#### THE OPENING TIP

- It's time for the postseason for the No. 9-ranked Purdue Boilermakers and it will be the last team to play in this weekend's Big Ten Tournament. The Boilermakers will tip off at approximately 9 p.m. ET, on Friday against either sixth-seeded Ohio State, 11th-seeded Penn State or 14th-seeded Minnesota. Purdue is aiming for its first semifinals appearance since the 2018 tournament in New York City.
- Purdue owns a 3-0 record against its three possible opponents, defeating Ohio State at home and Penn State and Minnesota on the road.
- The contest will be televised on BTN with **Brandon Gaudin, Robbie Hummel** and **Andy Katz** on the call. On the radio waves, **Rob Blackman** and **Bobby Riddell** will be courtside on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on BigTenStats.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

#### THE NOTES TO KNOW

- 1) Purdue is looking to become the seventh team to win two Big Ten Tournament titles, having won a previous title in Indy in 2009.
- 2) **Matt Painter** coached in his 600th career game last Saturday (570 at Purdue; 30 at Southern Illinois). He ranks fifth on the Big Ten's all-time games coached list (570) behind **Tom Izzo** (928), **Bob Knight** (901), **Gene Keady** (782) and **Lou Henson** (647).
- 3) Purdue clinched a Big Ten Tournament double-bye for the seventh time in seven tournaments under the current format. Purdue hasn't played on a Thursday in the Big Ten Tournament since the 2014 season.
- 4) Purdue is 12-6 in quad-1 and quad-2 games and if Rutgers moves up one spot to 75, the Boilers would be without at quad-2, 3 or 4 loss.
- 5) Purdue led the Big Ten in field goal percentage for the first time during the **Matt Painter** era, shooting 47.6 percent in league play.
- 6) Purdue is 23-0 in games it scores 70 or more points. In games held under 70 points, Purdue is 2-6.
- 7) Purdue has won at least 12 league games for the seventh time in the last eight years. During that span, just three other programs have done it at least five times (Wisconsin - 6; Maryland, Michigan State - 5).
- 8) Purdue owned the Big Ten's best home record in 2017 (8-1), 2019 (10-0), 2021 (8-1) and will again in 2022 (9-1).
- 9) Purdue's 81 Big Ten wins since the 2016-17 season are the fourth-most conference wins for a power-conference team during that span.
- 10) Purdue is 7-3 all-time in the Big Ten Tournament when it is the three-seed (title - 2009; finals in 1998, 2018).
- 11) Purdue's six first-team All-Big Ten honorees since the 2015-16 season are the most in the Big Ten (Iowa - 5).

