#### SETTING THE SCENE

» Penn State men's lacrosse wraps up its spring break trip on the road, taking on Furman in a weekday matchup set for Tuesday, March 8 at Paladin Stadium. Opening faceoff between the Nittany Lions and the Paladins is set for noon. The game will also stream live on ESPN3.

» The Nittany Lions slipped to 3-2 on the year after surrendering their first road loss of the season in an 11-7 decision on the road at Penn last weekend. Senior TJ Sanders logged his third hat trick of the season, leading the team with three goals.

» Penn State trailed by as many as seven, 9-2, heading into the final period of play against the Quakers and rebounded with five goals in the fourth quarter, but could not complete the comeback, as time expired.

» Penn State and Furman will meet for the first time in program history Tuesday afternoon. The Nittany Lion matchup against Furman is the only time this season Penn State will square off against a team for the first time in program history this season. The Paladins enter Tuesday's midweek matchup looking for their first win of the season at 0-4 on the year in their third season as an NCAA DI program.

» Since entering both the USILA Coaches Poll and the Inside Lacrosse Media Polls, the Nittany Lions have made significant movement in the poll. This week, Penn State dropped out of the top 20 but is still receiving votes in both polls.

» A total of nine Nittany Lions have registered at least three goals this season, led by 13 from senior TJ Sanders. Redshirt junior Matt Florence is second with eight while freshman Grant Ament has seven on the season.

#### LAST TIME OUT: AT PENN

No. 20 Penn State's fourth quarter rally fell short as the Nittany Lions dropped an 11-7 decision to Penn Saturday afternoon at Franklin Field. Trailing by as many as seven, 9-2, heading into the final period of play, the Nittany Lions rebounded with five goals in the fourth quarter but could not complete the comeback.

Senior TJ Sanders led the team with three goals, while junior Nick Aponte tallied two goals and one assist for a three-point outing. Redshirt junior Matt Florence and freshman Grant Ament logged one goal apiece.

Junior Billy Lombardi matched a career-high mark, finishing 14-for-19 from the faceoff X, while also leading the team with a career-best seven ground balls. Sophomore Mike Aronow also matched a career-high mark finishing second on the team with four ground balls. Junior Tommy O'Neill and senior James Chakey added three ground balls, as Penn State won the ground ball battle, 35-28, against the Quakers.

#### **SHARING THE LOVE**

Having notched at least five assists in all but one game this season, Penn State is averaging 7.20 assists per game, which ranks 15th nationally and second in the Big Ten conference.

Nick Aponte is leading the team with at least one assist in all five games this season. Grant Ament also dished out at least two assists in the first three consecutive outings this year. With a teamhigh 10 assists, Ament's 2.00 per game ranks 16th nationally and third in the Big Ten. Ament's also averaging less than one turnover per game with a 10-3 assist to turnover ratio.

#### **A FAST START**

Following Penn State's 8-7 win on the road at No. 18 Cornell, the Nittany Lions improved to 3-0 on the year, marking the best start for the program since 2002. The 3-0 start to the 2016 season marked a first for head coach Jeff Tambroni, who has directed the Nittany Lions to back-to-back wins at the start of the season twice in the last four years.

#### **SCHREINER EARNS BIG TEN LAUREL**

Penn State's Will Schreiner earned Big Ten Specialist of the Week honors after helping direct the Nittany Lions to their third straight victory on the road at No. 18/15 Cornell. He becomes the first Nittany Lion in program history to earn Big Ten Specialist of the Week honors.

Schreiner logged seven saves in Penn State's thrilling 8-7 victory against the Big Red, marking the team's first win over a nationally ranked opponent this season. He registered three saves in the fourth quarter alone, including one huge save in the final minute of the game to keep the Nittany Lions on top for the win. He also led the team with three ground balls.

#### **DUO NAMED TO TEWAARATON WATCH LIST**

Penn State's Nick Aponte and TJ Sanders have been named to the 2016 Tewaaraton Award watch list. The Nittany Lion duo is among the top players across all three divisions of NCAA Lacrosse to be recognized as early contenders for the prestigious award, presented by Under Armour. The Tewaaraton Award, annually honors the top male and female college lacrosse player in the United States. On April 28, the field will be narrowed to 25 men's and 25 women's nominees.

