- » Penn State hosts NJIT and Princeton in this weekends EIVA Conference matches in Rec Hall. The Nittany Lions will face the Highlanders of NJIT on Friday at 7 p.m., followed by a Saturday February 20 matchup with the Tigers of Princeton with a first whistle slated for 7 p.m.
- » Penn State men's volleyball notched its seventh and eighth win of the season this past weekend moving to 3-0 in EIVA play in the process. Penn State downed Harvard in straight sets (25-23, 25-21, 25-21) and defeated Sacred Heart in the first four-set match of the season for the Nittany Lions (21-25, 25-22, 25-23, 25-13).
- » Penn State held steady at No. 7 in the latest AVCA Top 15 Coaches Poll. PSU has been in the top 15 the last five consecutive weeks since debuting at No. 10 in the AVCA DI-II pre-season poll. The Nittany Lions have now seen or will see a total of nine teams from the top 15 at some point during the regular season.
- » This weekend's matches against NJIT and Princeton are the beginning of an 11-game homestand at Rec Hall for the Nittany Lions. Penn State will compete at home for over a month with their next road match coming on April 1 in Princeton, N.J.
- » Penn State currently leads the EIVA with a 3-0 record in conference play. Princeton is second in the EIVA with a record of 2-0 in conference play and 2-5 overall. Geroge Mason is in thirdplace as the final team with an undefeated recordin conference play sporting a 1-0 record in
- » The Nittany Lions welcome NJIT to University Park holding a 36-1 all-time series lead over the Highlanders. Penn State's lone loss in the series came on February 19, 1998 on the road,
- » Penn State will look to continue its success against Princeton Saturday February 20th as they'll enter the match holding a 53-3 series lead over the Tigers. The Nittany Lions defeated Princetont 3-0 during their last matchup in Rec Hall back on April 29, 2015 in the EIVA semi-fi-
- » Following a 2015 season that featured Penn State men's volleyball's 17th consecutive trip the NCAA national semifinals, the Nittany Lions return a core group of nine letterwinners and three starters this year, while welcoming four freshmen to the roster
- » Penn State is ranked in the top-25 in five different team categories including top-10 rankings in Assists Per Set - 12.91 (2nd), Blocks Per Set - 2.49 (10th), and currently leads the nation in Kills Per Set - 13.60 (1st). Individually, Chris Nugent is ranked sixth in the nation in Points Per Set (4.86) and seventh in the nation in Kills Per Set (4.21), while Taylor Hammond is ranked second in the nation in Assists Per Set currently averaging 11.58.
- The 27-time defending EIVA champion Penn State men's volleyball team was selected as this year's EIVA preseason favorite. The Nittany Lions were voted to capture this year's championship crown by the league's seven head coaches, receiving six of a possible eight first-place votes in the preseason poll.
- » The Nittany Lions will square off a total of nine teams featured in the this season's AVCA preseason poll including eight teams ranked within the top 15 and two receiving votes.
- » University Park will be the site of the 2016 National Collegiate Men's Volleyball Championship, marking the sixth time in school history that Rec Hall has hosted the event. Penn State will serve as the host of the vaunted event on May 5-7, 2016. Penn State men's volleyball was selected as one of two Nittany Lion programs to host an NCAA national championship.






