After capturing the 2013 Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Regular Season Championship and MAAC Tournament Championship in its first season in the league, Monmouth University enters the NCAA Women's Soccer Championships with a first round match at No. 24 Penn State. The Hawks, who were selected third in the MAAC Preseason Coaches Poll, went unbeaten in league play (8-0-2), allowing just three goals in 10 regular season games, and three games during the conference tournament.

Monmouth, on a 14-game unbeaten streak with eight straight shutouts, has tied a school-record with 17 wins so far this season, set a new shutout record (16) and is on pace to set a new program-mark for goals allowed in a campaign.

IT'S TOURNEY TIME!

Monmouth, which qualified for a league-best 15 overall postseason tournaments as a member of the Northeast Conference, has now appeared in 13 postseasons under head coach Krissy Turner, including seven of the last eight overall. The Hawks won conference championships in 2007 after capturing the regular season championship, and again in 2009 as the number-two seed as a member of the NEC. In its first season in the MAAC, the Hawks claimed both the regular season and tournament titles.

Monmouth is now 10-10 in conference postseason history under current head coach Krissy Turner. Overall, in conference postseason history, the Hawks are a combined 15-11, dating back to 1995.

ALL-CONFERENCE

Under Coach Turner, Monmouth has generated 72 All-Conference players, as 10 Hawks earned league recognition in 2013. First-team players include Dana Costello, Ashley Lewis, Alexis McTamney, Alexa Freguletti, Monique Goncalves and Brianne Boyle, while Kim Clemmer and Monique Plescia earned second-team. The Hawks also placed McTamney and Julie Spracklin on the MAAC All-Rookie Team.

MONMOUTH'S THIRD TRIP TO THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

Following conference championships in 2007 and 2009 (Maryland) as members of the NEC, Monmouth qualified for the NCAA Championships. This is the Hawks' third trip all-time to the NCAA Tournament, and second trip to Penn State (2007).

CONTINUED SUCCESS

Behind its 17 victories this season, Monmouth has posted a double-digit win total for an eighth straight season. The last season MU did not post a double-digit win total was 2005.

UNBEATEN STREAK

The Hawks enter the NCAA Championships on a 14-game unbeaten streak. MU's 14-game unbeaten run is the second-longest unbeaten streak in program history. The longest unbeaten streak in MU history came during the 1994-95 seasons (17). Monmouth's last defeat came at Hofstra (2-1) on Friday, September 13.

WIN RECORD

Monmouth has tied the program record for wins in a single season with 17. The original record of 17 victories was set in 1994, and tied during both the 1995 and 1996 campaigns. During that three year span, the Hawks went a combined 51-11. Monmouth has surpassed the single-season record under head coach Krissy Turner, whose 2009 side won 15 matches.

UNDEFEATED AT HOME

Monmouth registered a 9-0 record at home on The Great Lawn this season, the sixth time in program history the Hawks went undefeated at home. The nine victories tied for the second-most home wins in a single season, as the Hawks went 10-0 in 1996, and 9-0 in 1988.

SHE'S A KEEPER!

Fifth-year senior goalkeeper Ashley Lewis, who won the starting job during the spring of 2013, a two-time MAAC Defensive Player of the Week and the 2013 MAAC Goalkeeper of the Year, has started 18 matches for the Hawks this year, posting 13 individual clean sheets, a 0.33 goals-against-average, and an .891 save percentage. Lewis, who ranks third in the NCAA (as of 11/11) in GAA, allowed six goals in the regular season. She also ranks sixth in save percentage (0.891).

Junior goalkeeper Jocelyn McCoy, an NEC All-Rookie Team selection in 2011, has appeared in three matches this season, all shutouts. McCoy, who has appeared in 33 career matches, including 31 starts, has registered a career goals-against-average of 1.02, a .776 save percentage and 13 shutouts.

UPPERCLASSMEN / UNDERCLASSMEN

Monmouth regularly starts five upperclassmen, as seniors Dana Costello, Monique Plescia and Ashley Lewis and juniors Alexa Freguletti and Kim Clemmer are routinely in the lineup. On the other hand, the Hawks also routinely start five freshmen and sophomores.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE

In its history, Monmouth women's soccer has built a tradition of excellence on the field. The Hawks have won conference regular season titles in 1995, 1996, 2000, 2007 and 2013. Added to its hardware, MU won the Northeast Conference championship trophy four times in the program's annals (1995, 1996, 2007, 2009), and finished as runner-ups in 2002 and 2006. In 2007, the women made their first NCAA Tournament appearance, and coupled that feat in 2009. This season marks the Hawks' first NCAA trip as a member of the MAAC, and the Blue & White's third appearance overall.

