THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

. This weekend marks the eighth and ninth meetings alltime between the two schools with Penn State having never lost to the Purple Eagles holding the 6-0-1 advantage.

. The two programs last met during the 2019-20 season with Penn State earning the series sweep at Pegula Ice Arena with scores of 3-2 and 2-0. During the second game of the series, then sophomore Oskar Autio registered his second-consecutive shutout and second career victory in the process.

 Niagara has never scored more than two goals against Penn State in the seven previous matchups as the Nittany Lions are outscoring the Purple Eagles 28-8 in the series. Penn State has won six-straight meetings after the first-ever meeting on November 6, 2015 ended in a 1-1 tie at Dwyer Ice Arena.

· Only nine current Nittany Lions have laced up their skates against Niagara led by senior Paul DeNaples with a pair of assists in four games against the Purple Eagles. Junior Connor McMenamin tallied the game-winning goal in each of the two games played during the 2019-20 season while senior Adam Pilewicz recorded his first collegiate goal against Niagara during an 8-2 victory on October 19, 2018.

· After splitting with Canisius a few weeks ago, Penn State is now 38-15-2 all-time against Atlantic Hockey opponents. The loss snapped a streak of 13-straight victories for Penn State against Atlantic teams dating back to the 2017-18 season. The Nittany Lions dropped a pair of games that season to Atlantic foes with losses to AIC and Mercyhurst over a three-week span.

HOCKEY VALLEY FIVE-0

• Penn State hit its magic number of five goals during the series finale against Canisius two weeks ago improving to 84-1-2 all-time when scoring five or more goals. Penn State was 4-0-0 in such games during 2020-21 after going 11-0-0 when scoring five or more goals in 2019-20.

• The Nittany Lions have won 26-straight games when scoring five or more goals, including two so far this season, with the last and only loss coming at Wisconsin on December 1, 2018, an 8-5 defeat.

CENTURY MARK

• A pair of seniors will reach the 100-game milestone for their careers on Thursday evening as Paul DeNaples and Ben Copeland will skate in their 100th collegiate game should they be in the lineup. DeNaples has spent his entire career in the Blue & White while Copeland transferred in from Colorado College and will be competing in just his third game as a Nittany Lion.

• With a pair of assists so far this season, DeNaples has moved into a tie for eighth on the Penn State all-time assists list for defenseman with 23 for his career while his 28 points put him tenth among defensemen in program history, just one point shy of Nate Jensen for ninth.

HELLO, OLD FRIEND

· Assistant coach Juliano Pagliero is a 2009 graduate from Niagara and will be facing off against his Alma Mater for the first time in four years this weekend. As a coach, the former CHA Player of the Year is 8-2-0 all-time against Niagara.

GOOD GUY, BAD GUY

• Sophomore Christian Sarlo is tied for the team lead with two goals, both have been game-winning tallies which are tied for fourth in the nation, however, Sarlo's three penalties also tie for the team lead.

GOALTENDING TANDEM

• Following a 27-save performance against Canisius two weeks ago, senior goaltender Oskar Autio moved past PJ Musico and into fourth on the all-time saves list at Penn State as he continues to inch closer to 1.000 career saves.

 With just one more appearance he will tie Musico for fourth all-time at Penn State with 30 appearances. Autio's 13 victories rank fourth all-time at Penn State just five behind Eamon McAdam for third.

 Sophomore Liam Souliere made his first start between the pipes against Canisius on October 9 picking up his second collegiate victory with a 36-save performance. His 36 saves tied his career-high which he first achieved against Arizona State last December.

DANNY DANGLEZ

· Freshman forward Danny Dzhaniyev leads the team through the first four games of the season with five points on two goals and three assists. He has registered at least one point in three of his four games played with a pair of multi-point efforts along the way.

• The rookie's five points are tied for sixth in the Big Ten and 35th nationally

DON'T GET SHORT WITH ME

 Junior Connor MacEachern sealed the 5-2 victory over Canisius with a short-handed, empty-net tally two weeks ago. After scoring earlier in the game this marked his first career multi-goal game and it also marked the first time in program history Penn State has allowed a shorthanded goal and scored a shorthanded goal in the same game.

BLOCK PARTY

· Penn State is averaging 16.5 blocks per game this season to lead the Big Ten paced by 22 and 26 blocks, respectively, in the games vs. Canisius two weeks ago.

