OPENING TIP: This is the 56th all-time meeting between Northwestern and Penn State ... PSU leads the series, 35-20.

- NU is looking for its first win in Happy Valley since Dec. 27,
- Head coach Chris Collins is 5-8 against the Nittany Lions since taking over the program in 2013-14.
- When meeting twice in the regular season, the two teams have split the last five series, with NU recording the last season sweep in 2012 (68-56, 67-66).

LAST TIME OUT: Northwestern swept the regular season series against Nebraska, winning 77-65 on Wednesday night (Feb. 22) inside Welsh-Ryan Arena ... The Wildcats have won five straight against the Cornhuskers ... NU took its largest lead of 21 points with 7:27 to play in the second half in the wire-to-wire win.

- Pete Nance led the team scoring 20 points (8-11, 4-5 3fg) and set a career-high in made threes. He added five boards and tied a career-high with five assists. He recorded his second 20/5/5 game of the season (Providence - 20/5/5). The last Wildcat to record two or more 20/5/5 games in the same season was John Shurna (3) in 2011-12.
- Boo Buie (15), Chase Audige (15) and Ty Berry (10) joined Nance in double figures. Audige added a season-high five
- NU tied its season-high drilling 13 threes, which it set earlier this season against Nebraska. NU last recorded two conference games with 13 or more threes in the same season in 2011-12 (Ohio State - 13, Penn State - 15).

BOO!: Boo Buie ranks sixth in the Big Ten and 80th nationally averaging 4.4 assists per game ... Buie ranks sixth in the conference with a 2.38 assist-to-turnover-ratio.

- His 81.2% free throw percentage ranks third in the league.
- He has scored 15+ points in five of the last seven games.
- Buie is second on the team averaging 15.1 points per game.

LAST MEETING: NU fell to Penn State 74-70 in the first game of the season series on Jan. 5, 2022. The Wildcats led by 10 points with 10 minutes to play, but were unable to hold on.

- Boo Buie scored a game-high 22 points on 8-of-14 shooting with five threes and eight assists.
- Pete Nance (15) and Robbie Beran (11) also scored in double figures.

TURNOVER MARGINS: The Wildcats' 14.0% turnover rate is the sixth-lowest total in DI, per KenPom. They also rank second in the Big Ten in both average turnover margin (4.2) and rank second in the conference and in the country with a 1.63 assist to turnover ratio.

- Northwestern currently ranks fourth in the conference at 6.9 steals per game. Per KenPom, the 'Cats also rank sixth in the nation with a 6.8% steal percentage.
- Under Chris Collins, the Wildcats have finished ranked in the Top-35 of KenPom's turnover percentage category in four of the last six seasons.

BOARD MEN: Northwestern's 9.81 offensive rebounds per game ranks seventh in the Big Ten. The Wildcats grabbed 10+ offensive rebounds in a four-game stretch from Jan. 9-18 (averaging 14.5 offensive boards per game) ... NU is averaging 10.2 offensive rebounds so far in conference play, which ranks third in the Big Ten ... The Wildcats tallied 16 offensive rebounds in their Feb. 8 win over Indiana.

NO EASY NIGHTS: From Jan. 15-23, the Wildcats faced three Top-10 opponents in a row (#10 Michigan State, #8 Wisconsin and #4 Purdue) for the first time in program history. According to the latest AP Poll (Feb. 21), NU will not face another ranked opponent in its last third games after playing back-to-back games against ranked foes in Illinois and Purdue. According to KenPom, Northwestern has the 41st toughest schedule in the country this





MORE NOTES...

DYNAMIC DUO: Northwestern has two players that rank in the Top-20 in the conference in points per game ... Pete Nance leads the team with 15.1 ppg (12th in conference), while Boo Buie ranks behind him in 14th at 15.0 ppg. NU hasn't had two 15.0+ ppg scorers in the same season since Jon Shurna (20.0) and Drew Crawford (16.1) in 2011-12.

YOUNG, THE GIANT: Ryan Young is fourth on the team in scoring this season, averaging 8.8 points per game coming off the bench ... In a four-game stretch from Jan. 15-26, Young averaged 12.5 points and 5.0 rebounds.

- Young has been consistently getting to the free-throw line for the Wildcats, ranking 25th in the nation (fourth in the Big Ten) with 6.6 fouls drawn per 40 minutes, per KenPom, and leading NU with 88 free throw attempts.
- During his career, Northwestern is 5-0 in games in which Young has scored 18+ points.
- Young scored 20 points on a perfect 8-of-8 shooting vs. High Point (Nov. 12) ... The last Wildcat to finish perfect from the field on at least eight FG attempts was Dererk Pardon on Feb 1, 2018 at Wisconsin (8-of-8, 17 points).
- Young led the team with 41 offensive rebounds last season, finishing in the Top 15 in the Big Ten in the category ... He also finished second on the team with 10 blocks, 114 rebounds, and 45 made free throws.

