#### THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- After 34 days off since their last game, Penn State begins the 2017 portion of their schedule as they continue conference play on the road with a two-game series against Ohio State in Columbus.
- This weekend marks the 15th and 16th games in the series history against the Buckeyes with the Nittany Lions holding just a 5-9-0 record against OSU including just a 1-5-0 mark at Value City Arena.

#### **LAST TIME THEY MET**

• The two teams split the season series last year with Penn State taking the opening game in each set and Ohio State salvaging the finale. The Buckeyes defeated the Nittany Lions 7-4 at Pegula in their final contest of the 2015-16 season.

### **NOT SO HAPPY NEW YEAR**

- In their first four seasons as a NCAA Division I program, Penn State is just 1-3-0 in initial games following semester break while being outscored 19-8 in those games, all of which were against Robert Morris.
- The Nittany Lions are also just 10-16-1 in the month of January over the last four seasons.
- Their 34 days off in between games also marks the longest break they've had by 11 days. Hopefully the extended break helps the Lions more than it hurts as they look for a fast start in the second semester of play.

### **SOPHOMORE SURGE**

- Second-year right-wing **Andrew Sturtz** has laughed at the idea of a sophomore slump and has instead had one of the most productive fall semester's in program history.
- The sophomore's 13 goals in 13 games played leads the entire Big Ten and is tied for tenth in the country while his 1.00 goals per game average is tops in the country.
- Sturtz's 13 goals is also the most all-time by any Nittany Lion at the semester break surpassing the 10 goals scored by Casey Bailey and Chase Berger during the first half of the 2014-15 and 2015-16 seasons, respectively.
- In just 50 career games played, Sturtz already ranks fourth on the all-time goal scoring list with 31 just 14 behind Casey Bailey's 45 which is the program record. His six game-winning goals is also just one back of Tommy Olczyk's program-leading seven.

### **TWO FOR YOU**

- Marking a new program-high, Penn State finished the first half of the season ranked No. 3 in both the uscho. com and USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine polls.
- The Lions also received first place votes in both polls for the first time in program history marking yet another first for the fifth year program.

#### **RUSSIA'S FINEST IMPORT**

 Freshman Denis Smirnov hails from Moscow, Russia and has quickly solidified himself as a top prospect for next summer's NHL draft.

- Smirnov leads the team and the entire Big Ten in points and assists with 27 and 17, respectively. Both marks lead all freshman across the country while ranking sixth and tied for fifth in the nation, respectively.
- Averaging 1.80 points per game through the first 15 of his career, Smirnov ranks third in the nation and trails only Kyle Connor (1.87) for the highest points per game total by a freshman since 2000. Connor was a Hobey Hat-Trick member last year for Michigan after leading the nation in points with 71 (35G, 36A).
- With his 27 points, the rookie is also nine points better at the semester break than both Casey Bailey and Taylor Holstrom were in 2014-15 when their 18 points was a first half program record.
- The 27 points by a freshman also ties the Penn State single-season freshman record held by both Casey Bailey and Andrew Sturtz. His 17 assists, however, already breaks the mark set by Scott Conway in 2014-15 for single-season freshman assists.
- Smirnov also broke the team point-streak record as he recorded at least one point in his first 10 games. The freshman leads the team with nine multi-point games so far this season and has registered one or more points in all but one game this season.

### **NUMBERS DON'T LIE**

- The Nittany Lions current boast the most potent offensive attack in the nation averaging 4.87 goals per game. Their +45 goal differential is also the best in the country while their 73 goals tie for fourth
- PSU's 13 wins tie for second in the nation with Boston College and UMass-Lowell only behind the 14 of Union.
- Penn State is also ahead of last season's record setting offensive pace with 195 points on 73 goals and 122 assists through 15 games at the end of the fall semester compared to 70-108-178 through 16 games after the 2015-16 fall semester.

### YOU CAN'T SCORE IF YOU PASS

- The Nittany Lions have scored at least four goals in 11 of their 15 games this season including 9 of their last 10 and are 11-0-0 when doing so. PSU has also won six games by four or more goals and nine games by three or more goals.
- Penn State has also scored the first goal of the contest in 11 games this season and are 10-0-1 when doing so including an impressive 10-0-0 when leading after the first period and 12-0-1 when leading after two periods.

### **SCOUTING OHIO STATE**

Ohio State is coming off a 6-3 New Year's Eve setback to Miami (Ohio) after splitting their Big Ten Conference opening series against Minnesota at the beginning of December.