#### **GOALS GALORE**

Despite a bit a bit of a decline in offensive production, Penn State is outscoring its opponents 61-56 on the year, with a scoring offense that's ranked 16th nationally and second in the Big Ten conference, averaging 12.20 goals per game.

Penn State scored 37 goals in just the first two games of the season, marking the most amount of goals in the first two games of the season in program history. The 37 goals were the most since Penn State scored 36 in the first two games of the 1987 season and the first 30-plus scoring through two games since the NIttany Lions had 33 goals in 2013.



Penn State men's lacrosse will honor the life and spirit of Nittany Lion goalie, Connor Darcey who passed away suddenly last year. ## **A CLOSER LOOK AT THE PALADINS**

#### **SCOUTING FURMAN**

The Paladins enter Tuesday's midweek matchup looking for their first win of the season at 0-4 on the year in their third season as an NCAA DI program. Furman dropped back-to-back games against ranked teams in the first two weeks of the season losing to then-No. 12 Ohio State, 8-7 and then-No. 6 North Carolina, 14-6 before falling to Lehigh and Mount St. Mary's.

David Williamson and Jonah Moore are leading the team with six goals each while Matthew VanGalen is atop the team standings with 18 points (4g, 2a). 2015 SoCon Freshman of the Year Reilly McDermott has totaled 44 saves on the year for a .484 save percentage.

#### **FRESHMAN INFLUENCE**

Through five games, the Nittany Lion newcomers have continued to make their mark, contributing 18 goals and 15 assists for nearly 30 percent of the team's total goal-scoring on the year.

At least one freshman has scored in all five games this season for the Nittany Lions. Despite the outcome, Kevin Hill logged his first multi-goal outing with a pair of goals against Villanova. Jimmy Nowoswiat and Robby Black also posted a pair of goals for their second on the year.

In the road-win at Cornell, Grant Ament logged his third multi-assist outing, leading the team with two helpers. Kevin Fox also tallied one goal during the Nittany Lions' 5-0 third-quarter surge.

Against Hobart, Ament recorded his first collegiate hat trick with three goals against Hobart, while also tallying a pair of assists for a team-high five points. Chris Sabia also led the team with three caused turnovers.

All 16 Nittany Lion rookies saw action in Penn State's 2016 season-opening victory against Robert Morris. Making the most of their debuts, a total of six newcomers combined for seven goals and six assists. Defensively, Sabia made his first collegiate start at defense, tallying three ground balls. Trevor Scollins also saw action in goal, notching two saves in 10:50 seconds between the pipes.

"The freshmen made an immediate impact," Tambroni said following the win over Robert Morris. "For Grant Ament and Chris Sabia to come out here and play with the poise that they did, says a lot about their character and a lot about the guys around them too."

#### SANDERS NEARING ANOTHER MILESTONE

With a team-high four goals in Penn State's win against Robert Morris, senior TJ Sanders notched his 100th career goal to join an elite group as just the seventh Nittany Lion all-time to amass 100 career goals. As the first Nittany Lion to hit the mark since Jack Forster in 2013, he needs 18 more goals to tie for first all-time. Sanders has scored at least two goals in all but one game this season.

#### **PENN STATE HOLDS OFF CORNELL, 8-7**

No. 20 Penn State held off No. 18 Cornell for a thrilling 8-7 victory on the road at Schoellkopf Field. The Big Red jumped out to a fast start, scoring two quick goals, including one just five seconds in to take over an early lead. Mike Sutton and Matt Florence responded for the Nittany Lions to tie the score, 2-2 with 1:30 remaining in the first. Penn State and Cornell kept it close in the second quarter until the Big Red broke open the tied score with a goal to pull ahead 3-2 as time expired in the first half.

The Nittany Lions came out of the intermission firing, using a 5-0 scoring streak to take control. James Chakey opened the stretch, followed by back-to-back goals from TJ Sanders. Kevin Fox and Ryan Keenan followed with a pair of goals to widen the advantage to four, 7-3 with 2:41 left in the third quarter.

The Big Red came storming back with four consecutive goals, scoring the last two 38 seconds apart to knot the score, 7-7 with 5:13 left in the game. Florence came through in the clutch with his second goal of the afternoon to send the Nittany Lions ahead for good, 8-7.

