The Nittany Lions also welcome Lock Haven for a 7 p.m. showdown on Tuesday, Sept. 23.

Michigan Notes

- The Wolverines entered the rankings for the first time on Sept. 16, sitting at No. 18 in the NFHCA Poll.
- Michigan is 4-2 this season, winning each of its last four games. Its only losses came to No. 2 North Carolina and No. 11 Wake Forest.
- Leslie Smith leads the team with 12 points this season, including five goals. She ranks 24th nationally in points per game (2.00) and goals per game (0.83). Ainsley McCallister is second in the country with 1.50 assists per game.
- Defensively, goalkeeper Sam Swenson has started four of the six games, tallying a .812 save percentage and holding a 0.70 goals against average.
- Marcia Pankratz is in her 15th season at the helm.

Lock Haven Notes

- The Bald Eagles are 5-1 this season and are on a five-game winning streak. Their only loss came against Providence to start the season.
- Offensively, Lydia George leads the team with six goals and 14 points. She ranks 13th in the country with 1.00 goals per game and 15th with 2.33 points per game.
- Defensively, the team ranks third nationally with a 1.12 goals against average.
- Goalkeeper Elaina White is 18th in the country with a .778 save percentage.

- Pat Rudy is in her 19th season as head coach.

Series History

Penn State is 18-14-1 all-time against Lock Haven, dating back to their first season of field hockey in 1964. The Nittany Lions have won 12-straight in the series, including a 3-0 win on the road last season.

50th Anniversary of Women in Sport

Field hockey was the first women's intercollegiate program at Penn State, starting up in 1964. The Nittany Lions defeated Susquehanna, 2-0, in the first intercollegiate event on Oct. 3, 1964. Head coach Charlene Morett-Curtiss has been around for parts of five decades, starting as a player in 1975. Overall, the Nittany Lions are 631-239-37 all-time and have made 29 NCAA Tournament appearances, ranking third in Division twice this season. Most recently, she I history.

Last Time Out

The Nittany Lions posted wins against No. 14 Princeton, 5-2, on Sept. 12 and against Lafayette, 5-1, on Sept. 14. Against the Tigers, the Nittany Lions rallied to score five second-half goals, including three from senior Taylor Herold (Fredericksburg, Va.), to secure the win. Then, they posted five goals against Lafayette, including two from senior It marks the first time Penn State has back games since 2012.

Fast Start

Penn State is off to a 5-1 start this season, its best start since 2005. That team started the season 17-1 and finished with a 6-0 record in the Big Ten.

Herold's Heroics

Senior Taylor Herold (Fredericksburg, Va.) posted three goals, all in the second half, against No. 14 Princeton on Sept. 12. It marked her first career hat trick. She ranks second on the team with 12 points and is tied for the team lead in goals with five.

Corner Defense

Penn State opponents have taken 38 penalty corners this season, but have only scored two goals.

Big Ten Honors

Redshirt senior goalkeeper Kylie Licata (Mountain Top, Pa.) was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week made a career-high 14 saves at No. 3 UConn and shut out Quinnipiac to earn the honor on Sept. 9. Licata openers, winning each of its last four. the Week (Sept. 2), while back Cori Conley (Oak Park, III.) was named Freshman of the Week following the season-opening wins. Licata made a career-high nine saves against the Lady Monarchs and shut out the Cavaliers. Conley played a key role defensively, helping a unit that held Virginia scoreless in a game for the first time since 2011.

Chrismer Capitalizing

Senior Jenna Chrismer (Mountain Top, Pa.) has been impressive offensively. Most recently, she posted a career-high two assists against No. 14 Princeton (Sept. 12) before tying her personal best with two goals vs. Lafayette (Sept. 14). She scored each Jenna Chrismer (Mountain Top, Pa.). of the team's goals in the 2-1 win over Old Dominion (Aug. 29), before tallying scored five-or-more goals in back-to- an assist against Virginia (Aug. 31) and at Quinnipiac (Sept. 7). She leads the team with 14 points and ranks 15th nationally with 2.33 points per game.

Solid in the Cage

Licata has been a force between the posts, making nine saves against Old Dominion and holding Virginia scoreless, the first time the Cavaliers were blanked since 2011. Then, at No. 3 Connecticut, she stopped a career-high 14 shots. She ranks fourth nationally with a .875 save percentage and ninth with a 0.81 goals against average.

Buttinger Breaks Out

Redshirt senior **Natalie Buttinger** (Kitchener, Ontario) scored the first two goals of her career in the 3-0 win over No. 6 Virginia.

Maryland (No. 1) is the only conference foe ranked higher. Penn State plays nine teams ranked that are ranked in the preseason poll.

Gebhart on the National Stage

Gebhart has been competing for the U.S. National Team each of the last two summers. She competed internationally in March, and was one of 30 players on the 2013-14 U.S. National Field Hockey Team.

The longest tenured coach in the Big Ten and the sixth-longest tenured at a single school in Division I field hockey history, Charlene Morett-Curtiss enters her 28th season as head coach of the Penn State field hockey program in 2014. Morett-Curtiss boasts a remarkable resume covering her time as the leader of the Nittany Lions. Over the last six years, Morett-Curtiss has led the Nittany Lions to three Big Ten regular season titles, two Big Ten Tournament championships and five NCAA Tournament appearances.

Morett-Curtiss currently ranks fifth all-time in Division I history in wins with 458 and is one of just six DI coaches to accumulate 400 career wins. She has led the Nittany Lions to the NCAA Tournament in 24 of her 27 years as head coach of Penn State and has helped maintain Penn State's distinction as the No. 3 ranked school in all-time NCAA Tournament appearances with 29.

A seven-time NFHCA Mideast Region Coach of the Year, Morett-Curtiss is an excellent teacher of field hockey. Her players earn national recognition on a yearly basis, 11 of whom have been named two-time first team All-Americans with Kelsey Amy being the most recent. Her teams dominate the national scene, consistently ranking among the Top 10 in the national polls. Penn State was ranked in the Top 10 of the STX/NFHCA poll for 32 consecutive weeks from the first poll of the 2005 season ending with the second poll of 2008. The squad achieved a No. 1 ranking in the STX/NFHCA poll for the first time in program history. From 2005-08, Penn State finished eighth, sixth, ninth and 11th respectively, in the final poll of the season.

Under Morett-Curtiss' tutelage, five of her players have been named Big Ten Athlete of the Year -- Traci Anselmo, Jen Coletta, Heather Gorlaski, Tracey Larson and Kiley Kulina. Six players have been voted the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year -- Natalie Berrena, Dawn Lammey, Larson, Tara Maguire, Allison Scola and Kelsey Amy. In 2012 and 2013, Brittany Grzywacz was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, earning the ninth and 10th Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honors from Penn State, joining Anselmo, Gorlaski, Becca Main, Jill Martz, Jill Pearsall and Jen Long. Long, Anselmo and Grzywacz are the only Lions to be named Defensive Player of the Year twice.

Since Penn State's entry into the Big Ten in 1992, Morett's program has produced more First Team All-Big Ten selections, Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year, Big Ten Athletes of the Year and Big Ten Freshmen of the Year than any other program. Penn State's 10 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honorees are five more than any other school.

With Laura Gebhart, Brittany Grzywacz, Taylor Herold, Ashtin Klingler and Kylie Licata earning All-Big Ten laurels last season, Penn State has now totaled 94 All-Big Ten selections since 1992, including 65 first team All-Conference choices, the most of any Big Ten school since Penn State moved to the Big Ten in 1992.

CHARLENE MORETT-CURTISS YEAR-BY-YEAR
