SCOUTING THE EAGLES

- ▶ The Eagles are coming off their fourth overtime contest of the season, after pushing Hofstra into an extra period on Saturday (Dec. 10). AU eventually fell to the Pride, 72-67.
- ▶ For the first time this season, AU put two players into the 20-point range. Sophomore Cecily Carl tied her career-high with a 21-point effort, while sophomore Kaitlyn Lewis hit a new career-best with a 20-point tally.
- ▶ Junior Emily Kinneston continues to lead the team with 10.8 ppg, followed closely by Carl with 10.7 ppg.
- ▶ Senior Lauren Crisler is the top Eagle on the boards, averaging 5.7 rpg.
- ▶ Junior Maria Liddane leads the team with 4.4 apg.

SCOUTING THE LADY LIONS

- ▶ Penn State remains undefeated at home after a 91-62 win over Pitt on Saturday, Dec. 10.
- ▶ The Lady Lions have gone three consecutive games shooting 45 percent or better from the floor.
- ▶ Lindsey Spann put in her third 20-point game of the season to lead the team in scoring. Amari Carter and Teniya Page joined Spann in double figures with 13 points apiece.
- ▶ Page and Spann both average in the double-digits with 19.6 and 13.6 ppg, respectively.
- ▶ Kaliyah Mitchell leads on the boards on both ends, averaging 6.6 rpg per game.
- ▶ Drexel (83-60) and Georgetown (68-54) are Penn State's only two losses of the season.

THE LAST TIME OUT

The American University women's basketball fell in an overtime nail-biter on Saturday (Dec. 10), dropping a 72-67 contest against Hofstra. This was the fourth overtime matchup this season for the Eagles, who are now 1-3 for overtime games.

AU was led by the scoring efforts of sophomores Cecily Carl and Kaitlyn Lewis, who both tallied career-highs against the Pride. Carl tied her career-best with a 21-point tally while contributing a team-high eight rebounds. Lewis surpassed her previous career-high by five points, shooting 4-of-4 from 3-point range to pull down 20 points. Lewis is shooting 56 percent from the field and 60 percent from behind the arc for the season.

The Pride was led by the pairing of Ashunae Durant and Krystal Luciano, who combined for 37 points, 19 rebounds and 12 assists. Durant put up a total of 23 points, 12 rebounds and six assists. Luciano contributed another 14 points, seven rebounds, and matched Durant with six assists.

Once again, it was the free throw line that became the deciding factor, as the Eagles led Hofstra from the field, 51.9 percent to 35.4 percent. From the charity stripe, however, the Pride dominated, shooting 81.8 percent while going 18-for-22.

OVERTIME CLASHES

- The Eagles have pushed four games into overtime so far this season - tying the 1984-85 team for a program record.
- The only overtime matchup in 2015-16 was the Feb. 3 contest at Bucknell, which AU lost, 60-54.
- AU is currently 1-3 in overtime contests. The Eagles' only victory in extra time was against reigning Atlantic 10 Champs, George Washington, 66-61.
- Georgia State was the only game in which AU was leading heading into the final minute. In the matchups against Delaware, GW and Hofstra, it was the Eagles who evened the score to send the game into OT.
- **Cecily Carl** sunk the game-tying basket against both GW and Hofstra, while **Michaela Nieuwenhuizen** tied the game against Delaware.
- AU has shot 34.8 percent in overtime this season, while their opponents have shot 37.5 percent.

SOPHOMORES ON THE RISE

- **Cecily Carl, Elina Koskimies, Kaitlyn Lewis** and **Michaela Nieuwenhuizen** have stepped up in a big way this season for the Eagles, contributing 231 of AU's 548 points thus far.
- As a group, they are shooting 49.1 percent from the field, 40.7 percent from behind the arc, and are averaging 6.4 ppg and 2.6 rpg.
- Carl is second on the team with her 10.7 ppg, and is No. 3 with 4.4 rpg.
- Carl has had six games above 10 points, including tying her career-high with 21 points at Hofstra.
- Lewis leads the team from behind the arc, shooting 60 percent. She is averaging 8.6 ppg.
- Lewis has had four double-figure performances so far this season, including a career-high tally of 20 points at Hofstra.
- Koskimies is next from long range with 38 percent shooting.
- Carl and Nieuwenhuizen hit key shots in the final minute of regulation against Delaware, George Washington and Hofstra to send the games into overtime.

LEWIS, FOR THREE!

- Sophomore **Kaitlyn Lewis** is currently ranked second in the NCAA from 3-point range with her 60 percent shooting this season. She is the only Patriot League player listed in the top five of the NCAA rankings.
- Lewis has put in two perfect games from behind the arc this season, shooting 5-of-5 against UMBC and 4-of-4 at Hofstra.
- She came into the season with 11 3-pointers from the 2015-16 season, and an in-game career-high of two. Now, only nine games into her sophomore campaign, she has surpassed both of those records.

CARL IN THE HISTORY BOOKS

- For the second time in as many years, sophomore **Cecily Carl** has made her mark in the AU record books. As a freshman, she put up one of the top ten blocking performances in program history with five rejections against Lafayette.
- This year, Carl adds her name to the career record board, with her 50 blocks since her Eagle debut last year.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- Seven players have surpassed the 10-point mark so far this season, including three that have scored in the double-digits in five of the Eagles' nine games.

- All five starters put up double-figure performances against VCU during the San Juan Shootout over Thanksgiving. Senior **Lauren Crisler** led with 14 points, followed by sophomore **Cecily Carl** (11), sophomore **Kaitlyn Lewis** (11), junior **Emily Kinneston** (11), and junior **Maria Liddane** (10). The last time the Eagles put all five starters in double figures was the 2003 game at Mount St. Mary's (Spriggs 16, Schuyler 15, Salem 13, Hunt 12, and Barnes 10).