#### **PENN STATE RALLIES PAST HOBART**

Helped out by an offensive surge in the fourth quarter, Penn State rallied past Hobart to earn its second straight win. Penn State's offense fired on all cylinders in the fourth quarter as the Nittany Lions came from behind to close out the game with nine goals in 11 minutes to secure the win.

Grant Ament, TJ Sanders and Ryan Keenan led the team with three goals apiece. Both Keenan and Ament's multi-goal scoring outings marked career high efforts for the pair. Ament also added two assists to lead the team with five points.

Matt Florence and Dan Craig posted multigoal outings, registering two goals each. Brian Prestreau, Kevin Fox and Billy Lombardi and Mike Sutton all logged one goal apiece to round out the balanced group of goal scorers.

#### AMENT EARNS BIG TEN WEEKLY HONORS

Penn State's Grant Ament earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors after helping guide the Nittany Lions to a 20-7 victory against Robert Morris.

Ament is the first Nittany Lion in program history to earn Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors and the fourth conference weekly award-winner all-time.

Ament recorded two goals and led the team with five assists for a seven-point outing in his collegiate debut in the Blue and White against the Colonials. He put away his first collegiate goal in the first quarter, just one minute after registering his first collegiate assist. ## HOME SWEET HOME

The 2016 Penn State men's lacrosse schedule features double the home dates this season as the Nittany Lions are set to welcome eight opponents to University Park this year.

PSU hosts back-to-back games at home in the first two weeks of the season for the first time since 2014, hosting Robert Morris and Hobart. Other non-conference dates include Villanova (2/27), Harvard (3/12) and UMASS (3/19). The Big Ten slate is also set to take place mostly at home with Penn State hosting Maryland (4/10), Johns Hopkins (4/17) and Michigan (4/30).

### **PSU PICKED FOURTH IN B1G COACHES POLL**

Penn State has been voted fourth in the 2016 Big Ten Preseason Coaches' Poll with Nittany Lions redshirt juniors Matt Florence, Drake Kreinz and senior TJ Sanders named Penn State's Players to Watch. Johns Hopkins claimed the top spot in the 2016 poll with a unanimous selection from the league's head coaches. Maryland and Ohio State rounded out the top three at spots two and three, respectively. Michigan and Rutgers were selected fifth and sixth.

## **BIG TEN PRESEASON PLAYERS TO WATCH**

Redshirt seniors Matt Florence and Drake Kreinz and senior TJ Sanders earned Penn State Big Ten Preseason Player to Watch honors. The preseason nod is the second straight for Kreinz and Sanders, who both earned 2015 Player to Watch honors prior to the inaugural season of Big Ten lacrosse.

Florence earns his first career Big Ten preseason honor, having capped off the season with Big Ten All-Tournament team honors. A 2015 Academic All-Big Ten selection, Kreinz served once again as Penn State's top faceoff specialist in 2015, playing in 13 of 14 games. A USILA All-America honorable mention, Sanders returns as one of the Nittany Lions' top offensive contributors in 2016, having earned both All-Big Ten honorable mention distinction and Academic All-Big Ten awards last year.

### TRIO TO LEAD AS 2016 CAPTAINS

A trio of midfielders will lead the team during its 2016 campaign. Seniors Tommy O'Neill and James Burke and redshirt junior Drake Kreinz have been voted as captains. The process for choosing captains has remained unchanged for years and Jeff Tambroni is confident in the system he has in place.

"There are a number of different factors going into the captains process," Tambroni said. "One is a consensus vote from last years team, we want to get exiting seniors, graduating seniors opinions on who they believe will lead this team most effectively."

After the team vote, Tambroni and fellow assistant coaches evaluate upperclassmen during the fall semester before making a final decision. Penn State men's lacrosse has experimented with the number of captains the team has every year. In 2014 three seniors led the team but in 2015 the task fell solely on senior Kyle Zittel.

#### **TAMBRONI SIGNS 11 TO NLI**

Jeff Tambroni has announced the signing of 11 newcomers to National Letters of Intent during the early signing period. From U.S. Lacrosse All-Americans and MVPs to state champions and honor roll athletes, this year's class features a talented group poised to join the team in 2016.

