QUICK HITS

- West Virginia hits the road for a midweek game at Penn State on Tuesday night.
- WVU is 43-70 all-time against the Nittany Lions. Tuesday's game marks the first time the two programs meet since the Mountaineers earned a 3-2, walk-off win over PSU on April 10, 2018, at PNC Park in Pittsburgh.
- West Virginia hasn't played a game in University Park since March 22, 2016.
- The Mountaineers are 2-3 against Big Ten Conference competition this season.
- The squad is coming off a series sweep over Baylor last weekend in Morgantown. WVU earned wins of 7-6, 8-4 and 7-5 to take all three games over the Bears.
- It marked the first time West Virginia swept a Big 12 opponent since May 6-8, 2016, against Texas.
- At 5-1 inside the league, the Mountaineers begin the week ranked atop of the Big 12 standings.
- West Virginia was included in Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's Division I poll this week, checking in at No. 24.
- Senior OF Austin Davis finished 11-for-16 with 10 runs scored in four games last week. He also was just a triple short of the cycle in Sunday's game against Baylor. For his efforts, Davis was named the Big 12 Player of the Week on Monday.
- WVU enters the weekend ranked No. 3 nationally and No. 1 in the Big 12 in stolen bases, with 102. The squad is No. 1 among "Power 5" programs in stolen bases since 2018.
- Prior to this season, West Virginia had only recorded 100 stolen bases in a season once in program history (114 in 1986).
- Davis has swiped 54 career bags, which sits at No. 5 in WVU's all-time record book. Junior outfielder Victor Scott II is No. 6 on the list, with 49. Scott II has 25 steals this season alone, good for No. 4 in the nation and No. 7 in single-season WVU history.
- Senior RHP Zach Ottinger earned a win and a save last week. He ranks No. 7 in program history with 46 career appearances out of the bullpen.
- Coach Randy Mazey is 283-218 with the Mountaineers since taking over in 2013 and owns 470 career wins in 16 seasons as a head coach.
- Sophomore C McGwire Holbrook homered and had six RBI in the Baylor series. For the year, he leads the team with a .349 average at the plate.
- Freshman INF Grant Hussey paces the club with six big flies, while Scott II's 30 RBI are tops on the team.
- Davis and Scott II each enter Tuesday's contest on a 15-game reached base streak.
- On the mound, the Mountaineer pitching staff has combined to strike out at least 10 batters in 15 of 30 games this season.

FIRST CLASS

WVU has brought in some of its best talent in program history over the past five seasons, resulting in top-35 signing classes from 2018-22, according to Perfect Game. Year in and year out, the Mountaineers draw the attention of the nation's top players.

KEY TEAM NOTES

- Since debuting as a program in 1892, WVU has logged more than 2,200 wins, produced 27 Major League Baseball players, 24 All-Americans and one United States Olympian.
- The 2022 campaign marks the 130th year and 127th season of baseball at WVU. The Mountaineers are the second-oldest program in the Big 12.
- WVU has won multiple games at the Big 12 Championship in six of the last eight tournaments, including five in a row.
- Two Mountaineers - junior OF Austin Davis and junior RHP Jacob Watters - were Preseason All-Big 12 selections. Watters also was named to the NCBWA's Preseason All-America Third Team.
- WVU was one of four schools to have multiple players represented on the preseason all-conference squad.
- Davis was an All-Big 12 Honorable Mention selection last season, while sophomore LHP Ben Hampton and INF Mikey Kluska appeared on the Big 12 All-Freshman Team in 2021.
- Additionally, Hampton was named a Freshman All-American by Perfect Game/Rawlings.
- Prior to the start of the season, fifth-year senior RHP Trey Braithwaite, redshirt junior RHP Noah Short and Watters were named to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Preseason Watch List. WVU was one of seven schools to have multiple players on the list, which honors the top relief pitcher in college baseball, as well as the only team in the country to have three players recognized.
- Junior OF Victor Scott II was featured on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays on Feb. 25. He earned the No. 5 spot following a critical, over-the-wall catch in center field at Charlotte. He was on the program again at the No. 8 spot for stealing home on March 25, vs. Youngstown State. Infielder Tevin Tucker was featured on the program on April 6.
- West Virginia finished 5-2 in February, good for its sixth winning record in the season's opening month in the last seven years. The club also went 9-7 in March.
- The Mountaineers scored their first-ever series win at then-No. 10 TCU, from April 1-3, in Fort Worth. It marked the first series win over a top-10 opponent on the road since March 17-19, 2017, at then-No. 10 Baylor.