HAPPY 100TH

- The match-up against VCU marked a significant milestone for **Head Coach Megan Gebbia**, as she entered her 100th game with the Eagles. Since her arrival in 2013, Gebbia has brought AU to new heights on the national stage, most notably in 2014 when she made history with the program's first Patriot League Tournament title and NCAA Championship berth.
- Senior **Cecily Carl** also hit her 100 game mark this season during the Dec. 3 contest against William & Mary at home.

SNAPPING STREAKS

- For the first time since 2013, the Eagles opened the season with a win, as the team beat out Youngstown State on their home court on Friday, Nov. 11., 77-64. The last time the AU women opened their season with a win was the November 12, 2013, home showing against Maryland-Eastern Shore (76-69).

THE EAGLES IN NON-PL PLAY

- AU had a strong non-conference schedule this year, which will close with a pair of Big Ten matchups, as the Eagles prepare to travel to Penn State (Dec. 18) and Michigan (Dec. 22).
- The Eagles have met teams from five different conferences in the first nine games of the season: America East, Atlantic 10, Colonial Athletic, Horizon and Sun Belt.
- AU beat out two-time reigning Atlantic 10 Champs, George Washington, in Bender Arena on Dec. 7 in an overtime contest that ended in a 66-61 tally.

AMERICAN CHOSEN TO FINISH FIFTH IN THE PATRIOT LEAGUE...

AU has been slated to finish fifth in the 2016-17 Patriot League preseason poll. The Eagles closed the 2015-16 season with a seventh place finish in the league, but lost only one starter from that team, Michelle Holmes. AU returns top scorer, senior **Lauren Crisler** (9.2 ppg, 6.4 rpg), along with sophomore **Cecily Carl**, who led the team in blocks (1.3 per game, 4.7 rpg), and junior **Maria Liddane**, who led in assists and steals (4.1 assists/game, 1.1 steals/game).

UP NEXT...

The Eagles will travel to Michigan on Dec. 22 for their final game before conference play. The Patriot League schedule will kick off on Dec. 30 with a 7 p.m. tipoff at Loyola Maryland.

MEGAN GEBBIA

HEAD COACH // FOURTH SEASON

It took only one year at the helm of the American University women's basketball program for Head Coach Megan Gebbia to cement herself in the AU history books. Since her arrival in 2013, Gebbia has brought AU to new heights on the national stage, most notably in 2014 when she made history with the program's first Patriot League Tournament title and NCAA Championships berth.

Now entering her fourth year with the Eagles, Gebbia has already established a legacy of successful student-athletes, having mentored the development of two NCAA Woman of the Year nominees, two Patriot League Players of the Year, an ECAC Division I All-Star, two All-Patriot League First Team players, a Patriot League Tournament MVP and four Patriot League All-Tournament Team selections. In recognition of these successes, Gebbia was recognized as a finalist for the 2014 Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year award and earned the Patriot League Coach of the Year in 2015.

Gebbia's student-athletes have also excelled in the classroom, earning CoSIDA Academic All-American First Team and Division I-AAA ADA Scholar-Athlete of the Year honors, two consecutive Patriot League Scholar-Athlete of the Year awards, an NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship, an American University President's Award honoree, and 26 Patriot League Academic Honor Roll selections.

"Coach Gebbia has clearly proven herself as an outstanding coach, but more importantly, she has demonstrated her vast ability as a leader, mentor and role model for our student-athletes," said Dr. Billy Walker, American University Director of Athletics & Recreation. "There's no doubt in my mind that the future is bright for AU Women's Basketball."

Gebbia arrived at AU for the 2013-14 campaign and quickly established herself as one of the greats in AU coaching history, becoming the winningest first-year coach in program history (22-10 overall). American finished the season tied for second in the Patriot League regular season play, registering a 14-4 record in the conference and advancing to the tournament semifinals.

In just one year, Gebbia took a team that ranked fifth in the conference in scoring defense to fifth in the nation for the 2013-14 season. She also helped develop three All-Patriot League selections in Alexis Dobbs, Jen Dumiak and Arron Zimmerman.

Her success continued in 2014-15, as the team posted a 24-9 overall record to set a program record for single-season victories. Despite a slow start to the season, the Eagles turned things around in time for the start of their conference schedule, posting a 16-2 record in the Patriot League to claim the regular-season title. AU's run through the league included a 10-0 record in the month of February, which laid the foundation for the Eagles' historical tournament run.

A victory over Lehigh secured the program's first-ever Patriot League Tournament title and advancement into the NCAA Tournament as a No. 14 seed.

Gebbia currently holds an overall winning percentage of .563 and .648 in regular-season Patriot League play.

Gebbia arrived at American after spending the previous 10 seasons at Marist College, serving as the associate head coach for her last seven seasons. While there, she aided in the development of 36 student-athletes who earned accolades throughout their careers from the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference and the Metropolitan Writers Association, including 10 All-MAAC honorees and five major award winners. Gebbia was also a part of eight straight, nine overall, MAAC Championships. In 2006-07, Marist upset Ohio State and Middle Tennessee State en route to the school's first-ever Sweet Sixteen appearance. The team became just the third No. 13 seed in NCAA history to make it to the round of 16.

Prior to joining Marist, Gebbia served as an assistant at Wright State for the 2002-03 season, and was in the same role at UMBC from 1996-2002. While at UMBC, she was responsible for signing two Street and Smith All-American honorable mentions, a conference Rookie of the Year and two All-Conference selections. She also served as an assistant at American under Jeff Thatcher for the 1995-96 season, during which the Eagles went 16-12.

Gebbia began her coaching career at her alma mater, Towson, and served as team captain of the Tigers' squad during her senior season. She is a native of Frederick, Md.
