- Ohio State's 110th season of Big Ten basketball starts this weekend when the Buckeyes travel to State College, Pa., to take on Penn State on Sunday evening.
- The Buckeyes lead the all-time series 38-18 and are 14-10 in games at Penn State. The teams have split the last four meetings at the Bryce Jordan Center over the last four seasons.
- Ohio State comes in on a high, having knocked-off No. 1 Duke 71-66 last Tuesday in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- That was the program's 10th win over a No. 1 ranked team and it was the third consecutive win in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge for the Buckeyes.
- Penn State dropped its Big Ten/ACC Challenge matchup at home to Miami on Wednesday and enter Sunday's game at 4-3 overall. John Harrar leads the Big Ten and is in the Top 15 nationally at 10.9 rebounds per game. The Nittany Lions are led by Mike Shrewsberry who is in his first year with the program.
- OSU has played three games this season that have all been decided with a basket in the final two seconds. The Buckeyes have also played two other games that were within one possession with less than 20 seconds to play.
- E.J. Liddell is third in the conference in points per game at 21.3 ppg. He has four games of 20 or more points and is coming off a 14-point, 14-rebound double-double in the win over Duke. He is also among the national leaders in blocks per game as he is averaging nearly four blocks per contest.
- Zed Key is the second Buckeye averaging in double figures at 10.0 ppg. He scored a career and game-high 20 points in the win over Duke. He had just five double-figure scoring games all of last season and has four already this season.
- Senior captain Justin Ahrens has two or more three-pointers in six of the seven games and is shooting over 41 percent from beyond the arc in his career.
- Transfer guard Cedric Russell had a bit slow start to the season but shined in the win over Duke. He was 3-of-3 from long range, including a key three-pointer with 2:32 left. He also grabbed the final rebound and sealed the win with two free throws. Russell finished with 12 points after having just three points on the year entering the night.
- The Buckeyes are averaging 8.3 makes from distance per game and shooting 37.7 percent as a team from long range.

BUCKEYES OPEN 110TH SEASON OF BIG TEN PLAY

- In Big Ten Conference play, the Buckeyes are 59-47 in league openers
- They are 73-33 in the first conference home game of the season and 39-67 in league road openers.
- Ohio State is 41-20 when the first conference game of the year is at home and 19-27 when opening conference play on the road.
- The Buckeyes beat Penn State 106-74 in the first conference game of the 2019-20 season in Columbus. Last season, OSU fell 67-60 at Purdue in the conference opener.

E.J. LIDDELL OFF TO A GOOD START

- E.J. Liddell has been one of the best players in the country so far this season.
- He is averaging 21.3 points, 7.3 rebounds, 3.7 blocks and 2.7 assists per game.
- He has led the team in scoring in every game but one and has had four 20+ point games, including a career-high 29 vs. Niagara on Nov. 12.
- He has blocked multiple shots in six of seven games, including a career-high eight at Xavier on Nov. 18.
- He leads the Big Ten in blocked shots per game (3.71) and is sixth nationally.
- He is third in the conference in points per game and in the Top 20 nationally.

LIDDELL BLOCKING SHOTS AND SCORING POINTS

- E.J. Liddell has scored 20+ points four times this season and he has also blocked multiple shots in all but game.
- In the game at Xavier on Nov. 18, Liddell did his best to pull the Buckeyes out of an 11-point first-half hole.
- He finished the night with a game-high 17 points to go along with seven rebounds and a career-high eight blocked shots.
- He is just the third Ohio State player in program history with at least 17 points and eight or more blocks in a game.
- Herb Williams had 20 points, 17 rebounds and eight blocks vs. Iowa on Jan. 7, 1978.
- Brad Sellers did it in an NCAA Tournament game as he had 23 points, 13 rebounds and nine blocks vs. Louisiana Tech on March 24, 1986.

WHEELER HEADS BACK TO STATE COLLEGE

- Ohio State graduate transfer Jamari Wheeler joined the program this summer after four years Penn State.
- And wouldn't you know it, his first Big Ten game with the Buckeyes will be right back in State College against the Nittany Lions.
- Wheeler played in all 127 games at Penn State and averaged 3.8 points, 3.0 rebounds and 2.6 assists
- He earned Big Ten All-Defensive Team honors in 2020 & 2021 while leading the conference in steals per game both seasons.
- His 191 career steals rank sixth-all time in Penn State basketball history.

AHRENS HUNTING HIS SHOT, AND USUALLY MAKING IT

- Senior captain Justin Ahrens is the team's three-point specialist. He is constantly hunting his shot and when he gets it, he usually hits it.
- Ahrens is shooting 44 percent from long range this season and is shooting over 41 percent from distance in his career.
- He has made 112 career three-pointers and just 13 shots from inside the arc.
- This season, he has only attempted two shots from two-point range.