Gerard Arceri (Saint James, N.Y.), Nick Cardile (West Grove, Pa.), TJ Connellan (Cazenovia, N.Y.), Colby Kneese (Dallas, Texas), Nick McEvoy (Bethesda, Md.), Mac O'Keefe (Syosset, N.Y.), Kane Randolph (Annapolis, Md.), Jack Rusboldt (Richmond, Va.), Mitch Schaefer (Canandaigua, N.Y.), Conor Smith (West Islip, N.Y.) and Barrett Sutley (Stevenson, Md.) are all set to arrive in Happy Valley.

Three of the signees are ranked within Inside Lacrosse's list of top 25 recruits with Arceri ranked No. 11, O'Keefe tabbed No. 23 and McEvoy slotted No. 25.

#### **SNAPSHOT: LOOKING BACK AT 2015**

2015 was a historic season for Penn State men's lacrosse as the team kicked off its first official year of participation in the Big Ten conference. The Nittany Lions opened the season with a non-conference upset win over No. 16/11 Penn and earned a pair of Big Ten wins over Rutgers and Michigan to qualify for the first ever Big Ten Tournament.

#### WHO'S BACK?

Penn State returns nearly all of its offensive production from last year, including Nittany Lion top scorer and USILA All-America honorable mention, TJ Sanders, who led the team with 29 goals and 13 assists in 2015 for a team-high 42 points. Mike Sutton also joins Sanders as one of two 20-plus goal scorers from last year. Sutton closed out the year second on the team with 24 goals, including eight multi-goal outings. Both Sanders and Sutton both earned 2015 All-Big Ten honorable mention distinction.

Another top returner at attack is Nick Aponte, who transitioned from midfield to attack late in 2015 season. Prior to the move, Penn State averaged 8.9 goals per game, but since transitioning in the first meeting against Johns Hopkins (4/17), the team improved to 10.33 goals per game, with Aponte highlighting the remainder of the season with three goals and one assist for four points in a close 10-9 victory against Michigan.

In the midfield, Penn State returns Big Ten All-Tournament Team honoree Matt Florence, who finished third on the team with 16 goals in 2015. Also moving positions last year and returning is Dan Craig, who transitioned from attack to the midfield mid-year. He scored 11 goals and finished second on the team with nine assists. Craig also enters the 2016 season with at least one goal in the last four consecutive games. Other returners at midfield include Brian Prestreau and Chris Young. Prestreau saw action in 13 of 14 games, notching five goals including one in each of the last two games of the season.

At defensive midfield, the Nittany Lions have a veteran crew of seniors; James Burke, Tommy O'Neill and James Chakey, with Burke at the longstick. Burke registered a teamhigh12 caused turnovers to go along with 34 ground balls. Defensively speaking, Penn State has Peter Triolo returning at close defense, who played in 13 games, starting the final 10.

Penn State is also solid at the faceoff "X" with returner Drake Kreinz who finished 129-237 on the year with a .544 winning clip.

#### WHO'S GONE?

Penn State is tasked with replacing standout goalie Connor Darcey, who passed away suddenly last summer. Darcey played all 14 games, recorded 176 saves with a .553 save percentage on the year. The Nittany Lions also saw departures from defenseman JP Burnside and Pat Manley at attack. Manley played in 13 of 14 games, tallying 12 goals and six assists for 18 points.

#### WHO'S NEW?

Ranked No.12 nationally by Inside Lacrosse, Penn State welcomes 16 newcomers in its freshmen class this year. The class includes five All-Americans, eight all-conference honorees, three all-league picks and a Canadian national champion. Defenseman Tommy Wright was slotted No. 12 in Inside Lacrosse's Power 100 Freshman Rankings while attackman Grant Ament came in at No. 31. Midfielder Drew Petkevich was slated No. 67, while Kevin Hill (midfield) and Robby Black (midfield) rounded out the group at No. 81 and No. 93, respectively.

#### **UP NEXT**

Penn State returns home for back-to-back games on its own turf. The Nittany Lions are set to welcome Harvard Saturday, March 12 for a 10 a.m. matchup at the Penn State Lacrosse Field. The matchup will broadcast live on the Big Ten Network with Mark Dixon and Matt

After guiding the Nittany Lions through the inaugural season of Big Ten Lacrosse, Jeff Tambroni returns for his sixth season as Penn State's head coach in 2016.