THE MAZEY EFFECT

Coach Randy Maze is in his 10th season at the helm in Morgantown and owns a 283-218 mark with the Mountaineers.

- Maze was named the Big 12 Coach of the Year and ABCA East Regional Coach of the Year in 2019, after leading West Virginia to its second NCAA Tournament appearance in three years.
- He became the first coach in WVU history to be selected for the Big 12's yearly honor, while the ABCA accolade was his second in three seasons and the fourth ever for a WVU coach.
- Maze's Mountaineer teams have won at least 30 games in four different campaigns and have finished .500 or better in eight of his nine seasons at the helm.
- Maze's 2019 club won 38 games, the most in his WVU tenure and second-most in school history, sitting only behind the 1994 squad (40 wins).
- April 9's game against Baylor marked Maze's 500th game as the skipper of the Mountaineers.
- Now in his 16th season as a head coach, he is 470-378-2 in his career.

HOMEOWN TALENT

Six West Virginia natives are featured on the 2022 roster, the second-most of any state (Pennsylvania, 8). Together, the group understands as well as anyone in the program about the honor and unique opportunity to represent the citizens of the Mountain State.

- The group includes freshman infielder/catcher Joel Gardner (Poca), freshman first baseman/outfielder Grant Hussey (Washington), sophomore infielder Mikey Kluska (White Sulphur Springs), senior left-handed pitcher Beau Lowery (Martinsburg), sophomore left-hander Trevor Sharp (Inwood) and redshirt junior right-hander Noah Short (Scott Depot).

COUNTRY ROADS, TAKE ME HOME

Along with the squad's six in-state products, WVU is represented by 14 total states this season.

- Pennsylvania leads the list with eight representatives, ahead of West Virginia (six), Virginia (five) and Alabama (three). WVU has two players from Florida, Kentucky, New York, Texas and Wisconsin, as well as one from Maryland, New Jersey, New Mexico and Ontario, Canada.

MOUNTAINEER BREAKDOWN

Take a look inside WVU's 40-man roster this spring:

- The roster is comprised of 16 freshmen, eight sophomores, one redshirt sophomore, four juniors, four redshirt juniors, three seniors, one redshirt senior and three fifth-year seniors.
- The group consists of four catchers, 11 infielders, eight outfielders, 20 right-handed pitchers and four left-handed pitchers.
- WVU also has a total of eight players with the ability to play multiple positions in the field, as noted on the squad's roster page.

VETERAN ADDITIONS

West Virginia stocked up with veteran talent over the offseason, adding four players with prior Division I experience to the roster in 2022.

- WVU has three fifth-year senior pitchers who have transferred in to finish their collegiate careers in Morgantown. RHP Trey Braithwaite arrived from Navy, while RHP Zach Bravo comes from Lamar and RHP Chase Smith from Pitt.
- In four seasons at Navy (2018-21), Braithwaite became Navy's all-time leader in saves (17). Smith also rewrote some records at his prior institution, appearing in 89 career games at Pitt from 2018-21, including a program-record 33 in 2019.
- Prior to his time in Division I ball, Bravo was selected in the 2019 MLB Draft, a 29th round pick by the Tampa Bay Rays.
- Additionally, a fourth Division I transfer joined the team in 2022 in redshirt junior C/INF Dayne Leonard, who played at Virginia Tech last spring.

WINNING IT LATE

Taking on an identity of a team that is never out of a game, West Virginia has won six games in the ninth inning or later this season.

