Michigan State is ranked No. 9 in the country in scoring offense (86.4 ppg), No. 3 in field goal defense (36.9%) and has scored at least 80 points 11 times this season.

## THE STARTING FIVE

### 1. Series History

Michigan State leads the all-time series with Penn State, 38-8 ... The Spartans have won 22 of the last 27 games in the series, including nine of the last 10 ... Tom Izzo is 31-7 in his career against Penn State ... Michigan State is 14-4 in road games in the series and has won three of the last four games.

### 2. Nick Ward Named Big Ten Player of the Week

Junior Nick Ward was named the Big Ten Player of the Week on Monday ... This is the second-straight week a Spartan has earned that honor, following junior guard Cassius Winston last week ... Ward averaged 21.0 points, 7.5 rebounds and 2.5 blocked shots in wins over Northwestern and at then-No. 14 Ohio State ... He connected on 60.9 percent of his shots (14-of-23) and 70.0 percent from the free throw line (14-of-20) ... Ward scored all 21 of his points during the first half of the win over Northwestern and followed that up with 21 points, eight rebounds and three blocks, hitting 5-of-7 field goals and 11-of-14 free throws in a road win at Ohio State ... This is the first Player of the Week honor this year for Ward and the third of his career.

### 3. Michigan State Pulls Away from Purdue in 77-59 Victory

Junior guard Cassius Winston scored a game-high 23 points and Michigan State pulled away from Purdue for a 77-59 win on Tuesday night ... Purdue cut MSU's 13-point halftime lead to four in the second half, but a Winston layup helped push the lead back to 57-48 and the Boilermakers got no closer than seven points the rest of the way ... Largely in part to the defensive effort of Matt McQuaid, MSU held Purdue guard Carsen Edwards to a season-low 11 points on 3-of-16 shooting from the floor, including 2-of-13 from 3-point land ... Winston scored 23 points to lead three players in double figures, with Nick Ward adding 16 points, nine rebounds and three blocked shots and sophomore forward Xavier Tillman added 11 points and five rebounds.

### 4. About the Spartans

Michigan State enters Tuesday's game with a 14-2 overall record and a 5-0 mark in the Big Ten ... The Spartans have won nine-straight games and 14 of the last 15 overall ... Through 16 games, junior guard Cassius Winston leads the team with 18.0 points per game and 7.4 assists per game ... Winston is sixth in the Big Ten in scoring and is No. 4 in the country in assists per game ... Junior forward Nick Ward is second on the team with 16.7 points and third on the team with 6.6 rebounds ... He is tied for 11th in the Big Ten in scoring and ranks fourth in the league, and is No. 13 nationally in field goal percentage, connecting on 65.5 percent of his shots ... Junior guard Joshua Langford is third on the team in scoring with 15.0 points per game, while adding 3.6 rebounds and 2.3 assists ... Sophomore forward Xavier Tillman is fourth on the team in scoring with 8.7 points and second with 7.8 rebounds, while redshirt senior Kenny Goins is sixth on the team in scoring with 6.6 points and leads the team with 9.4 rebounds per game, which ranks No. 32 nationally ... Senior guard Matt McQuaid is averaging 8.2 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.2 assists ... Redshirt junior Kyle Ahrens, who has started seven games, is averaging 6.1 points and 2.8 rebounds ... MSU ranks No. 9 in the country in scoring offense (86.4 ppg), No. 9 in field goal percentage (50.6%) and No. 3 in field goal percentage defense (36.9%).

### 5. Moving Up the Record Book

Michigan State junior forward Nick Ward and guard Cassius Winston are making their mark on the school record book ... Ward moved past the 1,000-point mark for his career on Nov. 23 (vs. Texas) and now has 1,187 points for his career, 34th all-time ... Ward's career field goal percentage of 62.5 percent ranks No. 2 all-time at MSU ... Winston, meanwhile, moved past Magic Johnson on the all-time list in assists on Dec. 3 (Iowa) ... Winston ranks No. 9 all-time with 542 career assists ... He also ranks No. 3 all-time at MSU in career 3-point field goal percentage (45.9%) ... Winston (966 points) is approaching the 1,000-point mark for their career.