Tambroni guided the Nittany Lions through a historic season in 2015 that brought Penn State's first appearance in the Big Ten Tournament following the first ever season of Big Ten lacrosse. The Nittany Lions opened the season ranked No. 14 in the USILA DI Preseason Coaches' Poll and knocked off No. 16/11 Penn during the 2015 season. Tambroni also led Penn State to its first two Big Ten conference victories as well as a berth to the conference tournament. He also mentored rising senior TJ Sanders to USILA All-America honorable mention honors.

In 2014, Tambroni led Penn State to its fourth consecutive above-.500 season. His student-athletes earned the eighth USILA All-American and third Scholar All-America honors of Tambroni's Penn State career. He also coached goalkeeper Austin Kaut to his school record third All-America honor and conference-best All-CAA First Team award.

Penn State's 2013 campaign saw Tambroni lead Penn State to one of the greatest seasons in program history while celebrating its 100th season. The Nittany Lions set new records for wins (12) and earned the program's first outright regular season conference title by sweeping the CAA with a 6-0 record. PSU rattled off 10 straight wins from March through May to earn the school's third NCAA bid and first chance to host an NCAA game.

Tambroni was named CAA Coach of the Year for the second time in his career (2011), while Kaut (under Tambroni's tutelage) was named Ensign C. Markland Kelly, Jr. Award for the nation's best goalie. Also, Kaut was CAA Player and Defensive Player of the Year. TJ Sanders was named Rookie of the Year and the Nittany Lions placed six on the All-CAA First Team.

During the 2012 campaign, Tambroni led the Nittany Lions to a secondplace CAA finish with two USILA All-Americans and six All-CAA honorees. Penn State finished with a 9-6 overall record and a 5-1 mark in conference action.

The 2011 CAA Co-Coach of the Year, Tambroni led the Nittany Lions to a 7-7 record and their first-ever CAA tournament berth during his first year at the program's helm.

In 2011, eight Nittany Lions garnered All-CAA recognition and freshman goalkeeper Austin Kaut earned Rookie of the Year honors while being named a USILA Honorable Mention All-American.

Prior to Penn State, Tambroni spent 10 seasons as head coach at Cornell (2001-10). He guided the Big Red to a 109-40 record and three NCAA Semifinal appearances (2007, 2009-10), including the 2009 national championship game.

Tambroni was named USILA Division I Coach of the Year following the 2009 season and was tabbed the 2007 and 2009 Field Turf/NCAA Division I Coach of the Year. Tambroni was also the 2004 and 2009 Ithaca Journal Male Coach of the Year and a three-time National Coach of the Week.

While at Cornell, Tambroni became the 10th-fastest coach to reach the 100-win mark when he accomplished the feat in his 134th career game in March 2010.

During his tenure, his players earned 37 first-team All-Ivy honors, including five Ivy League awards, and three conference Rookie of the Year selections. In addition, 39 players garnered All-America recognition.

Prior to serving as Cornell's head coach, he spent four seasons as a Big Red assistant coach (1997-2000). Tambroni also served as assistant coach at Loyola College in 1997 and at his alma mater, Hobart College, for three seasons. With the Statesmen, he helped the program reach the 1994 NCAA Division III national championship game.

A 1992 graduate, Tambroni earned his bachelor's degree in American studies. He earned first-team All-America honors as a senior and was twice named a second-team All-American (1990-91). The MVP of the 1990 NCAA title game, Tambroni helped lead the team to back-to-back NCAA championships (1990-91) and left Hobart tied for seventh on the school's all-time scoring list with 202 points.

Before embarking upon his collegiate coaching career, Tambroni coached the Heaton Mersey Lacrosse Club of the English Lacrosse Union for one year and served as a visiting coach for the Czech-American Lacrosse Foundation in Prague in the summer of 1996.

Tambroni and his wife, Michelle, have three daughters, Carissa, Madison and Ella. Michelle played field hockey at Penn State from 1988-90 and earned All-America honors as a senior.



**UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa. -** Penn State kicked off the 2016 season with a dominant 20-7 victory against Robert Morris Saturday afternoon at Holuba Hall.

"We're thrilled," head coach Jeff Tambroni said. "I thought our guys came out of the locker room and from the start of the game at the first whistle they played a very inspired game of lacrosse and gained a ton of momentum in the second and third guarter."

Penn State jumped out to an early lead in the first quarter as Matt Florence found the back of the net off an assist from Nick Aponte less than two minutes into the game to spark a 5-0 scoring streak. Aponte, Grant Ament, James Chakey and Brain Prestreau all added goals during the stretch.

