Following Saturday's game, the Spartans are off for 10 days, having played 11 games in 33 days ... The Spartans are ranked #19 in the Associated Press poll and #20 in the ESPN Coaches poll ... MSU is #16 in the NET Rankings and #1 in Strength of Schedule in the country among major conference teams ... MSU is No. 4 in the country in adjusted defensive efficiency from KenPom.com, ranking among the nation's leaders in Block% (#14), 2PT% (#44), 3-point % (#24) and effective FG % (#14).

THE STARTING FIVE**1. Defensive Minded**

One of the mantras for Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo has always been to Defend, Rebound and Run ... The Spartans have done just that so far this season, ranking No. 4 nationally in the KenPom.com Adjusted Defensive Efficiency ratings, the only Big Ten team among the top-10 ... The Spartans have allowed 60 points or fewer four times this season, rank second in the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense at 37.9 percent (No. 28 nationally), third in the Big Ten in both rebounding offense (41.6 rpg) and rebounding margin (+8.20 rpg) and No. 1 in blocked shots per game (6.70 bpg, which is No. 8 nationally).

2. Series History

Michigan State leads the all-time series with Penn State, 41-9 ... The Spartans have won 25 of the last 31 games in the series, including 12 of the last 14 ... Tom Izzo is 34-8 in his career against Penn State ... Michigan State is 25-2 in games played at the Breslin Center and has won nine of the last 10 at home ... The Spartans won the only meeting the teams last year, beating the Nittany Lions, 60-58, at the Breslin Center.

3. No. 19 Michigan State Opens Big Ten Play with 75-67 Win at Minnesota

No. 19 Michigan State put four players in double figures and opened up a 19-point lead in the second half before hanging on to beat Minnesota, 75-67, in the Big Ten Conference opener for both schools at Williams Arena Wednesday night ... The Spartans had three players each score 15 points, with junior forward Malik Hall finishing with 15 points, nine rebounds and four assists, senior forward Gabe Brown with 15 points and eight rebounds and junior guard Tyson Walker had a season-high 15 points, five rebounds and three assists, while redshirt senior Joey Hauser finished with 10 points seven rebounds and two assists.

4. In Big Ten Conference Openers

Following the 75-67 win over Minnesota on Wednesday, Michigan State is now 17-10 in Big Ten Conference openers under Head Coach Tom Izzo ... The Spartans are 8-9 in Big Ten road openers under Izzo ... MSU is 22-4 in Big Ten home openers under Izzo ... The last time the Spartans lost a Big Ten Conference home opener was during the 2014-15 season, when Maryland beat MSU, 68-66.

5. About the Spartans

Michigan State enters the game on Saturday with an 8-2 overall record, and wins in eight of their last nine games ... MSU's two losses have come to teams ranked in the top-10 of the Associated Press rankings ... The Spartans have been led this year by a stingy defense, which ranks among the leaders in the Big Ten in scoring defense (No. 5, 63.9 ppg), field goal percentage defense (No. 2, 37.9%), 3-point field goal percentage defense (No. 3, 26.8%), rebounding margin (No. 3, +8.20 rpg) and blocked shots (No. 1, 6.70 bpg) ... Senior forward Gabe Brown is one of two players scoring in double figures and one of eight players averaging at least 5.0 points per game ... He leads the team with 13.1 ppg, while senior forward Marcus Bingham Jr. is second on the team with 10.1 points per game and leads the team with 7.1 rebounds and 3.0 blocked shots per game ... Junior forward Malik Hall is third with 9.7 ppg, while freshman guard Max Christie is averaging 8.9 ppg and 3.3 rpg ... Junior forward Julius Marble is averaging 5.9 ppg and 3.2 rpg and redshirt senior forward Joey Hauser adds 6.1 ppg and is second on the team with 6.1 rpg ... Junior guard Tyson Walker is averaging 6.7 ppg and leads the team with 4.7 assists, while sophomore teammate A.J. Hoggard is averaging 6.2 ppg, 4.3 apg and 2.1 rpg.