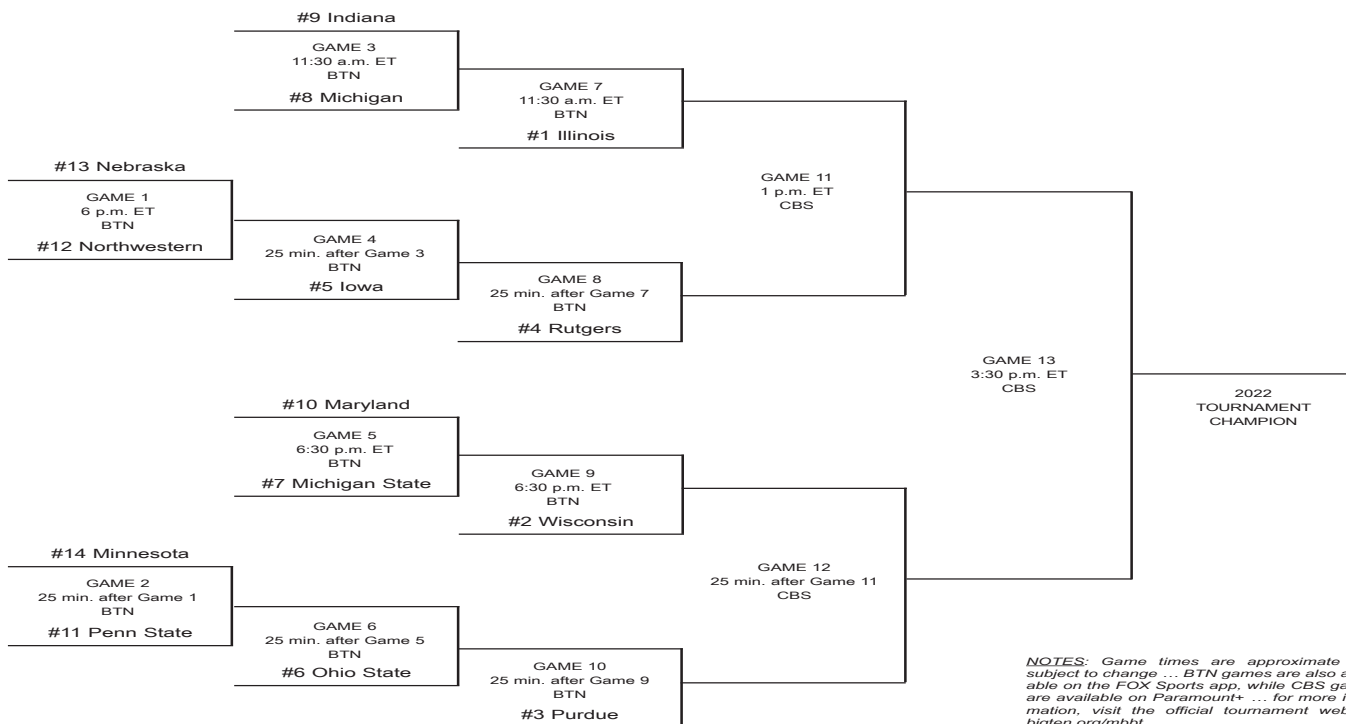

Purdue is looking for its second Big Ten Tournament title when it heads to Indianapolis this weekend as the No. 3 seed. This marks the fifth time that Purdue has been a No. 3 seed, winning the title as the 3-seed in 2009 and reaching the finals in the inaugural event in 1998 and again in 2018. Purdue is 5-1 in its last two tournaments as a 3-seed and seven of its 14 wins have been as a 3-seed.

Most of Purdue's success in event has come in Indianapolis, posting a 7-10 record. The Boilermakers are 7-6 in the city in their last seven Big Ten Tournaments, winning the title over Ohio State in the 2009 Big Ten Tournament, 65-61. It is Purdue's only win in five tries against Ohio State in the Tournament.

Purdue's four title-game appearances are the fifth most in the Big Ten (Ohio State - 9; Wisconsin, Michigan State - 7; Illinois - 7).

Purdue (2009) and Michigan State (2014) are the only 3-seeds to win the Big Ten Tournament. Six more 3-seeds have been runner-up, including Purdue twice.

## DEFENSE MIGHT BE COMING AROUND

- Despite struggling most of the season on the defensive end, Purdue is showing signs of turning things around.
- Over the last six games, Purdue is allowing 67.0 points per game, holding five of six opponents to 70 or fewer points.
- It has also forced 60 turnovers (10.0 per game) after forcing just 7.6 turnovers per game in the previous nine games.
- Despite Purdue's defensive woes, there have been just four games in which teams have shot over 48 percent from the field against Purdue, done by just two teams (Rutgers twice, Michigan twice).
- Much has been said about Purdue's defensive issues and it currently sits just outside the top 100 in KenPom defensive efficiency, but since Feb. 13 (6 games), Purdue's defense ranks 61st nationally in efficiency, according to Bart Torvik.

## THE WHAT-IF GAME

- Purdue is 25-6 on the season and 14-6 in the Big Ten Conference. Outside of a 24-point loss to Michigan, the Boilermakers have been in every game, losing the other five games by a combined 16 points.
- Rutgers (Dec. 9) – Ron Harper Jr., hit a running, 40-footer as the clock expired to defeat Purdue 70-68. The issue: Purdue was just 7-of-26 from long distance. Rutgers was 7-of-14.
- Wisconsin (Jan. 3) – Johnny Davis scored 37 points to lead Wisconsin to a 74-69 win. The issue: Purdue was 15-of-24 from the free throw line.
- Indiana (Jan. 20) – Rob Phinisee hit a 3-pointer with 18 seconds left to give Indiana a one-point lead in a 68-65 victory. The issue: Purdue was 7-of-17 from the free throw line and had 10 first-half turnovers as Indiana built a 9-point halftime lead.

• Michigan State (Feb. 26) – Tyson Walker hit a 3-pointer with one second left for a 68-65 decision. The issue: Purdue had 17 turnovers allowing 19 fast-break points.

• Wisconsin (March 1) – Chucky Hepburn hit a banked-in, fadeaway 25-footer with one second left for a 70-67 decision, moments after Johnny Davis hit a 20-foot bank shot from straight on. The issue: Purdue was 11-of-20 from the free throw line.

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
- Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
- Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
