THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This weekend marks the 34th and 35th meetings alltime with Ohio State holding the 17-13-3 edge including an 8-7-2 mark at Value City Arena.
- Last season the series was split 1-1 with the final two contests being cancelled due to Penn State's COVID-19 pause late in the season. Penn State won the season series in 2019-20 with a record of 2-1-1 taking seven of the possible 12 points en route to its first Big Ten regular season championship. The Nittany Lions are 5-2-2 against the Buckeyes over the past four seasons in Columbus including a decisive 5-1 victory in the 2019 Big Ten semifinals.
- Junior Kevin Wall leads all current Nittany Lions with four points in six career games against the Buckeyes with two goals and two assists as only three current Penn State players have registered goals against OSU with junior Connor McMenamin and sophomore Jimmy Dowd Jr. each adding one. Only six current Nittany Lions have points against the Buckeyes.

PHILLY SPECIAL

- Senior Clayton Phillips scored twice while adding an assist to tie his career-high with three points during a 6-4 victory over No. 6 North Dakota on Saturday night and was named Big Ten First Star of the Week for his efforts marking his first career weekly award.
- The two goals marked the first time in his career with multiple scores in a game as he is now third on the team with six points on three goals and three assists. His six points are good for third in the Big Ten among defensemen and rank 20th nationally while his three goals lead all Big Ten blue-liners and are tied for second nationally among d-men.

NITTANY LION SPECIAL

- Penn State went 3-for-5 with the man-advantage in its win over North Dakota last Saturday. It was the first time the Nittany Lions had three or more powerplay tallies since December 3, 2020 when they went 4-for-6 against Michigan.
- With the strong performance last weekend, PSU's powerplay is up to third in the Big Ten and 12th in the nation at 26.9 percent (7-for-26).
- The Nittany Lions entered last weekend with the second-best penalty kill in the conference and the fourth best in the nation, however, North Dakota went 3-for-6 with the man-advantage in the game snapping a streak of 25-straight kills for Penn State in the process. With the livies starting last week as well and the minor slip up, the Nittany Lions are now third in the Big Ten and 18th in the nation at 88.2 percent (30-for-34).

ALL THE WAY TUNED UP

- Senior goaltender Oskar Autio earned his fourth career shutout against Niagara two weeks ago tying Peyton Jones '20 for the all-time program record.
- Autio is 4-1-0 so far this season and is currently tied for third in the Big Ten with a 2.00 goals-against average, good for 19th in the nation, while his .922 save percentage is good for sixth in the Big Ten and 24th in the nation.

'COPE'ING WITH CHANGE

• Colorado College transfer Ben Copeland is beginning to hit his stride with the Nittany Lions as he is currently riding a three-game point-streak (1-4-5) with two multipoint games in his last three games. The senior's career-best point-streak is five games dating back to his freshman season in 2018-19.

• Copeland registered his first Nittany Lion goal last Saturday as he hit the empty net to secure Penn State's 6-4 victory against then-No. 6 North Dakota.

KECKS GON' GIVE IT TO YA

- Junior Connor MacEachern has registered three multipoint games in his last four including a pair of multi-goal games over that span marking the first two of his career. MacEachern tallied two goals against North Dakota on Saturday including the eventual game-winner giving him four on the season which is already a new career-best in just seven games.
- MacEachern's seven points on the year are tied for ninth in the Big Ten while his four goals are tied for fourth in the conference. The Junior was named Big Ten Third Star of the week on Tuesday marking the first time in his career he has earned a weekly award.

YOU'RE MY WONDERWALL

- Junior Kevin Wall scored five goals in a series sweep against Niagara two weeks agao including his first career hat-trick and tenth in program history during the series finale
- Wall leads Penn State in scoring with his six goals and eight points and is currently riding a three-game point-streak (5-1-6), just one shy of his career-high four game streak from last season.
- Wall's six goals are tied for the Big ten lead and tied for sixth nationally while his eight points are tied for sixth in the conference.

I CAN FEEL IT COMING IN THE 'SUUL-EE'-AIR TONIGHT

- Sophomore goaltender Liam Souliere had another strong showing between the pipes two weeks ago against Niagara improving to 2-0-0 on the year with a 33-save effort against Niagara.
- Souliere's .945 save percentage is good for second in the Big Ten, behind only Ohio State's Jakub Dobes at .964, and tied for seventh in the nation while his 2.00 goals-against average is tied for third in the Big Ten and 24th nationally.

200 FOOT GAME

- Penn State is currently performing well at both ends of the ice leading the Big Ten and ranking fourth in the nation in scoring offense averaging 4.29 goals per game.
- On the defensive side, the Nittany Lions are tied for second in the Big Ten and 14th nationally allowing just 2.14 goals per game, a far cry from the 3.68 goals per game surrendering during the 2020-21 season.