KEY WAS THE KEY TO BEATING NO. 1 DUKE

- Sophomore Zed Key got his body into better shape during the offseason to prepare himself for being ready in the big moments.
- Against No. 1 Duke on Nov. 30, he certainly stepped up and the Buckeyes rode him to the win.
- Key found himself one-on-one in the post most of the night and delivered, to the tune of 8-of-15 shooting for a career-high 20 points.
- His previous high before that night was 14 points.

BIG COMEBACK TO BEAT NO. 1 DUKE

- Ohio State was down 15 points early in the second half against No. 1 Duke on Nov. 30.
- The Buckeyes held Duke to just 7-of-31 shooting (22.6 percent) in the second half and the Blue Devils didn't make a field goal in the final five minutes.
- That allowed the Buckeyes to comeback and take the lead with less than a minute to play and held on for a 71-66 victory.
- That was the first time in 185 games in which Duke lost after leading by 10 or more at half-time (*ESPN Stats and Info*)
- The Blue Devils also don't give up 15-point leads very often.

DECIDED AT THE BUZZER

- The Buckeyes have played three games this season that have been decided by a shot in the final seconds.
- OSU beat Akron with a lay-in at the horn by Zed Key.
- Meechie Johnson Jr. lifted the Buckeyes past No. 21 Seton Hall on a three-pointer with two seconds left in the first game of the Rocket Mortgage Fort Myers Tip-off.
- Two nights later, Florida turned the tables with a running, pull-up three-pointer at the buzzer to steal a 71-68 victory in the championship game.
- This doesn't include the games against Xavier (11/18) and then No. 1 Duke (11/30) that were both one-possession games with less than 20 seconds to play.

RECAPPING THE DUKE GAME

- For the better part of the game, it didn't look like it was going to be Ohio State's night vs. top-ranked Duke. But the Buckeyes hung in and used a 14-1 run over the final five minutes to knock-off the No. 1 Blue Devils 71-66 in front of a sellout crowd at Value City Arena.
- Sophomore Zed Key had his best night as a Buckeye, powering in a career-high 20 points on 8-of-15 shooting.
- Graduate Cedric Russell was also huge in the closing moments. He was 3-of-3 from long range, had three rebounds and was 3-of-4 from the line, sealing the victory in the final seconds. Russell finished with 12 points on the night.
- Junior E.J. Liddell had another all-round great game. He notched his second double-double of the year with 14 points and 14 rebounds. He also dished-out a career-high six assists and swatted three shots.
- Freshman Malaki Branham was big in the first half, keeping the Buckeyes in the game early. He was 4-of-6 shooting and had eight points and two rebounds.
- Senior captain Justin Ahrens was 2-of-7 from long range and was one-off his career-high with six rebounds.
- The Buckeyes rushed out to an early six-point lead but missed free throws and turnovers allowed Duke to flip the score and the Blue Devils would lead 43-30 at the break. The lead was still 11 points with under seven minutes to play but Duke would score just four points in those final seven minutes.
- Key scored six consecutive points to cut the lead to 65-59 and then Russell canned a huge three-pointer from the corner, pulling the Buckeyes within two. Duke missed its final six shots of the night and after early struggles from the line, the Buckeyes made 5-of-6 down the stretch to seal the deal.

BUCKEYES WIN AGAIN IN THE BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE

- Ohio State's win over No. 1 Duke on Nov. 30 bumped the Buckeyes' all-time record in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge to 9-11 in it's 20 appearances.
- The Buckeyes have won their matchup each of the last three seasons.
- OSU trounced another ACC blue-blood North Carolina 74-49 in Chapel Hill in 2019 and then took down Notre Dame 90-85 in South Bend last season.
- This year's meeting was the fourth meeting be-

tween Ohio State and Duke in the Big Ten/ACC Men's Basketball Challenge.

- Duke won the first meeting in 2002 in Greensboro, N.C., which was the Buckeyes' first appearance in the annual event. The teams then split the meetings in 2011 and 2012, with each team winning on its home court.
- Chris Holtmann's teams are 3-2 with the wins over Duke, Notre Dame and UNC and losses to Clemson and Syracuse.

BUCKEYES VS. NO. 1

- Following it's win over No. 1 Duke on Nov. 30, Ohio State is now 10-11 all time vs. the No. 1 ranked team in the AP poll.
- The Buckeyes are 7-5 at home vs. the No. 1 team. In fact, the last six times OSU has played No. 1, it has been played at Value City Arena.
- Overall, the Buckeyes have won eight of the last 11 meetings with the No. 1 ranked team.
- That streak dates back to a 90-84 overtime victory over No. 1 Duke in the ECAC Holiday Classic in New York on Dec. 29, 1978.
- In the win over Duke, Zed Key led the Buckeyes with a career-high 20 points. E.J. Liddell had a double-double with 14 points and 14 rebounds to go along with a career-high six assists. The Buckeyes erased a 15-point second-half deficit and finished the game on a 14-1 run over the final five minutes.

