

- Penn State welcomes Bucknell for a mid-week, non-conference contest on Wednesday.
- The Nittany Lions are 130-30-1 all-time against its most-faced opponent.
- Penn State has won eight straight in the series and 29 of the last 30.
- The Nittany Lions are coming off a three-game series at No. 23 Maryland, where Penn State took one of three games.
- Penn State earned a 6-4 win in 10 innings in Saturday's contest for its first win over a ranked road opponent since May 13, 2007 at No. 16 Michigan.
- Johnny Piacentino hit a two-run homer in the sixth, while Tayven Kelley hit a go-ahead two-run double in the 10th.
- Travis Luensmann threw three innings in relief on Saturday to pick up his first career win.
 - On the weekend, Matt Wood went .500 at the plate (6-for-12) with two RBI, including a game-tying RBI single on Saturday.
- On the season, Wood has more extra base hits (11) than strikeouts (8) through 24 games played.
- Cole Bartels homered in Sunday's game.
- Over the last 10 games, Jay Harry is batting .324 with three doubles and two homers.

Wood Off To Strong Start

- Through 24 games played, junior Matt Wood is batting .393 with five doubles, two triples, four homers, 21 RBI and 20 runs.
- Wood leads the Nittany Lions in batting average, hits, runs, triples, homers, RBI, walks (14), slugging percentage (.643) and on-base percentage (.476).
- He sits fourth in the Big Ten in batting average, eighth in on-base percentage and ninth in slugging percentage.
- Wood has more extra-base hits (11) than strikeouts (8) this season.
- The lefty batter has been impressive facing righty (.412) and lefty (.364) pitchers.
- Wood paces PSU with 12 multi-hit games and five multi-RBI games this season and is riding a current seven-game hit streak.
- Wood is batting .471 with runners in scoring position.
- The Gibsonia, Pa. native is batting .419 over the last 10 games with a double, a triple and seven RBI.
- He batted .500 in the Maryland series (4/1-3) with six hits and two RBI. He had three hits in each game, including the game-tying RBI single in Penn State's win on Saturday.
- Earlier this season, on opening weekend, Wood went 3-for-4 with four RBI and four runs while crushing two homers and a double in game one against LIU.
 In D1baseball's preseason rankings Wood was tabled as the top catcher in the Big Ten.
 - In D1baseball's preseason rankings, Wood was tabbed as the top catcher in the Big Ten and the 16th-best catcher in the country.

Pennsylvania Influence In Starting Rotation

- In all 25 games this season, Penn State's starting pitcher has been a Pennsylvania native.
- Sophomore Travis Luensmann (Altoona) has made six starts, and seven appearances, with 39 strikeouts in 30.2 innings. Luensmann struck out eight in six innings against Maine (2/25).
- Luensmann made a strong relief appearance in Penn State's win at No. 23 Maryland, throwing the final three innings, allowing just one run.
- He was ranked as the No. 2 pitcher in Pennsylvania in the 2020 class by Perfect Game.
 Freshman Tommy Molsky has made seven starts, and eight appearances, tallying 2
 - Freshman Tommy Molsky has made seven starts, and eight appearances, tallying 29 strikeouts. Molsky tied a career high with six strikeouts against UMass (3/12).
- Graduate student Mason Mellott has made four starts and nine appearances.
- Mellott, graduating in August 2021 with a bachelor's degree in Kinesiology, ranks fourth all-time at Penn State with 13 saves and tied fourth with 76 appearances. Mellott is on the NCWBA Stopper of the Year Watch List.
- Junior Kellan Tulio has made six starts and seven appearances. with 17 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average.
- Tulio pitched the last two seasons at Louisville before transferring to Penn State. Tulio was ranked as the top pitcher in Pennsylvania in the 2019 class.
- Jaden Henline made the start in game one at Maryland, going five innings.
- Penn State is challenged with replacing a 2021 rotation that featured three MLB draft selections in Conor Larkin (9th round, Toronto Blue Jays), Kyle Virbitsky (17th round, Oakland A's) and Bailey Dees (18th round, New York Yankees).
- The Nittany Lions were one of only four Division I schools to have all three members of their starting rotation selected. Penn State has eight pitchers who have been drafted since 2016.

