The No. 5 Penn State field hockey team hosts two conference games this weekend. First, the squad takes on Rutgers on Friday at 3:30 p.m. That game will be broadcast live on the Big Ten Network. Then, the team takes on No. 18 Indiana on Sunday at noon. The game against the Hoosiers will be Pink Day and Senior Day.

#### Senior Day/Pink Day

Against Indiana, nine seniors will be recognized for their contributions to Penn State field hockey, including **Katie Andrews** (Lancaster, Pa.), **Katie Breneman** (Washington Boro, Pa.), **Natalie Buttinger** (Kitchener, Ohio), **Jenna Chrismer** (Mountain Top, Pa.), **Amanda Dinunzio** (State College, Pa.), **Laura Gebhart** (Mount Joy, Pa.), **Casey Haegele** (Warrington, Pa.), **Taylor Herold** (Fredericksburg, Va.) and **Kylie Licata** (Mountain Top, Pa.).

These seniors have been to the NCAA quarterfinals twice (2011, 2012), won two Big Ten regular season titles (2012, 2013) and earned two Big Ten Tournament championships (2011, 2012). The two fifth-year seniors have made four-straight tournament appearances.

The game will also be Pink Day, raising awareness for breast cancer. The Nittany Lions and the Hoosiers will each be wearing pink warmup shirts. Pink Penn State field hockey knit caps will be given away to the first 200 fans in attendance.

**Rutgers Notes**

- The Scarlet Knights are in their first season in the Big Ten and have compiled a 6-7 record, including a 1-4 mark in league play.

- Rutgers has a Big Ten win over Ohio State (Oct. 10) and has played ranked opponents Virginia (Sept. 14) and Northwestern (Sept. 26) to overtime, while falling by just one game to ranked foes Michigan (Sept. 28) and Michigan State (Oct. 3).

- Offensively, Katie Champion leads the Scarlet Knights with eight goals and 21 points this season. Sofia Walia has notched a team-high six assists.

- Defensively, goalkeeper Shevaun Hayes holds a .692 save percentage in the cage.

- Meredith Long is in her third season at the helm.

**Series History**

Penn State is 13-4-3 all-time against Rutgers. The two teams haven't faced each other since the Nittany Lions won

1-0 on Sept. 14, 1993. Penn State has won the last seven games in the series, and haven't lost in the last 10 meetings.

**Indiana Notes**

- The No. 18 Hoosiers have compiled a 9-3 record this season, with a 1-3 mark in conference play.

- Most recently, Indiana has back-to-back wins against ranked opponents, downing No. 4 Duke, 3-2, on Oct. 5 and defeating No. 20 Michigan State, 2-1, on Oct. 11.

- Offensively, Audra Heilman leads the team with 12 goals, five assists and 29 points. Through Oct. 12, she ranked fifth nationally with 1.00 goals per game.

- Defensively, the squad was 14th nationally through Oct. 12 with a 1.42 goals against average. Sydney Supica ranked first in the country with seven defensive saves and goalkeeper Maggie Olson was seventh with a .790 save percentage.

- Amy Robertson is in her 15th season as the head coach.

**Series History**

Penn State is 16-3 all-time against the Hoosiers. Last season, the Nittany Lions picked up a 4-0 win on the road. Penn State has won the last five meetings.

**Last Time Out**

Senior captain **Laura Gebhart** (Mount Joy, Pa.) posted her first career hat trick, leading the No. 5 Penn State field hockey team to a 4-1 win against Bucknell at the Field Hockey Complex Oct. 14. Gebhart scored all three of her goals in the first 18:46 of the game. Senior **Taylor Herold** (Fredericksburg, Va.) also scored in the game, tying her for 10th on the program's all-time goals list with 48.

**Herold Moving up Goals List**

Herold reached the 100-point mark with a goal and two assists at Ohio State (Sept. 28), giving her 100 career points. She has 48 goals and 15 assists for her career. Her 48 goals are tied for 10th on Penn State's all-time list. She is two goals away from tying head coach **Charlene Morett-Curtiss** for ninth with 50.