- Trailing, 4-1, at one point, WVU scored four unanswered at Charlotte on Feb. 25, including the go-ahead run in the top of the ninth.
- At the Cambria College Classic on March 4 in Minneapolis, WVU overcame a 4-2 deficit to top Minnesota, 5-4, with a ninth-inning run.
- WVU also had two walk-off wins in one week on March 8 vs. Rider (5-4) and March 11 vs. Ohio State (7-6). Freshman INF Grant Hussey's double (Rider) and senior OF Austin Davis' single (OSU) were the game-winning hits.
- On April 1, West Virginia opened Big 12 play with a wild, ninth-inning comeback at TCU. Trailing by a run and down to its last strike, WVU stole home to tie the game and added the go-ahead run when the ball got away from the catcher.
- Sophomore INF Nathan Blasick drew a bases-loaded walk in the bottom of the ninth inning to walk-off Baylor, 7-6, on April 8, in Morgantown.

WAGENER FIELD AT MONONGALIA COUNTY BALLPARK

Wagener Field at Monongalia County Ballpark took on Rick and Jay Wagener's namesake on Aug. 30, 2021, following a major gift donation of \$1 million to the program. Rick Wagener was a standout pitcher at WVU from 1968-71.

- The donation will help with the maintenance and upkeep at Monongalia County Ballpark, as well as assist in the team's greatest needs.
- Rick Wagener, who is a 1971 graduate and first-ever freshman to play at the varsity level for the Mountaineers, serves as the managing partner and registered principal at Wagener-Lee, LLC, a financial and investment advisor located in Columbia, Maryland. His wife, Jay, also is a WVU grad.
- Wagener spent three seasons in the New York Mets organization from 1971-73, after being selected by the club in the second round of the 1971 January Secondary Draft.
- Prior to April 9's game against Baylor, the Mountaineers honored the Wageners with a field dedication ceremony.

HOME, SWEET HOME

The 2022 season marks West Virginia's eighth at beautiful Monongalia County Ballpark. With the help of Mountaineer Nation, the venue has become one of the greatest atmospheres in all of college baseball.

- WVU has tallied an impressive 103-56 mark at home since the ballpark opened in 2015. What's more, the club has never had a losing home record at the park.
- The squad's 100th win at the stadium came in a 17-8 triumph over Marshall on April 6, 2022.
- The Mountaineers have won 22 consecutive midweek, home games, dating back to a 9-6 win over Niagara on April 3, 2017.
- A record crowd of 4,355 packed the stands to watch WVU's NCAA Regional opener vs. Fordham on May 31, 2019.
- Mon. County Ballpark was named BaseballParks.com's Ballpark of the Year in 2015.

BRING IT ON

Once again this season, the Mountaineers are enduring several stiff tests in its non-conference slate, mixed in with the always competitive Big 12 Conference.

- WVU has nine opponents on its schedule that played in the 2021 NCAA Tournament. That includes Campbell, Central Michigan, Charlotte, Duke, Oklahoma State, Rider, TCU, Texas and Texas Tech.
- Seven of those squads appeared in an NCAA Regional, while Texas Tech reached a Super Regional and Texas punched a bid to Omaha for the College World Series. Additionally, five of those squads were featured in the USA Today Baseball Coaches Poll to begin the 2022 season.
- In all, West Virginia will play 22 games against reigning NCAA Tournament teams in 2022, including 15 away from home.

SPEED KILLS

Over the last five seasons, few have been better on the basepaths than the Mountaineers. According to the numbers, WVU's aggressive baserunning has become a part of the program's DNA.

- From 2018-21, West Virginia has swiped 309 bases, good for No. 1 in the Big 12 Conference in that time.
- Additionally, the squad ranked No. 14 nationally and No. 1 among "Power 5" teams in stolen bases from 2018-21.
- This season, the Mountaineers have been as aggressive as ever on the basepaths, ranking No. 3 nationally in the category.
- The club stole 11 bases against Youngstown State on March 25, the most in the program's Big 12 era.
- Prior to this spring, the squad had only stolen 100 bases as a team once ever. Of note, the program's single-season record for stolen bases is 114, set in 1986.
- Individually, junior OF Victor Scott II has swiped 25 bags in 2022, good for No. 7 in single-season WVU history.

