PENN STATE CLOSES OUT SEVEN-GAME HOME SLATE

The Penn State softball team will take on in-state foe Saint Francis in a rescheduled non-conference contest Wednesday, April 26. First pitch of the doubleheader against the Nittany Lions and the Red Flash is set for 5 p.m. with game two set to start approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of game one.

SERIES HISTORY WITH THE RED FLASH

Penn State carries the 31-4 all-time series record against Saint Francis, having played the in-state foe 34 times in Happy Valley. The two teams have only met up one time on neutral territory with the Nittany Lions earning the victory at the East Carolina Invitational in the 1995 season. Last season, the Blue and White shut out Saint Francis 6-0 in game one before notching a 4-2 victory in game two. Head coach **Amanda Lehotak** is 4-2 against the Red Flash after the Nittany Lions split the doubleheaders in both the 2014 and 2015 seasons. The doubleheader against the two squads marks the fifthstraight season in which the two teams have played each other at Beard Field with four-straight seasons of doubleheaders.

The Nittany Lions and Red Flash have taken on three common opponents in the 2017 season and posted similar results against all three. First, both team secured victories over Cleveland State in neutral site games before both falling to in-state rival Pittsburgh. Penn State and Saint Francis also both played a doubleheader and earned sweeps over Bucknell.

PSU WALKS OFF IN GAME ONE AGAINST SCARLET KNIGHTS

Sophomore **Tori Dubois** blasted a two-run home run in the bottom of the eighth inning that would give the Penn State softball team its second walk-off win of the week in an 11-9 victory over the Scarlet Knights of Rutgers in a Big Ten Conference game. The walk-off home run marked the first since the 2008 season for the Blue and White when it took a 4-3 victory over Michigan State on a **Desi Giordano** homer.

HITTING CLINIC

The Nittany Lions tallied 10-or-more hits for the 11th time this season when they tied a season-high 15 against the Scarlet Knights. For the first time in the 2017 season, every player in the Penn State line-up tallied at least one hit against Rutgers with five players tallying 2-or-more hits in the contest, three bringing in 2-or-more runs and three players hitting a home run.

NITTANY LIONS EARN SERIES VICTORY OVER RUTGERS

Despite dropping the final game of the three-game series against the Scarlet Knights of Rutgers, Penn State earned its second Big Ten Conference series victory of the 2017 season, winning the first two games of the series. The Blue and White notched 10 hits to mark the 12th time in the 2017 season and the third-straight game in which it notched 10-or-more base knocks in game two agaisnt Rutgers. Moreover, Penn State earned its fourth shutout of the season and its second in the week as it defeated Bucknell 1-0 in game one of the doubleheader Wednesday, April 19.

_ehotak led Penn State to its most successful season since the 2011 campaign with a 30-24 overall record and a fourth-place 14-9 record in the Big Ten Conference, breaking three offensive records in the process. The 2016 Nittany Lions posted a record-breaking .314 batting average with 468 hits that included 75 doubles. The Blue and White got off to

its best start in conference action in the history of the program with an 11-3 record before winning a program-best five conference series and sweeping three B1G series in 2016. Penn State carried an 11-game win streak at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, sweeping two conference series at home. The Blue and White secured 14 wins in 2016, which ranks second in program history and earned 10 wins for just the eighth time in program history. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions reached its 10 conference victories in fewer games than any other team as it took just 13 conference contests. The Nittany Lion offense had and White paced the conference with 457 hits, while ranking third with a .317 batting average and a .969 fielding percentage

In 2016, senior Macy Jones broke the Penn State career RBI record and walk record with 137 career RBI and 100 career walks donning ranks in the top-10 in six single season batting categories and nine out her career in the top-10 of seven career batting categories for the Nittany Lions. Sophomore Alyssa VanDerveer tied the single the career batting record book four times after her sophomore campaign, ranking fourth in home runs with 24 after two seasons. 2016 with Jones tying the single game home runs record with two against Michigan State and Tori Dubois knocking three doubles Brackpool both found their names in the Penn State career record and Brackpool ranking in the top-10 in career home runs.

Defensively, Penn State finished the season ranked third in the Big up the middle. Ten with a .969 fielding percentage, while senior Reina Furuya tied for third all-time in single game assists with eight against Saint Francis. The win over the top-ranked Tigers marked the first time that Penn State has defeated a top five team since it took a 1-0 victory over then-No. 1 Michigan, Feb. 18, 2006.

The Blue and White fell behind 1-0 in the bottom of the third back but answered with two straight multi-run innings, including a five-run third inning that chased freshman starter Maribeth Gorsuch out of the game. The Tigers brought in ace Carley Hoover to shut down the Penn State offense, however, **Shelby Miller** launched the first homer of the 2017 season for the Nittany Lions over the center field fence.

Sophomore **Madison Seifert** got the start in the circle, throwing all seven innings and keeping the powerful LSU offense to just six hits and three runs, while striking out three.

FRESHMAN MAKE IMPACT IN OPENING WEEKEND

Four freshman made appearances in the lineup during opening weekend for head coach **Amanda Lehotak**. **Delaney Elling** started all five games behind the plate and finished the weekend with a .308 batting average, tallying four hits, including one multi-hit game in her first weekend donning the Blue and White. **Destiny Weber** notched three starts as the designated players, while **Christa Wagner** started one game in the designated player slot and pinch hit twice for the Nittany Lions. The Nittany Lions first travel to Baton Rouge, Louisiana. for the LSU Tournament before heading to Atlanta, Georgia for its first appearance in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge. The Blue and White close out the month of February in Conway, South Carolina for the Chanticleer Showdown and open the month of March at the Colorado State Classic. Penn State continues its five weeks of travel in Washington with a doubleheader against Seattle and two games in the Husky Classic. Penn State returns from spring break and travels to Washington D.C. for four games at the GW Capital Classic, March 18-19. Following a mid-week home-opener, the Nittany Lions go back on the road to Michigan and Pittsburgh and also make trips out to Michigan State, Nebraska and Maryland in the 2017 campaign.

NITTANY LIONS COMING OFF HUGE 2016 SEASON

Lehotak led Penn State to its most successful season since the 2011 campaign with a 30-24 overall record and a fourth-place 14-9 record in the Big Ten Conference, breaking three offensive records in the process. The 2016 Nittany Lions posted a record-breaking .314 batting average with 468 hits that included 75 doubles. The Blue and White got off to its best start in conference action in the history of the program with an 11-3 record before winning a program-best five conference series and sweeping three B1G series in 2016. Penn State carried an 11-game win streak at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, sweeping two conference series at home. The Blue and White secured 14 wins in 2016, which ranks second in program history and earned 10 wins for just the eighth time in program history. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions reached its 10 conference victories in fewer games than any other team as it took just 13 conference contests. The Nittany Lion offense had 23 games with 10-or-more hits and scored 10-ormore runs on nine occasions. After the conclusion of conference play, the Blue and White paced the conference with 457 hits, while ranking third with a .317 batting average and a .969 fielding percentage.

PSU TO PLAY 17 HOME CONTESTS IN 2017

The Nittany Lions will play 17 of its 56 scheduled games in the friendly confines of the Nittany Lions Softball Park and Beard Field. Last season, Penn State played 20 regular season games at Beard Field, posting an 14-9 overall record. Penn State has posted a 54-51-1 overall record at Beard Field in its six year existence which is good for a .514 winning percentage.