- The Buckeyes boast a 9-3-4 overall record and a No. 11 national ranking as well as the nation's third highest scoring offense, averaging 4.44 goals per game.
- That offense is led by a pair of seniors and a freshman. Tanner Laczynski, a Philadelphia Flyers draft pick leads the team with 22 points on six goals and a team-best 16 assists. Seniors Nick Schilkey and David Gust pace the squad in goal scoring with 13 and 11, respectively, as the only two Buckeyes with double-digit goals.
- It's no surprise that Ohio State is third in the Nation in scoring and has already totaled 71 goals in 16 games as they returned nine of their top-10 scorers for last year's roster. Schilkey and Gust paced the team last year with 41 and 36 points, respectively
- In total Ohio State has four NHL draft picks on their roster. In addition to Laczynski, senior goal-tender Matt Tomkins (Chicago) and sophomore forwards Dakota Joshua (Toronto) and Miguel Fidler (Florida) have also been drafted.
- Between the pipes a pair of seniors have shared time with Chicago Blackhawks draft pick Matt Tomkins securing most of the time with 11 appearances and a 6-2-3 record. Tomkins has registered a .900 save percentage and a 2.60 goals against average so far this season.
- •While Penn State has the best PK in all the land, Ohio State struggles as they rank 58th in the nation stopping only 74.7 percent (56-for-75) of opponent's man-advantage opportunities. However, they make up for that on the offensive side as their power-play unit is currently fifth in the country as they have converted 17-of-70 chances (24.3 percent) into goals.



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## PENN STATE GAME NOTES

### **A VERY SPECIAL TEAM "S"**

- Penn State ranks near the top of most special team's categories through the first semester of play. The Nittany Lions rank first in PK at 92.5 percent (62-for-67) including killing off 16-of-16 in their last 5+ games.
- Penn State also ranks ninth with the man-advantage as they have converted 20-of-88 (22.7 percent) opportunities including 11-for-33 (33 percent) over their last seven games
- PSU's 20 power-play goals is also good for tied eighth in the nation.

### **CONTROLLING THE DOT**

- Penn State leads the nation in face-off win percentage controlling 57.1 percent of draws through the first semester of play.
- Chase Berger is currently ninth in the nation winning draws at a 63 percent clip to pace the entire Big Ten. **Dylan Richard** ranks second on the team at 57.6 percent.

#### **MR. JONES**

- Smilling in the bright lights of "Hockey Valley" freshman goaltender **Peyton Jones** has impressed during his first 13 games between the pipes compiling an undefeated 11-0-1 record.
- Standing in the spotlight: The freshman leads the Big Ten with a 1.97 goals against average and is second with a .920 save percentage, both marks rank seventh and 13th in the nation, respectively.

### **BLUE LINE BEAUTY**

- Junior defenseman **Trevor Hamilton** has rattled opposing offenses with powerful hip checks and a team leading 31 blocked shots during his first semester as a Nittany Lion.
- A big part of both the power-play and penalty kill, Hamilton registered a man-advantage tally in each game during the sweep over Michigan to close out the fall semester.
- The junior is currently third in the Big Ten lead in defenseman scoring with 15 points (3G, 12A) which is also tied for eighth nationally while his 1.00 point per game average ranks sixth in the country among blue-liners.

### **RECAPPING MICHIGAN**

- •Over a month ago Penn State swept Michigan for just the second time ever while snapping a five-game losing streak to the Wolverines.
- The series was the first of its kind where Penn State was ranked higher in the polls then Michigan.
- The Nittany Lions outscored the Wolverines, 11-2 over the weekend while going 4-for-8 on the power play and 6-for-6 on the penalty kill.
- Jones and Smirnov garnered First and Third Stars of the week honors following the sweep and it was the third

- · Smirnov collected five points over the weekend with a pair of multi-point efforts. The rookie collected three helpers on Thursday before adding one goal and one assist during the finale.
- Sturtz collected three goals during the series including two in Thursday night's 6-1 victory.

### **RECAPPING 2015-16**

Penn State put together its best season during it's young existence earning the first 20-win campaign for Guy Gadowsky as the Nittany Lion Bench Boss with a 21-13-4 record while posting their second-straight winning season in Big Ten play (10-9-1-0).

- · Penn State set 7 new single-season program standards during 2015-16 including most wins (21), most points (366), most goals (140), most assists (226), most shots (1,579), most shots/game (41.55) and most goals/ game (3.68).
- · For the third straight season the Nittany Lions won their opening Big Ten game by defeating Michigan State at home, 4-2. They followed that up with a 6-1 victory the following night to earn a sweep in the first conference series for the second straight season after doing the same to Wisconsin in 2014-15.
- Nittany Lions climb to as high as No. 14 in the uscho. com poll on numerous occasions while also earning their first-ever USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine ranking debuting at No. 15 in the December 14, 2015 poll.
- Penn State sweeps Wisconsin January 15-16, 2016.
- Penn State beats Minnesota, 5-3, at Mariucci Arena marking the first Nittany Lion victory in Minneapolis, February 6, 2016.
- Vince Pedrie earns All-Big Ten Second Team honors as well as All Freshman Team laurels.
- David Goodwin earns second-straight All-Big Ten Honorable Mention honors.

### **NITTANY LIONS PICKED FOURTH**

- · Penn State, entering its fifth season of varsity hockey, was picked fourth for the second consecutive year in the Preseason Coaches' Poll behind Minnesota, Ohio State and Michigan, but ahead of Wisconsin and Michigan State in the preseason poll.
- The Nittany Lions were picked sixth in both 2013-14 and 2014-15. Penn State exceeded expectations last season, leading the Big Ten for stretches of the season and finished third in the regular season and advanced to the Big Ten semifinals.

