#### ON THE FLY...

- · Michigan State will take on another top-10 team as it opens Big Ten play by visiting No. 6/6 Penn State on Friday (7 p.m.) and Saturday (6 p.m.) at Pegula Ice Arena.
- MSU was 2-2 against Penn State last year as each team went 1-1 at home.
- For the first time since the start of the 1988-89 season, MSU will play seven of its first nine games on the road ... Following the first game of a home-and-home with Michigan on November 14, the Spartans will play seven of their next nine games at home.
- Patrick Khodorenko has seven points (1g, 6a) over the first six games, including points in each of the last three contests, posting a 1-5--6 line over the span.
- · Khodorenko has had a good amount of success in his career against Penn State with 12 points (3g, 9a) in 12 games vs. the Nittany Lions.
- · Defensive partners Dennis Cesana (2g, 2a) and Jerad Rosburg (1g, 3a) lead all Spartan blueliners with four points each ... Spartan defensemen have combined for 13 points (5g, 8a) so far this year, equating to just over 31% of MSU's total points.
- The Spartan power play ranks 10th nationally at 29.2% (7-for-24) ... MSU was 2-for-6 and 2-for-5, respectively, last weekend, and has a power-play goal in four of six games this season ... Patrick Khodorenko leads the Spartans in power-play points with four (1g, 3a).
- · Michigan State's scoring has been spread out so far this season with nine different players scoring the last 10 Spartan goals (Nico Müller has two goals) over the last four games ... Fifteen different players have points this season.
- The Spartans rank third nationally in faceoff winning percentage .565 ... Tommy Apap leads all Spartans with a .605 winning percentage, followed by Patrick Khodorenko at .579.
- · Junior defenseman Tommy Miller had two assists the last time out, marking his first multi-point game since February 2018.
- Head coach Danton Cole enters the weekend with 498 career wins through his 19-year head coaching career ... Cole won a combined 244 games, including playoffs, in six years as a professional coach in the AHL and UHL; 205 wins in seven seasons with the NTDP U-17 and U-18 teams; and 49 victories in his five-plus seasons in college hockey (Alabama Huntsville and MSU).

#### **About Penn State**

Ranked sixth in both polls nationally, Penn State is coming off a sweep at home of then-No. 7 Wisconsin (W, 6-1; W, 4-2) ... The Nittany Lions have played all seven of their games at home so far this season ... Nationally, PSU ranks second in total goals (32), fourth in goals per game (4.57) and second in shots on goal (38.14), while defensively they're ninth in goals allowed per game (2.0) ... The Lions are 31.4% (11-for-35) on the power play, which ranks sixth in the country, and the penalty kill has erased 90.6% (29-of-32) of opponent power plays – 13th best nationally ... Senior forward Nate Sucese leads the team and is tied for third nationally in points with 13 (7g, 4a) ... In goal, senior Peyton Jones is 6-0 with a 1.47 GAA and .947 save percentage.

#### **Against the Nittany Lions**

Patrick Khodorenko is averaging a point per game in his career vs. PSU with 12 points (3g, 9a) in 12 career contests ... Mitchell Lewandowski has six points (3g, 3a), including two game-winning goals, vs. Penn State ... Three (2g, 1a) of Adam Goodsir's six points, including a game-winning goal, last season came against the Nittany Lions ... Goaltender John Lethemon is 3-3-1 with a .917 save percentage in seven starts vs. PSU ... MSU is 1-2-1-1 over the last two seasons at Penn State.

#### **Cornell Series Recap**

The Spartans dropped a pair of games to No. 4 Cornell, 3-2 and 6-2 ... All four Spartan goals in the series came via the power play as MSU was 4-for-11 (.363) ... Dennis Cesana and Patrick Khodorenko scored the first night, while freshmen Josh Nodler and Nico Müller both recorded tallies on Saturday ... Defenseman Tommy Miller had his first multi-point game since February 2018 with two assists on Saturday night.

#### Life on the Road

For the first time since 1988, Michigan State is playing seven of its first nine games on the road. The Spartans started with four straight on the road (at Northern Michigan and at Colorado College), before hosting No. 4 Cornell last weekend in what was its latest homeopening series since 2005. After opening its Big Ten slate at Penn State, the Spartans will play the first of a home-and-home with Michigan in Ann Arbor on Thursday, Nov. 14.

However, the Spartans will get to stick close to home beginning with the Saturday, Nov. 16 matchup vs. Michigan. That game will mark the start of seven of nine contests at Munn and nine of 11 in the state of Michigan.