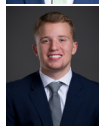

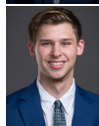

### ABOUT PENN STATE

Penn State enters Sunday's game with a 7-9 overall record, including an 0-5 mark in the Big Ten ... The Nittany Lions are coming off a 70-64 loss at Nebraska at Thursday night ... Penn State has lost a pair of Big Ten games at home, to Indiana in December (64-62) and on Jan. 6 to Wisconsin (71-52) ... The Nittany Lions beat Virginia Tech, 63-62, at home in November ... Junior forward Lamar Stevens leads the team with 18.6 points and 8.1 rebounds ... He is fourth in the Big Ten in scoring and tied for sixth in rebounding ... Freshman guard Rasir Bolton is second on the team with 12.6 points and 32 3-point field goals, while senior guard Josh Reaves is third on the team with 10.1 points and leads the team with 3.2 assists ... Redshirt junior forward Mike Watkins, who had 12 points and 14 rebounds in the loss at Nebraska, is averaging 7.9 points and leads the team with 8.2 rebounds ... Penn State is scoring 67.9 points per game, but only 58.4 per game in league play (14th) ... The Nittany Lions also rank sixth in the league in scoring defense in league games, allowing 67.8 points per game.

### SERIES HISTORY

Michigan State leads the all-time series with Penn State, 38-8 ... The Spartans have won 22 of the last 27 games in the series, including nine of the last 10 ... Tom Izzo is 31-7 in his career against Penn State.

### LAST MEETING

Michigan State scored 52 points in the second half and fought back from a 12-point deficit in the second half en route to a 76-68 win over Penn State at the Breslin Center on Jan. 31 ... Miles Bridges scored 23 points and grabbed nine rebounds to lead three players in double figures ... Cassius Winston finished with 15 points and 10 assists and Joshua Langford scored 14 points, had four rebounds and two assists ... After shooting only 37.5 percent in the first half, MSU connected on 62.5 percent of its shots (15-of-24) in the second half.

### EXPERIENCE MATTERS

While Michigan State entered this year after losing a pair of players to the NBA Draft, Head Coach Tom Izzo knew that he returned an experienced rotation ... The team's most-oft used starting lineup – redshirt senior Kenny Goins, senior Matt McQuaid, and juniors Joshua Langford, Nick Ward and Cassius Winston – has played a combined 480 games with a combined 257 starts .. Add in the team's top two reserves – redshirt junior Kyle Ahrens and sophomore forward Xavier Tillman – and the top seven players have combined for 607 games played and 268 starts ... Langford has missed the last three games with an ankle injury ... When he did not start against Northwestern on Jan. 3, it broke a streak of 73-straight starts dating back to the 2016-17 season.

### STREAKING

Michigan State has won 17-straight Big Ten Conference games, dating back to the 2017-18 season ... The Spartans won their final 12 games of the 2017-18 regular season and have opened the 2018-19 season with five-straight conference wins ... The MSU school record for consecutive conference wins is 18, set over the course of the 1998-99 season (15) and the 1999-2000 season (3) before losing at Ohio State on Jan. 20, 2000 ... The Spartans have won their last nine conference road games, a school record.

### JUNIOR CLASS LEADING THE WAY

Michigan State's juniors are leading the way for the Spartans ... The three true juniors – Joshua Langford, Cassius Winston and Nick Ward – have combined to play in 255 games and start 201 games through 16 games this season ... As a trio, they are averaging 46.9 points, 12.1 rebounds and 10.3 assists, while connecting on 52.3 percent of their field goals (262-of-501) ... Through 16 games, those three have accounted for 54.2 percent of the team's scoring (750 of 1,383 points), 27.6 percent of its rebounds (194 of 704) and 48.4 percent of the team's assists (164 of 339).

### WARD MAKING HIS MARK ON RECORD BOOK

Junior forward Nick Ward hit a pair of free throws with 2:37 left in the first half of the win over Texas on Nov. 23, moving him past the 1,000-point mark for his career ... Ward is the 50th player in Michigan State history to reach the 1,000-point mark ... In 86 career games, he has now scored 1,187 points, a 13.8 per game average ... With 26 points against Iowa on Dec. 3, Ward passed a Who's Who of MSU greats on the all-time list, moving past former teammate Miles Bridges (1,055 points), Magic Johnson (1,059 points) and Johnny Green (1,062 points) ... Ward now ranks 34th all-time at MSU and needs nine more points to pass Kelvin Torbert (2001-05) and Alan Anderson (2001-05) for 33rd place ... In addition, Ward's career field goal percentage of 62.5 percent (438-of-701) ranks tied for No. 2 all-time at MSU, trailing only Ron Charles (1976-80, 63.9%) ... Among active NCAA players, Ward ranks 14th in the country in field goal percentage.

