NCAA TOURNAMENT SECOND ROUND UPDATE

- The senior class of Talia East, Ariel Edwards and Maggie Lucas claimed their 100th career win with the victory over Wichita State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, which is tied for second in school history. Fellow senior Dara Taylor, a two-year transfer from Maryland, has been on the roster for 75 of those wins.
- The senior class is 100-30 (.769), which is tied for second with Class of 1992-95. The Class of 1994 leads with a 103-18 record.
- The Lady Lion seniors account for 74.7% of Penn State's points (1,690 of 2,263) this season and 46.5% of PSU's rebounds (620 of 1,334).
- Senior guard/forward Ariel Edwards became the 36th member of Penn State's 1,000-point club with a 17-point performance against Wichita State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- In the last five games, Edwards is averaging a team-best 21.2 points and 5.8 rebounds with a 51.9% shooting
- · Senior center Talia East rejected a pair of shots against Wichita State to become the eighth player in school history with 100 career blocks.
- · East also posted her fifth career double-double and first in an NCAA Tournament game with 13 points and a season-best 13 rebounds against the Shockers.
- The double-digit rebounding effort was East's third in her last four NCAA Tournament games.
- In her last four NCAA Tournament games, East is averaging 10.8 rebounds per game.
- Senior guard Maggie Lucas was 3-for-4 from the free throw line against WSU, which propelled into first place on Penn State's single-season free throws made chart. Lucas' 177 freebies this season break Tyra Grant's mark of 176 set during the 2009-10 season.
- Lucas finished with 22 points against Wichita State for her 17th 20-point performance of the season and 64th
- The 22-point effort is the third 20-point performance in the NCAA Tournament for Lucas.
- Lucas moved into the Top 60 in NCAA history in scoring with 2,482 career points, which is 57th all-time.
- · Additionally, Lucas moved into a tie for fifth place on school season scoring list with 644 points. She also scored 644 points in the 2012-13 season.
- Senior guard Dara Taylor needs two dimes to reach the 500-assist plateau for her collegiate career.
- Penn State is 2-1 all-time against the #11 seed with wins over DePaul (1992 second round; 77-54) and Dayton (2011 - first round; 75-66) and a loss to TCU (2001 - first round; 77-75).
- The Lady Lions and Gators have split the only two meetings between the teams.
- Penn State won the series opener, 91-67, on Jan. 8, 2000 at home, but dropped a 92-79 decision at Gainesville on Dec. 3, 2000.

- · PSU is 5-5 all-time when serving as the three seed.
- The Lady Lions have won 10 of their last 11 home NCAA Tournament games.
- Penn State is 18-5 overall record in NCAA Tournament games.