 Sophomore Christian Berger paces Penn State with 10 blocks on the season to rank fourth in the Big Ten and tied for 15th in the nation. DeNaples ranks fifth in the Big Ten and tied for 25th nationally with nine blocks through four games.

· Connor McMenamin is tied for fifth among all forwards in the nation with seven blocks on the season including an impressive stretch during the series finale against Canisius where he had three-consecutive blocked shots during the penalty kill all without a stick.

SCOUTING NIAGARA

• The Purple Eagles lost seven of their top-10 scorers from a team that finished the 2020-21 season 7-12-3. Niagara 2020-21 season 7-12-3. Niagara was swept by North Dakota two weeks ago to open the season los-ing 6-2 and 4-0.

• Walker Sommer returns for his senior season after leading the team with eight goals and 15 points last season. Ryan Naumovski also returns after a 13-point season in 2020-21 and he scored one of the two Purple Eagle goals against North Dakota.

• Chad Veltri returns between the pipes for Niagara after posting a 5-7-2 record last season with a a 5-7-2 record last season with s .914 save percentage and a 2.61 goals-against average.

Niagara averaged just 19 shots per game in its two-game series against North Dakota. The Purple Eagles allowed four power-play goals to the Fighting Hawks on seven opportunities while only scoring one man-advantage goal of their own on eight chances.

• Niagara averaged 2.59 goals per game during the 2020-21 season while allowing 3.18, however, albeit a small sample size, they are av-eraging just 1.00 goals per game while allowing 5.00 through two games this season.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD

· Penn State has scored the opening goal in all three of its victories this season after going 7-4-0 when scoring first last season. Over the past five seasons, the Nittany Lions are now 70-17-9 when scoring first.

· Penn State has also held the lead entering the third period in each victory this season moving to 130-12-10 all-time when carrying a lead into the final period. On the flip side, the Nittany Lions are just 13-96-7 all-time when trailing entering the third period with just one win in each of the past six seasons when in that situation.

UNDERCLASSMEN PACING PLAY

• Through the first four games of the season, Penn State's underclassmen have led the way combining for more than half of Penn State's goals scored and over two-thirds of the total points.

• The sophomores have scored five goals while adding eight assists for 13 points while the freshman have three goals and nine assists for 12 points. The juniors and seniors have combined for six goals and six assists for 12 points.



· Penn State hits the road for the first time this season with a trip to Nashville, Tennessee for the US Hockey Hall of Fame game against North Dakota at Bridgestone Arena on Saturday, October 30.

THE GREAT GADOWSKY

 Head Coach Guy Gadowsky registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State. Gadowsky is now 158-133-23 all-time behind the Penn State bench.

• The 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year registered his 300th career victory in 2019-20 and currently ranks 74th all-time throughout all divisions with 331 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 42nd with his 331 wins and is currently 14th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

• Senior Paul DeNaples was selected by his peers as the ninth captain in program history for the 2021-22 season. Senior classmates Adam Pilewicz and Clayton Phillips along with junior Connor McMenamin will serve as alternates.

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula lce Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its ninth season entering 2021-22. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.

• The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.

• The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New last season an continuing in 2021-22 is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 22nd collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his 10th at Penn State in 2021-22.

AT PENN STATE

In a season unlike any other in 2020-21, Gadowsky led Penn State back to the Big Ten semifinals for the sixth consecutive season and the seventh time overall as he became the winningest coach in the history of the tournament after securing his 11th victory in B1G tournament play.

The Bench Boss registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State.

Penn State captain Alex Limoges went on to sign an AHL contract with the San Diego Gulls and in just 23 games scored 11 goals while adding 10 assists for 21 points.

Following the season Aarne Talvitie inked his entry-level, NHL contract with the New Jersey Devils while earlier in the season former Nittany Lion Peyton Jones also put pen to paper on an NHL contract giving Penn State six NHL signees in the past two seasons and 10 overall.

Near the conclusion of the 2020-21 NHL season former Penn State forward Brett Murray (2017-18) made his NHL debut with the Buffalo Sabres becoming the second Nittany Lions to skate in an NHL contest.

Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship during the 2019-20 season with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.

Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October against Sacred Heart.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucese landed on the Second-Team West while also

being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucese took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

HC

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nit-

tany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual



national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning record in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a twoyear contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he took a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's