Henline, Shingledecker Lead Bullpen

- Senior Tyler Shingledecker leads the team with 11 appearances and three wins. The lefty has held opponents without an earned run in eight of his 11 outings.
- The versatile Shingledecker has gone more than an inning in seven appearances and has 22 strikeouts. He recorded all four outs via strikeout in his appearance at Maryland.
- Sophomore Jaden Henline has struck out 29 batters in 24.2 innings, while sitting third in the Big Ten with three saves. In nine appearances (one start), Henline has thrown two or more innings in seven outings, including four innings with no earned runs allowed against Rutgers (3/25).
- Senior Steven Miller and junior Jordan Morales have also established themselves as key members of the bullpen. Miller has a 2.55 ERA and a save in eight appearances.
- Miller struck out six in a career-high 3.2 innings against Milwaukee (3/19).
- Morales is 2-0 with 22 strikeouts in 15.2 innings over 12 appearances.

Nittany Lions Finding Power

- Over the last 10 games, Penn State has tallied 21 extra-base hits, including 10 doubles, six triples and five homers.
- Jay Harry leads the team with five extra base hits over that span, with three doubles and two homers.
- Johnny Piacentino has two triples and hit a two-run homer at Maryland (4/2).
- Josh Spiegel has a triple and a homer, while Cole Bartels hit a solo homer at Maryland (4/3).
- On the season, Matt Wood leads PSU with 11 extra-base hits, pacing PSU with two triples (tied with Piacentino) and four homers to go with five doubles.
- Billy Gerlott leads PSU with six doubles, while Kyle Hannon, Spiegel and Wood each have five.
- Harry has three homers this season, while Spiegel has two.

B1G Road Win

- Penn State earned a 6-4 win in 10 innings over Maryland on Saturday (4/2).
- The Terrapins were ranked No. 23 in the USA Today Coaches Poll and 25th in the Baseball America Poll.
- Penn State earned its first win in a true road game against a ranked opponent since a 15-5 win over No. 16 Michigan (5/13/07).
- The Nittany Lions recorded their first win against a ranked opponent away from home since March 2, 2019 against No. 21 Duke (8-7).
- Johnny Piacentino launched his first homer of the year, a two-run shot, in the sixth, while Matt Wood tied the game, 3-3, with an RBI single in the eighth.
- Penn State broke the tie in the 10th with a two-run double by Tayven Kelley and an RBI double by Jay Harry.
- Travis Luensmann earned the win on the mound, throwing three innings in relief and allowing just one run.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Bucknell

- Bucknell is led by Scott Heather, in his 10th season. Heather has guided the Bison to 183 wins.
- The 2014 Patriot League Coach of the Year led Bucknell to Patriot League regular season and tournament championships and an NCAA Regional appearance.
- Bucknell is 12-14 overall and 8-4 in Patriot League play this season. The Bison earned an 8-6 win at Duke on March 5.
- Last weekend, Bucknell split conference series' at Lafayette and Lehigh.
- Anthony Sherwin paces Bucknell with a .363 average and 26 runs, while Grant Voytovich leads Bucknell with 22 RBI.
- Six regular members of Bucknell's lineup have a .300 or better average.
- Bucknell has a team ERA of 6.34.
- Tyler O'Neill has a 2.31 ERA in eight appearances over 23.1 innings.

Against The Bison

- The Nittany Lions hold a 130-30-1 lead in the all-time series against Bucknell.
- Penn State has won eight straight games in the series and 29 of the last 30 matchups.
- Bucknell is one of five opponents Penn State has played more than 100 times: Michigan (49-51), Ohio State (39-71), Pitt (88-46-1) and West Virginia (71-42).
- In the last matchup, Penn State earned a 9-6 win to open the 2020 season in Cary, N.C.
- Making his collegiate debut, Matt Wood went 3-for-4 with a double, three runs and an RBI.