» The Nittany Lions have four players scoring in double figures, led by junior forward Seth Lundy, who is averaging 14.3 points per game.

» Two of Penn State's top four scorers are transfers, senior guards Sam Sessoms (Binghamton) and Jalen Pickett (Siena), while their rotation also includes senior forward Jalanni White (Canisius) and senior guard Jaheam Cornwall (Gardner-Webb).

» Max Christie has started every game and leads the team in minutes played (30.2 mpg), while averaging 8.9 points and 3.3 rebounds He has scored in double figures four times, including a career-high 18 points in a win at Butler.

» Jaden Akins is averaging 15.2 minutes per game and is averaging 5.1 points and 2.8 rebounds ... He scored a career-high 12 points in the loss to then-No. 6 Baylor in the Bahamas.

» Pierre Brooks, who is averaging 1.7 points and 1.0 rebounds, scored five points off the bench in the win over UConn in the Bahamas.

CHRISTIE NAMED BIG TEN CO-FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

» Max Christie was named the Big Ten Conference Co-Freshman of the Week on Dec. 6, sharing the award with Wisconsin freshman Chucky Hepburn.

» In two games, Christie averaged 12.0 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists ... He scored a team-high 14 points, with three rebounds, three assists and two blocks, to lead five players in double figures in the win over Toledo on Saturday ... Christie added 11 points and two rebounds in a win over Louisville.

» Christie was key on the defensive side, holding Louisville's leading scorer Noah Locke, averaging 14 points per game, scoreless, and helping to force Toledo's Ryan Rollins into 7-of-22 shooting.

BROWN NAMED TO BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

» Senior forward Gabe Brown was selected to the All-Tournament Team at the Battle 4 Atlantis

» Brown averaged 12.7 points and 5.0 rebounds while shooting 46.7 percent from the floor (14-of-30), including 42.9 percent from 3-point land (6-of-14) in three games.

» He had his second career double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds in the win over UConn.

SPARTANS SHARE THE BALL

- » Unselfishness has always been a trademark of all Tom Izzo teams.
- » That has been especially true for nearly the last decade as MSU established the top-five school record for assists during that span.
- » In 2018-19, the Spartans led the country in total assists and handed out the second-most in a single season in MSU history (715), recording an assist on 66.8 percent of their field goals that season.
- » In 2017-18, MSU led the country in assists per game (19.1) and handed out 670, then the second-best mark in program history.
- » In 2015-16, MSU tallied a school record 719 assists, good for the 22nd-best total in NCAA history ... MSU's nation's-best assist average of 20.5 was the 23rd-best average in NCAA history.
- » ***The Spartans have handed out at least 15 assists five times, including 20.0 in the last three games, and are averaging 15.4 per game in 2021-22.***

DEFEND, REBOUND, RUN

- » Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo has always said that if his teams can defend and rebound, it will lead to positives.
- » The Spartans have led the Big Ten in rebounding 10 times in the last 19 years and led the nation in rebounding four times – in 2009, 2010, 2016 and 2019.
- » In 2019-20, MSU led the Big Ten in rebounding offense (40.6 rpg) and tied for the league lead in rebounding margin (+7.5 rebounds) ... That same year, the Spartans led the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense, limiting opponents to 37.9 percent shooting.
- » ***In 2021-22, the Spartans are third in rebounding offense (41.60 rpg) and third in rebounding margin (+8.20 rpg).***

BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE HISTORY

- » Following its 73-64 win over Louisville on Dec. 1, Michigan State is now 9-12 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge
- » The Spartans won three of their last five Big Ten/ACC Challenge games, with wins over Notre Dame (2017) and Louisville (2015, 2021).