SCOUTING OHIO STATE

- The Buckeyes return nine of their top-10 scorers from a season ago including all five leading scorers led by Travis Treloar who finished the 2020-21 season with 12 goals and 20 points. Quinn Preston, Tate Singleton and Gustaf Westlund are each back after tying for second on the team a season ago with six goals.
- OSU finished last season 7-19-1 dropping a 4-0 decision to Michigan in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Ohio State has opened the 2021-22 season 4-2-0 through six games including a series split to open Big Ten play last weekend against Michigan State dropping a 2-1 decision before a 5-1 win in the series finale.
- Singleton is currently leading Ohio State with three goals and five points through the first six games of the season. Five other Buckeyes have each found the net twice in the early going.
- The Buckeyes begin the 2021-22 season with a new face between the pipes as Tommy Nappier graduated in the spring after backstopping OSU for the past three seasons as one of the top goaltenders in the Big Ten.
- Freshman Jakub Dobes has appeared in five of the first six games for Ohio State posting a 4-1-0 record with a .964 save percentage and a 0.86 goals-against average to rank first in the Big Ten and third in the nation for both categories.
- Ohio State's defense has been top tier so far in 2021-22. It currently leads the Big Ten in goals allowed per game (1.50).
- Ohio State has dominated in the faceoff dot so far this season, leading the Big Ten winning 59.3 percent of draws. Centers Patrick Guzzo and Georgii Merkulov lead the way, winning 67 percent of their draws.
- Freshman forward Cam Thiesing and freshman defenseman Mason Lohrei are two newcomers that have stood out for the Buckeyes. The duo both have four points on the season, with Thiesing being second on the team in shots with 22.



IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST

- · Penn State has scored the opening goal of the game in six out of seven games so far this season with a record of 6-0-0 when doing so. Over the past five seasons, the Nittany Lions are now 73-17-9 when scoring first.
- Penn State has also held the lead when entering the third period in all six of those games improving to 133-12-10 all-time when leading after 40 minutes.
- Penn State is outscoring its opponents 10-3 in the first period this season having scored at least one first period goal in six of seven games with multiple first period tallies in four of those games

· Sophomore Christian Berger collected just one point in 22 games played during the 2020-21 campaign, but is currently third on the team with six points on two goals and four assists through the first seven games this sea-

HOCKEY VALLEY FIVE-O

- Penn State hit its magic number of five goals in the win over North Dakota improving to 86-1-2 all-time when scoring five or more goals. Penn State was 4-0-0 in such games during 2020-21 after going 11-0-0 when scoring five or more goals in 2019-20.
- The Nittany Lions have won 28-straight games when scoring five or more goals, including four so far this season, with the last and only loss coming at Wisconsin on December 1, 2018, an 8-5 defeat.

PACKING THE PEG

- Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 129-of-141 home games where fans were permitted to attend, which included a streak of 104-consecutive regular-season games from March 14, 2014 through November 22, 2019.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 87 occasions including 10 games in 2019-20 while five of the final six home crowds during the 2019-20 season rank in the top-10 all-time in the building including a record crowd of 6,475 against Notre Dame on February 1, 2020.
- In 2019-20, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,990) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (103.6 percent).
- Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

WELCOME HOME

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula lce Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its ninth season entering 2021-22. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.
- The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.
- The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New last season an continuing in 2021-22 is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other leadule.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 22nd collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his 10th at Penn State in 2021-22.

AT PENN STATE

In a season unlike any other in 2020-21, Gadowsky led Penn State back to the Big Ten semifinals for the sixth consecutive season and the seventh time overall as he became the winningest coach in the history of the tournament after securing his 11th victory in B1G tournament play.

The Bench Boss registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State.



Penn State captain Alex Limoges went on to sign an AHL contract with the San Diego Gulls and in just 23 games scored 11 goals while adding 10 assists for 21 points.

Following the season Aarne Talvitie inked his entry-level, NHL contract with the New Jersey Devils while earlier in the season former Nittany Lion Peyton Jones also put pen to paper on an NHL contract giving Penn State six NHL signees in the past two seasons and 10 overall.

Near the conclusion of the 2020-21 NHL season former Penn State forward Brett Murray (2017-18) made his NHL debut with the Buffalo Sabres becoming the second Nittany Lions to skate in an NHL contest.

Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship during the 2019-20 season with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.

Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October against Sacred Heart.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucese landed on the Second-Team West while also

being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucese took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nit-

tany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual

national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifi-

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning record in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a twoyear contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn

Gadowsky took a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival and guided it to both the crowns in 2007-08. The team earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1998, and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian Coach of the Year.

More than 20 Tiger players went on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

AT ALASKA

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he took a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's