Head Coach

The 2022 baseball season is Rob Cooper's ninth as head coach of the Nittany Lion baseball program. Cooper was selected as the 14th head baseball coach in Penn State history on August 9, 2013. Not shy about stating his ultimate goal of returning Penn State to Omaha in June, the Lions have made significant strides under his leadership.

Under his tutelage, 11 players have been drafted and 12 total have signed with MLB teams in the last four seasons with a full draft. However, his strong belief in the first part of the term "student-athlete" is perhaps the top reason he has proven to be an excellent fit at Penn State. Even with state-of-the-art facilities, the chance to take on elite competition and a program history that includes five trips to the College World Series, Cooper cites the value of a Penn State degree as one of the top reasons to play baseball at Penn State.

The Nittany Lions finished the 2021 season with an 18-24 record, playing against exclusively Big Ten opponents. The wins included a 3-2 victory over No. 18 Michigan on March 26 and a series sweep over Michigan State in which Penn State out-scored the Spartans, 39-13. The Nittany Lions also won two series against Rutgers. Penn State scored 10 or more runs in six games, Penn State's most against Big Ten opponents since 2008 (8) and the most in a season since 2016.

Penn State led the Big Ten in doubles (93) and doubles per game (2.21), ranking 10th in the country in doubles per game. The Nittany Lions sat third in the conference in batting average (.269). Penn State hit 34 home runs, its most since 2012, and had five players with four or more homers.

Sophomore Matt Wood collected Second Team All-Big Ten honors, batting .295 with four homers and 21 RBI. Wood became the fifth All-Big Ten selection under Cooper. Senior Gavin Homer led the Nittany Lions with a .310 batting average, a .429 on-base percentage and tied with Johnny Piacentino for the team-lead in runs (30). Junior Justin Williams hit .302 and paced Penn State with 48 hits. Piacentino led the squad with eight homers and 32 RBI to go with a team-best .525 slugging percentage.

Senior Kyle Virbitsky paced the Penn State rotation with a 4.17 ERA, five wins, 77.2 innings pitched and 88 strikeouts. Virbitsky ranked seventh in the Big Ten in strikeouts and third in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.40). His 88 strikeouts are tied for the 10th-most in a season at Penn State. Senior Conor Larkin earned three wins and 69 strikeouts in 63.2 innings and fellow senior Bailey Dees was responsible for four wins and 53 strikeouts in 66 innings.

The Nittany Lions continued their success in the classroom with a program-record 19 players earning Academic All-Big Ten accolades.

Penn State had four players drafted from the 2021 squad. Larkin was selected in the ninth round (272nd overall) by the Toronto Blue Jays. Williams was a 17th round selection (508th overall) by the Houston Astros and Kyle Virbitsky followed, being selected 518th overall by the Oakland A's. Bailey Dees was drafted in the 18th round (543rd overall) by the New York Yankees. All three members of the starting rotation were drafted, making Penn State one of only four schools to accomplish that in 2021.

It marked the third time in program history that Penn State had four or more players selected in a single year and the second time that Penn State had three pitchers selected in a draft. The Nittany Lions have had eight pitchers drafted since 2016. The four selections were double of any other Pennsylvania school and three of the draftees are Pennsylvania natives. Penn State was off to a 10-5 start in 2020 before the COVID-19 pandemic canceled the remainder of the season. Penn State was among the conference leaders offensively, ranking second in on-base percentage (.394), slugging (.422), triples (7), doubles (30), third in batting average (.289) and walks (77), and fourth in scoring (6.7 runs/game) and runs (100). On the mound, Penn State ranked sixth in the NCAA with a 1.01 WHIP and also eighth with a 2.16 team ERA. The Nittany Lions also ranked 15th with 6.33 hits allowed per nine innings and 18th with a 3.63 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