FIRST-YEAR PHENOM: Julian Roper II leads all Big Ten first-year guards with 29 offensive rebounds this season.

Roper ranks second among Big Ten first-years in steals (25)
 ... Also has a 3% steal percentage, second-best on the team behind Chase Audige.

HE'S COMING HOME: Evanston native **Elyjah Williams** returns to his hometown this year as a graduate transfer from Fairleigh Dickinson. Williams averaged 13.9 points, 7.6 rebounds, and 1.5 blocks per game last season, shooting 55.6% from the field and 42.0% 3PT. In total, Williams played in 116 games and made 74 starts across four seasons with the Knights.

RETURN OF THE 'CATS: Chris Collins' squad is among the most experienced in the Big Ten heading into this season. The Wildcats returned four starters for the second-consecutive season, tied for second-most in the conference. The 'Cats return:

- 78.1% of scoring from last season, second in the conference behind Purdue.
- 73.7% of minutes, third most in the Big Ten
- 69.1% of rebounds, third in conference.
- 84.1% of assists, second in Big Ten behind Purdue, led by team assist-leader Boo Buie (4.0 APG). Buie's 4.0 APG ranked seventh-best in the Big Ten last season.

B1G START: Northwestern opened Big Ten play with a 67-61 win at Maryland on Dec. 5 ... It marked NU's first win at Maryland in program history ... The Wildcats held Maryland to 28.8% shooting (17-of-59) from the field, Maryland's lowest shooting percentage since joining the Big Ten.

STOLE THE SHOW: Northwestern generated 19 turnovers in its season opener vs. Eastern Illinois. The Wildcats finished with 16 steals, the most since Dec. 20, 2007 against Howard (18 steals).

 Robbie Beran and Boo Buie both set career highs with five steals apiece ... It marked the first time two Wildcats had five steals in the same game since at least 2010. **NANCE BREAKOUT:** Pete Nance leads the team averaging 15.1 points, 6.4 rebounds, and 1.1 blocks per game while shooting 49.5% from the field and 43.8% from three.

- Nance scored a career-high 28 points vs. Maryland on Jan.
 12 ... In that game, he also set career highs in field goals
 (10) and minutes (40), while tying career highs in made
 3-pointers (3) and free throws (3).
- Nance has recorded a team-high four double-doubles this season (9th in Big Ten), including two with 20+ points and has led the team in scoring seven times.
- Nance is 35 points away from 1,000 in his career. He would become the 38th player in program history to reach the milestone.

AUDIGE SIEGE: Chase Audige ranks second in the Big Ten averaging 1.88 steals per game ... He also ranks third in the conference with a 3.9% steal percentage.

- Audige is currently one of three players in the Big Ten averaging 10+ points, 4.0+ rebounds, and 1.5+ steals per game this season.
- Audige has five 20-point games in an NU uniform, including two this season ... He scored a season-high 23 points on 10-of-17 shooting vs. Wisconsin on Jan. 18 and scored 20 points on Jan. 9 at #13 Ohio State.
- Audige led the Wildcats in scoring (12.3 points per game) in his first year with the program in 2020-21 ... the last Wildcat to average over 12 points per game in their first season of action for Northwestern was Kevin Coble in the 2006-07 season (13.4 ppg).

TOP-10 TAKEDOWN: Northwestern defeated #10 Michigan State, 64-62, at the Breslin Center on Jan. 15 for its first ranked win of the season, snapping an eight-game skid in East Lansing.

- Marked the second-straight season in which NU knocked off a Top-10 ranked Michigan State team ... Also marked the 'Cats' third win over an AP Top-10 opponent under Chris Collins (also vs. #4 MSU on Dec. 20, 2020 and at #7 Wisconsin on Feb. 12, 2017).
- Northwestern's fifth win in program history on the road vs. a Top-10 opponent (h/t @collegebb_ref).
- Northwestern forced 17 Spartan turnovers (including 12 in the first half), which led to 16 Wildcat points.
- Ryan Young made his first start of the season and led the team with 18 points, eight rebounds, and two steals.

20/20 EXPERIENCE: Ty Berry led the way with a career-high 23 points at Ohio State, while **Pete Nance** and **Chase Audige** added 20 points apiece. They are first Wildcat trio with 20+ points each in the same game since Vic Law, Ryan Taylor, and AJ Turner did so against La Salle on Nov. 23, 2018 ... They are also the first to do so in a conference game in the Chris Collins era (2013-present).