**Herold's Heroics**

Herold posted three goals, all in the second half, against No. 14 Princeton on Sept. 12. It marked her first career hat trick. Against Ohio State (Sept. 28), she had a career-high two assists. Scoring

a goal in seven of the last eight games, she is first on the team with 34 points and 14 goals and tied for first with six assists. Herold has four multi-goal games this season. Through Oct. 12, the senior ranked fifth nationally in goals per game (1.00).

**Gebhart with the Hat Trick**

Gebhart has started all 77 games since arriving on campus as a freshman. Against Bucknell (Oct. 14), the senior had her first career hat trick, scoring all three goals in the first 18:46 of the game.

**Gebhart on the Assist**

Currently, she has 44 assists, which is two away from tying her for seventh on Penn State's all-time list and three from tying her for sixth. She is tied for first on the team with six assists.

**Coming up with Corners**

Through Oct. 12, the Nittany Lions ranked third nationally with 8.54 penalty corners per game. The squad has had 12 or more on four separate occasions, including a season-high 16 against Lock Haven.

**Big Ten Honors**

Redshirt senior goalkeeper **Kylie Licata** (Mountain Top, Pa.) was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week twice this season. Most recently, she made a career-high 14 saves at No. 3 UConn and shut out Quinnipiac to earn the honor on Sept. 9. Licata earned Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week (Sept. 2), while back **Cori Conley** (Oak Park, Ill.) was named Freshman of the Week following the season-opening wins. Licata made a career-high nine saves against the Lady Monarchs and shut out the Cavaliers. Conley played a key role defensively, helping a unit that held Virginia scoreless in a game for the first time since 2011.

**Chrismer Capitalizing**

Senior **Jenna Chrismer** (Mountain Top, Pa.) has been impressive offensively. Most recently, Chrismer tallied two goals at Ohio State. Prior to that, she posted a career-high two assists against No. 14 Princeton (Sept. 12) before tying her personal best with two goals vs. Lafayette (Sept. 14). She scored each of the team's goals in the 2-1 win over Old Dominion (Aug. 29), before tallying an assist against Virginia (Aug. 31) and at Quinnipiac (Sept. 7). She is second on the team with eight goals and tied for second with 20 points.

**Solid in the Cage**

Licata has been a force between the posts, making nine saves against Old Dominion and holding Virginia scoreless, the first time the Cavaliers were blanked since 2011. Then, at No. 3 Connecticut, she stopped a career-high 14 shots. Most recently, she made 10 saves against No. 18 Michigan. She ranks fourth nationally with a .805 save percentage through Oct. 12.

**Ehret Making Noise**

Sophomore **Emilee Ehret** (Philadelphia, Pa.) has scored a point in seven of the last 10 games, and posted a goal and an assist in two of those games. She has played a key role in penalty corner chances, being the primary player to insert for the Nittany Lions.

**Dazzling Dinunzio**

Senior **Amanda Dinunzio** (State College, Pa.) posted the first multi-goal game of her career against Lock Haven, scoring two in the contest. It was a career-high four points for the senior. In back-to-back games at No. 2 Maryland (Oct. 10) and vs. Bucknell (Oct. 14), she posted her first two assists of the season.

**Buttinger Breaks Out**

Redshirt senior **Natalie Buttinger** (Kitchener, Ontario) scored the first two goals of her career in the 3-0 win over No. 6 Virginia.

been at the top of the Big Ten in those seasons as well, being named co-conference regular season champions in 2013 and the outright winner in 2012. The squad won the Big Ten Tournament in 2011 and 2012.

**Excelling with Experience**

Penn State brings back six starters and three of its top six scorers from a season ago. The squad returns two 2013 Big Ten first team members in **Laura Gebhart (Mount Joy, Pa.)** and **Kylie Licata (Mountain Top, Pa.)**, while **Taylor Herold (Fredericksburg, Va.)**, who garnered second team honors, also returns. Herold led Penn State with 30 points (13 goals, four assists) last year. Gebhart was a 2013 Longstreth/NFHCA Division I second team All-American.

**Preseason Accolades**

Seniors **Katie Breneman (Washington Boro, Pa.)**, Gebhart and Herold were each named to the 2014 Big Ten Field Hockey Players to Watch List.

**Remaining Elite in the Rankings**

The Nittany Lions were selected No. 8 in the 2014 Penn Metro/NFHCA Division I Preseason Poll. The squad holds the second-highest ranking of any Big Ten team in the top 20. Maryland (No. 1) is the only conference foe ranked higher. Penn State plays nine teams ranked that are ranked in the preseason poll.

