a team-high eight blocks.

What's Next?

Penn State earned the No. 1 seed for the EIVA Tournament and will host the two-day event on April 25 and 27. Matches on April 25 are set for 5:30 and 7:30 p.m., while Saturday's championship match is set for a 7 p.m. start.

Nittany Lions Secure 29th EIVA Championship

Penn State had earned at least a share of the EIVA title after defeating Princeton and George Mason on March 29-30 to improve to 11-1 in the league. An outright claim on the title required another EIVA win by the Nittany Lions or a Harvard loss. George Mason dealt Harvard a 3-1 loss on Saturday, April 6 to give Penn State its 29th conference crown since 1976. This is the 18th time under head coach Mark Pavlik that the Nittany Lions have won the regular season title. Penn State earned the No. 1 seed and will host the 2013 EIVA Championship on April 25 and 27.

Russell Tabbed EIVA Offensive Player of the Week

Sophomore Aaron Russell was honored as the EIVA Offensive Player of the Week on April 1. This is the third honor of the season for Russell. Russell helped lead the Nittany Lions to league wins against Princeton and George Mason. He combined for a team-high 35 kills, averaging 3.89 kills per set with a .286 hitting percentage. He also had a team-best four aces, nine digs and three blocks on hiw was to 40.5 points for the weekend.

Seifert Pounds Career High in Kills

5 Redshirt freshman Matt Seifert was one of three Nittany Lions to post double-digit kills at 15 IPFW on March 9. He finished third on the team with 11 kills, a personal best, and also tied for first on the team with three blocks. Seifert went on to post six kills and two blocks at Ball 9 State on March 10.

Russell and Seifert Garner EIVA Weekly Awards

Sophomore Aaron Russell and redshirt freshman Matt Seifert picked up EIVA Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week awards, respectively. The duo helped guide the Nittany Lions to EIVA wins against George Mason and Princeton on Feb. 22-23. Russell led the Nittany Lions with 35 kills with a .329 hitting percentage. He was second on the team in blocks with eight, averaging 1.00 per set and tallied three aces and nine digs. Seifert was unstoppable at the net combining for 13 total blocks for the weekend. He averaged 1.86 blocks per set. Seifert also posted 12 kills on .350 hitting, with two digs and an ace.

Nittany Lions Sweep EIVA Awards

Junior Peter Russell and redshirt sophomore Connor Curry earned EIVA Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week laurels, respectively, on Jan. 28. The pair led Penn State to wins against Loyola-Chicago, Sacred Heart and Harvard. Russell hit .358 for the week and totaled 26 kills, four aces, 13 digs and eight blocks. Curry combined for 29 digs, averaging 2.64 digs per set. His effective passing helped Penn State hit .240 for the week.

Russell and Curry Earn EIVA Weekly Honors

Two Nittany Lions were named EIVA Players of the Week. Redshirt sophomore Connor Curry was named the EIVA Defensive Player of the Week, while sophomore Aaron Russell was named the EIVA Offensive Player of the Week on Jan. 14. The duo helped Penn State to a 2-1 record in the Outrigger Invitational.

Russell, who was named to the Outrigger All-Tournament Team, led the Lions offensively with 42 kills and 45.0 points. He finished second on the team with 22 digs, averaging 1.69 per set and had a team-best 3.23 kills per set on .295 hitting. Curry was the starting libero for all three matches in Honolulu. He posted a team-high 29 digs (2.23 per set) and also had six assists. His effective passing helped Penn State hit .296 for the week.

Two members of the Penn State men's volleyball team earned spots on the Outrigger Invitational All-Tournament Team. Sophomore Aaron Russell and redshirt-freshman Taylor Hammond were Penn State's honorees. They joined Ohio State's Michael Henchy, Hawaii's JP Marks and Matthew Cheape, as well as Robert Page and the Most Outstanding Player Dane Worley of UCLA.

Men's Volleyball Debuts at No. 8 in AVCA Div. I-II Preseason Coaches Poll

The Penn State men's volleyball team debuted in the 2013 AVCA Division I-II Preseason Coaches Poll at No. 8. The Nittany Lions face six teams in 2013 that are ranked in this year's preseason poll, including No. 6 UCLA, No. 11 Ohio State, No. 5 Lewis, No. 10 Loyola-Chicago and No. 14 George Mason. Hawaii, Penn State's second opponent in the Outrigger Invitational, received votes in the preseason poll.

Russell Named Off the Block Preseason All-American

Sophomore Aaron Russel was named to the Off the Block Preseason First Team All-America Team for Division I-II. He was one of 20 players nationwide selected to the teams. A total of 10 players were named Preseason First Team and Preseason Second Team All-Americans. Players from 11 different programs were picked. Russell helped guide Penn STate to a 23-6 overall record in 2012, including a 14-0 record in EIVA action. He was a 2012 Third Team Volleyball Magazine All-American, a First Team All-EIVA honoree and was named to the EIVA Champion-ship All-Tournament team.