SPARTANS IN PRESEASON TOURNAMENTS

- » Including playing in the championship game of the Battle 4 Atlantis last weekend, Michigan State has had success in preseason tournaments in recent years.
- » In 2018, the Spartans won the Las Vegas Invitational, beating then-No. 17 UCLA 87-67 in the opening game, before topping Texas in the title game.
- » In 2017, MSU won the Victory Bracket of the PK80 Invitational in Portland, Ore., beating North Carolina, 81-63, in the title game.
- » MSU won the 2013 Coaches vs. Cancer Classic in Brooklyn and the 2015 Wooden Legacy in California, while finishing second in the 2014 Orlando Classic.
- » In 2019, MSU finished in fifth place in the Maui Invitational and no preseason tournaments were held in 2020 due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

BROWN AND HALL TABBED CAPTAINS FOR THE 2021-22 SEASON

- » Gabe Brown and junior Malik Hall were selected as co-captains for the Spartans for the 2021-22 season, Head Coach Tom Izzo announced on Sept. 28.
- » Brown appeared in 25 games last year, starting five times, and was fifth on the team in scoring with 7.2 points per game.
- » Hall appeared in all 28 games last year, starting nine times, and was sixth on the team with 5.2 points and fourth with 4.2 rebounds per game.

THE WALKER WATCH

- » Michigan State added junior guard Tyson Walker to the roster in April following his transfer from Northeastern University.
- » Through 10 games this year, Walker has scored in double figures twice, including a season-high 15 points at Minnesota, while averaging 6.7 points.
- » He has led MSU in assists four times this season, including a career-high 10 against Louisville.
- » Walker helped lead Northeastern to its fourth Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) regular season title last year as the Huskies went 8-2 in league play and finished 10-8 overall ... In 18 games during the 2020-21 season, Walker led Northeastern with 18.6 points per game, while adding 4.8 assists and 2.4 steals per game, which ranked No. 13 in the country ... In CAA games, the 6-foot guard led the CAA in scoring with 19.3 points and 2.5 steals per game.
- » Walker was named the CAA Defensive Player of the Year and was an All-CAA first team selection ... Walker scored in double figures in 17 of 18 games last season, including the last 16.
- » He led the CAA with a pair of 30-point games and scored 27 at North Carolina on Feb. 17, becoming the first player in four seasons to score 20 or more points in the first half against the Tar Heels.
- » A native of Westbury, N.Y., Walker was a finalist for the Lou Henson Award, announced by Colleg Insider.com and presented annually to the top mid-major player in college basketball.

SMITH AWARDED SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2020-21 SEASON

Michigan State men's basketball Head Coach Tom Izzo announced at MSU's on-campus media day on October 20 that sophomore Davis Smith had been awarded a scholarship for the 2021-22 year ... Smith walked on to the team prior to the 2020-21 season ... The son of former MSU All-American and long-time NBA standout Steve Smith, the youngest Smith appeared in eight games last year ... Of Smith, Izzo said, "he earned a scholarship because he's Davis Smith, not Steve Smith's son."

STAFFING CHANGES ANNOUNCED

At Michigan State's on-campus media day on October 20, Head Coach Tom Izzo announced a pair of staff changes, with long-time assistant Mike Garland, who is in his 22nd year with the program, moving to Special Assistant to the Head Coach ... Izzo turned to former Spartan Mark Montgomery, who had been hired in June as recruiting coordinator, to take over as an assistant coach ... Montgomery's return to the program, he was on Izzo's staff for 10 years prior to becoming head coach at Northern Illinois, was one of several involving former players ... Former captain Austin Thornton is now the program's video coordinator and 2019 graduate Matt McQuaid is the team's assistant director of basketball operations.

HEAD COACH TOM IZZO

Now in his 27th season at Michigan State, Hall of Fame coach Tom Izzo has built the Spartans into one of the elite programs in the nation ... The Spartans' 23 straight NCAA Tournaments are a Big Ten record, the second-longest active streak in the nation and the fourth-longest active streak of all time ... He's been able to accomplish this while playing more ranked teams than anyone else since 1998 ... Michigan State has appeared in eight Final Fours since 1999, the most in the nation.

CHAMPIONS CLASSIC RENEWED

ESPN announced on Tuesday, Nov. 9 that the season-opening Champions Classic, featuring Michigan State, Duke, Kansas and Kentucky, has been renewed for three more years through 2025 with the four participating schools ... The neutral site doubleheader debuted in 2011 and will continue to rotate among New York City (2021), Indianapolis (2022) and other sites, with the 2023-25 venues to be announced at a later date ... The Spartans will play Kentucky next year in Indianapolis.