Michigan State has won nine-straight games, beating opponents by 18.8 points per game in that span ... In the last five games, MSU has won by 22.2 points, led in large part by its defense and rebounding ... During the nine-game stretch, MSU allowed only 66.3 points per game and opponents shot only 36.6 percent from the floor ... Overall this season, the Spartans are limiting opponents to 36.9 percent shooting from the field ... No opponent has shot above 50 percent against the Spartans ... MSU ranks No. 3 nationally in field goal percentage defense (36.9 percent) ... Michigan State has held five opponents to below 60 points this season ... The Spartans have only been out-rebounded once this season (Kanaz) and rank No. 4 in the country in total rebounds per game (44.00) ... MSU ranked No. 2 in the country in rebound margin (+12.0 overall) and No. 4 in total blocked shots (91) through Jan. 11.

**CASHING IN**

Junior guard Cassius Winston is among the nation's leaders in assists, averaging 7.4 per game, which ranks No. 4 in the country ... Among active leaders in the NCAA, Winston ranks No. 5 with 542 assists ... He has scored at least 20 points seven time this season and MSU is 7-0 in those games ... Winston is the only player in the country averaging at least 18.0 points per game, 7.0 assists per game and shooting at least 45.0 percent from 3-point land.

**AT HOME IN THE POST**

Junior forward Nick Ward and sophomore forward Xavier Tillman have been formidable in the post, both at home and away ... Ward hit 12-of-13 field goals against Green Bay on Dec. 16, the second-best single game field goal percentage in MSU history (92.3%) ... Ward is shooting 76.8 percent at home this year (53-of-69) and is averaging 18.7 points per game ... Tillman, meanwhile, is shooting 69.2 percent from the floor (27-of-39) ... Combined, the forwards have connected on 66.4 percent of their field goals (150-of-226), including 72.5 percent (95-of-131) in games at the Breslin Center.

**BACKCOURT STRENGTH**

Michigan State's backcourt of junior guards Joshua Langford and Cassius Winston is among the best in the country ... Since arriving in East Lansing in 2016, the duo has appeared in a combined 168 games, with 129 starts between them ... Winston, who has started 55 times in 86 career games, leads the team in scoring with 18.0 points per game and assists with 7.4 per game, which ranks No. 4 nationally ... He is shooting 49.0 percent from the floor (97-of-194) and 45.7 percent from 3-point land (43-of-94) ... Langford has played in 83 career games with a team-high 75 starts ... He is third on the team in scoring with 15.0 points per game, while adding 3.6 rebounds and 2.3 assists ... Langford is shooting 44.3 percent from the floor (70-of-158) and 40.3 percent from 3-point land (29-of-72) ... Combined, they are averaging 30.8 points, 5.5 rebounds, 9.3 assists and shooting 46.9 percent from the floor (167-of-356), including 43.4 percent from 3-point land (72-of-166).

MSU's nation's-best assist average of 20.5 was the 23rd-best average in NCAA history ... The Spartans recorded an assist on a nation's-best 71.3 percent of its field goals ... Through 16 games in 2018-19, MSU leads the Big Ten in assists and rank No. 1 nationally (21.2) ... The Spartans have handed out an assist on 68.9 percent of their field goals (339-of-492).

**FROM BEYOND THE ARC**

### SPARTANS IN PRESEASON TOURNAMENTS

Michigan State has had success in preseason tournaments in recent years ... In beating Texas, 78-68, to win the Las Vegas Invitational on Friday, it marked the second-straight year the Spartans had won a preseason tournament and the fourth time in the last six years ... Last year, MSU won the Victory Bracket of the PK80 Invitational in Portland, Ore., beating North Carolina, 81-63, in the title game ... MSU has won the 2013 Coaches vs. Cancer Classic in Brooklyn and the 2015 Wooden Legacy in California, while finishing second in the 2014 Orlando Classic.