### **GOODWIN, PEDRIE NAMED B1G PLAYERS TO WATCH**

• Forward David Goodwin and defenseman Vince Pedrie were among the 13 athletes named to the Big Ten Preseason Players to Watch List on Monday, Sept. 26.

- Goodwin, returns as the leading point scorer from last seasons roster with 38 on 11 goals and a career-best 27 assists. His 27 helpers was also a new single-season program record.
- Goodwin is currently the career leader in points (90) and assists (57) while his 33 goals rank him third alltime. His 90 points in currently 8th in all of college hockey for current players.
- The senior's 72 points over the last two seasons are the most in a two-year stretch in program history as he boasts the second and third best scoring seasons behind Casev Bailey's 40-point outburst in 2014-15.
- A double major in economics and Spanish, Goodwin has benn an All-Big Ten Honorable Mention the past two seasons.
- Pedrie, a communications, Arts and Sciences major, missed the final six games last season due to injury, but was still a unanimous pick for the Preseason Watch List by the opposing coaches.
- The strong d-man with a wicked shot returns as the leading goal-scoring defenseman in conference games last season with seven. He finished the year with eight goals and 14 assists for 22 points, good for eighth on the team

- The final is the newest member of the Lions, Matt Erlichman, and resides about 80 miles south of State College in Bedford, Pa.

### **CANADIAN INFLUENCE**

- Seven Nittany Lion call Canada home, which is the same ammount as last season, marking the most in the programs breif history.
- Three hail from Alberta: **James Robinson** (Cochrane), **Dylan Richard** (Sherwood Park) and **Brandon Biro** (Sherwood Park).
- A trio of freshman join the Lions from Ontario: **Liam Folkes** (Scarborough), **Sean Kohler** (Oakville) and **Kris Myllari** (Kanata).

### **RUSSIAN CONNECTION**

- A pair of Nittany Lion freshman hail from Russia by the way of Pennsylvania as both Nikita Pavlychev (Yaroslavl) and Denis Smirnov (Moscow) become the first Lions to wear the Blue and White from the Motherland.
- Both forwards migrated to the U.S. and to Pennsylvania in their early teen years, playing youth hockey in the Keystone State.

### **PACKING THE PEG**

- Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 54-of-56 home games, including all 18 during the 2015-16 season.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 35 occasions including 15 games last season.
- In 2015-16, Penn State ranked seventh in average attendance (6,093) and led the nation in building capacity percentage (105.4 percent).
- Last season, Penn State had a season-total of 109,681 fans that have been to Pegula Ice Arena, which is the most in the facilities short three-year history.

### **WELCOME HOME**

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula lce Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

### **STRENGTH IN NUMBERS**

• Penn State has 27 players on the 2016-17 roster and after dealing with injuries throughout the majority of last season they are excited about this added depth. With 16 forwards and eight defensemen the internal competition and confidence is high.

### THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its fourth season entering 2016-17. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 20 league games, including 10 home contests.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a shootout win and one point for a shootout loss.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only major football conference to sponsor men's hockey.
- The 2017 league tournament will take place at Joe Louis Arena in Detroit, Mich. with the tournament champion earning the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

### **MEET COACH GADOWSKY**

**Guy Gadowsky**, the 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year, will guide the Nittany Lions in his 17th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program in 2016-17. Gadowsky is currently coaching his fifth Penn State varsity team.

### **AT PENN STATE**

In 2015-16 the Nittany Lions rise continued as Gadowsky led Penn State to their best finish since making the leap to NCAA Division I status. The Lions secured their first 20-win season, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose to as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll during the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6th the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before bowing out to eventual champion Michigan 7-2 in the semifinals.

Of his 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

Those 2015-16 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense including most goals (140), assists (226), points (366), shots (1,579), goals/gm (3.68) and shots/gm (41.55) to go along with those program-best 21 victories.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, garnering a winning season in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title up until the final weekend of

the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs, eventually scoring his first NHL goal in the season finale. Bailey was an All-Big Ten First Team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable mention by the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign had gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play. Additionally, his Lions earned wins over every Big Ten team during the season including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions during the Big Ten Conference's first season. Penn State, which faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals

In 2012-13, Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to a 13-14-0 record during their inaugural NCAA Division I season. He guided the squad to several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten teams (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL arena (19,529).

In 2011-12, Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

### AT PRINCETON

Before coming to Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second straight NCAA tournament appearance.

During the 2007-08 campaign, Gadowsky, who inherited a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival, guided Princeton to both the ECAC Hockey tournament and lvy League crowns. The team earned its first NCAA tournament berth since 1998, and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, pre-





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sented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

While at Princeton, Gadowsky had more than 20 players go on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

### **AT ALASKA**

Prior to Princeton, Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he inherited a team that had not won more than 14 games in the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, who were ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

In addition, Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.

### **BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING**

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign as he garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

### **PLAYING CAREER**

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. The three-time WCHA All-Academic Team member collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

In addition, Gadowsky spent a portion of the 1993-94 season competing with the Canadian National Team and also played professionally in Austria, The Netherlands and Sweden.

### **PERSONAL LIFE**

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.


