BIG TEN TOURNAMENT SEMIFINAL UPDATE NO. 1 PENN STATE VS. NO. 4 MICHIGAN STATE

- The Lady Lions are 26-13 all-time against the Spartans, including a regular-season sweep this season. Penn State topped the Spartans, 71-56 on Feb. 10 at home and 76-55 in East Lansing.
- ✓ Penn State is 2-1 in Big Ten Tournament games against Michigan State.
- The Lady Lions last met the Spartans in the Big Ten Tournament in 2005 with MSU picking up with 83-76 semifinal round win.
- With the 76-66 win over Ohio State, Penn State improves to 25-16 all-time in the Big Ten Tournament, including 13-3 in quarterfinal play.
- ✓ PSU is 7-5 all-time in the semifinal round at the Big Ten Tournament.
- ▼ The Lady Lions improve to 10-4 when the No. 1 seed in the Big Ten Tournament.
- ▼ The Ohio State win marked the 25th win of the season for the Lady Lions. It is the 13th 25-win campaign in program history and the third consecutive season that Penn State reached the mark.
- ✓ This is only the second time in program history that the Lady Lions have posted three consecutive 25-win seasons, joining the 1993-94, 1994-95 and 1995-96 campaigns.
- ✓ Penn State is off to its best start in its first 29 games since the 2003-04 squad also started 25-4.
- With 18 points against Ohio State, Maggie Lucas moved into ninth place on Penn State's single-season scoring list with 593 points, passing Tanisha Wright (2004-05) for the spot.
- Lucas needs one point to tie Kahadeejah Herbert (594; 1984-85) for eighth place and four tallies to tie Tyra Grant (597; 2009-10) for seventh place on the single-season scoring list.
- Lucas needs seven points to become just the second player in school history to have 600 points in more than one season, joining Kelly Mazzante. It will also be the seventh time a player scored 600 markers in a season
- With four assists versus the Buckeyes, Alex Bentley tied Brianne O'Rourke for seventh place on Penn State's all-time helpers list with (560).
- Mia Nickson recorded her 600th rebound in a Penn State uniform with her 11-rebound night against Ohio State.
- ✓ **Nikki Greene** score her 1,100th point in a Lady Lion uniform against the Buckeyes.
- ▼ The 17 points Greene scored against OSU set a career-high for her in Big Ten Tournament games, surpassing her mark of 12 vs. Purdue on March 3, 2012.
- Bentley is now tied for eighth in Lady Lion history with 709 career field goals made, sharing the spot with Angie Potthoff.
- Greene needs 11 rebounds to move into the Top 20 on Penn State's single-season rebounding list for the third time in her career.
- Bentley was selected as the 2013 Frances Pomeroy Naismith Award winner for the nation's top female collegian 5-8 and under.
- Penn State is the 2013 Big Ten regular-season champions. The Lady Lions claim back-to-back crowns for the first time since the 2002-03 and 2003-04 teams accomplished the feat.
- ✓ The Lady Lions' 14-2 record in conference play is the best mark since the 2003-04 team went 15-1.
- Penn State is the #1 seed in the Big Ten Tournament for the sixth time in program history (1995, 2000, 2003, 2004, 2012).
- Lucas was selected as the 2013 Big Ten Player of the Year, becoming the third player in school history to earn the honor (Helen Darling, Kelly Mazzante - twice).
- ✓ Lucas and Bentley were named to the All-Big Ten first team. The Lady Lions have 28 All-Big Ten first team selections, the most of any team in the Big Ten since joining the conference in 1992-93.
- Bentley garners first team accolades for the third time in her career, making her the fifth player in PSU history to earn the honor three or more times.
- ✔ Coquese Washington was named Big Ten Coach of the Year by the media for the second-straight season.
- Greene took home third team All-Big Ten accolades from the coaches and earned an honorable mention nod by the media.
- ✓ Greene is the ONLY Lady Lion in school history with 1,000 points, 900 rebounds and 200 blocks.
- ▼ The Lady Lions are 8th in the March 4 AP and the March 5 USA Today Sports Coaches' poll.
- → Bentley and Lucas are among players named to the Wade Watch List, the Naismith Top 30 Watch List, the Wooden Award Top 20 and 2013 Ann Meyers Drysdale Award (USBWA) Midseason Watch List.