The Wildcats have had multiple players finish with 20+ points in the same game three times already this season ... Pete Nance (22) and Ryan Young (20) did so in the win over High Point on Nov. 12, while Nance (20) and Boo Buie (23) also did so in the setback vs. Providence on Nov. 22.

STREAKING: Northwestern went on a three-game B1G win streak, defeating Rutgers (79-78 0T), Nebraska (87-63) and Indiana (59-51). The Cats defeated Rutgers in overtime before RU went on a four-game winning streak against AP ranked teams. Boo Buie led the team in scoring over the stretch, averaging 21.0 points per game.

CHRIS COLLINS

SULLIVAN-UBBEN HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Chris Collins is in his ninth season at Northwestern. He was named the University's 24th head men's basketball coach on March 27, 2013.

Collins guided the Wildcats to heights never before reached during the 2016-17 season. The unforgettable campaign saw Northwestern accumulate a school-record 24 wins while earning the program's first NCAA tournament berth and victory in school history.

NU captured the nation's attention with its outstanding start to the season. An 18-4 start, including a six-game winning streak in Big Ten Conference play – the program's first since 1933 – saw the team crack the top 25 of the AP poll on Jan. 30, the team's first national ranking in seven years. NU went on to record 10 wins in league play, its most since the 1932-33 campaign.

NU was rewarded with an NCAA tournament berth on Selection Sunday and the Wildcats earned a 68-66 victory over Vanderbilt in an opening-round contest in Salt Lake City. Northwestern pushed second-ranked and eventual national runner-up Gonzaga to the limits in the second round before eventually suffering a narrow loss.

Collins' contributions to the program were rewarded by being named one of four national finalists for the Naismith Men's Coach of the Year award. Following the season, Collins agreed to a contract extension that runs through the 2024-25 campaign.

Collins came to Evanston after serving on the coaching staff at Duke since July 22, 2000. He was promoted to Associate Head Coach in the summer of 2008. During Collins' 13 seasons on the Blue Devils' staff, Duke posted an overall record of 385-77 while recording eight ACC tournament championships, four ACC regular season titles, eight in-season tournament titles and national championships in 2001 and 2010.

Before returning to his alma mater, Collins served as an assistant coach at Seton Hall for two years with Tommy Amaker. Collins spent the 1997-98 season as an assistant with the WNBA's Detroit Shock.

While attending Duke, Collins was a team captain as a senior and fouryear letterman from 1993-96. He ranks 11th among Duke's all-time leaders in three-point field goals (209) and 10th in three-point field goal attempts (539). Collins averaged 9.1 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.4 assists as a collegian. He earned second-team All-ACC honors as a senior.

Collins is the son of former NBA All-Star, Doug Collins, who is currently a senior advisor for the Chicago Bulls. A native of nearby Northbrook, Illinois, Collins is a 1996 graduate of Duke with a bachelor's degree in sociology.

2021-22: Recorded a career-high five steals while also leading the team in points (17) and assists (six) against Eastern Illinois (11/9) ... Led the team with seven assists while scoring 19 points against High Point (11/12) ... Dished out a career-high nine assists along with 13 points in a win over New Orleans (11/16) ... Scored a game-high 23 points on 8-of-15 shooting against Providence (11/22) ... Scored a game-high 22 points and tallied six assists to help defeat Georgia (11/23) ... Recorded 16 points, five rebounds, and four assists in a win over Maryland (12/5) ... Scored 11 points in 20 minutes against Ill. Springfield (12/20) ... Chipped in 12 points and four assists against Michigan State (1/2) ... Recorded team highs with 22 points and eight assists against Penn State (1/5) ... Tallied eight assists against Ohio State (1/9) ... Scored a team-high 18 points, scoring six of the team's nine points in overtime in a win over Rutgers (2/1) ... Scored a game and season-high 27 points with a career-best six threes in a win at Nebraska (2/5).

2020-21: Led the team with 41 made threes and 96 assists ... Finished in the Top 10 in assists per game in the Big Ten ... Was one of four Wildcats to average double figures in scoring (10.3 ppg) ... Named the Big Ten Player of the Week for the first time in his career after scoring a career-high 30 points in a win over #4 Michigan State (12/20).

COLLINS on BUIE...

"We all know what Boo needs to be for us to be successful. He's our catalyst, he's the guy with the ball-our point guard/our quarterback. We expect him to be a top-half point guard in this league, and to be the guy who runs the show for us.