#### Khodorenko Gets Better With Age

Patrick Khodorenko is off to another good start with seven points (1g, 6a) through six games. Khodorenko had his best season in the Green and White last year with career highs in goals (18), points (37), shots (117), power-play goals (9) and game-winning goals (2). Khodorenko has increased his output in all five of those statistical categories over each season during his time at MSU.

The native of Walnut Creek, California, who played for Danton Cole with the USNTDP, entered the season with 87 career points, which was the 11th best total among all active players, while his 38 career goals were eighth among all active skaters. He enters this weekend's series at Penn State with 94 career points (39g, 55a).

Khodorenko will be wearing a letter for his first time as a Spartan, as he was named one of the team's two assistant captains in May.

#### Strong in the Dot

The Spartans rank third in the country in faceoff winning percentage at .565. Leading the way is Tommy Apap, who ranks fifth in the Big Ten in faceoff winning percentage at .605 (69-45). Patrick Khodorenko is close behind at .579 (62-45). Adam Goodsir is also above .500 at .535.

The Spartans have won more faceoffs than their oppoennts in four of six games, including taking 69% of draws in a 5-1 win at Colorado College on Oct. 26.

#### Spreading the Wealth

Scoring for the Spartans has been spread out so far this season as entering Friday's game at Penn State, 11 different players have scored the last 12 MSU goals, and in total, 11 players have combined for the Spartans' 15 total goals. Conversely, MSU didn't have 11 different goal scorers until its 23rd goal last season.

#### Colorado College Series Recap

In the first series between the programs since 1981, the Spartans and Colorado College split the two games ... MSU bounced back from Friday's 3-1 loss with goals from five different players in a 5-1 win on Saturday ... Jeard Rosburg (1g, 1a), Gianluca Esteves (1g, 1a), Sam Saliba (2a) and Patrick Khodorenko (3a) all had multiple points ... Nicolas Müller and Esteves both recorded their first-career goals, while Cole Krygier had the first game-winning goal of his career ... John Lethemon made 35 saves, including 18 in the third period, in the win ... MSU dominated in the faceoff circle, winning 64.8% of draws ... MSU had just three power plays, going 1-for-3.

#### **Esteves Taking Advantage of Early Opportunities**

Junior Gianluca Esteves has a goal and two assists in his five appearances so far this season. Last season, Esteves skated in just three games, and entering this season, he had three assists in 38-career games. Esteves, who has played on the left wing along with Tommy Apap and Brody Stevens so far this season, had an assist in the seasonopening win at Northern Michigan. In the Spartans' 5-1 win at Colorado College, Esteves scored the first goal of his career and picked up an assist later in the contest for his first multi-point game.

#### Cole Closes in on 500

Coach Danton Cole brings a career record of 498-410-55 into this weekend's series with Cornell. Cole's is in the 19th season of his head coaching career, which started with the Muskegon Fury in the United Hockey League in 2001-02. Cole went on to coach three seasons with the Grand Rapids Griffins in the AHL and then spent two more seasons in the UHL with Motor City. In six total seasons, including playoffs, in the AHL and UHL, Cole won 244 games. He won 23 games over three years at Alabama Huntsville and then 205 over six seasons with the NTDP U-17 and U-18 teams. Cole has 26 wins in now his third season at MSU.

#### **NMU Series Recap**

The Spartans never trailed in the season-opening 5-3 win and twice had two-goal leads ... Tommy Apap had the first two-goal and game-winning goal of his career, while Brody Stevens notched his second career multi-point game with a goal and assist ... John Lethemon made 28 saves, including 13 in the third period, in Friday's win ... MSU was 2-for-5 on the power play on Friday and 0-for-5 on Saturday ... MSU improved to 43-31-5 in season-openers, including 2-1 under coach Danton Cole.

#### **Donnelly Enters MSU Athletics Hall of Fame**

Mike Donnelly (1982-86) was formally inducted into the Michigan State Athletics Hall of Fame on Thursday, Oct. 24. Donnelly, who holds the NCAA single-season goal record with 59 in 1985-86, helped lead MSU to the national championship that same season. Donnelly scored the game-winning goal in the third period of the 6-5 victory over Harvard in the title game and was named the tournament's most outstanding player. The first-team All-American and Hobey Baker Award finalist went on to play 11 seasons in the NHL and helped the Los Angeles Kings to the 1993 Stanley Cup Final. Donnelly is the ninth Spartan hockey player or coach to be inducted into the MSU HOF.

#### Late Start

Michigan State's regular season home-opening series against Cornell is its latest home-opening set at Munn Ice Arena since the 2005-06 season (Nov. 4-5). As a result, MSU will be playing four regular season games in December this season for the first time since 2013.