### WINSTON NAMED LAS VEGAS INVITATIONAL MVP

Junior guard Cassius Winston was named the Las Vegas Invitational Tournament Most Valuable Player after his performance in a pair of games at Orleans Arena ... This is the second-straight year that Winston has been named MVP of a preseason tournament as he took top honors when MSU won the PK80 Invitational Victory Bracket in 2017 in Portland, Ore. ... In Las Vegas, Winston averaged 19.5 points, 8.5 assists and 3.0 rebounds while shooting 50.0 percent from the floor (13-of-26) and 50.0 percent from 3-point land (7-of-14) ... In addition to Winston, junior guard Joshua Langford and junior forward Nick Ward both earned spots on the all-tournament team ... Langford averaged 21.5 points and 3.5 rebounds while hitting 57.7 percent of his shots (15-of-26), including 61.5 percent from 3-point land (8-of-13) ... He scored a career-high 29 points in the title game win over Texas ... Ward averaged 11.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 1.5 blocked shots to earn a spot on the tourney team.

### WARD, WINSTON EARN NATIONAL ACCOLADES

Michigan State juniors Nick Ward and Cassius Winston also earned national accolades ... Ward was selected to the watch list for the 2019 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame today ... He was one of 21 players selected to the watch list, recognizing the nation's top big man ... Winston was named one of 20 watch list candidates

for the 2019 Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award ... Named after Class of 1971 Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic and Holy Cross guard Bob Cousy, the annual honor, now in its 16th year, recognizes the top point guards in Division I men's college basketball.



### WARD, WINSTON NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN TEAM

Michigan State juniors Nick Ward and Cassius Winston were selected to the Preseason All-Big Ten Team at the league's media day on October 11 ... Ward and Winston were among 10 players selected to the all-league team and Michigan State was one of only two schools with multiple players selected ... This is the second-straight year that Ward has been named to the Preseason All-BIG team ... Ward was a Big Ten honorable mention selection by the coaches and a third team honoree by the media in 2017-18 ... He finished third on the team in scoring with 12.4 points and led the team with 7.1 rebounds, adding 1.3 blocks per game in 18.9 minutes ... Winston was an All-Big Ten Third Team honoree last season and was selected to the United States Basketball Writers Association All-District V team ... He finished second on the team in scoring with 12.6 points per game and led the team with 6.8 assists per game and in 3-point field goal percentage, connecting on 49.7 percent of his shots from long distance (75-of-151) ... Winston led the Big Ten, and was No. 8 in the country, in assists per game.

### LANGFORD, MCQUAID NAMED CAPTAINS

Junior guard Joshua Langford and senior guard Matt McQuaid were selected as captains for the 2018-19 season, announced by Head Coach Tom Izzo ... The Spartans held their first day of practice for the 2018-19 season on Sept. 27, when Izzo made the announcement ... Langford finished fourth on the team in scoring last year, averaging 11.7 points per game, while adding 3.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists ... He was fourth on the team in 3-point field goals (44) and hit 40.4 percent of his shots ... McQuaid ranked sixth on the team in scoring, averaging 6.0 points off the bench. He started two games, including scoring a career-high 20 points against DePaul last year, and was fifth on the team in minutes played, averaging 20.5 per game ... Langford and McQuaid were the co-recipients of the team's John E. Benington Defensive Player of the Award last year.

### DEFENSIVE MINDED

Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo wanted to see improvements in the team's defense during its recent homestand ... A 101-33 win over Tennessee Tech on Nov. 18 was a display of that ... The 68-point margin of victory for MSU tied the Breslin Center record for widest margin of victory, set on Dec. 21, 1992 against Morehead State (121-53) ... MSU held Tennessee Tech to 33 points, the fewest points scored by an opponent since holding Binghamton to 33 points in a 76-33 win on Dec. 5, 2015 ... The 14 points scored by Tennessee Tech in the first half were the fewest by an MSU opponent in the first half since holding Binghamton to 12 points (41-12 lead) on Dec. 5, 2015.

### 100 IS THE NUMBER

The win over Green Bay on Dec. 16 marked the 50th time MSU has scored 100 points in a game ... The Spartans improved to 49-1 all-time when scoring 100 points, with the lone loss coming in a triple-overtime 109-106 loss to Gonzaga at the 2005 Maui Invitational.