Looking to spark some momentum, Robert Morris' Eric Rankel popped in a goal to cut the Nittany Lion advantage to four with less than two minutes remaining. Florence answered with his second goal of the quarter to send Penn State ahead 6-1 at the end of the frame.

The Colonials opened the second quarter with a goal from JonPatrick Kealey to trim the gap back to four, 6-2. Penn State came storming back with 11 consecutive goals spanning the remainder of the second quarter and into the third to surge ahead by as many as 15, 17-2.

TJ Sanders kicked off the scoring streak with back-to-back goals, scoring his first on an extra-man opportunity after the Colonials were whistled for cross-checking. Sanders powered the charge with a total of four goals in the offensive push, while Mike Sutton, Aponte, Florence, Robby Black, Prestreau, Kevin Fox and Ament all chipped in a goal apiece to bolster the lead.

Robert Morris looked to halt the momentum with a pair of goals from Luke Laszkiewicz, 17-4, with 5:09 left in the third but the rookie duo featuring Nick Spillane and Jimmy Nowoswiat answered with a pair of goals to push Penn State up 19-4 at the end of the third quarter.

Just a few minutes into the fourth quarter, Matt Donnelly put away his first collegiate goal to give the Nittany Lions their largest lead of the game, 20-4. The Colonials looked to rebound with three consecutive goals, but could not recover as the Nittany Lions claimed a 20-7 win as time expired.

**NOTES:** The Nittany Lions put up 20 goals for the first time since downing Michigan 22-7, Feb. 8 2014 ... Penn State improves to 21-17 all-time in season-openers and 11-5 when playing at home ... PSU is also 5-1 in yearly openers under the direction of sixth year head coach Jeff Tambroni ... Penn State improves to 2-2 in the all-time series against Robert Morris and 2-1 when playing at home ... Sanders' four goals are the most for a Nittany Lion since Pat Manley had four at Johns Hopkins April 11, 2015.

**UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa.** - Helped out by an offensive surge in the fourth quarter, Penn State rallied past Hobart 17-12 Saturday afternoon in Holuba Hall.

Penn State's offense fired on all cylinders in the fourth quarter as the Nittany Lions came from behind to close out the game with nine goals in 11 minutes to secure the win.

Grant Ament, TJ Sanders and Ryan Keenan led the team with three goals apiece. Both Keenan and Ament's multi-goal scoring outings marked career high efforts for the pair. Ament also added two assists to lead the team with five points. Matt Florence and junior Dan Craig posted multi-goal outings, registering two goals each. Brian Prestreau, Kevin Fox and Billy Lombardi and Mike Sutton all logged one goal apiece to round out the balanced group of scorers.

Sanders opened the scoring for the Nittany Lions with an early goal, but the Statesmen answered back with a pair of goals to pull ahead, 2-1 with 10:03 remaining in the first quarter.

From there, Penn State and Hobart kept it close, trading goals throughout the first quarter and into the second. With the Statesmen leading by one, 5-4, Lombardi won the faceoff and charged toward the net for a goal to spark a 3-0 scoring streak. Sutton and Florence chipped in back-to-back goals, to round out the stretch that pushed Penn State ahead 7-5 with 4:42 left in the second quarter.

Hobart answered back in the third quarter with two consecutive goals to even the score, 7-7 with 10:48 remaining in the third quarter. Craig looked to spark a run with a goal off an assist from Ament, to give the Nittany Lions a one-goal lead, 8-7. With PSU unable to sustain the momentum, the Statesmen rallied with a 4-0 run to take over a three-point lead, 11-8 with 14:48 in the fourth quarter.

Rallying back, Ament opened up a 5-0 run with an unassisted goal to send Penn State surging ahead, 13-11. Sanders and Keenan went back-and-forth, totaling four goals after Ament's. Hobart looked to halt the momentum with a goal to arrive within one, 13-12, with 8:35 remaining in the game. The Nittany Lions answered back with goals from Fox, Ament, Florence and Craig to wrap up a 17-12 win in favor of Penn State.