OHIO STATE VS. THE AP TOP-10 AND TOP-5

- Ohio State is 78-139 (.359) all-time vs. teams in the AP Top-10
- The Buckeyes have won seven of the last 11 meetings vs. Top-10 ranked teams dating back to the start of the 2019-20 season
- Against just Top-5 teams, Ohio State is 42-73 (.365) all-time.
- The last win was a 71-66 victory over No. 1 ranked Duke on Nov. 30 of this season.
- The Buckeyes also split a pair of meetings with Top-5 Duke in 2011 and 2012

ONE-POINT GAMES

- The Buckeyes scored with less than a second remaining to beat Akron 67-66 on opening night.
- That was the 135th one-point game in program history and the Buckeyes are now 73-62 in those games.
- OSU has had just a single one-point game each of the last two seasons and then opened this year with a one-point game.
- Under Holtmann, the Buckeyes are 2-3 in one-point contests.
- OSU has won its last two one-point games. In addition to the win over Akron, the Buckeyes beat No. 4 Michigan 68-67 in the semifinals of the Big Ten Tournament last season.

SUEING OUT WITH ABDOMINAL INJURY

- Ohio State forward Justice Sueing will be out for an extended period of time after having an abdominal injury evaluated earlier this week. The Honolulu, Hawaii, native will rehab the injury and is expected to return sometime this season.
- “We look forward to getting Justice back when he is healthy,” said head coach Chris Holtmann. “I’m disappointed for him because I know how much he is looking forward to his senior year. I know he will rest, rehab and be ready to go when he is healthy.”
- The fifth-year senior is in his third year with the program. He played and started all 31 games last season and was third on the team in scoring at 10.7 ppg.

LIDDELL OPENS WITH TWO BIG NIGHTS

- Junior E.J. Liddell opened the season with two big games, scoring 25 points in game one vs. Akron and then a career-high 29 points vs. Niagara.
- He also grabbed 11 rebounds vs. Akron to post his fifth-career double-double.
- Liddell made was 3-of-6 from long range vs. Niagara and was 9-of-16 (.600) overall from the floor.
- He had three assists in each game and swatted a total of seven shots.
- For the two games, he averaged 27 points and shot 55.9 percent from the floor.

BUCKEYES SOLID ON OPENING NIGHT

- With the win over Akron in the season-opener, Ohio State improved to 101-21 in season-openers and 104-17 in the home opener
- Head coach Chris Holtmann is 5-0 in season-openers at Ohio State and 9-2 all-time in his career.

20-WIN SEASONS

- The Buckeyes are one of just three Power 5 programs to win 20 games the last four years, joining Kansas and Oregon.
- Broadening it out to three other conferences, Houston and Memphis from the AAC, Creighton from the Big East and Gonzaga from the WCC have also won 20 games in each of the last four seasons
- Any way you look at it, the Buckeyes are in rare 20-win company

HOLTMANN INKS TOP-10 CLASS IN 2022

- Head coach may not smile a ton on the court during the games but off the court, when looking at his 2022 signing class, he can’t help but smile.
- The five-player class includes four-star point guard Bruce Thornton, 6-6 four-star forward Brice Sensabaugh, four-star guard Roddy Gayle Jr., 6-11 four-star center Felix Okpara and one of the top guards in Ohio in Bowen Hardman.
- Thornton | G | 6-2, 205 | Alpharetta, Ga.** a consensus four-star recruit is ranked No. 41 overall in the class. Tough, gritty point guard. Led Milton to the Class 7A state title last season and a top-3 preseason ranking this year.
- Sensabaugh | F | 6-6, 235 | Orlando, Fla.** A four-star recruit and Top-75 prospect. Didn’t play last year due to injury but is regarded as one of the top scorers in the class
- Gayle Jr. | G | 6-4, 195 | Niagara Falls, N.Y.** a two-time first team All-Western New York honoree before transferring to Wasatch Academy where he averaged 10 ppg and helped Wasatch to its best season in program history.
- Okpara | C | 6-11, 215 | Lagos, Nigeria** a consensus four-star recruit who is ranked No. 50 overall in the class. Long, athletic center who is one of the top shot-blockers in the class. Moved from Nigeria to the states in 2018.
- Hardman | G | 6-3, 175 | Cincinnati, Ohio** a three-star recruit who is one of the best shooting guards in Ohio. Averaged over 15 ppg last season and shot nearly 40 percent from beyond the arc.

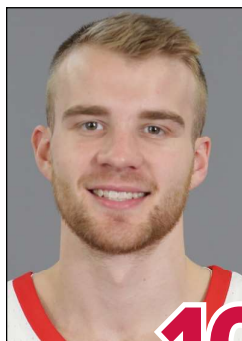

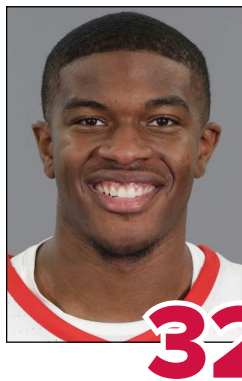
