Nittany Lions Close Out 17-Game Road Swing at East Carolina: Penn State Baseball will close out a 17-game road schedule to open the season with a three-game series at East Carolina this weekend. The Nittany Lions are coming off a tough 2-6 spring break trip, where they earned victories over Samford and UAB. Sophomore Joe Kurrasch, junior John Walter and junior Steven Hill will start on the mound for the Nittany Lions this weekend. Kurrasch will be making his first career start in a Penn State uniform.

Most Recently: In Penn State's 6-5 victory over UAB this past Sunday to snap its six-game losing streak, senior Jordan Steranka hit an RBI single in the top of the ninth inning to put the Nittany Lions in line to pick up the win. The Pittsburgh native also hit a two-run homer in the game. Freshman Casey Kulina entered the game in the ninth inning and got in a bases loaded jam with nobody out. The freshman turned in a gutsy performance and struck out the side to pick up the save. Hill had arguably the best start for a Nittany Lion starter this season, as he went 7.2 innings, giving up three earned runs. Hill fanned three batters and did not walk anybody. Sophomore Greg Welsh came in to relieve Hill and picked up the win.

What's Next: Following the three-game set with East Carolina, the Nittany Lions open the 2012 home season at Medlar Field on March 21 against Pittsburgh at 3:35. It will be "Dollar Dog Night" at the ballpark. Penn State will open Big Ten play on March 23 against Indiana in the beginning of a three-game series. All fans in attendance will receive a free schedule magnet.

Scouting East Carolina: East Carolina enters this weekend's series with a 11-4 overall record and is coming off an 18-11 barn burning loss over Virginia Commonwealth. Nevertheless, the Pirates have won six of its last eight games. East Carolina faced Purdue once earlier this season, losing 6-4 to the Boilermakers, who cracked the Baseball America Top 25 earlier this week. The Pirates are hitting a solid .289 as a team and are led by Corey Thompson, who sports a .367 batting average with two homers, 12 RBI and three doubles. The Pirates do have a lot of power, hitting 11 home runs as a team and slugging at a .405 clip.

Steranka on a Hot Steak: Jordan Steranka has been swinging a very hot bat as of late. During his five-game hitting streak, he is hitting .429 with a homerun, four RBI and three doubles. He is slugging at a .714 clip over the span and has sported a 1.143 OPS. Steranka leads the team with a .356 overall batting average and is also tied for the team lead in home runs and doubles.

Diaper Dandies: Lately, the freshmen have stepped up into big roles for Penn State. Aaron Novak has started the last two games in right field for the Nittany Lions. On March 10 against UAB, Novak blasted a homer over the leftfield fence for his first career-hit as a Penn Stater. Novak recorded two hits in that game, which earned him a start the next day. In Penn State's win on March 11, Novak hit two singles and drove in a run to help the Lions pick up a big win over the Blazers. In addition, catcher JC Coban has started the last four games at catcher for the Nittany Lions and earned his first career RBI over Spring Break.

100 in 100 for Searer: Penn State junior shortstop Elliot Searer recorded his 100th career hit in his 100th career game on March 3 against Samford. Searer currently has 103 hits in 107 career games as a Nittany Lion.

Lewis Earns First Win as a Nittany Lion: Penn State RHP Cody Lewis hurled a nice quality start against Samford to earn his first ever win in a Penn State uniform on March 3. Lewis went six innings, giving up seven hits and just one earned run. Notably, Lewis shut down 11 of the last 13 Bulldog hitters he faced to hold Penn State's lead in check. Lewis previously played his ball at Arizona (2009) and Saddleback JC (2010). The Laguna Niguel, Calif. native was required to sit out last year due to transfer rules.