**NOTES:** TJ Sanders recorded his second straight game with at least three goals and 18th of his career ... Sanders has recorded multi-goal outings in each of the last five games dating back to April 19, 2015 .... Penn State moves to 24-34-1 in the all-time series against Hobart with wins in five of the last six meetings ... "Coming into this game we knew it was going to be more of a six-on-six, – more of a slugfest so to speak," head coach Jeff Tambroni said. "We knew it was going to be more make-it take-it for them and we knew we were going to have to start more of our possessions in the defensive end and get a stop and get it back in the offensive end."

Six Nittany Lions tallied at least one goal in the win, led by two goals apiece from senior TJ Sanders and redshirt junior Matt Florence. Sophomore Ryan Keenan, senior James Chakey, freshman Kevin Fox and junior Mike Sutton rounded out the scoring effort with once goal apiece.

Four Nittany Lions picked up at least two ground balls, led by three from sophomore goalie Will Schreiner. Senior Peter Triolo, freshman Kevin Fox, and Sutton all had two each. Chakey also led the team with two caused turnovers.

Cornell jumped out to a fast start, scoring two quick goals, including one just five seconds of the game to take over an early lead. Sutton responded for the Nittany Lions with an unassisted goal to put Penn State on the board, 2-1. "We seemed not to have a lot of rhythm today," head coach Jeff Tambroni said. "The momentum just never seemed to shift in our favor."

Villanova held a 26-32 advantage at the faceoff x, helped out by Luke Palmedesso, who finished 22-for-27 for the Wildcats.

The Wildcats opened the scoring with their first goal of the afternoon from Christian Cuccinello with 11:16 remaining in the first quarter. Sutton answered back for the Nittany Lions to tie the score, 1-1 with 3:52 remaining. The Wildcats responded with a goal on the man advantage to spark a 3-0 spurt that lifted Villanova ahead by three, 4-1 with less than two minutes to play in the quarter.

Sanders put an end to the run nearly three minutes into the second quarter with his lone goal of the game off a behind-the-net feed from Ament to make it 4-2. Just 30 seconds later, the Wildcats scored to move back up by three, 5-2. Villanova fired back with another goal to remain ahead, 16-6, heading into the final stanza.

**UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa. -** No. 20 Penn State's fourth quarter rally fell short as the Nittany Lions dropped an 11-7 decision to Penn Saturday at Franklin Field.

Trailing by as many as seven, 9-2, heading into the final period of play, the Nittany Lions rebounded with five goals in the fourth quarter but could not complete the comeback as the Quakers held off Penn State.

"I thought every time we tried to fix sometime Penn came right back," head coach Jeff Tambroni said. "Momentum and possession time seemed to have not favored us all that well, but that's on us, not a particular unit."

Penn opened the game scoring 25 seconds in for an early lead, before adding two more goals to send the Nittany Lions into the second quarter trailing 2-0.

Billy Lombardi matched a career-high mark, finishing 14-for-19 from the faceoff X, while also leading the team with a career-best seven ground balls.

"It was good to see us win more face offs, that was good. It's a sign of moving in a positive direction," Tambroni said.

Mike Aronow also matched a career-high mark finishing second on the team with four ground balls. Tommy O'Neill and James Chakey added three ground balls, as Penn State won the ground ball battle, 35-28, against the Quakers.

The Quakers scored once more in the second frame before Nick Aponte halted the streak with a goal to put Penn State on the board, 4-1 with 6:10 remaining in the quarter. Penn answered back with a 3-0 stretch, scoring the first goal of the strike on the man advantage to stretch the Quaker lead to as many as six, 7-1 at halftime.

Nearly two minutes into the third quarter, Matt Florence scored to cut the deficit to five, 7-2. Penn responded with back-to-back goals to send the Nittany Lions into the fourth quarter trailing 9-2.

TJ Sanders sparked the Nittany Lions' fourth-quarter with his first goal of the game to shave the deficit to six, 9-3. The Quakers looked to halt the momentum with a goal, but Sanders answered with back-to-back goals, going to the top right corner for his third goal of the afternoon off a pass from Aponte to cut the deficit to five, 10-5, with 7:39 remaining in the game. Grant Ament and Aponte looked to mount a comeback with a pair of goals to make it 11-7, but Penn held off the attempt as the Quakers came away with the win as time expired.

**NOTES:** Penn State moves to 23-14-1 in the all-time series against Penn, having played the Quakers on the road for the first time since 1975 ... With three points, Aponte has now registered at least one point in 23 consecutive games dating back to April 5, 2014 ...