### SPARTANS CRUISE PAST NORTHERN MICHIGAN IN EXHIBITION

Junior forward Nick Ward scored 24 points and had nine rebounds and junior guard Cassius Winston added 13 points and seven assists as No. 10 Michigan State jumped out to a 30-point halftime lead en route to a 93-47 win over Northern Michigan in an exhibition game at the Breslin Center on Oct. 30 ... Ward and Winston led four players in double figures as junior guard Joshua Langford added 12 points and freshman forward Marcus Bingham Jr. finished with 11 points ... Michigan State went into the break with a 43-13 lead, with Winston (11) and Ward (10) pacing the way ... The Spartans connected on 48.1 percent of their field goals (13-of-27) and scored 20 points in the paint and 25 on fast breaks ... The Spartans out-scored the Wildcats, 22-0 over the next eight minutes and took a 31-7 lead on a 3-pointer from Winston at the 8:05 mark ... MSU took its biggest lead of the half, 31 points (43-12) on a pair of free throws from Ward with two minutes left to play in the half ... The Green & White took their biggest leads, 49 points (85-36) on a layup from sophomore forward Xavier Tillman with 4:04 to play in the game ... Ten different players scored for Michigan State.

George graduated in three years, earning his bachelor's degree in communication ... He is currently pursuing a Master of Arts in education ... Goins, a fifth-year senior, earned his bachelor's degree in advertising management and is pursuing a master's degree in communication.

### STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

In total, the 2018-19 schedule is highlighted by 15 games against teams that appeared in the 2018 postseason, including 11 against 2018 NCAA Tournament teams ... Eight opponents appeared in the 2018 NCAA Tournament, including non-conference opponents Kansas, UCLA, Texas, North Carolina and Florida, as well as conference foes Michigan, Ohio State and Purdue ... Four opponents played in the 2018 National Invitation Tournament, Florida Gulf Coast, Louisville, Nebraska and Penn State.

### SPARTANS IN THE NBA

Michigan State had seven players on NBA opening day rosters, including Denzel Valentine (Chicago Bulls), Gary Harris (Denver Nuggets), Bryn Forbes (San Antonio Spurs), Draymond Green (Golden State Warriors) and Zach Randolph (Sacramento Kings), along with rookies Miles Bridges (Charlotte Hornets) and Jaren Jackson Jr. (Memphis Grizzlies).

### SPARTANS IN THE POLLS

Michigan State's men's basketball team was ranked No. 10 in the country in the Associated Press Preseason poll and the USA Today Coaches poll ... The Spartans, who finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 5 in the AP poll, received 1,024 total points ... This is the seventh-straight year the Spartans have opened a season ranked among the preseason top-25 and the 11th time in the last 12 years ... Under Head Coach Tom Izzo, Michigan State has been ranked in the preseason 19 times.

### COACHING STABILITY

Michigan State has had just two basketball coaches in the last 42 seasons and three in the last 49 ... Tom Izzo is in his 24th season, having taken over from his mentor Jud Heathcote, who spent 19 years as head coach (1976-95) ... Before Heathcote, Gus Ganakas spent seven seasons as head coach. Ganakas provided commentary on Spartan radio broadcasts for 31 seasons.

### MSU Athletics Mourns Passing of Former Coach Gus Ganakas

Former Michigan State men's basketball head coach Gus Ganakas, who coached the Spartans from 1969-76 and was part of the athletics department from 1964 until his retirement in 2000, passed away on Friday, Jan. 11. He was 92 (1926-2019).

#### Statement From Head Coach Tom Izzo

"Spartan Basketball has lost a dear friend today. Gus was one of the most selfless and positive people that I've ever been around. Our thoughts and prayers are with the entire Ganakas family as they grieve their loss.

"You'll learn all you need to about Gus when you look at the way he handled being replaced as head coach. Most of us would have wanted our replacement to fail, hoping it would make us look good. But that wasn't who Gus was. Instead, he made sure that the local high school superstar Earvin Johnson knew that Michigan State was still the right place for him to attend and that new coach Jud Heathcote was the right guy to play for. As they say, the rest is history. But there is no doubt that Spartan Basketball wouldn't be what it is today without Gus Ganakas.

