THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This week marks the 19th and 20th meetings all-time between the two programs with Notre Dame holding the 10-5-3 advantage including a 4-2-2 mark at Pegula Ice Arena.
- The teams have been more even over the past two seasons splitting three of the four series they played. Ten of the 18 games in the series have been decided by a goal or less with 15 of the 18 decided by two or less goals.
- Only five current Nittany Lions have scored against the Irish with only three players having multiple goals led by Alex Limoges with four goals and one assist for five points in 12 games while Aarne Talvitie and Sam Sternschein have each added a pair of goals in six and 13 games, respectively.
- Junior Oskar Autio has just one appearance and no games started against the Irish for his career having allowed two goals on 18 shots in just over 30 minutes of action.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

- For the first time in program history, Penn State secured the Big Ten regular-season championship in 2019-20 and No. 1 overall seed entering the conference tournament. Penn State's 12 victories and 41 points in conference play last season were both program highs.

HOME IS WHERE YOU MAKE IT

- Penn State is 86-44-14 all-time at Pegula Ice Arena including an 11-5-3 record last season and a program-best 15 home victories during the 2018-19 season.
- The Nittany Lions are 6-2-0 on home ice so far this season and with the postponement of a series against Michigan in Ann Arbor schedules for next week are now in the middle of a 12-game homestand.
- With a 6-2-0 record at home this season, Penn State's .750 win-percentage is tied for sixth in the nation out of teams who have played more than two home games and is second in the Big Ten behind Minnesota's .800 win-percentage at Mariucci.

COMING ON STRONG

- Penn State has lost just three times in its last 11 games after beginning the year 0-5. That .727 winning percentage is the 11th best mark in the NCAA over that time and the second-best mark in the Big Ten since December 3 only behind Minnesota (.750). The Nittany Lions' eight wins are also the 7th most in the nation and one behind Minnesota for the most in the Big Ten since December 3.
- At 5-3-0 since the beginning of the second semester, the Nittany Lions are off to their best post-winter break start in the last six seasons.
- Penn State is also 5-0-0 this semester when senior Adam Pilewicz is in the lineup while the five conference wins this are the most Big Ten wins Penn State has ever registered in the month of January.

YOU'RE A BIG STAR

- Last Friday against Wisconsin, sophomore Connor McMenamin tied three separate Penn State single-game records for points (5), assists (4) and assists in a period (3).
- His five points and four assists were both career-highs and have only been done a handful of times in the past. McMenamin tied Andrew Sturtz who secured five points on November 4, 2017 against Mercyhurst while joining Sturtz and teammate Alex Limoges for the single-game assist record.
- McMenamin was named the Big Ten's Third Star of the Week following his career game where he nearly doubled his 2020-21 point output in just a single game. The sophomore's 11 points are now one shy of his career-high and are good for fifth on the team.

BREAK THE WALL DOWN

- Sophomore Kevin Wall has been one of the most improved players in the entire nation so far this season and leads the team with 16 points on eight goals and eight assists and is currently riding a three-game goal streak, just one shy of his career-long.
- Wall's 16 points are tied for 23rd in the nation and seventh in the Big Ten, but 15 of his points have come in 14 Big Ten games as he is tied for second in the race for the scoring title just three points shy of Wisconsin's Cole Caufield. All eight of his goals have come in conference games where he ranks second, only one goal off Caufield's pace.

- The sophomore has four multi-point efforts in his last six games and now has six for his career. Wall has registered at least one point in five of his last six games with five goals and four assists for nine points during that span.

WE'VE GOT THE POWER'PLAY'

- After going just 1-for-16 on the powerplay over the first five games of the season, including an 0-for-12 start, Penn State has regained its man-advantage swagger having scored at least one powerplay goal in six of the last nine games going 10-for-28 in the process. Penn State's 35.7 percent conversion rate during that stretch is the top mark in the country.

- Following the hot stretch the Nittany Lion powerplay currently stands at 25 percent (11-for-44) and has jumped from near the bottom nationally to 10th out of the 51 teams who have played games so far this season. Even with such a strong stretch on the man-advantage, Penn State still only ranks fourth in its own conference.