**Gebhart on the National Stage**

Gebhart has been competing for the U.S. National Team each of the last two summers. She competed internationally in March, and was one of 30 players on the 2013-14 U.S. National Field Hockey Team.

**On the Turf and in the Classroom**

The Penn State field hockey program was recognized by Gladiator and the National Field Hockey Coaches Association with the National Academic Team Award for sporting a team GPA above 3.0 in the 2013-14 academic year. In addition, the Nittany Lions placed 12 players on the Gladiator by SGI/NFHCA Division I National Academic Squad.

Katie Andrews, Katie Breneman, Carly Celkos, Amanda Dinunzio, Emilee Ehret, Abby Fuhrman, Laura Gebhart, Kirsten Gochnauer, Jacqueline Kenney, Haley Kerstetter, Lauren Purvis and Whitney Reddig all earned the accolade.

**Challenging Schedule**

Penn State has again put together a top-tier schedule, facing nine teams that were ranked in the 2014 NFHCA Preseason Poll, including conference-foes Maryland (1), Northwestern (14), Michigan State (16), Michigan (17) and Iowa (20). Along with the conference opponents, the squad also has matchups against Connecticut (3), Virginia (6), Princeton (7) and Old Dominion (9). Seven teams (ODU, Virginia, Connecticut, Quinnipiac, Princeton, Michigan State and Maryland) each made the 2013 NCAA Tournament.

The longest tenured coach in the Big Ten and the sixth-longest tenured at a single school in Division I field hockey history, Charlene Morett-Curtiss enters her 28th season as head coach of the Penn State field hockey program in 2014. Morett-Curtiss boasts a remarkable resume covering her time as the leader of the Nittany Lions. Over the last six years, Morett-Curtiss has led the Nittany Lions to three Big Ten regular season titles, two Big Ten Tournament championships and five NCAA Tournament appearances.

Morett-Curtiss currently ranks fifth all-time in Division I history in wins with 458 and is one of just six DI coaches to accumulate 400 career wins. She has led the Nittany Lions to the NCAA Tournament in 24 of her 27 years as head coach of Penn State and has helped maintain Penn State's distinction as the No. 3 ranked school in all-time NCAA Tournament appearances with 29.

A seven-time NFHCA Midwest Region Coach of the Year, Morett-Curtiss is an excellent teacher of field hockey. Her players earn national recognition on a yearly basis, 11 of whom have been named two-time first team All-Americans with Kelsey Amy being the most recent. Her teams dominate the national scene, consistently ranking among the Top 10 in the national polls. Penn State was ranked in the Top 10 of the STX/NFHCA poll for 32 consecutive weeks from the first poll of the 2005 season ending with the second poll of 2008. The squad achieved a No. 1 ranking in the STX/NFHCA poll for the first time in program history. From 2005-08, Penn State finished eighth, sixth, ninth and 11th respectively, in the final poll of the season.

Under Morett-Curtiss' tutelage, five of her players have been named Big Ten Athlete of the Year -- Traci Anselmo, Jen Coletta, Heather Gorlaski, Tracey Larson and Kiley Kulina. Six players have been voted the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year -- Natalie Berrena, Dawn Lammey, Larson, Tara Maguire, Allison Scola and Kelsey Amy. In 2012 and 2013, Brittany Grzywacz was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, earning the ninth and 10th Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honors from Penn State, joining Anselmo, Gorlaski, Becca Main, Jill Martz, Jill Pearsall and Jen Long. Long, Anselmo and Grzywacz are the only Lions to be named Defensive Player of the Year twice.

Since Penn State's entry into the Big Ten in 1992, Morett's program has produced more First Team All-Big Ten selections, Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year, Big Ten Athletes of the Year and Big Ten Freshmen of the Year than any other program. Penn State's 10 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honorees are five more than any other school.

With Laura Gebhart, Brittany Grzywacz, Taylor Herold, Ashton Klingler and Kylie Licata earning All-Big Ten laurels last season, Penn State has now totaled 94 All-Big Ten selections since 1992, including 65 first team All-Conference choices, the most of any Big Ten school since Penn State moved to the Big Ten in 1992.
