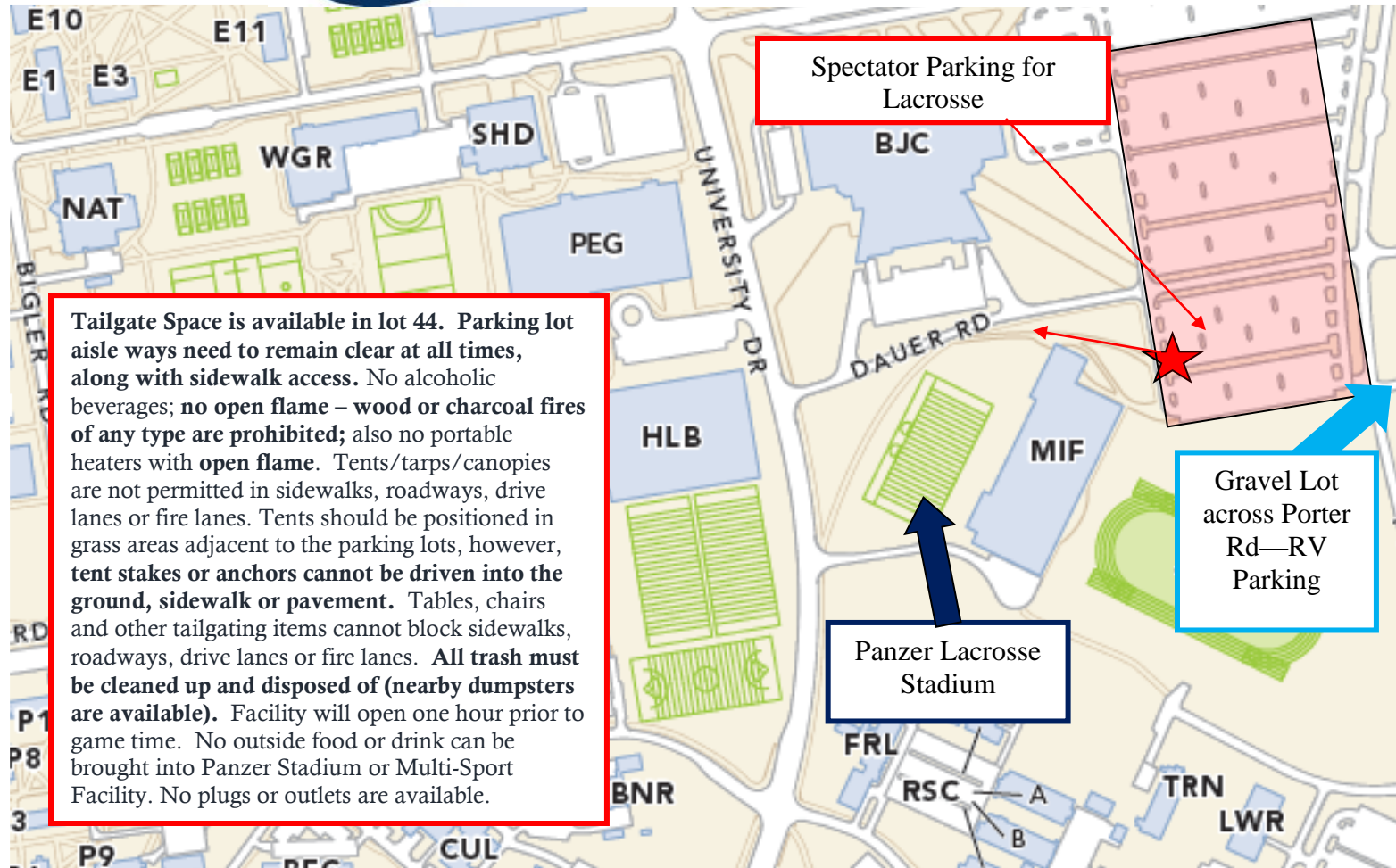




PENN STATE



Tailgate Space is available in lot 44. Parking lot aisle ways need to remain clear at all times, along with sidewalk access. No alcoholic beverages; no open flame – wood or charcoal fires of any type are prohibited; also no portable heaters with open flame. Tents/tarps/canopies are not permitted in sidewalks, roadways, drive lanes or fire lanes. Tents should be positioned in grass areas adjacent to the parking lots, however, tent stakes or anchors cannot be driven into the ground, sidewalk or pavement. Tables, chairs and other tailgating items cannot block sidewalks, roadways, drive lanes or fire lanes. All trash must be cleaned up and disposed of (nearby dumpsters are available). Facility will open one hour prior to game time. No outside food or drink can be brought into Panzer Stadium or Multi-Sport Facility. No plugs or outlets are available.

Panzer Lacrosse Stadium is the location of Penn State Lacrosse games. The entrance to the stadium is on the northwest side of Multi-Sport Facility (MIF). Spectator Parking is located in the BJC Lot 44 designated by a red square on the map. The red star indicates the visiting team bus drop off location. RV's are permitted to park during the duration of the lacrosse game (no overnight parking available) however they must go across Porter Road to the gravel lot below Medlar Baseball Stadium.