FINNISH FLARE

- Junior Aarne Talvitie tied his career-high with three points in last Friday's victory along with securing his second multi-goal game this season.
- Talvitie ranks third on the team with 13 points on seven goals and six assists and has four goals and four assists for eight points in his last six games.
- The junior's seven goals this season are a new career-high and are tied for the fifth most in the Big Ten.

SCOUTING NOTRE DAME



• Notre Dame is coming off a sweep at the hands of Michigan after a sweep of their own against Minnesota. The Irish are 7-8-1 on the year and 5-6-1-0-1-1 in the Big Ten and sit in fourth place, just a single point ahead of Penn State in the conference standings.

• The Irish have played just four of its first 12 games on the road and are a perfect 4-0-0 with sweeps over Michigan and Minnesota when the Gophers were the top-ranked team in the nation. Notre Dame will begin a stretch of four-straight games on the road this weekend and eight of its next 10 games will be played away from Compton Family Ice Arena, which was selected earlier this week as the host for the 2021 Big Ten Tournament.

• Junior Alex Steeves leads an Irish offense that ranks fifth in the Big Ten averaging 2.50 goals per game with 13 points on seven goals and six assists. Classmates Graham Slaggert and Michael Graham have chipped in 12 and 10 points, respectively as the only three players with double-digit points this season.

• In Big Ten play this season, the Irish are averaging just 2.00 goals per game having scored just 24 goals in 12 games while having scored 16 goals in four games against Arizona State. The 2.00 goals per game in conference action is sixth in the Big Ten only ahead of Michigan State.

• With the graduation of Cale Morris in the rearview, Notre Dame has turned to goaltender by committee this year as both senior Dylan St. Cyr and sophomore Ryan Bischel have split time between the pipes. Both goaltenders have sub-.900 save percentages while Bischel has the slightly better goals-against average at 2.85 compared to St. Cyr's 3.01.

• The Notre Dame powerplay has left a lot to be desired this season ranking tied for 45th in the nation just slightly better than Michigan State for last in the Big Ten converting just 10.5 percent of the time (4-for-38).

CHASING GREATNESS

• Senior Alex Limoges leads all active Big Ten players in points with 118 for his career to rank third nationally. His 49 career goals are also the most among active players in the Big Ten and rank second nationally.

• With a single-point last week against Wisconsin, Limoges moved into a tie with Chase Berger '19 for third on the Penn State all-time points list with 118. He also stands in solo fifth on the Penn State all-time goals list just one goal shy of Smirnov and two shy of Berger. Limoges' next goal will be the 50th of his career.

• The senior's 15 points this season are tied for ninth in the Big Ten while his eight goals are tied for third in the conference and 14th nationally with Wall.

THE ELDER STATESMEN

• Limoges is part of an eight-member senior class that leads the Big Ten and ranks third in the nation in scoring with 51 points on 20 goals and 31 assists. The 20 goals are also the best mark for a senior class in the Big Ten and the fourth most in the nation.

SATURDAY NIGHT'S ALRIGHT FOR HOCKEY!

• The Nittany Lions played back-to-back Saturday games for the first time this season a few weeks ago after having played at least one game on every other day of the week prior to two weeks ago in Columbus.

• Historically Saturday has been the most successful day for Penn State. Over the past four-plus seasons the Nittany Lions are now 40-21-6 in games played on Saturday following a pair of victories the past two weeks. PSU went a 10-4-1 last season including a 6-1-1 mark during the second half.

• Over the past four seasons, Penn State has won the Big Ten Tournament on a Saturday, won it's first-ever NCAA Tournament game on a Saturday and last season came-from-behind to defeat Minnesota, 3-2 on a Saturday in a game that became a defacto Big Ten regular-season championship game.

• Penn State will not play another Saturday game until February 13 against Ohio State.

FREE HOCKEY!

• In its last series before semester break against Arizona State, Penn State won back-to-back overtime contests for just the second time in program history and first since the 2017 Big Ten Tournament semifinal and final that each went to double-overtime.

• It was just the seventh time in program history that Penn State has played in back-to-back overtime games and just the third time both games of a series have gone into an extra session and first time in four years. It also marked the first time ever PSU has won two overtime games in the same series.

• The Nittany Lions' first-ever NCAA Division I series against AIC in 2012 saw both games decided in overtime with Penn State splitting the series with the Yellow Jackets while a 2016 non-conference series in South Bend also needed extra time in both games with the Nittany Lions tying the opening game before winning the series finale against the Irish on an Andrew Sturtz '20 goal.

