UCLA earns top spot in preseason poll

BOWLING GREEN, OHIO (December 9, 2018) – UCLA, winner of the 2018 NCAA National Collegiate Women's Gymnastics Championship, earned the top spot in the 2019 preseason poll as voted on by the coaches of the Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association. The Bruins narrowly edged out Oklahoma, which received the most first-place votes.