- Fifth-year senior RHP Trey Braithwaite earned the win on Friday and the save on Sunday. Sophomore LHP Ben Hampton and freshman RHP Chris Sleeper also picked up wins in the series.
- Senior OF Austin Davis finished a triple short of the cycle on Sunday. For the weekend, he had eight hits and seven runs scored.
- Additionally, sophomore C McGwire Holbrook tallied six RBI in the series, including three on Saturday.
- Hampton logged 7.2 innings of work on Saturday, good for a career long. He also tallied his sixth straight quality start.

WATTERS' WORLD

After being named to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List last spring, junior RHP Jacob Watters' stock has continued to rise around college baseball.

- The Rocky Gap, Virginia, native was named a Preseason All-American by the NCBWA, earning a spot on the third team. He's the 10th player in program history to earn preseason All-America distinction.
- Watters also was placed on the Preseason All-Big 12 Team by the league's head coaches and also was on Perfect Game's Preseason Big 12 squad.
- He also appeared on the NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Preseason Watch List on Feb. 17.
- Additionally, D1Baseball.com listed Watters as the No. 12 relief pitcher in all of college baseball prior to the campaign, as part of the site's Top 75 bullpen arms.
- On March 20, Watters was used in a starting role for the first time this season, logging 4.0 innings in a no decision at Campbell.
- On March 25, the right-hander pitched 5.0, no-hit innings against Youngstown State. He earned the win after posting five strikeouts.
- Watters enjoyed a career night on April 1, at TCU, tossing a career-best 6.0 innings and matching his career high with eight strikeouts to help the Mountaineers to a Big 12-opening win.

HAMPTON INN

Sophomore left-handed pitcher Ben Hampton has taken control as the Mountaineers' ace in the starting rotation this spring.

- The De Pere, Wisconsin, native has logged six straight quality starts, dating back to March 5, vs. Illinois. His 7.2 innings of action on April 11 vs. Baylor was a career high.
- The lefty enters the week ranked No. 1 in the Big 12 in starts (8), No. 2 in wins (5), No. 5 in ERA (3.02), No. 6 in strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.10) and WHIP (0.99) and No. 7 in strikeouts (51).
- At 5-2 on the year, Hampton has fanned 51 hitters in 50.2 innings. He struck out a career-high 10 in his season debut vs. Kent State on Feb. 19.
- Hampton's 4-3 record and 4.83 ERA in 2021 earned him Freshman All-America honors by Perfect Game/Rawlings. He fanned 47 on just 15 walks in 54.0 innings (14 app./10 starts).
- He became the 10th Mountaineer in program history to earn Freshman All-America distinction.

SHORT-CHANGED

West Virginia was picked to finish eighth in the Preseason Big 12 Poll, which was voted on by the conference's nine head coaches. However, WVU has finished above its preseason ranking in five of the last eight complete seasons inside the league.

IN THE DRAFT

Since its first two selections in 1965, the West Virginia University baseball team has seen 102 players taken in the MLB Draft, including 32 in the Randy Mazey era (2013-present).

- WVU had at least two players drafted in eight of the last nine seasons, including four in 2021.
- The squad's 2021 draftees were: LHP Jackson Wolf (4th round, 129th pick, San Diego), RHP Ryan Bergert (6th round, 190th pick, San Diego), RHP Madison Jeffrey (15th round, 462nd pick, L.A. Dodgers) and LHP Adam Tulloch (17th round, 522nd pick, L.A. Dodgers).
- In all, the Mountaineers have had eight players taken in the first five rounds of MLB Drafts over the years. Two of them were first rounders - Alek Manoah (2019, 11th overall, Toronto) and Chris Enochs (1997, 11th overall, Oakland).