THE REIGN OF TURNER

In her 16th season at the helm, Head Coach Krissy Turner has produced another top team. Her Monmouth coaching record currently stands at 176-99-29 (.627 win%).

SHUT OUTS

The Hawks have recorded 16 shutouts on the year, surpassing the program-record of 15 shutouts set in 1995.

DEFENDING THE NET

Monmouth has allowed just six total goals this season, including just a pair in MAAC matches. The Hawks, who allowed a program-low nine goals in 1995, ranked first in the MAAC in goals allowed, and rank first in the NCAA in goals-against-average (0.293).

FROSH PHENOM

Freshman forward Alexis McTamney, who netted 58 goals as a senior at Bordentown Regional High School and 125 during her prep career, has a team-high 27 points on a team-best 11 goals (five game-winners). McTamney, a four-time MAAC Rookie of the Week winner and the MAAC Rookie of the Year, added an assist in her first career game with the Blue & White, and in her second career start (vs. Seton Hall), netted a pair of goals.

McTamney's 27 points is the highest freshman point total at MU since Andrea Lopez notched 36 points on 13 goals and 10 assists in 2006, en route to being named both the NEC Rookie and Player of the Year.

OFFENSIVE UNIT

This season marks the first time since the 2009 season that five different Hawks posted a double-digit point total. In 2009, Monmouth's last conference championship season, Mary Wilks posted a team-high 31 points, while Andrea Lopez (17), Courtney Snyder (11), Ali Kliment (10) and BrieAnne Nomejko (10) all scored in double figures.

OFFENSIVE THREATS

The quintet of Alexis McTamney, Dana Costello, Julie Spracklin, Monique Plescia and Alexa Freguletti have combined for 90 points, behind 33 goals and 24 assists - that point total accounts for 84% of the Hawks' offensive output on the year.

DYNAMIC DUO

Freshman Alexis McTamney (27 points) and senior Dana Costello (22 points) are the first Monmouth duo to score 20+ points in a season since 2006, when Andrea Lopez (36) and Amy Hoyer (20) accomplished the feat.

COMING OUT PARTIES

Over the last three seasons, junior Monique Plescia has added 45 points for the Hawks, including 19 goals, while classmate Dana Costello has posted her fourth straight double-digit point season (posted a career-best 23 points in 2012). Plescia's seven scores this season, including the pair of tallys in the MAAC Tournament, ties her career-high.

SUSTAINABILITY

Three-time team captain senior Dana Costello's 82 career points places her eighth all-time in Monmouth history, two points behind Andrea Lopez (84; 2006-09) for seventh place on the total points chart. Costello's 27 career goals is tied for 10th in program history with former All-American Jeannette Goepfert, while her 28 assists ranks second individually, only behind Christie (Pearce) Rampone.

The Monmouth career leader in total points (212), goals (79) and assists (54) belongs to Christie (Pearce) Rampone, the US Women's National Team captain, who starred for the Hawks as a forward from 1993-96.

CURRENT NON-SCORING STREAK

Monmouth has not allowed a goal in the last 763:58 minutes of action. The last allowed score came with 3:58 remaining in regulation at Iona, a game that ended 1-1 following double overtime.

WINNING IN THE CLASSROOM TOO

In 2012, Monmouth (3.33 GPA) earned its 15th straight NSCAA Team Academic Award, given to Division I programs that have a 3.0 cumulative team GPA or higher. Last year, the women's soccer team posted a 3.481 (Fall, 2012) mark and 3.478 (Spring, 2013), which will put it in line for a 16th consecutive award. The marks were tops in both semesters among Monmouth athletic teams.

PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

Senior forward Dana Costello, a two-time first-team all-conference player in the NEC, senior midfielder Alexandra Baca, a 2012 All-NEC First Team member, and junior back Alexa Freguletti, also a first-team all-league player in 2012, were all named to the Preseason All-MAAC Team by the league's coaches.

CHANGE OF POSITION, SAME IMPACT

Sophomore Monique Goncalves earned All-Rookie honors a season ago as a forward, netting four goals, including a pair of game-winners, and an assist for nine points, as a freshman. This season, Goncalves was asked to move to back and has proven to be one of Monmouth's top defenders, and earned First Team All-MAAC honors as a back.