#### The Munn Project

The \$18.8 million Munn Ice Arena expansion project broke ground in mid-July, while an official groundbreaking ceremony was held Sept. 6. The expansion will provide the Spartans a new locker room, weight room, video room, training room with hydrotherapy pools, team lounge, offices and a hall of history among several other amenities. Michigan State basketball coach Tom Izzo and his family have pledged \$1.1 million toward the project.

#### ...Speaking of Munn

The Spartans posted a winning record at home for the second straight season in 2018-19, going 7-5-2 at Munn, including a 5-4-2 Big Ten record ... Home attendance average was up over 300 fans per game from the previous season as MSU ranked 10th nationally with an average of 5,461 in 2018-19.

#### **New Faces**

The Spartans have welcomed back a pair of alums to the coaching staff as Dan Sturges was named director of hockey operations in August, while Jim Slater was named the program's volunteer assistant coach in September. Sturges, who played for the Spartans from 2005-09, returned to MSU from the University of Colorado where he coached two of the school's ACHA programs. Slater retired this past summer after playing four years in Switzerland following his 10-year NHL career. The program also welcomed Lindsay Fast as the program's executive secretary, replacing Kris Smith who retired after 49 years at MSU.

#### Lewandowski Lights the Lamp

Mitchell Lewandowski, who has ranked first (19 goals, 2017-18) and second (16 goals, 2018-19), on the team in goals over the last two seasons, enters his junior season with 68 career points, including 35 goals. The last Spartan to score more than 35 goals over their first two seasons was Adam Hall, who scored a total of 42 from 1998-00 (16, 1998-99; 26 in 1999-00).

The junior from Clarkston was voted by the coaches to the preseason Big Ten All-Second Team.

#### **Back End Support**

The defensive pairing of Dennis Cesana and Jerad Rosburg combined for 40 points last season. Cesana, who was an All-Big Ten Freshman Team selection, led all conference rookies in assists (21) and was second in points (24). His 21 helpers were sixth most among all freshmen nationally and second best among defensemen. Rosburg had a career high in goals (4), assists (12) and points (16) a season ago and was voted winner of the team's outstanding defensive player award.

The Spartans return all but one defenseman from last season and for the first year under Danton Cole will have more than one senior blueliner on the roster with four in Jerad Rosburg, Butrus Ghafari, Damian Chrcek and Anthony Scarsella

#### Christian Krygier in Running for Spot on Team USA

Sophomore defenseman Christian Krygier had a solid showing at this past summer's World Junior Summer Showcase and is in the running for a spot on Team USA's roster for the World Junior Championships. In two games for the USA Blue squad, he led his team in scoring with three assists and a plus-4 rating. After the Team USA roster merge, he played in all four games, posting a plus-2 rating. The 2020 IIHF World Junior Championship will take place Dec. 26, 2019, - Jan. 5, 2020, in Ostrava and Trinec, Czech Republic.

#### Camping NHL Style

Danton Cole, a coaching veteran with international, professional and collegiate experience, was appointed head coach of the Michigan State hockey program on April 11, 2017.

Cole, who was a key member of some of the most successful Spartan hockey teams in program history, came to Michigan State from USA Hockey's National Team Development Program where he mentored some of the nation's top young players on the U-17 and U-18 teams for seven seasons

Year two of the Cole era saw the Spartans improve both their Big Ten win and point total over the previous season. The Spartans posted a winning record at home for the second straight year and were also above .500 against conference foes at Munn Ice Arena, as the facility again ranked in the top 10 nationally in attendance. Half of the Spartans' victories on the season came against top-15 opponents, which included a road sweep of No. 8 Cornell.

The Spartans' continued progress under Cole was furthered by Taro Hirose, who turned in one of the best seasons by a Spartan since 2000. Hirose tied for the national lead in points and ranked second in assists en route to being named Big Ten Player of the Year, a First Team All-American and a Hobey Baker Award finalist. The Big Ten scoring champion signed an entry-level contract with the Detroit Red Wings following the season, becoming the 100th player coached by Cole to reach the NHL.

Hirose was one of a program-record six Spartans to earn All-Big Ten accolades.

With the fourth-youngest roster in the nation that included just three seniors and 19 underclassmen, Cole facilitated progress in all facets of the Spartan program during his first season behind the bench in 2017-18. With five wins against ranked opponents, including three vs. top-10 teams, the Spartans improved their win total over the previous season against a schedule that ranked fifth-toughest in the country. In posting a winning record at home, including going undefeated against non-conference teams, the Spartans were rewarded with strong home crowds as Munn Ice Arena ranked 10th nationally in average home attendance during the season.

