## Match Notes

Nittany Lions Make 2015 Season Debut The No. 26 Penn State men's tennis team makes their 2015 season debut as they travel to Lexington, Ky. for the ITA Kickoff Weekend event. The Nittany Lions return to the ITA Kickoff Weekend for the first time since 2009. Penn State will take on No. 19 Kentucky on Friday at 1 p.m. On Saturday, the Nittany Lions will face either No. 20 USF or No. 25 Vanderbilt. The winners of Friday's matches will play at 5 p.m. on Saturday, with a consolation match being played at 1 p.m.

#### Next Up for Penn State

Penn State will make their home debut on Sunday, February 1 in the program's first ever triple-header. The action begins at 9 a.m. against Penn, followed by matches against James Madison and Temple. The Nittany Lions will look to repeat their home success from last spring, when they went 15-0.

#### Nittany Lions in the ITA Polls

Penn State opens the season ranked 26th in the ITA Poll, their highest rank ever to begin a season. Before last season, the Nittany Lions were never ranked above 34 at any point in the season. Sophomore Nika Dolidze and senior Tomas Hanzlik are ranked 59th in the ITA Doubles Poll.

#### Solid Fall Season

The Nittany Lions sent team members to five different tournaments, including the Penn Invitational, ITA All-American Championships, ITA Atlantic Regional, USTA Collegiate Clay Court Invitational and William & Mary Invitational. Six different Nittany Lions won at least four matches. Sophomore Aws Laaribi and senior Roman Trkulja had a strong fall in doubles, going 5-3.

#### Nittany Lion to Watch

Senior Tomas Hanzlik won six matches this fall after sitting out last spring with an injury. He reached the Round of 16 at the ITA Atlantic Regional this fall. The Prague, Czech Republic native is one win away from 50 career victories.

# **New ITA Match Format**

The Intercollegiate Tennis Association introduced a new match format for the 2015 season

- No ad scoring in singles or doubles
- No warm-up with opponents before singles or doubles
- Three doubles matches, each match one set to 6, with a tiebreaker at 6-6.
- Six singles matches, each match two out of three sets to 6, tiebreaker at 6-6.
- First team to 4 points wins the team match