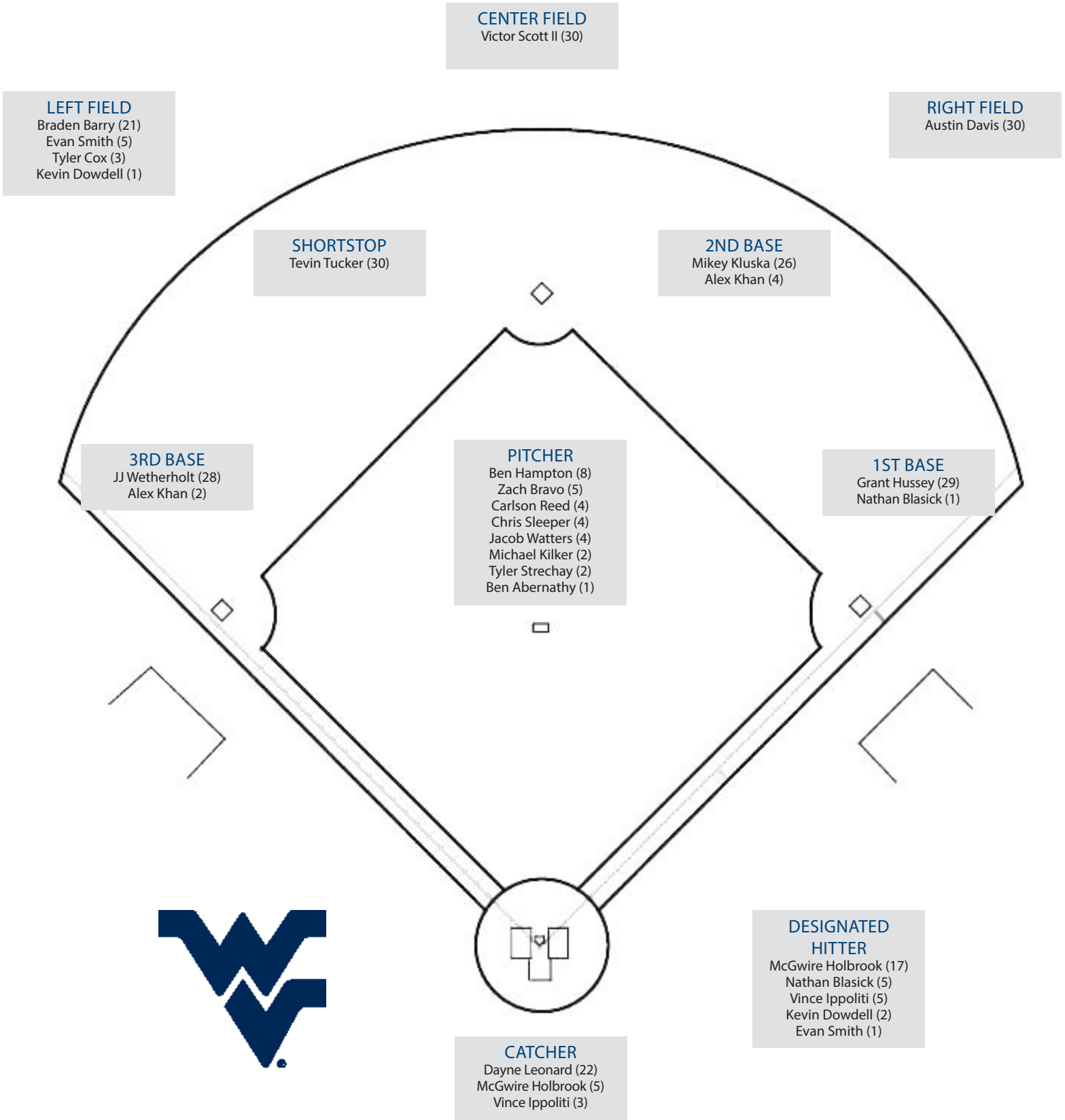