Penn State baseball's trip to Cuba prior to the 2016 season is perhaps the best example of Cooper's commitment to the first part of the "studentathlete" term. The Nittany Lions attended academic lectures and toured Havana, becoming the first NCAA Division I team to compete against a Cuban National Series team, the first U.S. team at any level to defeat a Cuban National Series team, the first U.S. baseball team to play in Cuba since restoration of diplomatic ties with Cuba, the second NCAA team to play in Cuba since restoration of diplomatic ties (Coastal Carolina men's basketball, August 2015) and the fifth NCAA Division I baseball team to compete in post-revolutionary Cuba. The harmony between academics and athletics was on full display, as multiple Penn State professors and a group of journalism students also joined the travel party.

The rare, once-in-a-lifetime experience helped bring a young Penn State team together, and the Lions went on to earn their first winning record (overall and in conference) since 2012. The starting lineup included at least three freshmen in all but six games and five to six freshmen in 19 games, and took on nine eventual NCAA tournament teams, including a three-game series at home against College World Series participant TCU. The Lions' 28 wins were a 10-win improvement over the previous season, and its 12 Big Ten wins doubled the 2015 total. Haley and Anderson were the first drafted out of Penn State since 2012, and Anderson and senior outfielder Greg Guers became the program's first All-Big Ten picks also since 2012. Pitcher Justin Hagenman became Penn State's first Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American since 1997.

Shortly after Cooper accepted the PSU head coaching position in 2014, the California native traveled to Taichung, Taiwan to serve as the head coach of USA Baseball's 18U National Team at the IBAF U18 World Cup. Cooper steered Team USA to an 8-1 record in World Cup play, including seven consecutive victories to win the gold medal.

Not long after the triumph in Taiwan, Cooper received one of the highest honors bestowed in the profession, as he was announced as the Rod Dedeaux USA Baseball Coach of the Year. With the honor, Cooper became just the 16th individual in the award's history to receive the accolade, joining the likes of Scott Brosius, Davey Johnson and Tommy Lasorda.

Cooper was also a member of the coaching staff for the 2007 and 2009 USA College National teams. The 2007 team earned a silver medal at the Pan Am Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Fourteen of the 20 players on the 2007 team reached the Major Leagues, including 2013 All-Star Pedro Alvarez. Fourteen of the 22 members of the 2009 team also reached the Major Leagues, including three-time All-Star Gerrit Cole.

Cooper brought an accomplished resume to Penn State that included three NCAA Tournament appearances as a head coach at Wright State and five more at various stops as an assistant coach, including two trips to the College World Series with Miami (Florida). Cooper was twice named the Horizon League Coach of the Year and guided Wright State to three league tournament championships and two regular-season championships after the team suffered six losing seasons in the seven years before his arrival.

Cooper began his coaching career at national power Miami, spending two seasons (1994-95) as a student/graduate assistant on the Hurricanes' staff. While at Miami, Cooper helped the Hurricanes to College World Series berths in 1994 and 1995. Cooper spent the 1996 season as an assistant and team academic coordinator at Wake Forest, then moved on to Tulane for the next two seasons, serving as the Green Wave's hitting coach. In 1997, the Green Wave won the Conference USA regular-season crown, and in 1998, they advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Cooper left Tulane following the 1998 season and returned to Sacramento City College, where he starred in the early 1990's before lettering at Miami in 1993.

Along with his college coaching experience, Cooper also was an associate scout for the Los Angeles Dodgers from 1990-92 and has been selected to four coaching stints with USA Baseball in 2000, 2007, 2009 and 2013.

Cooper earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Miami in 1994 and a master's in sports sciences/administration from Miami in 1996. He is married to his wife, Maureen, and has two sons, Jake and Tyson, who are both current members of the Penn State baseball team.