- After another Overtime win last weekend against Michigan State, Penn State is now 18-9-22 all-time in overtime contests including a 4-1-2 in three-on-three overtime games with four-straight victories. The Nittany Lions are just 4-8 in games that advance all the way to a shootout.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Nittany Lions once again used some late game heroics to defeat Michigan State two weeks ago with a come-from-behind overtime victory. Penn State scored during a 6-on-4 spurt with just 70 seconds remaining in regulation before Limoges' OT winner just 30 seconds into the extra session.

- In its last game before holiday break against ASU, Penn State got in a hole early as the Sun Devils scored three goals on three shots in a 69 second span early in the first period.

- The Nittany Lions never hung their heads coming all the way back to tie the contest just 4:21 into the second period and Penn State eventually won the game in overtime 5-4.

- The three-goal comeback victory ties the largest comeback in program history and it was the first time Penn State has comeback from a three-goal deficit since January 23, 2015 against Northern Michigan.

NINE TIMES!

- Penn State had scored just 10 goals in its first five games of the season before erupting for nine goals in a 9-5 victory over No. 7 Michigan on December 3.

- The nine goals tie the third most in a single-game in program history and tie the most-ever scored against a conference opponent. Penn State defeated No. 5 Notre Dame 9-1 nearly two years to the day on December 8, 2018.

- The Nittany Lions have now scored seven or more goals 24 times, including 16 times in the past three-plus seasons, and are a perfect 24-0-0 when doing so.



NEXT UP



- With the entire Michigan athletic department going on a two-week pause due to the B.1.1.7 variant of COVID-19, Penn State's series in Ann Arbor set for next week has been postponed and the Nittany Lions will next hit the ice at Pegula Ice Arena in two weeks against Ohio State on February 12-13.

ETCHED INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

- Penn State will look a little different when they hit the ice this season after graduating the largest senior class in program history and arguably one of the most decorated throughout the nation as well as having two juniors leave early after signing entry-level NHL contracts.

- The 2020 senior class accounted for 85 victories over their four years, just one shy of the most-ever by a single class, a distinction held by the class of 2019 with 86 wins.

• The group consisted of four of the top-10 scorers in program history led by Penn State's all-time leading scorer, Nate Sucese with 140 points and followed by Brandon Biro (116), Denis Smirnov (115) and Liam Folkes (103) in fourth, fifth and seventh, respectively. The group also featured Peyton Jones, the most decorated goalie in program history who holds nearly every single goaltending record Penn State.

• The 2020 senior class played in a total 1,142 games scoring 634 points on 258 goals and 376 assists and had four 100-point scorers.

• The Nittany Lions are also without the services of Evan Barratt and Cole Hults after the pair inked entry-level NHL contracts with the Chicago Blackhawks and the Los Angeles Kings back in April.

• Barratt ranked ninth on the all-time points list and tenth on the goals list at Penn State with 95 and 39, respectively, while Hults held nearly every single record for defensemen at Penn State and led the entire Big Ten with a plus-23 rating last season.

THE GREAT GADOWSKY

• Head Coach Guy Gadowsky was named a finalist for Big Ten Coach of the Year last season after leading the Nittany Lions to their first-ever B1G regular-season title. The Bench Boss secured the seventh 20-win season of his collegiate coaching career and his fourth with the Nittany Lions with a 3-2 victory over Minnesota to close out the regular season.

• Gadowsky registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9th at Ohio State. After a split last weekend against Wisconsin, Gadowsky is now 153-128-23 all-time behind the Penn State bench.

• The 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year registered his 300th career victory in 2019-20 and currently ranks tied for 78th all-time throughout all divisions with 326 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks tied for 42nd with his 326 wins and is currently 11th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

PACKING THE PEG

• Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 126-of-135 home games, which included a streak of 104-consecutive regular-season games that was snapped earlier this season.

• More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 86 occasions including 10 games in 2019-20 while five of the final six home crowds last season rank in the top-10 all-time in the building including a record crowd of 6,475 in the last home game against Notre Dame on February 1, 2020.

• Last season, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,990) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (103.6 percent).

• Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its eighth season entering 2020-21. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.

• The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.