SPARTANS ADD TWO ON SIGNING DAY

Michigan State's men's basketball team received signed National Letters of Intent from Trejuan Holloman and Jaxon Kohler on Nov. 10.

Tre Holloman (6-2, 175, Minneapolis, Minn./Cretin-Derham)

- » Ranked No. 67 nationally, No. 11 among point guards and the top player in the state of Minnesota according to 247Sports.com's composite rankings.
 - » A four-star point guard from Cretin-Derham, Holloman is also a three-star defensive back for the football team
 - » He averaged 20.3 points, 9.3 assists, 4.7 rebounds and 4.2 steals while shooting 49.0 percent from the floor in 23 games
 - » Helped lead the Raiders to a Class 4A state runner-up finish with an 18-5 record
 - » Holloman's mother, Crystal, played women's basketball at the University of Minnesota.
- #### Jaxon Kohler (6-9, 250, American Fork, Utah/ Southern California Academy [Calif.])
- » Ranked No. 62 nationally, No. 9 among forwards and No. 6 in Utah
 - » Scored 53 points and grabbed 23 rebounds and was named the Most Valuable Player at the Pangos All-American Festival in August
 - » Spent his first three years in high school at American Fork in Utah
 - » Named the Utah 6A Player of the Year as a junior, helping to lead American Fork to a 17-7 record and a state semifinal appearance
 - » Finished the season averaging 21.6 points, 8.9 rebounds and 2.5 assists
 - » Scored 26 points and had 18 rebounds in the state semifinals
 - » Watched highlights of Hakeem Olajuwon as a youth and wrote down post moves, step-by-step, in a journal before practicing them on a court.

FAMILY AFFAIRS

A pair of familiar names appear on the Michigan State roster in 2021-22 ... Returning for his junior year as a walk-on is Steven Izzo, the son of Head Coach Tom Izzo ... A 5-8 guard, Izzo walked on to the team prior to the 2019-20 season ... He appeared in eight games last year ... Also on the roster this season is sophomore guard Davis Smith, the son of Spartan legend Steve Smith ... The younger Smith played at Westminster Academy in Atlanta before coming to Michigan State ... His father was a two-time All-American and ranks second all-time in scoring at MSU.

GRADUATE MATTERS

Michigan State added a pair of fifth-year seniors to the squad this season in Western Michigan transfer Jason Whitens and Ferris State graduate Michael Peterson, both of whom walked on to the team this summer ... They join two other Spartans who have already started work on graduate degrees, as redshirt senior Joey Hauser and senior Gabe Brown earned their bachelor's degrees last year:

WHITENS SIDELINED

Redshirt senior guard Jason Whitens, a transfer from Western Michigan, will be out for the season after tearing his ACL in Michigan State's first exhibition game against Ferris State on Oct. 27 ... A physical player with a high motor and a knack for rebounding and defense, Whitens played just over three minutes and grabbed three boards before being sidelined ... As a redshirt junior in 2020-21 at WMU, he played in 19 games and made 18 starts while averaging 23.3 minutes ... Whitens averaged 5.4 points, 3.5 rebounds and 1.3 assists.

COACHING STABILITY

Michigan State has had just two basketball coaches in the last 46 seasons and three in the last 52 ... Tom Izzo is in his 27th season, having taking over from his mentor Jud Heathcote, who spent 19 years as head coach (1976-95) ... Before Heathcote, Gus Ganakas spent seven seasons as head coach ... Ganakas provided commentary on Spartan radio broadcasts for 31 seasons.