"Gus would go on to play a major role in any coaching success that I've enjoyed. Early on, he was on my staff and provided a great sounding board for a first time head coach. Throughout most of my career he also served as the analyst on our radio broadcasts, where he could always find the good in our performances, and tried his best to cheer me up despite how upset I might be.

"But most importantly, Gus has helped build the family atmosphere within Michigan State basketball. The connection between our past and our present is the best of any program in the nation because of Gus. Former Spartans from all eras feel connected to the current team, and much of that credit goes to Gus.

"We will all miss Gus ... his smile and his sense of humor. He's been a bright light to my entire family, from both my parents to my wife Lupe and children Raquel and Steven. But his impact on the entire Spartan family will continue to live on. And if there are ever tough times in heaven, they now have the perfect guy to make everyone feel just a little bit better."

#### Ganakas Bio

Ganakas attended Michigan State University from 1946-50 and returned to campus in September of 1964 to serve as the coordinator for the Ralph Young Fund, known today as the Spartan Fund.

Ganakas then became an assistant men's basketball coach in 1966 before taking over as the head coach three years later. He led the team an overall record of 89-84 in seven years as head coach, posting a winning record in each of his last five seasons. His most successful seasons were in 1973-74 with a fourth-place finish in the Big Ten, and in 1974-75, when the Spartans posted a 17-9 overall record, the second-highest victory total at the time.

His coaching career came to an end in 1976, but he continued to be a part of the Michigan State Athletics Department, serving as an assistant athletics director from 1976-98 and then as an aide to current Head Coach Tom Izzo from 1998-2000. Ganakas was also responsible for organizing the 1989 MSU Basketball Centennial Celebration.

For more than 30 years, Ganakas could be heard as one of the voices of Michigan State men's basketball, serving as a color commentator.

"For 20 seasons we were broadcast partners - a partnership that would turn into one of the greatest friendships of my life," said Will Tieman, play-by-play announcer from 1992-96 and since 2002. "You couldn't help but love Gus. He was truly one of the greats of the greatest generation"

A native of Mount Morris, N.Y., Ganakas earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Michigan State in 1949 and a master's degree in the same field in 1950. He came to Michigan State after serving in the U.S. Marine Corps during World War II, including seeing action in the Battle of Okinawa.

### Coach Izzo

In his 24th year, Tom Izzo (Northern Michigan, '77) is 588-227 (.721), and 277-122 (.694) in the Big Ten, as the head coach of the Michigan State basketball program. He ranks as the winningest coach in Michigan State history, having passed his mentor Jud Heathcote with his 341st career victory on Nov. 28, 2009. In his 23 seasons as a head coach, Izzo has captured eight National Coach of the Year awards, including the Clair Bee Award in 2005 and NABC honors in 2001 and 2012. In 1999, Izzo was named National Coach of the Year by Basketball Times, while earning similar honors from The Associated Press, Basketball News and the USBWA in '98. He also earned National Coach of the Year accolades from CBSSports.com in 2012. He earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in 1998, 2009 and 2012. Izzo was enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on September 9, 2016, cementing his status as one of the game's all-time greats.

### Among The Big Ten's Best

Tom Izzo's .694 winning percentage in Big Ten games ranks third all-time among league coaches with at least 10 years of service, behind former Wisconsin coach Bo Ryan (.717), and former Indiana coach Bob Knight (.700), and ahead of former Purdue coach Ward Lambert (.685). In all games, Ohio State's Thad Matta ranks first at .748, followed by Ryan (.737), Knight (.734), Izzo (.721), Wisconsin's Walter Meanwell (.712), and Lambert (.709). With 276 conference victories, Izzo ranks second all time.

### Izzo Among Best Ever

Through his first 23 seasons, Tom Izzo won 574 games, ranking fifth in college basketball history for most wins by a college coach in his first 23 years.

### Final Fours

Tom Izzo led MSU to seven Final Four appearances between 1999 and 2017, becoming just the fourth school in college basketball history to do it in any 17-year span, including just the third since the tournament field expanded to 64 teams in 1985. Izzo's seven Final Fours are the most by any coach since his first season in 1996 and he ranks fifth all-time, including tied for fifth among active coaches. The seven Final Fours are also the most by any Big Ten coach.