Penn State to Have at Least Four Games Televised this Season: The Nittany Lion baseball team will play in four games televised by the BTN starting with the Friday, Apr. 13 matchup against Michigan at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park. PSU's visit to Target Field to play Minnesota will air Saturday, May 5 at 3:00 p.m. as well Illinois' trip to Happy Valley on Sunday, May 13. Penn State's regular season BTN finale at Michigan State is scheduled for Saturday, May 19 at Noon. Should the Nittany Lions return to the Big Ten Tournament for a second consecutive season, their games will once again be shown live on Big Ten Network throughout the week of May 23-27.

Hill Earns Preseason Honors from College Sports Madness: Penn State junior pitcher Steven Hill has been named to the College Sports Madness Big Ten Preseason All-Conference Second Team. Hill is coming off a stellar 2011 season, as he was named Second Team All-Big Ten and Academic All-Big Ten. During 2011, Hill fired four complete games, which equals the total posted by every other Penn State pitcher since the beginning of the 2009 season. His year was

highlighted by a pair of shutouts after he blanked Northwestern, 12-0, on April 9 before firing another gem against Minnesota during a 7-0 victory on May 13. In his 15 starts last year, he posted a 6-5 record, including three wins during conference action. Hill held his opposition to three or fewer runs during 10 starts. Incredibly accurate, he averaged just 1.01 walks-per-nine innings, which stood as the 15th best rate in the nation. Overall, he issued just 12 free passes during the year.

THIS SEASON: Earned the start against West Virginia (2/18) in the Big Ten/BIG EAST Challenge ... After a slow start, settled down to strike out seven batters in just four innings of work ... Tossed 4.0 innings against UNCG, striking out seven batters for the second consecutive game ... Most quality start to this point came at Samford (3/4/12), where he went six innings, giving up one run and fanning seven batters.

AS A SOPHOMORE IN 2011: Pieced together an outstanding sophomore campaign, earning third-team All-Big Ten honors after going 6-4 with a 3.19 ERA and 59 strikeouts in 84.2 innings of work ... Held his opposition to a .234 batting average, which was the lowest mark in the conference ... Also ranked among the top-10 pitchers in wins, ERA, innings pitched, and strikeouts ... Allowed two runs or less in nine of his first 10 outings during the year ... Picked up his first win of the season after limiting NC State to one run on four hits over 5.1 innings of work on March 5 ... Continued to shine against top-notch competition after recording seven strikeouts while holding No. 26 Wichita State to just one hit over five innings on March 20 ... Posted another seven strikeouts during six shutout innings against Le Moyne on March 27 ... Put together his finest start of the season against Illinois on April 2 after setting a career-high with nine strikeouts while allowing just one run during a complete game effort ... Allowed just two runs in each of his next three starts, highlighted by a six-inning, one-hit effort against Purdue on April 17 and an eight-inning, five-strikeout performance against Ohio State on April 23 ... Earned his sixth win of the season after striking out seven while allowing just three hits over 6.2 innings against Iowa on May 7 during a nationally televised game on the Big Ten Network ... Wrapped up conference action with a 4-0 record, 3.06 ERA, and 36 strikeouts ... Started the first game of the Big Ten Tournament against Purdue, firing five innings with two strikeouts on May 25 ... Only qualifying pitcher in the Big Ten that did not allow a single home run during the year ... Honored with the Ed Drapcho Award as Penn State's most improved player ... Cut his ERA in half and allowed 12 fewer hits despite firing nearly twice as many innings as he did during his freshman campaign ... Named Third Team All-Big Ten ... Also named Academic All-Big Ten.

AS A FRESHMAN IN 2010: Saw significant action in freshman campaign, going 1-4 with a 7.95 ERA in 18 games (six starts) ... Was sixth on the squad with 43 innings pitched ... Ended the season with strong performance in the finale vs. Michigan (5/22), throwing 1.1 scoreless frames along with two strikeouts ... Allowed three runs in four innings vs. La Salle (4/27) in final start of the season ... Pitched a scoreless inning vs. Mount St. Mary's (4/21) ... Made first Big Ten start vs. Northwestern (4/11), throwing 4.2 innings while allowing four earned runs with five strikeouts, a game the Lions went out to win ...