EXPERIENCED COACHING STAFF

For the previous 11 years, Michigan State had one of the longest-tenured coaching staffs in Division I basketball ... Head Coach Tom Izzo and the trio of Dwayne Stephens, Mike Garland and Dane Fife had been together for 11 years, tops among Division I schools from 2010-21 (West Virginia is the currently the longest-tenured staff at 10 years) ... The Spartans made coaching staff changes this year and are not among that list, but have a combined 121 years of experience, including two assistant coaches – Doug Wojcik and Mark Montgomery – who have head coaching experience:

- Tom Izzo – 27th year at Michigan State, 43 years overall
- Dwayne Stephens – 19th at Michigan State, 25 years overall
- Doug Wojcik – 4th year at MSU (2 previously), 30 years overall
- Mark Montgomery – 1st year back at MSU (9 previously), 23 years overall

DRAYMOND GREEN HELPS LEAD TEAM USA TO GOLD MEDAL IN TOKYO

Former Michigan State men's basketball standout Draymond Green said that winning a gold medal with the United States at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics in August was among the highlights of his career ... Green had five assists and two steals in 16 minutes in the gold medal game as Team USA beat France, 87-82, for the country's fourth-straight gold medal ... It was the 16th time in the last 19 Olympics that Team USA has won the gold medal ... This was Green's second gold medal as he was on the Team USA squad that won at the 2016 Rio Games in Brazil ... Green is one of only five players to win two gold medals and win three NBA titles, joining Michael Jordan, Scottie Pippen, Kobe Bryant and LeBron James ... Green is the third former Michigan State player to win Olympic gold, joining Magic Johnson (1992) and Steve Smith (2000).

SPARTANS IN THE NBA

Twenty-two Spartans have been selected in the NBA Draft under Head Coach Tom Izzo, including 21 since the 2000 NBA Draft ... All-time, Michigan State has had 65 players selected in the NBA Draft ... Michigan State currently has seven players on NBA opening day rosters:

NATION'S BEST EIGHT FINAL FOURS IN 23 YEARS

Michigan State advanced to the 2019 Final Four, marking the eighth trip to the Final Four in 21 seasons under Tom Izzo ... The eight trips in the last 23 seasons rank as the most in the nation ... In addition, MSU has appeared in 23-straight NCAA Tournaments, marking the nation's second-longest active streak, and the longest streak in Big Ten history.

Coach Izzo

In his 27th year, Tom Izzo (Northern Michigan, '77) is 651-256 (.718), and 312-143 (.686) in the Big Ten, as the head coach of the Michigan State basketball program. He ranks as the winningest coach in Michigan State history, having passed his mentor Jud Heathcote with his 341st career victory on Nov. 28, 2009. In his 26 seasons as a head coach, Izzo has captured eight National Coach of the Year awards, including the Clair Bee Award in 2005 and NABC honors in 2001 and 2012. In 1999, Izzo was named National Coach of the Year by Basketball Times, while earning similar honors from The Associated Press, Basketball News and the USBWA in '98. He also earned National Coach of the Year accolades from CBSSports.com in 2012. He earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in 1998, 2009 and 2012. Izzo was enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on September 9, 2016, cementing his status as one of the game's all-time greats.

Among The Big Ten's Best

Tom Izzo's .686 winning percentage in Big Ten games ranks tied for third all-time among league coaches with at least 10 years of service, behind former Wisconsin coach Bo Ryan (.717), and former Indiana coach Bob Knight (.700), and ahead of former Purdue coach Ward Lambert (.685). In all games, Ohio State's Thad Matta ranks first at .748, followed by Ryan (.737), Knight (.734), Izzo (.718), Wisconsin's Walter Meanwell (.712), and Lambert (.709). With 312 conference victories, Izzo ranks second all time.

Izzo Among Best Ever

Through his first 26 seasons, Tom Izzo won 643 games, ranking fifth in college basketball history for most wins by a college coach in his first 26 years.

Final Fours

Tom Izzo led MSU to eight Final Four appearances between 1999 and 2019, becoming just the fourth school in college basketball history to do it in any 21-year span, including just the third since the tournament field expanded to 64 teams in 1985. Izzo's eight Final Fours are the most by any coach since his first season in 1996 and he ranks fifth all-time, including third among active coaches. The eight Final Fours are also the most by any Big Ten coach.