• The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New for the 2020-21 season is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

• Arizona State will play each Big Ten team four times all on the road giving each team 28 regular season contests. ASU is not eligible for conference awards or the Big Ten Tournament.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 21st collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his ninth at Penn State in the 2020-21 campaign

AT PENN STATE

This past year, Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the 2019-20 Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.



Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October and currently ranks tied for 78th all-time throughout all divisions with 318 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 45th with his 318 wins and is currently 13th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucece landed on the Second-Team West while also being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucece took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten

wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nittany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice

for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with



the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning re-

cord in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn State faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, and capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to double-digit wins (13-14-0) during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13, with several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells

Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA in 2011-12, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

AT PRINCETON

Before arriving in Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance.

Gadowsky took a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival and guided it to both the ECAC Hockey Tournament and Ivy League crowns in 2007-08. The team earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1998, and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

More than 20 Tiger players went on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

AT ALASKA

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he took a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.

BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign and garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

PLAYING CAREER

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. A three-time WCHA All-Academic team member, he collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, the Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.

PERSONAL LIFE

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.

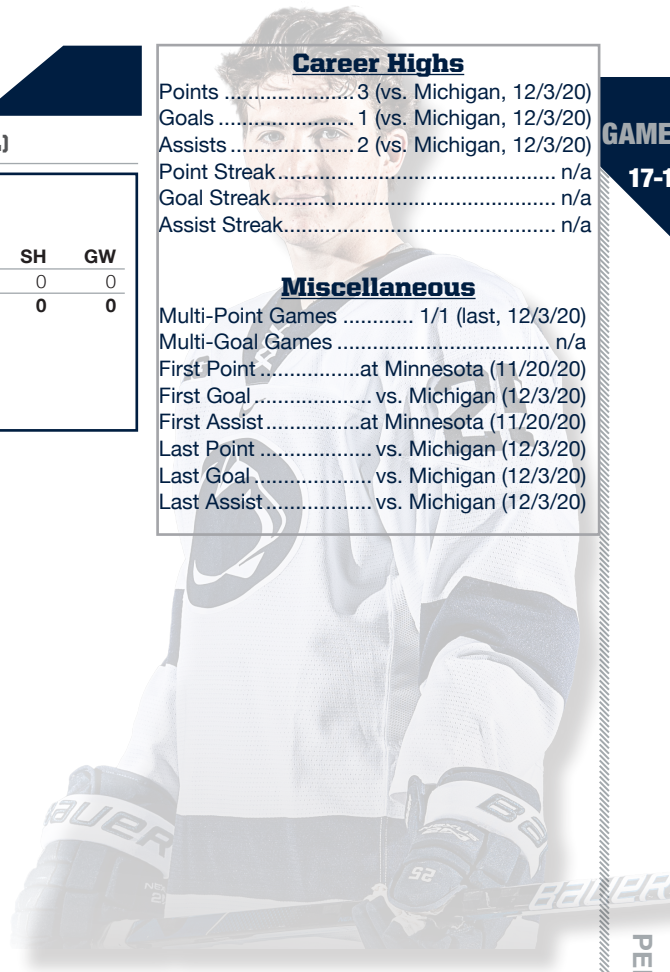

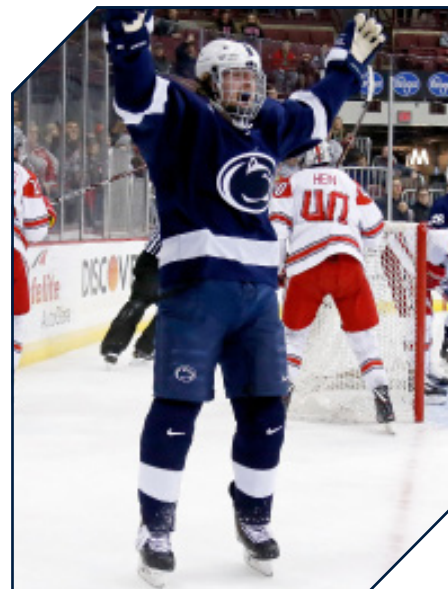

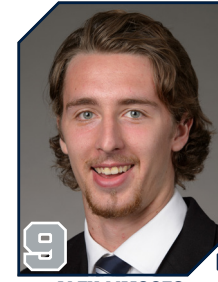