The young Spartan roster was bolstered by the program's high-scoring trio of Hirose, Patrick Khodorenko and Mitchell Lewandowski. Lewandowski became the first Spartan since 2006 to be named a conference rookie of the year as he was voted Big Ten Freshman of the Year, while Hirose earned All-Big Ten second team accolades.

In the classroom, the Spartans have produced a total of 33 Academic All-Big Ten honors over Cole's first two seasons. The 2018-19 squad had 11 student-athletes with GPAs of 3.5 or better, while the team GPA of 3.2 was the fourth highest in program history.

Under Cole's leadership of the program, the home of Spartan hockey – Munn Ice Arena – is currently undergoing an \$18.8 million renovation that will be ready for the 2020-21 season. The expansion project on the south side of the arena will provide the Spartans with completely new team accommodations, including dressing room, weight room, video room, offices and players' lounge, among other amenities.

Prior to returning to Michigan State as the seventh head coach in program history, Cole's highly-successful run with USA Hockey included guiding the U.S. to two gold medals (2012, 2014) and one bronze medal (2016) at the International Ice Hockey

Federation Men's Under-18 World Championship and three top-three finishes at the World Under-17 Hockey Challenge (2011, 2013, 2014), the top events in each age group.

His teams also enjoyed success in numerous international tournaments, having captured U17 titles at the Four Nations (2010, 2012) and Vlad Dzurilla (2011) tournaments. While leading the U18s, the U.S. has placed first on three occasions in major competitions: twice at the Four Nations (2011, 2015) and once at Five Nations (2014) tournaments.

Cole's first taste of international coaching came with the U.S. Under-18 Select Team at the 2009 Ivan Hlinka Memorial Cup, where he served as assistant coach. He assumed that same role in 2013 for the bronze-medal winning U.S. Men's National Team at the IIHF Men's World Championship.

Cole's coaching career started immediately following his playing days. After retiring from the Grand Rapids Griffins in 1999-2000, he remained with the team for the season as an assistant before spending 2001-02 with Muskegon in the United Hockey League, guiding the team to the playoff championship.

Cole followed that with a nearly three-year stint as head coach of the Griffins which included two Calder Cup Playoff appearances in 2003 and 2004. After coaching the UHL's Motor City Mechanics through 2006, he amassed a five-year pro coaching record of 222-126-17 (.632).

In 2006-07, Cole landed his first college job as an assistant at Bowling Green. After one year at BGSU, he was hired as head coach at Alabama-Huntsville where he went 23-59-12 in three seasons. He led UAH to the College Hockey America tournament title in his third season with the school in 2009-10, earning the program's second-ever berth in the NCAA Tournament, before moving on to USA Hockey in 2010.

Cole's playing career at MSU began in 1985-86 as he helped further the Spartans' trek to sustained national prominence. In his four years at Michigan State, the Spartans went 131-44-8 (.738), winning a NCAA National Championship (1986), making three NCAA Frozen Four appearances (1986, 1987, 1989), capturing two CCHA regular-season titles (1986, 1989) and two CCHA Tournament championships (1987, 1989).

As a junior at MSU, Cole was second in team scoring with 20 goals and 56 points, and then was the third-highest scorer as a senior with 29 goals and 62 points.

Cole, who was the recipient of the Distinguished Spartan Award in 2013, ended his Michigan State career with 69 goals and 94 assists for 163 points. He shares the MSU career games played record of 180 with former teammate Don McSween.

Cole graduated with a degree in finance and excelled in the classroom at MSU as he was a three-time CCHA All-Academic Team honoree. He is one of nine Spartan hockey players to have received the Big Ten Medal of Honor, garnering the accolade as a senior.

Cole was drafted in the sixth round, 123rd overall, by the Winnipeg Jets in the 1985 NHL Entry Draft. After making his pro debut with the AHL's Moncton Hawks in 1989-90, Cole saw his first action in the NHL that season as well.

Cole went on to play 11 seasons professionally. He played 318 NHL games over six seasons with Winnipeg, Tampa Bay, New Jersey, the New York Islanders and Chicago. His best season in the NHL came in 1993-94 when he put up 20 goals and 23 assists for 43 points in 81 games for the Tampa Bay Lightning. He is one of 15 Spartans to have hoisted the Stanley Cup as he helped the New Jersey Devils to the 1995 Cup.

Cole played four more seasons in the IHL for the Grand Rapids Griffins before retiring with the team in 1999-2000.

He represented the USA as a member of the Men's National Team on three occasions (1990, 1991, 1994) and earned outstanding player of the 1991 IIHF Men's World Championship.

A native Michigander, Cole was born in Pontiac and raised in Lansing.
